





#SHAURYASTORIES: REMEMBERING KARGIL WAR HERO 'SHERSHAAH' CAPTAIN VIKRAM BATRA



Kargil war hero Capt Vikram Batra was one of the Bravehearts of the country and his heroic tale deserves everyone's attention. For DNA's 'Shaurya Stories', look back at some inspiring stories of lesser-known heroes who created history in their own ways. Vikram Batra, who was bestowed with Param Vir Chakra posthumously died on July 7, 1999, during Kargil War fought between India and Pakistan.

Who was Captain Vikram Batra?

Born on September 9, 1974, Captain Vikram Batra spent his childhood in Palampur. During the 1999 Kargil War, his unit was ordered to recapture Point 5140 in his first major battle in the war. Even though the enemy had the higher ground, he led his men to a brilliant tactical assault on the enemy. The 13 J&K Rifles won a decisive victory which strengthened India's hold on the territory and he was immortalised when he reportedly told his commander: 'Yeh dil maange more.' His next operation was to capture the 17000-feet high Point 4875, a tough challenge made harder by the steep slopes and chilly temperature. On a fateful night, after shocking the enemy to retreat, he went to rescue a junior officer who had injured his legs in an explosion. Even though he took out five enemies with a grenade a bullet hit him on the chest.

Capt Vikram Batra was awarded Param Vir Chakra on August 15,

1999. His citation read as -

During 'Operation Vijay', on 20 June 1999, Captain Vikram Batra, Commander Delta Company was tasked to attack Point 5140. Captain Batra with his company skirted around the feature from the East and maintaining surprise reached within assaulting distance of the enemy. Captain Batra reorganized his column and motivated his men to physically assault the enemy positions. Leading from the front, he, in a daredevil assault, pounced on the enemy and killed four of them in a hand-to-hand fight.

On 7 July 1999, in another operation in the area Pt 4875, his company was tasked to clear a narrow feature with sharp cuttings on either side and heavily fortified enemy defences that covered the only approach to it. For speedy operation, Captain Batra assaulted the enemy position along a narrow ridge and engaged the enemy in a fierce hand-to-hand fight and killed five enemy soldiers at point-blank range. Despite sustaining grave injuries, he crawled towards the enemy and hurled grenades clearing the position with utter disregard to his personal safety, leading from the front, he rallied his men and pressed on the attack and achieved a near-impossible military task in the face of heavy enemy fire. The officer, however, succumbed to his injuries. Inspired by his daredevil act, his troops fell upon the enemy with vengeance, annihilated them and captured Point 4875.

Captain Vikram Batra, thus, displayed the most conspicuous personal bravery and leadership of the highest order in the face of the enemy and made the supreme sacrifice in the highest traditions of the Indian Army."

Shahid Kapoor-Mrunal Thakur starrer 'Jersey' gets festive release date




In one of the sequences, Kapil asked Raj, "We have heard that you check the stage personally in a rally before making a speech. Is it true?"


'voluntary exit' from Bigg Boss 14 house. The actor will be

Soni Razdan believes Rhea Chakraborty 'will do very well' in Bollywood, calls her 'innocent victim of twisted design'



Gill had taken on the Australian bowlers smashing 20 runs off a Mitchell Starc over, hitting three consecutive boundaries but Nathan Lyon got the big breakthrough. Pujara got his first boundary off the 103rd ball he's faced in the innings.

From there on, it was a game tailor-made for T20 star Pant. He went for twin boundaries in the very next over off Nathan Lyon and from there on, it was about just not committing hara-kiri.

But it all started with a 21-year-old Shubman Gill and a gritty Cheteshwar Pujara standing ground and stitching a slow yet steady 114-run partnership off 240 balls after Rohit Sharma was dismissed for 7 in the seventh over of the final morning. The wicket of the experienced campaigner was just the impetus the Australian bowlers needed to begin the day. But the duo of Gill and Pujara had other ideas.

AJINKYA RAHANE'S INDIA END 32-YEAR DOMINANCE OF **AUSTRALIA IN GABBA, WIN FINAL TEST TO CLINCH SERIES**



SHUBMAN GILL, RISHABH PANT AND CHETESHWAR PUJARA BLASTED 50S AS INDIA BECAME THE FIRST NATION SINCE WEST INDIES IN 1988 TO BEAT AUSTRALIA IN BRISBANE.

It took 32 long years, but finally, Australia's last big fortress has finally crumbled. Shubman Gill laid the foundation with a brilliant 91, Cheteshwar Pujara stonewalled and built the base strong enough for reality. Rishabh Pant enhanced his reputation as one of the best and aided by a solid stand with Washington Sundar, India defeated Australia by three wickets with two overs to spare to win the series 2-1 and regain the Border-Gavaskar Trophy. However, this win will be special in more ways than one when it comes to the history of Indian cricket. Ajinkya Rahane's side has ended 32-year domination of Australia at a venue and they did it with half of their side injured. No Virat Kohli, No Mohammed Shami, No Jasprit Bumrah and no Ravichandran Ashwin. Yet, India still got the better of Australia in their own den. The win in Brisbane on January 19 will be the day Indian cricket finally came off age and it exhibited the level of talent and depth in Indian cricket. This has made the Indian cricket team the second nation after South Africa to win consecutive Test series in Australia.

The day did not begin too well for India as Rohit Sharma was undone by a superb delivery from Pat Cummins. However, Shubman Gill and Cheteshwar Pujara followed the blueprint that had served them so well in the past. Shubman Gill showed more confidence while Cheteshwar Puiara set out to stonewall and grind the Australian bowlers down. In one over of Mitchell Starc, Shubman Gill blasted a six and two fours off the wayward Mitchell Starc as Australia failed to make inroads. Cheteshwar Pujara and Shubman Gill stitched a 114run stand and the youngster looked good for a maiden century but he was undone by a flighted delivery from Nathan Lyon to fall for 91. While Cheteshwar Pujara took plenty of blows on his body and weathered the bouncer barrage of the Australian bowlers, Ajinkya Rahane looked to play some positive strokes. However, in his guest for

proactivity, he edged Pat Cummins who looked the best of the bowlers. Rishabh Pant came in and played with a mixture of caution and recklessness although luck favored him totally. Cheteshwar Pujara continued to fight and registered a fifty off 196 balls, making this his slowest fifty. However, with the second new ball, Cheteshwar Pujara was trapped LBW by Pat Cummins and Australia sensed an opening. When Mayank Agarwal fell after a nervous nine, it seemed the game would be evenly poised. But, Rishabh Pant had other ideas.

Rishabh Pant found the boundary on a regular basis and he got confident support from Washington Sundar. When India needed 53 off 54 balls and Australia were trying to go for the kill, Washington Sundar changed the complexion of the game. The left-hander pulled a six and then a four off Pat Cummins as India got some breathing space. Towards the end, Washington Sundar and Shardul Thakur fell but fittingly, it was Rishabh Pant who sealed the win as he thumped a full toss from Josh Hazlewood to the long-off fence.

The fact that India managed to turn the series around after being bowled for an 88-year low of 36 in Adelaide speaks volumes of the mental fortitude of the Indian cricket team. Ajinkya Rahane's calm leadership in Melbourne and his leading from the front gave India the ultimate advantage in sealing a win in the Boxing Day Test. The guts and determination shown by the Indian players who battled injuries in Sydney will go into folklore. It will not be long for social media to term this victory as one of the greatest in the history of Test cricket. More so because it was done in so much adversity. Kolkata 2001, Adelaide 2003, Rawalpindi 2004, Trent Bridge 2007, Johannesburg 2007 will all be footnotes in India's greatest Test wins. But, Melbourne 2020 and Brisbane 2021 will be spectacular only because it was done under so much adversity.

Young wicketkeeper-batsman Rishabh Pant hit an unbeaten 89 runs off 138 balls to help India register a historic win against Australia on Day 5 of the fourth Test match, at The Gabba in Brisbane. With this three-wicket win, Ajinkya Rahane-led side succeeded in retaining the Border-Gavaskar Trophy and won the four-match Test series 2-1.

During the post-match ceremony, Pant said, "This is one of my biggest days in life. The support the team has given me even when I was not playing has been incredible. It's a dream come true. We've been practicing hard after the first Test. The team management always backs me and tells me you are match-winner and you have to go out there and win and I am happy I did it today. It was a fifth day pitch and the ball was turning." It is to be noted that Pant hit 97 runs during the third Test match, which helped India secure a crucial a draw at the Sydney Cricket Ground. "I keep thinking every day that I want to win matches for India, and I did it today," the southpaw added. Also revealing about the pitch condition, Pant said, "It was a fifth-day pitch and the ball was turning a bit. I thought I have to be disciplined with my shot selection." India started Day 5 slowly with opener Rohit Sharma returning to pavilion cheaply. After Sharma's departure, 21-yearold Shubman Gill held the fort for he visitor and smashed 91 runs off 146 balls.

Cheteshwar Pujara once again showed why he is an important part of Indian Test side as he hit 56 runs off 211 balls. Ajinkya Rahane (24) and Washington Sundar (22) also joined the party. For the home side, Pat Cummins claimed four wickets and off-spinner Nathan Lyon grabbed two wickets.

Skipper Ajinkya Rahane hails Indian team's character and determination after historic series win



Skipper Ajinkya Rahane has hailed the character and determination of the Indian team after winning the Border-Gavaskar Trophy against Australia. Rahane, who was given the captaincy in the last three games after original skipper Virat Kohli's departure has led team India to win two Tests one at the MCG and now the second at the Gabba - and draw the third at SCG, to keep his undefeated record as captain in the longest format intact.

Speaking after the win, Rahane was at loss of words as when he was asked what this victory means to the team and the country, Rahane said, "It means a lot to us. I don't know how to describe this victory. I am really proud of all the boys, showed character, attitude, especially after the Adelaide Test match. We have to fight really hard, we know Australia in Australia is a very dangerous team.

We just wanted to give our best and not think about results but as I said I don't know how to describe this victory. I'm really proud of each individual," Rahane said.

India weere bowled out for 36 in Adelaide Test. Skipper Virat had left the team. India had lost their premier fast bowler in Mohammed Shami. Defeated, two main men down and the humans dressed in whites turned warriors at the MCG led by the magnificient hundred by the stand-in skipper Rahane. Rahane scored 112 at the MCG and led India's fightback to trump Aussies in the Boxing day Test.

Coming to Brisbane Test, India needed 324 runs on the final day of the game to win the match and take the series in the bag. After Shubman Gill's 91 Cheteshwar Pujara as usual had a sedate start but Rahane's intent was visible and everyone knew they were going for the win. After Lunch, Shubman Gill playing on 65 came out with a positive mindset and wanted to take the game on, with Pujara playing himself as usual. When asked, at what point Team India started going for the target, Rahane said, "When I went in to bat, the conversation between me and Pujara was that he would bat normal, and I would play with intent and if we get close to the total, we knew we had Pant, Mayank to get the total for us. Credit to Pujara, the way he handled the pressure was magnificent. Rishabh, Washington were magnificient. India had two debutants in the Brisbane game and collective experience of 3 Tests and 10 balls before the start of the game, but India took all the 20wickets of the Australian team and also chased down the target in the fourth innings of the Test match. Asked if taking 20 wickets was the most pleasing thing for him, Rahane said, "Taking 20 wickets was the key, so we opted for 5 bowlers. Sundar brought the balance in place of Jadeja. The intention was clear to play five bowlers. Siraj played two Tests, Saini just one, so it was inexperienced but the character shown by the bowlers and everyone else was incredible."


