KIRTI KULHARI-LED CAST OFFSETS

WHAT THE FILM LACKS IN DEPTH

n unpretentious, medium-intensity drama such as Shaadisthan has an intrinsic advantage. The film's constricted bandwidth allows first-time director Raj Singh Chaudhary to exercise firm control on the interplay of the modest narrative tools at his disposal. Since there isn't a whole lot to unpack in the 90-minute Shaadisthan, streaming on Disney+Hotstar, the film is never in danger of turning into an unseemly, my-way-or-the-highway scramble.

It unravels like a thin, transparent wrapper that readily reveals its contents. Expectations are, therefore, always pegged at a reasonable level. Some might find Shaadisthan a tad bland and superficial, and not entirely unjustifiably, but the uncluttered and surprisingly decent film derives palpable benefits from the fact that it is happy to stay within its chosen limitations.

Chaudhary, who wrote the screenplay for and played a key onscreen role in Anurag Kashyap's Gulaal, displays firm grip on this clash-oftwo-worlds tale rendered in the form of a road movie that rarely veers off course.

A conservative middle-class family hitches a Mumbai-to-Ajmer ride with a band of footloose musicians on their way to a show. In the course of the uneasy journey, there is little love lost between the two groups aboard a camper van. Rising tensions engender the possibility of course corrections.

The eventual outcome of the voyage is predictable all right, but the means that Shaadisthan employs is neither in-your-face nor overly all-knowing. The debate that it stokes on the freedom of women to choose how they want to fight/negotiate/absorb the ill effects of patriarchy allows space for enough muddy greys for it not to be a black and white affair.

The cast, spearheaded by the dependable Kirti Kulhari and composed of several non-starry actors who hold their own, is solid enough to offset what the film lacks by way of depth. Together, they deliver a believable, if not dazzling, tale in which two women, a young Mumbai girl a day away from turning 18 and her docile mother who may have left her best behind, have to reckon with impulses that they, especially the older of the two ladies, aren't accustomed to confronting because the man who calls the shots in the Sharma household is oblivious to their emotional needs.

Arshi Sharma (Medha Shankar) has reason to hate her overbearing father (Rajan Modi) more than any other man in the world. But her submissive mom (Nivedita Bhattacharya, serving as a strong and steady foil for Kulhari) is content to do her husband's bidding without ever pausing to wonder if her unquestioning marital fealty has been worth the years that she has wasted on it. The three are on their way to the wedding of the man's nephew in Ajmer.

A minor act of rebellion by the disgruntled Arshi has resulted in the family missing their flight. Her about-to-wed cousin Cholu (Nishank





Verma) activates Plan B, under which she and her parents travel with four members of a band in their souped-up, colour-spangled minivan all the way to Ajmer. One of the musicians is Cholu's pal and the band is scheduled to perform at the wedding.

The lively, amiable quartet is made up of lead singer Sasha (Kulhari) and three easy-going men - Freddie (Apurv Dogra), Jigme (Shenpenn Khymsar) and Imaad (Ajay Jayanthi). Their fancy-free ways - they guzzle beer and smoke non-stop - do not go down well with Arshi's fretful, ultra-orthodox dad, who is worried stiff that his wife and daughter might not be safe in the company of the wayward musicians.

On the way, the vehicle makes a stopover in an Udaipur home-cumhotel owned by a man named Tiger (Kay Kay Menon in a special appearance), who ensures they have a good time while they are there. The break leads to an unplanned delay and an unintended detour. Arshi's mother is alarmed no end. Separated from her husband for a bit, she is at her wit's end.

Sasha, unable to fathom why the lady is so flustered, has a chat with her. The conversation is intercut with another that Imaad has with Arshi. Imaad wonders why the girl does not put up a fight. As two opposing worldviews collide, it becomes abundantly clear that Arshi is ready to rebel while her mother is completely at ease with being who she is.

As it juxtaposes two dissimilar worlds, Shaadisthan lets both its flanks roll out in their own ways without being overly judgmental about either. It might be easy to see on which side of the debate the filmmaker stands, but he lets the unadventurous Sharmas, especially the young girl and her submissive mom, have their say when the time is ripe. The musicians hold the upper hand for the most part because they are devoid of any inhibitions and their relationships have no strings attached. But every point that they make isn't necessarily at the expense of Arshi and Mrs Sharma. Neither the lady's given name nor her husband's is uttered even once because her identity is yoked to that of the man she is married to and she, on her part, is conditioned against mentioning her husband by name.

Though the men in the film aren't entirely unimportant, Shaadisthan eventually boils down to being a story of three women - a troubled teenager, a fiercely independent singer and a dutiful homemaker who appears to know no other way of living. All three eventually learn a little from each other.

This is what makes this film markedly different from many other gender-role dramas that Hindi cinema produces. The characters do not point fingers at each other. They have polite conversations. So, don't expect high drama and startling epiphanies. Look instead for the little parries and thrusts strewn across the film. While Sasha is the cocky one here, Mrs. Sharma, too, gets a shot at a proper comeback after she has been at the receiving end of much ribbing.

SUNIL GROVER SHARES HOW HE MAKES COMEDY SEEM SO EASY



HEARTWARMING SPORTS DRAMA

ZIPS ALONG NICELY

t isn't often that a movie inspires instant collective action. It is even rarer for a film to make a social impact before an audience has seen it. Skater Girl, out on Netflix, is one such. It has had a lasting effect on Khempur, which isn't even a dot on the map. The nondescript Rajasthan village located 45 km from Udaipur now has a community skatepark of its own where girls, the audience is told at the end of the film, "are encouraged to dream".

Directed by debutante Manjari Makijany, Skater Girl is a simple and heartwarming sports drama that zips along nicely and steers clear of the timeworn methods that Bollywood reserves for the underdogfighting-all-odds genre. It revolves around an impoverished tribal teenager (newcomer Rachel Saanchita Gupta) who discovers skateboarding and makes a dash for freedom.

The girl, Prerna Bhil, has stopped going to school because she has no money to buy textbooks. What's worse is that her father is hell bent on marrying her off. She is trapped in a conservative, stratified society. Skateboarding promises to set her free.

She has to get the better of poverty and patriarchy, surmount other social obstacles and negotiate sharp caste barriers on her way to fulfilling her desire to compete in a national skateboarding event that could change her life forever.

Skater Girl, written by the director and her sister Vinati Makijany, blends a realistic account of life in an actual village with elements of restrained fiction while keeping overt melodrama at bay. The storyline may not abound in major surprises but it doesn't succumb to cliches either. The direct, unshowy methods that the film employs to get its point across enhance its efficacy and relatability.

The cast of Skater Girl includes Waheeda Rehman in a special appearance. The veteran actress requires all of two sequences to lend the story a strong emotional context. All the other performances in the film ring true thanks to actors who make a fair fist of seamlessly merging with the milieu.

The young boys and girls of Khempur learn to express themselves through a new sport brought into their midst by a 34-year-old Indian-British girl, Jessica (Amy Maghera). The latter has arrived in the village on a personal mission. Soon thereafter, a friend from Los Angeles, Erick (Jonathan Readwin), reaches the place on a skateboard and opens an avenue for the children.

It isn't, however, a smooth ride for Prerna despite the constant support she receives from her spunky kid brother Ankush (Shafin Patel). Her precarious plight - she is a bundle of fears, misgivings and doubts - reflects the enormity of the hurdles that a girl like her has to inevitably deal with before she can mount a skateboard, let alone take up the sport in right earnest. Her stern father (Ambrish Saxena) sees her as





no more than a helping hand for his wife (Swati Das), around the house and in the kitchen, until it is time to send her away as a bride. Prerna's growing friendship with an upper-caste boy Subodh (Vinayak Gupta) upsets the latter's teacher-father (Anurag Arora) just as much as it gets her own father's goat.

Breaching caste lines here is as difficult as getting the village folk to accept the girl's new-found passion for skateboarding. The replacement of the flat wooden carts that the children use as indigenous playthings by something as alien and empowering as skateboards represents a massive leap that isn't taken kindly to by the conservative community. The skateboarders and their mentors soon run into a volley of protests.

The whole village is up in arms against the kids because, in the excitement of discovering a new sport, not only do they give school a miss, they also begin to cause minor mishaps all around the village. The disruptive nature of skateboarding, a sport without rules that allows the participants to push the limits of what is possible, shatters the calm of the sleepy, dusty hamlet where demarcations - the most glaring of them is manifested by the segregated water handpump for the low caste villagers - are etched in stone.

"No matter where you go in the world everybody hates skateboards," Erick quips. In another scene, the Maharani (Waheeda Rehman) reminds Jessica that her people are averse to change. When matters come to a head, Erick and Jessica are left with no option but to attempt the seemingly impossible - carve out a dedicated space for the budding, over-enthusiastic skateboarders.

Many stumbles and hiccups later, the two visitors are ready with a plan that pave the way for the children to hit the ground running. A few of the skatepark builders and the skateboarding mentors are integrated into the film's plot.

One cannot be faulted for wondering if Skater Girl is another of those well-meaning films that end up propounding a Saviour Syndrome. To be fair, it is mindful of the pitfall. Jessica, whose real reasons for being in Khempur are revealed late in the film, is aware that, no matter what, she isn't the one around here who knows best. In a scene at a defining juncture of the story, she says to Erick: "Do I really know what's best for them? I am an outsider. Maybe I should stop interfering in their lives."

But she and Prerna, who graduates beyond the hand-holding stage once she decides to assert her own agency, have gone too far down the path of quiet rebellion to pull away from the process of emancipation set in motion by the free-spirited, rustic skateboarders. It takes some doing for the village children to master the many tricks of skateboarding but, as in the case of everything else that life throws at them, they are naturally adept at taking the rough with the smooth.



MSK Prasad reveals why Rohit Sharma was promoted as opener in Test format



ROHIT WILL BE SEEN IN ACTION IN THE INAUGURAL WORLD TEST CHAMPIONSHIP (WTC) FINAL AGAINST NEW ZEALAND, SCHEDULED TO START FROM JUNE 18TH IN SOUTHAMPTON

Former chief selector MSK Prasad has opened up on Rohit Sharma's meteoric rise in the Test format, saying that the team management was confident about his ability to perform in red-ball cricket. Just like his white-ball stint with India, Rohit initially struggled to cement his place in the Test format. However, it's been a completely different story since his promotion to the top. In his maiden Test as an opener, Rohit scored 176 and 127 in the first Test against South Africa. He followed up with scores of 14 and 212, securing his place in Indian whites. In an exclusive MSK Prasad revealed how Rohit was assigned the role in the traditional format.

"Rohit's Test career was full of ups and downs but his ODI performance, especially after 2016-17, shot up in a phenomenal way. His stint in white-ball cricket was on another level. With Cheteshwar Pujara, Ajinkya Rahane, Virat Kohli and Hanuma Vihari in the middle order, we thought Rohit would be a good fit at the top in place of Murali Vijay. "After Rohit's dream run in the 2019 World Cup, we thought

Rohit would definitely perform in Test cricket and decided to make him an opener in the South Africa series. And the rest is history. I had a chat with Kohli and Shastri, and it was a joint decision to assign him the role," Prasad told media.

"Rohit grabbed the opportunity with both hands and notched up a brilliant double century. If you perform in Test cricket, you're labelled as a 'complete player'. Rohit was 'more than happy' to start the innings in the Test format," he further said. The 34-year-old currently averages 79.52 in 18 home Tests, with seven tons and six half-centuries under his belt. Overall, the Mumbaikar has donned 38 Test caps, where he has scored 2615 runs at 46.69.

Rohit will be seen in action in the inaugural World Test Championship (WTC) final against New Zealand, scheduled to start from June 18th in Southampton. Rohit has secured his position at the top but the team management is spoilt for choices over his opening partner, with young Shubman Gill and technically sound Mayank Agarwal in their ranks.

New Zealand have advantage but we are mentally prepared, says Ajinkya Rahane



India vice-captain Ajinkya Rahane on Wednesday admitted New Zealand would go into the World Test Championship (WTC) final with the advantage of having played two Tests in England, but said his teammates are prepared to face the challenge of playing a one-off Test without a competitive game.

"They are a quality team. We are not going to take them lightly. Yes they played two Test matches against England before the final, so they have this advantage. But as I said this final is all about whoever is going to give their best for the next five days -- in each and every session," said Rahane. He pointed out that the Kiwis have all the bases covered.

India will head into the WTC final with a few practice sessions that Rahane described as being good. A poor start may not give them the chance to come back as it did in Australia where they played four Test matches and could bounce back from 36 all out and the crushing loss in the first Test by winning two of the next three Tests under Rahane. "I feel it is a mental thing, if you can switch mentally and adapt to it quickly. That is really important. Yes, it is a one-off game but as I said we want to take it as another game, not to think of it as a final. We don't to put too pressure on ourselves," he added. "What is important for us is to start well. We have been playing well and consistent cricket." The 33-year-old Rahane said the team management is backing the India youngsters to play fearless cricket and perform with freedom. "I am not telling them anything. They know their gameplans, they know they have played their best cricket for one, one-anda-half years. They are backing themselves and have the confidence. We believe in their ability, and are allowing them to play their game," he said. "We don't want to create any confusion. As long as we are playing as a unit and playing to our potential, we are not telling them anything. Want them to play with freedom and play fearless cricket."

KANE WILLIAMSON LIKELY TO BE FIT FOR IND VS NZ SHOWDOWN



New Zealand opener Tom Latham has said that captain Kane Williamson and wicketkeeper-batsman BJ Watling are recovering well and is confident the duo will be available for the World Test Championship (WTC) final against India from June 18 at the Hampshire Bowl. "They are recovering reasonably well. It was important for them to get a bit of rest and be fully fit heading into the next week, so I am sure they will go through the fitness testing protocol over the next day or two in order for them to be ready to go for the next week. Fingers crossed. We will have a fully fit squad," said Latham, who stood in place of Williamson in the second Test against England at Birmingham which the Kiwis won. New Zealand defeated England in the second Test by eight wickets on Sunday to clinch their first Test series win in England since 1999. They managed to do it with a side that missed many frontline players.

SHAKIB AL HASAN BANNED FOR 4 GAMES OF DHAKA PREMIER LEAGUE AFTER **UNRULY ON-FIELD BEHAVIOUR: REPORTS**



Star Bangladesh cricketer Shakib Al Hasan has been let off lightly with a four-match suspension from Dhaka T20 Premier League, following his on-field meltdown during a match between Mohammedan Sporting and Abahani Limited. According to leading Bangladesh cricket portal 'BDCrictime', "Mohammedan Sporting Club captain Shakib Al Hasan has been banned for four matches due to his arrogant behaviour in the Dhaka Premier League. He will not be able to play the eighth, ninth, tenth and eleventh round matches of the DPL." While his team Mohammedan won the match easily by DLS method. Shakib lost his cool twice during the game -- once when he kicked the stumps after a strong leg-before appeal against his Bangladesh teammate Mushfiqur Rahim and secondly when umpires called for covers with one ball left to complete a minimum of six overs of the Abahani innings which would be required for a result. This time, he rushed from mid-off and uprooted the stumps.



NOVAK DJOKOVIC OUTLASTS STEFANOS TSITSIPAS AT FRENCH OPEN TO WIN 19TH MAJOR



Novak Djokovic came all the way back after dropping the first two sets to beat Stefanos Tsitsipas 6-7 (6), 2-6, 6-3, 6-2, 6-4 in the French Open final Sunday for his 19th Grand Slam title.

Djokovic's second trophy at Roland Garros moves him one major championship away from tying the men's record of 20 shared by Rafael Nadal and Roger Federer. It also puts reigning Australian Open champion Diokovic halfway to a calendar-year Grand Slam, something no man has accomplished since Rod Laver in 1969. The 34-year-old Djokovic eliminated 13-time French Open champion Nadal in a semifinal that lasted more than four hours Friday night. That might be why the 22-year-old Tsitsipas had the upper hand early, and Djokovic looked drained for two sets. Eventually, though, he started making fewer mistakes, got his best-in-the-game returning on track, served almost flawlessly down the stretch and was able to complete his sixth career comeback from two sets down — and second of the past week. Indeed, the International Tennis Federation said Djokovic — who trailed 19-year-old Lorenzo Musetti two sets to none in the fourth round — is the first man in the professional era to win a Grand Slam tournament after twice facing a 2-0 deficit in sets. Experience could have been a factor, too. This was the first major final for Tsitsipas and 29th for Djokovic, who also won the French Open in 2016, along with nine titles at the Australian Open, five at Wimbledon and three at the U.S. Open.

Former Pakistan pacer Yasir Arafat has praised former India captain and current BCCI president Sourav Ganguly for his humble nature. I think he was a little busy that time. Still, he attended my wedding ceremony," Arafat told Sports Yaari YouTube Channel. Arafat, who played a lot of



cricket around the world in leagues and county games, had a short-lived international career as he played just 3 ODIs, three Tests and 13 T20Is. As, he started playing county cricket at the twilight of his career for Surrey, Sussex, Hampshire, and Somerset and also played in the Big Bash League (BBL) for Per th Scorchers. Arafat also revealed that he got an offer from Bollywood superstar Shah Rukh Khan to play in the IPL for the Kolkata Knight Riders but it didn't materialise after Pakistan players were banned from the league after the first edition.
