

Ashley Giles, England's director of cricket, has asserted that the country's posse of contracted cricketers will not miss international fixtures this year to participate in the rescheduled Indian Premier League (IPL), which was postponed earlier this month due to the rising number of Covid-19 cases in the country. A potential window to complete the remainder of the IPL season is in September, before the Twenty20 World Cup. However, England are scheduled to tour Bangladesh and Pakistan for limited-overs matches during that period. "If those tours go ahead, I'd expect them (players) to be there," Giles told British media. "We're planning on the involvement of England players in England matches." As many as 14 English players were part of IPL 2021 before its suspension.







"I fully support Sonu's ideas and I will actively work towards finding ways to support education because I have always believed that #educationforeverychild is a birthright.


"And we cannot as a society let the virus change that," Priyanka concluded her post. Meanwhile, many fans were emotional while conveying their hero worship for Sonu.



NEWLYWEDS SUGANDHA MISHRA-SANKET BHOSALE BOOKED FOR FLOUTING COVID-19 NORMS AT WEDDING

Days after their marriage, singer and comedienne Sugandha Mishra and her husband, comedian Sanket Bhosale have been booked for flouting COVID-19 norms during their wedding ceremonies that were held on April 26. The couple have been booked for violating restrictions imposed by Punjab government. The case was registered on Wednesday against the two and the owner of the resort after a video showing a large gathering at the wedding event went viral on the internet. Taking cognizance of the same, a case was booked against the newlyweds. Reportedly, the case was registered under Section 188 (disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant) of the Indian Penal Code and relevant sections of the Disaster Management



Act. While no arrests have been made, an investigation is ongoing in the case. According to a Times of India report, 'the FIR mentions that from the media clip it emerged that several people gathered at the marriage function.' For the unversed, the Punjab government had restricted wedding guests to 10 people keeping in mind the spike in COVID cases. Earlier, in an interview, Sugandha had revealed that they were taking necessary precautions and following all COVID-19 related norms. She had even mentioned that only close family members and friends would be attending the wedding and prior to entering the venue, they would have to undergo the Rapid Antigen Test, given the current Covid-19 pandemic.

YOU CAN FUDGE DATA, HOW DO YOU HIDE BODIES?

MUMBAI, (IANS) With more dead bodies found floating in the Ganga amid the ongoing second wave of the Covid-19 pandemic, Bollywood celebrities took to social media to express shock and condemn the horrific incidents.

Actor-filmmaker Farhan Akhtar tweeted on Wednesday: "The news of scores of bodies being discovered floating in rivers and washed up on its banks is absolutely heartbreaking. The virus will be defeated someday but there has to be accountability for these failures in the system. Until then, the pandemic chapter is not closed!"

Actress-filmmaker Pooja Bhatt wrote: "You can fudge the data.. how do you hide the bodies? This will haunt us for generations to come." Reacting to a news piece talking about the same, actor-comedian JaavedJaaferi wrote: "This is tragic and horrific."

Earlier, Bollywood celebrities like Urmila Matondkar, Shekhar Suman and Divyenndu Sharma had also reacted to the shocking development. On Monday, around 45 dead bodies in a decomposed stage were found on the banks of the Ganga in Buxar district, and the district administration claimed the bodies were from the upstream districts of Ghazipur, Varanasi or Prayagraj in Uttar Pradesh. After Bihar's Buxar, around two dozen bodies have been found on the banks of the Ganga at adjoining Ghazipur district of Uttar Pradesh, some of which have been partially cremated and then thrown into the river.



INDIA TO TOUR SRI LANKA FOR THREE ODIS **AND THREE T20IS - DETAILS HERE**

THE INDIAN TEAM WILL BE TRAVELLING TO SRI LANKA IN THE FIRST WEEK OF JULY AND NONE OF THE ENGLAND-BOUND PLAYERS WILL BE PART OF THAT SERIES



India will be going to Sri Lanka in July for a limited-overs series of three ODIs and three T20Is. After BCCI President, Sourav Ganguly said that India and Sri Lanka will be involved in a limited-over series, Sri Lanka Cricket (SLC) has proposed an itinerary to the BCCI.

In a report in ESPN Cricinfo, as per the itinerary, India's white-ball team will be arriving on July 5 and they will be in the island country till July 28. The series will start with the ODIs and end with the T20Is. The first ODI will take place on July 13, followed by games on July 16 and 18. The T20I series will start on July 22 and will go on till July 27. the upcoming ICC T20 World Cup to be slated to held in India..

The report stated that the Indian team will be serving a 7-day quarantine but in two parts. The first part will be of three days of hard guarantine in hotel rooms and in the second the team will be allowed to train but the movement will be restricted to just the hotel and the ground for four days. While Virat Kohli and co will be in England preparing for the five-match Test series against the hosts after the completion of the World Test Championship (WTC) final, BCCI will be sending a second-string team specially for the limited-overs while some players will be looking to stake a claim for

NO VIRAT KOHLI, ROHIT SHARMA IN INDIA'S SQUAD FOR SRI LANKA, SOURAV GANGULY WANTS 'DIFFERENT TEAM

As India will be travelling to Sri Lanka in July for three ODIs and five T20Is, BCCI president Sourav Ganguly on Sunday said that the top players will be missing this tour.

While the dates for the series is still unclear, Ganguly has confirmed that big names such as captain Virat Kohli and his deputy Rohit Sharma will not be part of the tour. Both Kohli and Rohit will be engaged in a marquee five-match Test series in England.

According to the ICC's Future Tours Programme (FTP), India are scheduled to play three T20Is in Sri Lanka in July. Last year, India's tour was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

"We have planned a white ball series for the senior men's team during the month of July where they will play T20 Internationals and ODIs in Sri Lanka," Ganguly was quoted by PTI in an interaction.

When asked if Team India will segregate the two teams, Ganguly said that it will be a different side, which won't have anyone from the outfit that will be in the United Kingdom at that time.

"Yes, it will be a team of white-ball specialists. It will be a different team," the former India captain said, making it clear that the cricket board also has the preparation of white ball regulars in mind.

India's tour of England will end on September 14 and the BCCI would want the likes of Shikhar Dhawan, Hardik Pandya, Bhuvneshwar Kumar, Deepak Chahar, Yuzvendra Chahal - who are not part of the English tour to be match ready.

"The BCCI president is very keen that all our top players are match ready and since England doesn't have a white ball leg the month of July can be utilized well," a BCCI source told PTI.

As for Kohli and Sharma, they do not need to come from the UK, which has in place some hard quarantine rules. "Technically, in the month of July there are no official senior India team matches. The Test squad will be playing intrasquad games. "So there is no harm in India's white-ball experts getting some match time and selectors also get to fix the missing jigsaws in selection puzzle."

IND VS ENG: RAHUL DRAVID PREDICTS VIRAT KOHLI-LED SIDES WIN CHANCES IN TEST SERIES AGAINST ENGLAND

Former India skipper Rahul Dravid on Sunday said that the Virat Kohli-led side has a very good chance of winning the Test series in

England. India and England are slated to lock horns in the five-match Test series in the UK this year. The series would commence in August, and India is also slated to square off against New Zealand in the finals of the World Test Championship (WTC) in June. "I really do think India have a very good chance this time. There's no question about England's bowling. Whatever bowling attack England put on the park, especially their seam-bowling attack, is going to be fantastic. They have a lot of players to pick and choose from and that's going to be terrific," Dravid said in a webinar organised by Live Aid India, trust to help those affected by Covid-19, as reported by ESPNcricinfo. "But if you look at their top six or top seven, you really think of one great batsman, a world-class batsman who is Joe Root. Obviously, Ben Stokes is another one, who is a good all-rounder, but for some reason, Ravichandran Ashwin seems to do well against him. And that should be an interesting contest. I know he's done well against Stokes in India, but it'll still be an interesting subplot to the series," he added. Dravid also said that Kohli's side would be well prepared for the Tests against England and he also opined that a lot of players in the squad have the much-needed self-belief. "But I just think India will be well-prepared, have the confidence from Australia, there's a lot of belief in the squad. A couple of players have been to England a few times, there's a lot of experience in the batting order this time around, so this is probably our best chance, maybe say 3-2 to India. I think India will play really well in England this time. It's a great opportunity we've got. After the WTC final, they're going to be in England for a whole month before the Test series starts. I don't think any team has had that kind of time to prepare for a Test series as India will have this time so that surely should be a great advantage," said Dravid. Talking about India's squad for the WTC final and five-match Test series against England, Dravid said: "It does seem balanced. It's a 20-member squad. The only other one who could have merited selection would've been Kuldeep Yaday, but he's fallen away over the last little bit. Also, with the kind of recent performances from Axar Patel, Ravindra Jadeja, and Washington Sundar, they're clear about the kind of balance they want in the squad."

Australia have done a few times in the past where their firstchoice team would be playing a Test series home or away, they'll have a specialist side for limited-overs selected and going for a series. But now with the emergence of India's talent pool across formats, it wouldn't be difficult for India to have two different sides playing at the same time.

India took 30 players to Australia including reserves and the circumstances were such that every last player got to play a game and whoever came in made an immediate impact and showed what he is capable of when given an opportunity at the highest level. Mohammed Siraj, Axar Patel, Shubman Gill, Shardul Thakur, Washington Sundar to name a few, performed and showed their mettle.

With BCCI president Sourav Ganguly recently saying that India will be having a 'specialist' limited-overs side going to Sri Lanka to play in three ODIs and five T20Is, this might be a great opportunity for the Indian team to test their bench strength and the ones who had a great IPL season ahead of the ICC T20 World Cup and with the player limit extending up to 23, many players would be eager to make their mark.

So let's take a look at the make-up of this specialist side and which players might get a shot at plying for India in the white-ball formats:

Shikhar Dhawan and Prithvi Shaw look certainties for the openers' slots, with an outside chance of Devdutt Padikkal getting a maiden call-up given his exploits in the Vijay Hazare Trophy and in the IPL for the Royal Challengers Bangalore. Dhawan and Shaw, on the other hand, are in the form of their lives having stitched five 50-plus partnerships for Delhi Capitals in this year's IPL including two 130-plus stands.

For the middle-order, Suryakumar Yadav, Ishan Kishan will be back. Shreyas Iyer, who underwent shoulder surgery will be facing a race against time to get fit by July, otherwise, Manish Pandey could be relooked with Sanju Samson as the second wicket-keeper forming a strong middle-order.
