

Janhvi Kapoor, Rajkummar Rao's horror comedy is plain horrible

In the 2018 'Stree', Bollywood gave us A Ghost Who Walks, her twisted 'ultey' feet leaving tracks of gleeful subversion in the small town she haunts. A few hiccups notwithstanding, 'Stree' was a sharp feminist comment on the age-old fear of strong, desirous women. With the same producer and lead actor toplining 'Roohi', this week's new release in theatres, I was hoping for an encore. Sadly, the Dinesh Vijan-Rajkummar Rao's horror comedy is just plain horrible, with not one laugh in sight. There's nothing funny about 'pakdaai shaadi', in which young women are kidnapped and forced into unwanted marriages. Every time a film decides to bring it up, it makes you cringe. Why would a film in this day and age want to give space to this 'tradition' that should have been deep-sixed long back? 'Roohi' spends too much of its opening in setting up one such 'kidnap', for the benefit of a naive, open-mouthed 'gora' (Alexx O'Nell), which brings together a couple of small-town layabouts, Bhawra (Rajkummar Rao) and Kattani (Varun Sharma), and a shy young woman Roohi (Janhvi Kapoor), and deposits them in the middle of a jungle, for no good reason. A muscle-bound hood (Manav Vij) shows up once in a while. Why? We never quite get





it. The characters mumble, and fumble, and it's all a jumble. There's something up with Roohi. The two fellows soon discover that she is a shape-shifter, switching from a whisper to a roar whenever she feels like it. There was potential to this idea: a woman is never just one thing, or another. She has as much right to be many entities, as anyone else. But the film squanders it with great determination, and tasteless jokes.

What's missing is a coherent plot and writing. All we get is one cringeinducing sequence after the next ('jhaad-phoonk', exorcism, women in chains), where we are treated to problematic lines: when, when will mainstream movies stop terming wives 'chudails'? No, it never was funny; the usage now just arouses fury. Just tossing in one line as a disclaimer that the film doesn't encourage superstition, is not a buy-out. Neither is the reliable Rao's presence, usually a guarantee of quality. Sharma's brand of dialogue delivery already feels jaded. Kapoor tries gamely, but never gets a break-out right till the end. The climax is a real cracker. Finally, you get why the film was made. What a waste of an ending.

ALIA BHATT THROUGH EYES OF DIRECTORS MEGHNA GULZAR, GAURI SHINDE: SHE GIVES US CUES ON WHERE TO CALL 'CUT'





Alia Bhatt is a fine actor, a mainstream star, a star kid and also often a subject of online memes. But if one asks her directors, the moments between becoming a character in a story and the person she is, are when Alia Bhatt truly reveals herself. The moments that are rarely seen by outsiders but most intimately experienced by her collaborators. On Alia Bhatt's birthday, indianexpress.com reached out to filmmakers Gauri Shinde and Meghna Gulzar, who made Dear Zindagi (2016) and 2018 Raazi respectively, and explored the vulnerable and receptive side to the actor. While in Dear Zindagi, Alia offered a profound, intimate portrayal of a young girl struggling with the effects of childhood trauma, Raazi saw Alia giving a searing performance as a young woman left alone in a battle field, where she finds love only to lose it forever.

Gauri and Meghna, who gave the actor two remarkably different characters to play, worlds to inhabit and enemies to fight, revisited their experiences of filming Alia and how her strength lies in her ability to

feel deeply. Meghna remembers Alia's trembling hands during a scene that made her realise that the actor was not playing Sehmat anymore but had become her.

"There's a vulnerability and delicateness to Sehmat, to her being that Alia brought to the character just with the way she approached and performed it. There were times when you could see her hands physically trembling on screen and you can't always pull that off as a performance. You have to be trembling in your core while being that character for it to show up in this way in front of the camera," the

Sehmat allowed Alia to tap into myriad emotions, of which guilt proved to be particularly crucial as the woman's journey on her mission was filled with long-lasting regrets as well as suffocation of not being able to mourn her sins. Meghna shares how the scene where Sehmat finally breaks down after realising that she had come too far to go back, Alia took the charge and guided her director's gaze to a direction that she wanted the sequence to take.

"The scene where she breaks down in the shower- the scene after the interval- after she kills Abdul, all I told her was, 'This is how you are standing, this is what you do. You turn on the shower and you take it from there.' Where she went, how much she cried it's all her. I just let the camera roll till she had finished her cycle of outburst and that's when I called cut. So, a lot of times I was taking the cues from here as to where I needed to call cut and a lot of times she was taking the cues from me as to how high the emotions needs to go, which is I think a fabulously synergised working relationship between an actor and a filmmaker." It's the same synergy that Gauri Shinde mentions when she talks about seeing Alia as Kaira in Dear Zindagi. Like Meghna, even Gauri found herself in an equation with the actor where they didn't need to converse to discuss a scene. "She just got it. I don't know what else to say. Of course we thought the same way as people but it's also because Alia is very receptive. She is open to feeling things," Gauri says.

DON'T WANT TO GET INTO RUT OF REPEATING MYSELF: RAJKUMMAR RAO



Actor Rajkummar Rao says he wants to stay away from the comfort zone of playing to the gallery despite knowing that some of his "gestures" might impress the audience. In his decade-long Bollywood journey, Rao has emerged as a performer known for capturing the essence of his characters be it his National Award-winning turn as the righteous lawyer in Shahid or the menacing terrorist Ahmed Omar Saeed Sheikh in Omerta. The 36-year-old actor said even though his attempt is to play regular relatable men on screen, he avoids getting "trapped" in a certain image. "There are times when I try and be conscious that I can't repeat certain gestures and avoid that. I know it might work beautifully for the audience and perhaps even the scene, but I restrain myself. "I don't want to get into the rut of doing the same thing, repeatedly. I don't want to be trapped," Rao told PTI in an interview. To distinguish between his roles, the actor said he prefers to dive deep into brainstorming sessions with his directors. Citing the examples of Vikramaditya Motwane's Trapped, Hansal Mehta's Shahid and the upcoming Badhaai Do, helmed by Harshavardhan Kulkarni, the actor said the depth of the character decides the amount of time he dedicates to the preparation. But if it's a comedy film, like his latest Roohi, his process is more "organic." "When you do a comedy, it's spontaneous, you can't force it. It's about being there and having fun with your lines. I don't plan anything when it comes to comedies. The trick is to surrender." Rao returns to the horror-comedy universe, three years after the blockbuster Stree. "When producer Dinesh Vijan suggested that we do a horror-comedy, I was thrilled. I knew I had to play these two wild characters unlike anything. At some point, Vicky (Rao's character in Stree) and Bhawra will meet in one film. That was exciting because I'd be playing a double role. I had to play Bhawra remarkably different than Vicky, from his looks to the way he speaks." Helmed by Hardik Mehta, Roohi also stars Janhvi Kapoor and Varun Sharma. Rao is aware that the film rides on massive expectations, as it's not only one of the first major titles to release theatrically this year but also the first sequel in the horror-comedy universe.

PRIYANKA CHOPRA CELEBRATES OSCAR NOD FOR THE WHITE TIGER: 'ANNOUNCING IT MYSELF MADE IT MORE SPECIAL'

Priyanka Chopra has shared a post celebrating the nomination of The White Tiger in the Best Adapted Screenplay category in Oscars 2021. The global icon shared a photo showing all the nominees in the said category and a photo of herself with Ramin Bahrani, who wrote and directed the Netflix movie. The film is an adaptation of the Man Booker Prize-winning novel of the same name by Arvind Adiga. Priyanka is both the producer and actor in The White Tiger. The White Tiger, published in 2008, revolves around the character of Balram Halwai, a native of Laxmangarh village, who rises from his humble background to become a successful entrepreneur. He becomes the driver of a rich Delhi Man and later murders him. Rajkummar Rao and Adarsh Gourav also star. Gourav plays the main role of Balram Halwai while Rao essays the character of his employer Ashok



After a decade of hectic touring and nonstop work, Bieber has finally settled into a regular work-life schedule.

3RD T20I: ENGLAND THRASH INDIA BY 8 WKTS, TAKE 2-1 LEAD



AHMEDABAD, (IANS) England bowlers' early strikes and tight bowling in the initial phase of the Indian innings followed by opener Jos Buttler's unbeaten 83 led their team to a crushing eight-wicket win in the third T20 International at the Narendra Modi Stadium here on Tuesday. With the victory, England took a 2-1 lead in the five-match series.

The first six overs turned out to be the difference in the match. India could make just 24 for three in the powerplay stage whereas England cruised to 57/ 1 thanks to Buttler's strokeplay.

Chasing a 157-run target, England began well raising 23 for the first wicket before Jason Roy (9 off 13) was dismissed.

However, Buttler (83 off 52 balls, 5x4s, 4x6s) kept up the charge as England took 14 off Chahal's first over — the innings' fourth — and followed it up with 16 runs in the fifth over of the innings bowled by Shardul Thakur.

Buttler's partner, Dawid Malan who is also a big-hitter, played second fiddle and kept rotating the strike before he was out stumped off the bowling of Washington Sundar.

Jonny Bairstow (40 not out off 28 balls) then added an unbeaten 77 runs for the third wicket to see England home.

Earlier, skipper Virat Kohli had hammered an unbeaten 77 (46 balls, 8x4s,

4x6s) to help India reach 156/6 in 20 overs.

Kohli played a captain's knock once again, following the unbeaten and matchwinning 73 he made in the second T20I, as wickets around him kept falling. India had been reduced to 24 for three in the sixth over with K.L. Rahul, Rohit Sharma and Ishan Kishan back in the pavilion. Jofra Archer (0/32), Mark Wood (3/31), Adil Rashid (0/26) and Chris Jordan (2/35) bowled in the powerplay and made things difficult for India. The India captain added 40 runs with Rishabh Pant for the fourth wicket in just under six overs to bring India's innings back on track. Pant was run out and Shreyas lyer followed soon after. But Kohli added 70 runs for the sixth wicket with Hardik Pandya (17 off 15 balls), who surprisingly played second fiddle.

India would have been in a poor position had they not managed quick runs in the slog overs. They made 69 in the last five overs with the majority of those runs coming off Kohli's bat.

Kohli though had a blip in the field when he dropped Buttler in the 15th over but by that time Buttler had already made 76. Yuzvendra Chahal too spilled a catch. Brief scores:

Rishabh Pant letting me down with DRS calls, says all-rounder Ravichandran Ashwin

Team India off-spinning all-rounder Ravichandran Ashwin, who was the star for his side taking 32 wickets in four Tests against England and even scoring a century with the bat, still thinks he needs to improve upon one of his skills going into the next series. Ashwin, who was adjudged the 'Player of the Series' in the series, has taken a total of 44 wickets in the last two series and was also awarded the 'ICC Player of the Month' for taking 24 wickets in the month of February, in a recent chat revealed that wicket-keeper batsman Rishabh Pant was letting him down as far as the use of Decision Review System (DRS) was concerned during the series. In the recently concluded Test series, India had a little tough time as far as the reviews were concerned while umpires were spot-on with their calls on many of the occasions. Speaking to India Today, Ashwin said, "I think we need to change the lens with which people are looking at me for the DRS. "Before this series against England, my DRS (usage) was extremely good. Because you take the DRS, you need to rely on the keeper's resources.

VIRAT KOHLI SCRIPTS YET ANOTHER RECORD: 1ST BATSMAN TO SCORE 3000 RUNS IN MEN'S T20IS

India captain Virat Kohli scored a well-composed half-century to power India to a seven-wicket win over England in the second Twenty20 international on Sunday.

Kohli hit an unbeaten 73 off 49 balls as India chased down a target of 165 in 17.5 overs to level the five-match series at 1-1. It was Kohli, who finished off the game in style, with a flicked four and then a pulled six against Chris Jordan. But that was not before he hit five fours and three sixes and also became the first batsman to reach 3,000 runs in T20 internationals. Kohli now has 6001 runs from 87 T20Is since making his debut in the format in Zimbabwe in 2010. He is also the leading run-scorer in the Indian Premier League with 5878 runs from 192 matches.

INDIA EXPOSED OUR WEAKNESS IN HANDLING SLOW CONDITIONS, SAYS EOIN MORGAN

India have exposed England's "weakness" in handling slow conditions but competing here will only prepare them well for the Twenty20 World Cup, feels skipper Eoin Morgan. India drubbed England by seven wickets in the second T20 to level the five-match series 1-1 on Sunday night.

Morgan admitted they struggled to get used to the slow surface used for the second match. "I suppose the difference was in the wicket we played and how we adapted. It was different wicket from the one we batted in the first game. The pitch was slow and low and one thing that does is expose our weakness on these surfaces a little bit," said Morgan at the post-match virtual media interaction on Sunday night. "We don't play a lot on slow, low wickets and the more that we can do that, the better. You only become better in these conditions by playing in them and making mistakes."

The English skipper, however, said playing in such tough conditions ahead of the ICC World T20 later this year in India, will only help them. "I thought the other night, the pitch really suited us because it had more pace in it - similar to a wicket at home, a Cardiff wicket or somewhere like that, that was a little bit uneven and maybe stood up a little bit. "But this took us out of our comfort zone and really was a typical Indian wicket that we would play on in an IPL game. Again, your accuracy has to be on," Morgan said. "You tend to learn quicker if you're winning and confident and everything goes reasonably smoothly – you can integrate the learning quite quickly - but equally, if we have to lear n the hard way, we're still going through that process of trying to learn game-on-game so when it comes to the World Cup in seven months' time, we can be as best prepared."
