## DHONI HINTS AT PLAYING IPL 2022, HOPES TO PLAY HIS FAREWELL GAME IN CHENNAI



**NEW DELHI, (IANS)** MS Dhoni, the captain of Chennai Super Kings (CSK) on Tuesday hinted that he will continue playing for the franchise for at least one more IPL season by saying that his fans can see him play a 'farewell game' in Chennai next year. Chennai Super Kings are likely to go through a big transition phase post mega auction in 2022 and there is speculation whether MS Dhoni will be seen in yellow jersey or not. However, the 40-year-old wicketkeeper-batsman, in an event celebrating 75 years of India Cements, said that he hopes to play his last match in Chennai. "When it comes to farewell, you can still come and see me play for CSK and that can be my farewell game. So, you will still get that opportunity to bid me farewell. Hopefully, we will come to Chennai and play my last game over there and we can meet the fans there," Dhoni said while interacting with fans during the virtual event. The former India captain, who hung up his boots from international cricket last year, has not played in Chennai since 2019 as the 2020 edition of the cash-rich league was held in the UAE and CSK played matches in the first phase of IPL 2021 in Mumbai before it was suspended due to Covid-19.

# ARYAN KHAN, SON OF SHAH RUKH KHAN, SENT TO 3-DAY NCB CUSTODY WITH 2 OTHERS

After several hours of heated arguments between the NCB lawyers and the advocates of the three accused, the court rejected the latter's plea for bail and sent them to the agency's custody for another 3 days. In the order, ACMM Nerlikar noted that the accused (Aryan Khan) had accompanied the co-accused (Merchant) from whom the contraband drugs were recovered. Seeking extended custody for the accused trio till October 11, the Additional Solicitor-General Anil Singh argued that links found on Aryan Khan's WhatsApp chats point to an international racket. Besides the 8 nabbed from the swoop on the cruiser, Singh said that one more person has been arrested by the NCB from Juhu and recovered 'commercial quantity' of drugs from him, and the custody of the accused trio was necessary to unearth their nexus. Making a strong plea for bail, Khan's lawyer Satish Maneshinde said that he was invited by the party organisers, he did not pay for the party, was allotted the best suite on the ship, no drugs were found on him, but a small quantity of 6-gm Charas was recovered from his friend Merchant. Merchant's lawyer Taraq K. Sayed pointed out that the NCB remand application was absolutely silent on the quantity of drugs recovered from each accused. At this, when the ACMM asked the agency, the NCB replied that small quantities of 6 gm and 5 gm respectively were recovered from Merchant and Dhamecha, besides 5 gm MDMA and 10 gm Cocaine found from another accused Vikrant Chhoker, but did not mention Aryan Khan's name here. Singh contended that though commercial quantity of drugs may not

## MUMBAI DRUGS CASE: FROM ARYAN KHAN, ARBAAZ MERCHANTT TO MUNMUN DHAMECHA - KNOW ALL ABOUT THOSE INVOLVED

Satish Maneshinde, the lawyer arguing in defence of Aryan Khan said in the Court, "Accused number 1, Aryan Khan was invited for the cruise party. However, he did not have a boarding pass. He didn't have any seats or cabins there. Secondly, according to the seizure, nothing has been found in his possession. He is arrested only based on chats." Other accused in the case include Nupur Satija, Ishmeet Singh Chadha, Mohak Jaswal, Gomit Chopra and Vikrant Chhoker. Here's all we know about those involved in the case. Read on.  
**Munmun Dhamecha**  
Munmun is originally from Madhya Pradesh's Sagar district. At present, no one from her family lives in Madhya Pradesh. She is 39 years old and is a fashion model by profession. As per reports, her parents are no more. Her brother Prince Dhamecha lives in Delhi.  
**Nupur Sarika**  
Nupur Sarika works as a primary teacher in Delhi. Mohak had given drugs to her. Nupur Sarika had reached the rave party hiding these drugs in sanitary pads. Reportedly, NCB recovered drugs from her.  
**Ismeet Singh**  
He is a resident of Delhi and has his own chain of hotels. NCB collected 14 MDMA Ecstasy pills from him.  
**Mohak Jaswal**  
Mohak Jaswal is an IT professional from Delhi. Mohak took drugs from a local person in Mumbai, then he gave the drugs to Nupur. He asked Nupur to hide drugs in sanitary pads so that he can collect it from her in the party.

be found, the accused trio's custody was required for a few days more to find out the links, who is the sources, how it was financed. The NCB added that Aryan Khan's phone was being investigated to ascertain his involvement in the consumption or possession of drugs, and Maneshinde cited past judgements to prove that commercial quantity of drugs found on someone else cannot be used to incriminate another accused, while WhatsApp chats can't be used to frame the accused. The trio was produced before the court after their one-day remand granted on Sunday ended on Monday. Khan, along with 8 others were apprehended by the NCB raids on Cordelia Cruise ship where the alleged rave party took place on October 2 evening, and on Sunday arrested them, sparking a major sensation across the country. After the operation, the NCB said it had recovered 13 gm Cocaine, 21 gm Charas, 5 gm Mephedrone, and 22 MDMA Ecstasy pills besides Rs 133,000 cash. Besides Khan, Merchant, Dhamecha and Chhoker, the NCB nabbed others like Nupur Sarika, Ismeet Singh, MohakJaswal and Gomit Chopra. The Spokesperson of Congress Atul Londhe and Shiv Sena's Kishore Tiwari have slammed the NCB action as a diversionary tactic intended to shift attention from the huge quantity of drugs allegedly smuggled through the Mundra Port in Gujarat which is operated by the Adani Group. Last month, the DRI had raided the port and found two containers with around 3,000 kg of drugs worth Rs 21,000 crore from there, and the Opposition parties have demanded a Supreme Court-monitored probe into the incident.

**Vikrant Chhoker**  
A resident of Delhi, Vikrant is reportedly a drug addict.NCB has recovered 5 gms Mephedrone (intermediate quantity), 10gms cocaine (intermediate) from him.  
**Gomit Chopra**  
Gomit is one of the leading and best fashion makeup artists in Delhi. Trained at MAC, he can create varied looks. Gomit was reportedly hiding drugs in a contact lens case. NCB recovered 4 MDMA pills and some cocaine from him.  
**Aryan Khan**  
Shah Rukh Khan's son Aryan Khan was also arrested by the Narcotics Control Bureau on October 3. He has been sent to NCB custody till October 7. According to a report by anandabazar.com, "Aryan has admitted that he had taken drugs at the party."  
**Arbaaz Merchant**  
Arbaaz Merchantt is Aryan Khan's school friend. Both have partied together several times before and their photos went viral on the internet ever since the sensational arrest of Aryan in the drugs case on October 3. Reportedly, NCB has recovered 6 grams of charas from him.  
**Shreyas Nayar**  
Shreyas is a resident of Goregaon area in Mumbai. In the rave party, different groups were partying. Drugs were supplied by Shreyas to one of these groups. Shreyas couldn't go to the party because of some unknown reasons. He is one of the event managers of this rave party.

After Shah Rukh Khan's son Aryan Khan was detained and questioned by the Narcotics Control Bureau on Saturday superstar Suniel Shetty expressed his support for him. The NCB raided a party at which Aryan was a guest. It was also said to have discovered narcotics onboard. In a video uploaded by ANI, Suniel was speaking at an event and asked for a 'breather' for Aryan. "I would like to say that wherever there is a raid, several people are caught. And we assume that this child must have consumed drugs or this child must have done it. But the proceedings are on, let's give that child a breather," he said. The actor added, "Whenever something happens in Bollywood, the media scrutinises everything and jumps to conclusions. Give the child an opportunity. Let the real reports come out. Baccha hai (He's a kid). Taking care of him is our responsibility." As far as the update in the case is concerned, Aryan Khan has been arrested in connection with the rave party. "It's a result of a painstaking investigation that went on for two weeks. We acted on specific intelligence inputs, involvement of some Bollywood links has come to light," said NCB chief SN Pradhan to ANI. Sources said that besides Aryan Khan, his friend Arbaaz Merchantt, Munmun Dhamecha, Nupur Sarika, Ismeet Singh, Mohak Jaswal, Vikrant Chhoker and Gomit Chopra are also being questioned by the NCB.



## Mumbai thrash Rajasthan by 8 wickets, keep playoff hopes alive

**SHARJAH, (IANS)** Mumbai Indians produced a clinical performance to beat Rajasthan Royals by 8 wickets in the 51st match of the IPL 2021 to stay alive in the qualification race for the playoffs of the tournament at the Sharjah Cricket Stadium, here on Tuesday.

A sensational bowling performances by Nathan Coulter-Nile (4/14) and James Neesham (3/12) helped Mumbai Indians restrict Rajasthan Royals to a paltry total of 90-9 in 20 overs. Apart from Coulter-Nile and James Neesham, Jasprit Bumrah (2/14) also picked two crucial wickets for Mumbai. Opener Evin Lewis was the top-scorer for Rajasthan with his 24. In reply, Mumbai Indians played freely and overhauled the target in

8.2 overs. Ishan Kishan was the top-scorer for Mumbai with 50 off 25 while Mustafizur Rahman (1/32) and Chetan Sakariya (1/36) picked one wicket each for Rajasthan.

With this win, Mumbai jumped two spots to be placed just below Kolkata Knight Riders in fifth place.

### PLAYING LAST WILL ALLOW US PLAN BETTER TO GRAB IPL PLAY-OFFS SPOT: ROHIT

Mumbai Indians skipper Rohit Sharma is happy that they are playing Sunrisers Hyderabad on the last day of the league stage since they would have a clear idea about what needs to be done to sneak into the IPL play-offs.

Mumbai Indians after their facile eight-wicket win over Rajasthan Royals still have a negative run-rate of -0.048 and not only do they need to win against Sunrisers Hyderabad but also expect that KKR lose to Royals a day before to make their passage easier.

If it doesn't happen, they would need to win big against SRH.

Asked if it is an advantage to play a team like SRH on the last day, the MI captain said: "All eight teams are capable of beating each other. But the good thing is that KKR play before us, so we will know what to do."

The skipper was pleased that they achieved whatever they wanted from the game chasing a target of 91 in just 8.2 overs. "We had to come here and do what we had to do, which was to get the two points. It was a chance to improve our run rate as well. We got off to a flier, and we said there is a chance for us to up the run rate. It was the perfect game for us to do that."

Ishan Kishan is back in form with a 50 off 25 balls and skipper said that he didn't tell the youngster as to what he needs to do "Kishan is playing after a couple of games, so we wanted him to take his time. I didn't say anything to him [after he played a maiden]. All we wanted for him was to play his shots, which he did. When you are under the radar, it is important to do your job."



### 21-YEAR-OLD FROM JAMMU CLOCKS STUNNING 150-KMPH ON IPL DEBUT

IT'S MONDAY morning, but Jammu's Gujjar Nagar can't stop talking about Sunday night. That's when Umran Mallik, the son of a local fruit and vegetable seller, clocked 150 kmph on his IPL debut for Sunrisers Hyderabad. Umran isn't the first Indian to touch that magical mark — Javagal Srinath, Varun Aaron and Jasprit Bumrah are among those who have been there before — but cricket's obsession with young tearaways and the 150 milestone has triggered a growing buzz around the 21-year-old. It's been quite a journey for India's latest pace sensation, and one that had his father Abdul Mallik worried for a while. Occasionally, when Umran would step out to play tennis-ball cricket at night, the father would secretly follow. "You know how this age is. There are a lot of youngsters who are spoiling their lives by taking drugs and such. I was worried. But he (Umran) convinced us that the only 'nasha' (high) he has is playing cricket, so the family need not to be worried. Sometimes, I used to hide and see whether he was actually playing or not," Abdul, now an elated father, tells media. From being a net bowler for Sunrisers to rubbing shoulders on match day with the game's greats in IPL, life has moved rapidly for Umran who began his career just four years ago on a concrete pitch in Gujjar Nagar. At the IPL nets, he had been troubling teammate David Warner and on debut, consistently hit over 140kmph in his first over to hurry the likes of young India star Shubman Gill. But then, Umran's real journey had begun quite a while back when he landed at the coaching nets near his home without even proper cricketing shoes. "He was a simple lanky boy who wanted to bowl in the nets. I said, 'Ok, bowl'. We had a player who used to play for the J&K team. He saw Umran and told me, 'Sir, this boy has sheer speed and can be nurtured to play higher cricket'. Who knew then that three years down the line he will be playing IPL," says Randhir Singh Manhas, the coach. Umran went for the under-19 trials in Jammu and was later picked for the J&K team. He was spotted by J&K veteran Parvez Rasool and coach Irfan Pathan, who were looking for talent across the region. "Some of the junior players in our side used to be afraid to face him. They feared they would get hit. He had raw pace, which caught everyone's eye," Rasool says.



### DEFINITELY NOT A PERSONAL BATTLE, EVERYBODY IS DIFFERENT: ASHWIN ON MORGAN



Senior Indian off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin has sought to end the controversy surrounding his on-field showdown with England skipper Eoin Morgan over an extra run during an IPL match, saying it was not a personal battle but a difference of opinion on how the game should be played.

During last week's IPL match between Delhi Capitals and Kolkata Knight Riders, which is captained by Morgan, Ashwin tried to take a run after a throw ricocheted off his batting partner Rishabh Pant's body. Morgan and Ashwin then had an altercation with the England white-ball skipper calling the Indian a "disgrace" and accusing him of not adhering to the 'Spirit of Cricket' despite the fact that MCC rules allow scoring of runs after rebound from a batsman's body. England had benefitted from such a rebound not so long ago when they were awarded four runs after a throw from the deep struck Ben Stokes' bat during the 2019 World Cup final, and the umpire signalled overthrows, leading to their title triumph. "Look, I think it's definitely not a personal battle or one on one battle and I wouldn't deem it like that at all. People who want attention may be taking it that way, but I am not looking at it that way at all," Ashwin said after last night's game against Chennai Super Kings.

"...I was not the one who was aware that it had hit Rishabh (Pant). So I just felt like they had already decided they were going to have a go, and that is one of the reasons why I said the words that were used were not in the right direction and not in the right space," he explained. He was referring to his Twitter posts after that game in which he asked Morgan and Tim Southee to not use "derogatory" words and lecture him on 'Spirit of Cricket' by taking a moral high ground.

### WHY DHONI UNDER BOWLED BRAVO ON A PITCH THAT COULD HAVE SUITED HIS SLOWER-CUTTERS



Why was Dwayne Bravo given just two overs, the 18th and the 20th? That decision from MS Dhoni might well have proved the difference between a win and a loss. It was a two-paced tacky pitch ideally suited for Bravo's slower ones that grip the surface. Dhoni wasn't asked the question at the post-match but in a general observation on the pitch, he said he thought taller bowlers who hit the deck posed more problems. That would fit a bowler like Delhi's Kagiso Rabada who has the ability to pound the track with his slow cutters, and not someone like Josh Hazlewood or even Deepak Chahar who bowled seven overs between them. Bravo can not only serve out the full dipping slower ones but also possesses the ability to deliver the cutters that grip the surface. Be as that may be, Bravo nearly won the game in his two overs, the 18th and 20th of the chase, when he was brought out of the cold storage. He could have sealed it in his first itself had K Gowtham held on a to a regulation catch at long-on that would have taken out the danger man Shimron Hetmyer. Instead, it ran away to the boundary to leave Delhi Capitals needing 18 from 14.

But Bravo wasn't done yet. He nearly pulled it off in the final over when he had to defend just 6 runs. It came down to three from four after a dot ball, when he induced Axar Patel to squirt one of his typical well-outside-off slower one straight to covers. This time, though, Bravo slipped a full ball on the pads and Kagiso Rabada helped it away to the fine-leg boundary. The man who celebrated the most was Hetmyer, hopping, pumping his fist, and roaring away. And why not, it was a lovely gem from him under pressure. When Hetmyer walked out at N0.7, below R Ashwin, Delhi Capitals required 39 from 35. Ashwin's promotion was quite understandable as Shikhar Dhawan was still there, and Ashwin had showed in the previous game that in a run-a-ball situation on a slow pitch, he could do the job adequately. As it transpired, not only Ashwin but Dhawan too combusted, slamming a wide half-volley to cover fielder.

The 26-year-old, who scored 18 runs off 20 balls in the match, said that he looked to take his time at the crease, "When I went into bat (at 71/3), we needed to score at a run-a-ball pace. I aimed to finish the match for the team. Shikhar bhai told me to take my time at the crease, so I took my time and enjoyed my batting."Ripal also enjoyed watching Kagiso Rabada finish the match with a boundary in the last over.

"It was very important for us to win the match. It was a crunch situation when we needed 2 runs from 3 balls. We were looking for a couple of runs and it was great to see Rabada hit a boundary. I was disappointed that I didn't finish the match, but it was great that the team won the match and reached 20 points," he said.

# Rohit Sharma on cusp of joining elite six hitting club

Match 51 of the ongoing IPL 2021 season will witness defending champions Mumbai Indians playing Rajasthan Royals in a pulsating encounter which has a lot at stake for both the teams. With the fortunes of making the play-offs not completely in their hands courtesy a sea-saw season for both MI and RR, victory seems to be the only way forward to ensure they are alive in the 8-team competition to stake a claim in the last four stage.

Amidst the intense battle between the two teams at the Sharjah Cricket Ground to keep their play-off hopes alive, there are a few milestones which could be achieved by key players on their sides. The most notable among them being that of Mumbai Indians skipper Rohit Sharma, who is on the cusp of registering 400 sixes in T20 cricket. Known for his crisp ball striking courtesy his immaculate timing, MI skipper will fancy his chances to clear the boundary rope twice against RR and join an elite club of six hitting batters in the shortest format of the game. clash are as follows Ishan Kishan requires just a single to register 1000 runs for Mumbai Indian in the IPL. The hard hitting southpaw is known for his explosive knocks in the middle order. Kishan has amassed 999 runs in 39 innings for MI even since joining the franchise. Overall, the left hander has scored 1318 runs in the marquee Indian T20 league. Rajasthan Royal's David Miller is 41 runs short of registering 2000 runs in the IPL. The belligerent South African middle order batsman has scored 1959 runs in 88 IPL matches.

Mumbai Indian's swashbuckling seam all-rounder Hardik Pandya is just three sixes away from registering 100 sixes in the IPL.
