



## SONU SOOD CALLS OUT CHINA FOR BLOCKING OXYGEN CONSIGNMENTS TO INDIA AS LIVES ARE BEING LOST, CHINESE AMBASSADOR ASSURES 'SMOOTH FUNCTIONING'

Chinese Ambassador to India Sun Weidong has assured actor Sonu Sood of "smooth functioning of export channel of materials to India". Weidong's reply came after Sonu Sood called out China for blocking consignments of oxygen concentrators being transported to India. Both Sonu and Weidong had a conversation over a series of tweets. Sonu took to Twitter on May 1 and wrote, "We are trying to get hun-

dreds of oxygen concentrators to India. It's sad to say that China has blocked lots of our consignments and here in India we are losing lives every minute. I request @China Amb India @MFA China to help us get our consignments cleared so we can save lives."

In his reply, Weidong wrote back to Sonu, "@SonuSood Noted your twitter info. Mr. Sood. China will do its utmost to support India fighting Covid-19. To my knowledge, freight air routes from China to India are supplies from cities in China. Will continue to ensure smooth funcoperating normally. The past two weeks have witnessed 61 freight flights from China to India in operation. We've provided convenience in customs clearance & transportation for India to transport medical

On Saturday, 392,488 new cases of coronavirus infections were detected in India, about 9,500 less than the previous day's tally of 401,993. At the start of April, India had been reporting less than one lakh cases a day. This rose to nearly 4 lakh cases a day, with the daily count rising every single day.

## NO CHARTER FLIGHT FOR AUSTRALIA PLAYERS AT THIS MOMENT: CA CHIEF HOCKLEY



Cricket Australia currently has no plans to arrange a charter flight to bring its players back home from COVID-19-ravaged India once the IPL gets over, its chief Nick Hockley said on Monday. Hockley insisted that Australian players are feeling safe and secure in the IPL bio-bubble but his comments came before it emerged that two KKR players have tested positive for the dreaded virus, leading to the postponement of the franchise's game against RCB on Monday. Australian pacer Pat Cummins' Kolkata Knight Riders teammates — Varun Chakravarthy and Sandeep Warrier — have returned positive tests. Mumbai Indians batsman Chris Lynn had recently requested Cricket Australia to arrange for a charter flight for Australia players after the tour nament concludes on May 30. "There's no suggestion at the moment of any charter flight," Hockley told Melbourne radio station SEN. "We're working closely and talking closely with the Australian Cricketers' Association, with the players and

with the BCCI to make sure everyone's okay and the people have got full information. "We've been in touch with the players there and they are generally in good spirits. The work the BCCI has done around the (bio-secure) bubble means they are feeling safe and secure, and those we've talked to are generally planning to complete their playing commitments." The Cricket Australia boss said they are monitoring the situation and a decision will be made but not immediately. "The BCCI have come out and said they understand and want to support the players in making sure they get home safely at the end. "The tournament doesn't finish until the 30th of May, so for the moment it's monitor the situation and as we get closer to the end of the tournament we'll need to see where the situation is at," he said. The Australian government recently banned its citizens from travelling back from India, which is battling a severe second wave of the pandemic that causing thousands of daily deaths.

## BCCI STARES AT IPL RESCHEDULING NIGHTMARE: KKR-RCB POSTPONED AFTER TWO PLAYERS TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

The Indian Premier League (IPL) match between Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) and Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) on Monday has been postponed after two Indian players in the KKR team – spinner Varun Chakravarthy and medium pacer Sandeep Warrier – tested positive for Covid-19. And with teams that played against KKR over the last 14 days being asked to self-isolate by their respective franchises, the BCCI had a rescheduling nightmare on its hands. "Varun Chakravarthy and Sandeep Warrier were found to be positive in the third round of testing in the last four days. All other team members have tested negative for COVID -19," said an IPL press release. It added: "Both the players have isolated themselves from the rest of the squad. The Medical Team is in continuous touch with the duo and are monitoring their health. Meanwhile, the Kolkata Knight Riders have now moved towards a daily testing routine to identify any other possible cases and treat them at the earliest." The new date for the KKR-RCB game that was scheduled to be played at Motera Stadium in Ahmedabad on Monday will be announced soon. Over the last 14 days, KKR played against Delhi Capitals, Rajasthan Royals, Punjab Kings and Chennai Super Kings. It is learnt that players from those sides have been asked to self-isolate by their respective franchises. Match officials involved in those matches, too, might have to serve a quarantine period now.

## Shaw-Shikhar continue to sizzle as Capitals subdue Kings and move to top of the table



Stand-in-captain Mayank Agarwal's unbeaten 99 gave Punjab Kings some hope at the halfway stage. However, his seventh half-century for the franchise went in vain after yet another excellent knock from Shikhar Dhawan — a sparkling 47-ball 69 — that helped Delhi ace the 167-run chase with 14 deliveries to spare and climb to the top of the points table.

After a thunderous match-winning essay — a 49-ball 92 — against Punjab Kings a fortnight ago, Dhawan had provided a peek into his mindset and the changes he has brought about in his game. "It was a conscious effort from my side to improve my strike rate. Started taking more risks. Not afraid of changes, always open towards it. Not scared of getting out as well. Have worked on a few shots. My slog shot has improved a lot. It was there earlier as well, but now I play it more freely. I'm more relaxed now," the left-hander had said. Two weeks later, against the same opponents, Dhawan anchored another perfectly-timed run-chase for Delhi Capitals with a sumptuous knock. Prithvi Shaw's pyrotechnics may have propelled them to 63/0 in the Powerplay. But with 56 needed off seven overs, it was Dhawan's aggressive approach that gave the scoreboard the required impetus.

## KL Rahul hospitalised with acute appendicitis, to undergo surgery

Punjab Kings' (PBKS) in-form skipper KL Rahul will miss the upcoming games of the Indian Premier League (IPL) as the franchise revealed that he has been diagnosed with acute appendicitis. PBKS announced the news on Twitter ahead of their clash against Delhi Capitals (DC) at Narendra Modi stadium, Ahmedabad on Sunday. Rahul will undergo surgery and it is unlikely he will be back in action for the remainder of the IPL 2021 season. "KL Rahul complained of a severe abdomen pain last night and after not responding to medication, he was taken to the emergency room for further tests which revealed that he was diagnosed with acute appendicitis. It will be resolved surgically and for safety measures he has been transferred to the hospital for the same." Punjab Kings wrote in a tweet. Rahul is currently the leading run-scorer of the tournament with 331 runs from seven games at an average of 66.20 including four half-centuries. The franchise announced Mayank Agarwal as stand-in skipper for the remainder of the IPL season in absence of Rahul.



## **IPL 2021: 'DON'T SEE MYSELF PLAYING FOR ANY** OTHER IPL TEAM, SAYS RCB SKIPPER VIRAT KOHLI



Virat Kohli, the only Indian player to play in the Indian Premier League (IPL) for just one team for the 14th season now shared his love and loyalty ahead of the 2021 edition o the cash-rich league, starting in two days time with his side Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) taking on the defending champions Mumbai Indians in the tournament opener. Kohli, who started his journey in the IPL in

2008 with the RCB as a youngster has played under various captains since, from Rahul Dravid to Anil Kumble to former New Zealand all-rounder Daniel Vettori. He took the charge in the year 2013 and since then has been the leading the men in red and gold and the elusive silverware still awaits the Bangalorefor three times.

RCB took to Twitter quoting Kohli on Wednesday with the skipper in a vibrant picture with a red background, "I don't see myself leaving or playing for any other IPL team" Home is where the is! heart #PlayBold #WeAreChallengers #IPL2021". RCB's journey has ebbed and flowed in the IPL for years now and with the new signings of players like Glenn Maxwell, Kyle Jamieson, Dan Christian, the Kohli-led side will be hoping to end the trophy drought. In the last year's tournament too, Kohli, who is from Delhi was asked about the opportunity for his side to qualify in the top two spots ahead of his side's final league stage game against the Delhi Capitals, after beating his Delhi boys, Kohli had said, "I've always been a Bangalore boy in the IPL, never sort of drifted towards Delhi."

Kohli, who is currently the highest run-getter in the lucrative tournament has scored 5878 runs in the 192 games he has played in franchise, after reaching the final the IPL thus far, with five centuries and 39 fifties.

### SRH HAVE A NUMBER OF LEADERS, IT'S VITAL WE STAY TIGHT: WILLIAMSON ON WARNER

Newly-appointed Sunrisers Hyderabad captain Kane Williamson believes that conversations on his predecessor David Warner's future in the playing XI is still on as the Australian is a world class player. Warner was stripped of SRH captaincy on Saturday after the team lost five out of its first six matches and Williamson's elevation to the post hasn't changed the fortunes as it suffered a 55-run defeat in the hands of Rajasthan Royals.

"There are a number of leaders in the group. It's important we stay tight. And for us it is about building as a side and make adjustments," Williamson looked a bit uncomfortable on Warner question during the post-match presentation. The skipper said that the team needs to be clear about strategies and execution.

"Rather than over-search for the win, we just have to be clear about how we need to operate. Warner is a world class player and we have our cards on the table. I am sure there are a number of conversations to be had," Williamson at best was evasive.

On the match front, he admitted that once Royals posted 220 for 3 the chase was anyways going to be difficult. "A tough day. A very competitive total from RR. It was Jos' day and he was outstanding. With the bat you do need to get a few things to go your way and when you're losing wickets it makes it all the more harder to chase 220. "We have had a lot of challenges over the last three weeks, but we need to make small adjustments and put in improved performances. Jos and Sanju were key, so we wanted Rashid to bowl as many deliveries as possible against them."
