



Prolonged injuries, lack of support and backing during the period between 2018-2020 forced India's star off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin to contemplate retirement. In an interview with ESPNCricinfo, Ashwin revealed that it was one of the most difficult times for him as a cricketer. The first phase, he said, was right after the England series in 2018, followed by abdomen tear in Austra-



lia later that year after the Adelaide Test. "Between 2018 and 2020, I contemplated giving up the sport at various points. I thought, 'I have put in a lot of effort, but it is not coming through.' The harder I tried, the farther it felt. Especially with athletic pubalgia and the patellar tendonitis - I used to bowl six balls and then I used to be gasping for breath. And there would be pain all over the place. So you needed to make adjustments. When the knee pain got excruciating, the next ball I would probably jump less. When I jumped less, obviously the force needs to be produced through the core and the back and the shoulders, so the pubalgia would act up. So the third ball I would be extra side-on to try to use the hips. By the time I was done with six balls, I would be like, 'I need a break here."

'BOWLING LIKE KAPIL DEV WAS MOST DIFFICULT ASPECT: RANVEER SINGH DELVES INTO '83' CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT



Bollywood actor Ranveer Singh, who will soon be seen portraying Kapil Dev, captain of the 1983 cricket World Cup-winning team, in the upcoming sports biopic '83', delved into the intricacies of portraying the character for the big screen. My body is very different from his so I had to transform my physicality drastically in order to achieve it. It took a long time, in fact, months to perfect the action. Initially, my body was too heavy because I was coming off of the shoot of 'Simmba'."

He further spoke about Balwinder Singh Sandhu, the legend of the 83-world cup who was also Ranveer's coach and said, "Our coach noticed that my body was too heavy and he said jab tu run-up mein aata hai toh tu aisa lagta hai ki pehelwan bowling karne aa raha hai. And he sent me away for a month just to change my physicality to bring it closer to Kapil's athleticism and then once I did that, I started making some headway." "I was playing cricket for 4 hours a day for 6 months and doing physical conditioning for 2 hours a day for those 6 months. Four months of prep and 2-3 months of shoot, I put in a lot of hours," added the actor.

Shah Rukh Khan's son Aryan Khan's arrest in alleged drugs case Bollywood's megastar Shah Rukh Khan and Gauri Khan's son Aryan Khan was arrested by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) from a Goa-based cruise in an alleged drugs case on October 3. He was accused of the consumption and distribution of drugs. However, the probe agency failed to prove their allegations in court and Aryan was granted bail after spending 26 days in jail. Currently, he is out of jail and has been imposed with14 conditions on him. Among other things, he is asked to not leave Mumbai without informing the agency and not to leave India without permission from the special NDPS court.

Shilpa Shetty Kundra's husband Raj Kundra's arrest in alleged pornography case

In July 2021, Shilpa Shetty's husband and businessman Raj Kundra was arrested in an alleged porn case by Mumbai Police. He was accused of creating and distributing porn films through an app. He was granted bail in September. Not just this, several actresses including Sheryn Chopra and Poonam Panday, also alleged that they were approached by Kundra for the adult content.

Jacqueline Fernandez, Nora Fatehi summoned by ED in Sukesh Chandrashekhar case

Actresses Jacqueline Fernandez and Nora Fatehi were summoned by Enforcement Directorate (ED) in connection with the Rs 200 crore money laundering case and for their alleged connection with Sukesh Chandrashekhar. The central agency stated that Jacqueline Fernandez and Nora Fatehi received top models of luxury cars and other expensive gifts from the accused.

Kangana Ranaut's Twitter account was permanently suspended

In May, actress Kangana Ranaut's Twitter account was 'permanently suspended for repeated violation of Twitter rules, a company spokesperson had said. Kangana's tweets on the postpoll violence in West Bengal had sparked outrage on social media, with many demanding actions against her. Some called it a call for violence.

Manoj Bajpayee's web series The Family Man 2 faced a lot of flak ahead of its release, with several political leaders raising objections to the show for portraying Tamilians as 'terrorists' in the popular series. In the show, actor Manoj Bajpayee's character Srikant Tiwari was pitted against a new and powerful adversary, Raji (Samantha Akkineni).

Bollywood actor Kartik Aaryan made it to the headlines when Karan Johar roped him for Dostana's sequel. But later the production house announced that they will be recasting for the movie. Dharma production's shared a note on Instagram. "Due to professional circumstances, on which we have decided to maintain a dignified silence we will be recasting 'Dostana 2', directed by Collin D'Cunha. Please wait for the official announcement soon", it said. Meanwhile, there were reports that Kartik's "unprofessional" behaviour had irked the makers and they decided on dropping him from the board.

Pearl V Puri's arrest in the alleged rape case

In June, Television actor Pearl V Puri was arrested in connection with the alleged rape and molestation case. 

PANAMA PAPERS LEAK CASE: AISHWARYA RAI BACHCHAN GETS MOBBED AS SHE LEAVES ED OFFICE

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) summoned Bollywood actress Aishwarya Rai Bachchan on Monday, December 20 for questioning in the Panama Papers leak case. As the actress left the ED office in Delhi after five years, she was mobbed by the paparazzi and the public. A video has also been shared online in which the 'Ae Dil Hai Mushkil' actress is seen exiting the ED office as she is hoarded by the camerapersons and public before she sits in her car.

The Indian government's financial and economic intelligence agency, ED has been investigating the case since 2016 and has registered a money laundry case under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 (PMLA) in this matter. The Bachchan family has been issued notices to explain their involvement in foreign remittances since 2004 under the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) Liberalised Remittance Scheme (LRS). Also, a few companies established in 1993 had Amitabh Bachchan, Aishwarya's father-in-law, listed as the director of four offshore companies - three in the Bahamas and one in the Virgin Islands. These firms had a huge capital between USD 5,000 to USD 50,000. Aishwarya Rai Bachchan was made the director of one of these companies initially but later, she was declared as a shareholder. Her parents, father Kotedadi Ramana Rai Krishna Raj and mother Vrinda Krishna Raj Rai, and her brother Aditya Rai were also declared partners in the said company. The company was dissolved in 2008, one year after Aishwarya got married to Abhishek Bachchan.

RAJ KUNDRA ON PORNOGRAPHY CASE: NEVER BEEN INVOLVED IN PRODUCTION, DISTRIBUTION



Businessman Raj Kundra, who was arrested in a pornography case earlier this year and later granted bail, on Monday claimed he has never been involved in the production and distribution of pornographic content in his life. In a statement issued on a social media platform, Kundra, who is married to actor Shilpa Shetty, said the entire episode was nothing but a "witch hunt". The businessman also said has already been pronounced "quilty" by the media, and he wishes his privacy is not intruded anymore with this continued "media trial".

The Supreme Court last week granted protection from arrest to Kundra in connection with an FIR registered against him for allegedly distributing pornographic videos. In July this year, Kundra was arrested by the Mumbai Police in another case where he was accused of distributing porn films through an app. He was granted bail in September.

On Monday, Kundra stated that, "After much contemplation, considering there are many misleading and irresponsible statements and articles floating around and my silence has been misconstrued for weakness. I would like to start by stating that I have NEVER been involved in the production and distribution of "pornography" EVER in my life."

"This whole episode has been nothing but a witch hunt. The matter is subjudice so I can not elucidate, but I am ready to face trial and have full faith in the judiciary, where the truth will prevail." Kundra said, unfortunately he has already been pronounced "guilty" by the media and that his family and he have been subjected to a lot of pain (continuously), violating his human and constitutional rights at different levels.

"The trolling, negativity and toxic public perception has been very debilitating. To set the record straight, I do not hide my face in shame, but wish that my privacy is not intruded anymore with this continued MEDIA TRIAL. My priority has always been my family, nothing else matters at this juncture," he said. Kundra said he believes it is every person's inalienable right to live with dignity and he requests the same. The businessman had been booked under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code, the Indecent Representation of Women (Prevention) Act and the Information Technology Act for allegedly distributing/ transmitting sexually explicit videos.

Fearing arrest, Kundra first sought an anticipatory bail from a sessions court, but it was refused, so he moved the Bombay High Court, claiming that he had been framed.

The HC also rejected his anticipatory bail application on November 25. The FIR named actors Sherlyn Chopra and Poonam Pandey as co-accused.

Kundra's lawyers had claimed he was in no way connected to content creation, publication or transmission of alleged illegal videos even as the actors, who were named as co-accused, had given full consent to shoot the videos.

BOMBAY HIGH COURT REJECTS ARMAAN KOHLI'S BAIL PLEA IN DRUGS CASE

Bollywood actor Armaan Kohli was arrested in the last week of August in a drugs case. NCB had recovered some quantity of cocaine from the actor's house and he has been in jail since then. After the special NDPS court rejected his bail, Bombay High Court has also denied bail to the actor. As per the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), 1.2 grams of MD was recovered from Kohli's house, while bigger quantities of drugs were recovered from the co-accused in the case. The court held that after examining the material obtained during the probe, 'prima-facie' it seemed that Kohli was 'wellconnected with the co-accused pertaining to the illicit trafficking of drugs.' Special prosecutor Advait Sethna had submitted chats/messages between Kohli and the co-accused along with their bank statements before the court. The judge noted that bank transactions corroborated alleged transactions (revealed from the chats). Kohli failed to explain the purpose of contraband recovered from his house and the financial transactions, the NDPS court had said.







ON MONDAY, SOUTH AFRICA'S T20 MZANSI SUPER LEAGUE WAS CANCELLED FOR THE SECOND TIME DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, THE COUNTRY'S CRICKET BOARD SAID.

Cricket South Africa on Monday stated that there will be no tickets made available for India's tour of the Rainbow Nation due to the rising Covid-19 cases in the world as well as in South Africa.

The statement read, "CSA wishes to inform the most ardent fans of cricket as well as all sports lovers that owing to the increasing COVID cases around the world, and the fourth wave locally, the two cricketing bodies have taken a joint decision to protect the players and the tour by not making tickets available for the India vs Proteas offerings. This decision was taken in order to avoid any breaches that could compromise the tour from a Covid-risk perspective and to also maintain a hazard-free bubble environment."

RAHUL DRAVID CALLS FOR 'GOOD INTENSITY' AS TEAM INDIA HIT HARD IN NETS SESSION IN CENTURION



Team India had an intense net session at the SuperSport Park in Centurion, ahead of their three-match Test series against South Africa. starting on December 26. Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) shared a video of Team India's first net session where newlyappointed head coach Rahul Dravid could be heard telling the players to put in a 'quality practice' and show 'good intensity' in the session. "The next three days are going to be extremely important in terms of our preparations and getting ourselves ready for the first Test," said Rahul Dravid. Batting coach Vikram Rathour said the batting conditions are difficult due to the overcast condition. "Today was a centre wicket practice session. It was a fresh wicket with overcast conditions, pretty challenging for the batters. So extremely happy with the way they went about it," he said. India's middle-order batter, Shreyas Iyer, who has scored a century on his Test debut against New Zealand, deemed the conditions at the SuperSport Park in Centurion as 'bowlers delight.' Bowling coach Paras Mhambrey also shared his insights and said: "You have to be prepared for such conditions. Yes, we thought it would be sunny when we walked out here. Overcast conditions are always challenging from the bowlers' perspective as well to hit the right areas. You will get these kinds of conditions in a Test match, and you should be able to exploit them." Veteran speedster Ishant Sharma has praised his fellow pacemen Jasprit Bumrah and Mohammed Shami. He said: "It was damp initially, moving a bit. I think Jassi and Shami bowled pretty well. They (batsmen) played pretty well. They know what kind of bowlers they will face and how the conditions will be."

ASHES 'ON THE LINE', JOE ROOT WANTS **ENGLAND TO REPLICATE JOS BUTTLER'S FIGHT**



England cannot afford to feel sorry for themselves after losing the second Ashes Test against Australia and going 2-0 down in the fivematch series, captain Joe Root said on Monday.

Beaten inside four days in the series opener in Brisbane, England succumbed to their second successive defeat in Adelaide despite Jos Buttler's dogged resistance with the bat. "The Ashes are on the line here, if that is not motivation, I don't know what is," Root said after his team's 275-run defeat in the day-night Test.

Buttler's 26 runs from 207 balls delayed Australia's victory charge for a while and Root said that should be the blueprint for the remaining matches in Melbourne, Sydney, and Hobart.

"Ultimately that is the attitude and the mentality we have to harness over the next five days," Root said.

"I am extremely proud of the way the guys fought today, that attitude and desire that's how we need to go about a whole test match.

RAFAEL NADAL TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 after abu dhabi event



Rafael Nadal has tested positive for COVID-19 upon arrival in Spain after making his comeback from injury in an exhibition event in Abu Dhabi last week, the Spaniard said on Monday.

"I am having some unpleasant moments but I hope that I will improve little by little. The 35-year-old said he had tested negative at all times when he was in Kuwait and Abu Dhabi, and had last tested negative on Friday last week. NEW ZEALAND TO RETURN TO PAKISTAN FOR 5 ODI, 5 T20I MATCHES

New Zealand will make up for this year's abandoned tour of Pakistan by playing 10 white-ball matches in April 2023, the Pakistan Cricket Board said on Monday. New Zealand aborted its limited-overs tour to Pakistan in September due to security fears just before the toss in the first one-day international was due to take place at Rawalpindi. England followed the New Zealand decision by also abandoning its short tour to Pakistan just before the T20 World Cup in October. New Zealand's tour in April 2023 comprises five ODIs and five Twenty20s. Dates and venues have not been determined. The PCB also said that New Zealand will tour Pakistan in December 2022 to play two Test matches as part of the World Test Championship and will also play three ODIs which will count towards qualification for the 2023 World Cup in India.

racial prejudice charges against some of its legends ahead of the first Test against India, but skipper Dean Elgar says his team remains focussed on putting up a professional effort against the "best team" in the world. South African cricket has been going through administrative crisis over the last 24 months, so much so that Elgar can't remember who is running the show at the moment. To add to that, the sport has also been rocked by racism allegations. Last week, the Social Justice and Nation Building Commission (SJN), in its report, accused former South Africa captain and current CSA director Graeme Smith, current head coach Mark Boucher and former batter AB de Villiers of engaging in racially "prejudicial conduct" against players. The SJN also accused CSA of discriminating against players on basis of their race. In a virtual media interaction arranged by CSA ahead of the Boxing Day Test against India, Elegar was expectedly asked about the latest controversy involving South African cricket but he said the team is not greatly affected by it.

"No, it hasn't really been too tough for us. As players, we've kind of gotten used to some bad news around us the last year and a half. We try to adapt to it accordingly. It's not ideal, obviously, to have these headlines coming up though," he said.

"We just want to focus on our cricket. We want to focus on playing a really tough series against India. It's great to have them in South Africa again. "So yeah, for us, it's all about focusing on cricket, focusing on our next few days of preparation, kind of nail down our cricketing

South Africa cricket was hit by yet another controversy relating to skills," said the southpaw. However, Elgar said instability in Cricket South Africa administration has been tough to deal with.

> "We haven't had a lot of stability from an administrative point of view. We've had so many different administrators that we don't even know who's there now. Hopefully sooner than later there is a lot more stability that comes within CSA." He rued lack of support (from all quarters) for the coaches and team management.

> "I think from a player's point of view, we back our coaches, we need to give them a lot of love. I think sometimes they put in so much work... that's the biggest thing (that goes unnoticed) because I know what they do behind the scenes," he said.

> "It's not nice to see our coaches get lambasted for things despite the work they're putting in behind the scenes." Asked how the constant controversies impacts the team environment, Elgar said that the players have a job to do no matter what happens off the field.

> "We've been through such crappy times that we've actually formulated such a good bond within our group and for me, it's not an excuse for us. If it happened in the first month of these bad kind of scenarios, then maybe it might be that but we've been there.

> "We've formulated something that works for us as a close group. We have an extremely strong culture which has been tested and pushed to levels that I don't think it will be pushed through in my short term of being captain. I think we've come out on top of it.

> "We are a professional team, we focus on cricket and hopefully cricket can look after us," added Elgar.

IPL 'NEXT BIG STEP' TO GROW WOMEN'S SPORT: SOPHIE DEVINE

Franchise cricket has raised the profile of women's cricket and a fullfledged Indian Premier League (IPL) is the "next step" for its growth, New Zealand captain Sophie Devine said.

The Indian cricket board currently hosts a short three-team women's competition along with the lucrative men's IPL which will welcome two new franchises and become a 10-team affair next year.

Devine cited the success of the Women's Big Bash League (WBBL) in Australia and its impact to make her point.

"The success of the WBBL in Australia has been enormous in raising the profile, and the standard of cricket as well has certainly improved," Devine said on Monday at an event to mark the beginning of live cricket streaming on Amazon Prime Video from Jan. 1.

"I'd love to see a woman's IPL kick off. I think it's certainly the next step in growing the game globally for the women side of things.

"So fingers crossed and in the next few years, there might be something on the cards," the 32-year-old said.

Teammate Suzie Bates said franchise cricket had "drastically" changed women's game.

"Any franchise opportunities supporting the international game is the key for the game growing and India is the next big step in my opinion after the success of the WBBL and The Hundred competition in England," Bates said.



All-rounder Amelia Kerr, who has played the women's competition in India, echoed the sentiment.

"They've started with a few exhibition matches but we speak of the passion and the love for the game that India has and how successful the men's IPL is.

"I think a woman's IPL would be incredible," the 21-year-old added.


R ASHWIN ADMITS HE CONSIDERED RETIREMENT: 'A LOT OF PEOPLE WERE BACKED, WHY NOT ME?'

Prolonged injuries, lack of support and backing during the period between 2018-2020 forced India's star off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin to contemplate retirement. In an interview with ESPNCricinfo, Ashwin revealed that it was one of the most difficult times for him as a cricketer. The first phase, he said, was right after the England series in 2018, followed by abdomen tear in Australia later that year after the Adelaide Test. "Between 2018 and 2020, I contemplated giving up the sport at various points. I thought, 'I have put in a lot of effort, but it is not coming through.' The harder I tried, the farther it felt. Especially with athletic pubalgia and the patellar tendonitis – I used to bowl six balls and then I used to be gasping for breath. And there would be pain all over the place. So you needed to make adjust-



ments. When the knee pain got excruciating, the next ball I would probably jump less. When I jumped less, obviously the force needs to be produced through the core and the back and the shoulders, so the pubalgia would act up. So the third ball I would be extra side-on to try to use the hips. By the time I was done with six balls, I would be like, 'I need a break here.'" Ashwin, however, said that it was not just the injuries and their consequential exhaustion that led him to consider retirement but also how those around him were not sensitive enough to his injuries. "I felt like a lot of people were backed, why not me? I have done no less. I have won a lot of games for the team, and I am not feeling backed," he said. "I don't usually look for help, that somebody needs to back me, that somebody needs to cushion me or give me empathy. I felt I was not being able to be excellent and felt I needed a shoulder to lean on. It was not happening. I thought maybe I should try to find something else and be excellent at that." The 35-year-old Ashwin admitted that he felt 'crushed' after the then India head coach Ravi Shastri termed Kuldeep Yadav India's no.1 overseas spinner following the latter's five-for in Sydney in 2019. While the match ended in a draw, India clinched a historic Test series win Down Under. Following the triumph, Shastri proclaimed that 'there is a time for everyone (referring to Ashwin's fitness and injury issues). But now Kuldeep is our frontline number one overseas spinner.' While he was happy for his teammate and the fact that India won the series, Ashwin felt like he was being thrown under the bus. "I hold Ravi bhai in high esteem. We all do. And I understand we all can say things and then retract them. In that moment, though, I felt crushed. Absolutely crushed. We all talk about how important it is to enjoy your team-mates' success. And I was happy for Kuldeep. I have not been able to get a five-for but he has a five-for in Australia. I know how big it is. Even when I have bowled well [at other times], I haven't ended up with a five-for. So I am genuinely happy for him. And it's an extremely happy occasion, to win in Australia," said Ashwin. "But if I have to come and partake in his happiness, and the success of the team, I must feel like I belong there. If I feel like I am being thrown under the bus, how am I supposed to get up and come for a party to enjoy the team's or teammate's success? I went back to my room and then I spoke to my wife. And my children were there. So we were able to, you know, shrug it off, and I still made it to the party, because, end of the day, we had won a massive series," he said.

NAPOLI CAPTAIN INSIGNE TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19



Napoli captain Lorenzo Insigne has tested positive for Covid-19, the Serie A club said on Tuesday.

"The player will undergo a period of isolation at home. The team, following indications from the local health authority, has carried out a round of swab tests and the results will be announced in late afternoon," read a club statement.

The Italy international has played a central role in Napoli's Serie A title challenge this season, scoring four goals in 15 league appearances and helping Luciano Spalletti's side climb to second place, four points behind leaders Inter Milan.

Insigne will miss Napoli's home clash with relegation-battling Spezia on Wednesday, their final fixture before a two-week winter break.

'RIGHT TIME TO PASS ON THE MICROPHONE': DAVID LLOYD RETIRES FROM COMMENTARY



Former England cricketer and coach David Lloyd has left his role as a commentator with Sky Sports after 22 years. Also known as 'Bumble', the Englishman joined started commentary in 1999 with Sky.
