

SIKH BODY SUBMITS COMPLAINT AGAINST KANGANA RANAUT IN MUMBAI SEEKING FIR OVER 'DEROGATORY' LANGUAGE



A Sikh organisation on Monday submitted a complaint seeking registration of an FIR against Bollywood actor Kangana Ranaut in Mumbai alleging that she had used derogatory language against the Sikh community in her social media post. A Khar police station official said a complaint was received from the Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee (DSGMC) and they are looking into it. He said a delegation led by Manjinder Singh Sirsa, a Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) leader and president of the DSGMC, submitted the complaint against Ranaut. In the complaint, the DSGMC mentioned that Ranaut had intentionally and deliberately portrayed the farmers' protest (Kisan Morcha) as a Khalistani movement and also dubbed the Sikh community as Khalistani terrorists. It claimed that she had recalled the massacre and genocide that happened during 1984 and earlier, as a planned and calculated move on part of then prime minister Indira Gandhi, the official said quoting the complaint.

KOLKATA, (IANS) After India's comprehensive 3-0 series win against New Zealand, the head coach Rahul Dravid on Sunday said he is impressed with his team's performance throughout the three matches but they have to keep their feet on the ground and need to be realistic about the victory. Rohit Sharma's fantastic fifty and a clinical bowling performance led by Axar Patel



(3/9), powered India to a convincing 73-run win over New Zealand in the third and final T20I, helping the hosts complete a 3-0 clean sweep in the three-match series at the iconic Eden Gardens on Sunday. Speaking after the win, Team India head coach said New Zealand had arrived in India immediately after a World Cup final loss and it wasn't easy for the visitors to play back-to-back matches.

"It was a really good series win. Everyone played really well right through the series. It feels good, nice to start well. We are also quite realistic. We have to keep our feet on the ground and be a bit realistic about this win. Not easy for NZ to play a World Cup final and then to turn up three days later to play three games in six days, was never going to be easy for them," said Dravid during the post-match presentation. "Nice from our perspective but we have to learn from this series and move forward. It's a long journey ahead over the next 10 months and we'll have our share of ups and downs," he added.

JACQUELINE FERNANDEZ BURNS THE INTERNET WITH PICTURES IN BODY-HUGGING SUIT



RANI MUKERJI ON FINANCIAL INSTABILITY IN BOLLYWOOD: 'BEING FROM A FILM FAMILY DOES NOT ALWAYS SPEAK OF ANY PRIVILEGE'



Rani Mukerji reprises the role of Vimmi "Babli" Saluja in Bunty Aur Babli 2, a sequel to 2005's Bunty Aur Babli. In a recent interview, she detailed the trials and tribulations she experienced before making it big in the film industry.

She said that despite belonging to a reputed family with strong connections to the world of cinema — her father Ram Mukherjee was a film director and her mother, Krishna Mukherjee, was a playback singer — she was not exactly privileged.

While speaking to Bollywood Bubble, Rani explained that back in the day, belonging to a film family did not guarantee wealth. People would sell their homes just to release their films, and producers would be "left on the roads" because they didn't have money. "Being from a film family does not always speak of any privilege," she said. "People are poor also, they come from humble backgrounds," she added.

Rani debuted in the film industry in 1996 with her father's Bengali film Biyer Phool. In the same year, she debuted in Hindi cinema with Raja Ki Aayegi Baraat, in which she was cast by noted producer Salim Akhtar. Rani claimed that "Salim uncle" did not cast her because she was "somebody's daughter, somebody's niece." She was cast, she said, probably because he noticed a "spark" in her. "I was chosen because he thought I probably had the spark to be able to face the camera. And I did have to give an audition. The director and the DOP [director of photography] liked the way I looked, and Salim uncle was confident enough. All actors who make it big in the industry are newcomers when they start off, and they start somewhere. It was the same case with me. I started and I worked on myself and worked hard. I am happy that today I have fans who support me through thick and thin."

DHAMAKA: NETFLIX'S THRILLING KARTIK AARYAN-STARRER IS AN ATTACK ON ALL THE RIGHT PEOPLE



The 'villain' at the centre of Netflix's Dhamaka, starring Kartik Aaryan, has a very clear objective. He doesn't want to take over the world, nor is he after fame and riches—although, it can be argued, he isn't completely averse to the idea of some extra cash and a moment in the sun. He is, instead, motivated by revenge, but the sort that you, as a member of the audience, can get behind. Raghubeer Mhata attacks all the right people—the greedy news media, the corrupt government, the apathetic public that have collectively wronged him—and he's here for his pound of flesh.

He is an angry man, and Dhamaka is an angry film. Too angry, some might say, considering how overeager it is to point fingers at those it wants to hold accountable for their (in) action. Exploited and forgotten by the powerful elite, Raghubeer has come to claim what he is owed. He was a part of the construction crew that helped build the Bandra-Worli Sea Link, he says. It was during that time that three of his crew members died because of glaring safety lapses. But nobody cared. Three men died, and nobody cared. Not only were the deaths swept under the rug, the story didn't even make the news.

And for that, he blames the politicians who were instrumental in burying the incident at sea, and the TV channels that were complicit in ensuring that the bodies, so to speak, didn't float to the surface. And so, on a sunny day, he calls up a local radio station and asks for Arjun Pathak, a disgraced former anchor who is carrying out a punishment posting for vaguely defined misdeeds. Raghubeer tells Arjun that he has planted bombs across the city, and to prove his claim, detonates one on the Sea Link. He might be a common man, but he is playing God—Raghubeer is both the creator and the destroyer.

Dhamaka treats television news like the reality show that it is both Raghubeer and Arjun know that they're on TV, and both have crafted narratives for themselves in their minds. But neither realises that there is a Bigg Boss watching from above, using them as puppets for his own amusement and gain. They're both being exploited, although very differently. It makes them two sides of the same coin, and perfect foes for a cat-and-mouse thriller. Raghubheer has a grudge, Arjun Pathak has a grudge, but perhaps most noticeably, Kartik Aaryan has a grudge. Forever typecast as a heartthrob, the actor (and the film) leans in on Arjun's utter lack of redeeming qualities. It's quite interesting to note that despite experiencing so much, virtually in real-time, Arjun barely evolves as a person, and remains, until the final frames, a reactionary character. More than this ef forts to live up to the requirements of several emotionally draining scenes, it is Aaryan's willingness to be an absolute prick that is most admirable. Dhamaka, ultimately, is a movie about a rather despicable man coming to the gradual realisation that he isn't the hero of his own story, but rather, the villain of a larger one. He thinks only about himself; even after the first bomb goes off, his mind remains focused on how he can use the situation to his advantage. He remembers only much later that his estranged wife is on the ground, putting her life on the line as she covers the story.



ROHIT, HARSHAL, AXAR STAR AS DOMINANT INDIA **THRASH NEW ZEALAND TO WIN T201 SERIES 3-0**

eam India completed a commanding 3-0 win beginning the Rahul Dravid era in style against New Zealand. Skipper Rohit Sharma, Harshal Patel, Axar Patel, Deepak Chahar, Venkatesh Iyer all contrib uted to a massive win by 73 runs in the third and final match of the T20I series at Eden Gardens in Kolkata. Rohit decided to bat first after winning his third consecutive toss in the series. On a dewy evening, he and his new opening partner Ishan Kishan got the team off to a flier scoring 69 runs in the powerplay. Rohit was smacking everything and raced off to 39* off just 17 balls. However, the innings slowly went into lumber as New Zealand skipper on the day, Mitchell Santner pegged back India twice in his first over by

getting rid of Ishan and Suryakumar Yadav. Santner soon removed Rishabh Pant, in his next over and India were reeling now despite the start they got. Rohit, on the other hand, marched on and brought up his second fifty of the series. But a blinder from Ish Sodhi off his own bowling cut short his stay. The lyers - Shreyas and Venkatesh - rebuilt with a few boundaries but they too got out in quick succession. India's innings was going nowhere only to be saved by late cameos by Harshal Patel and Deepak Chahar to reach the score of 184 runs, which now was in the zone of a good score. New Zealand needed a good start to challenge the total and one thing which they didn't want was losing wickets and they lost them, plenty. It seemed like Axar Patel was

prepping for the Test matches as he took three wickets one after the other quickly as he pegged the visitors early. Martin Guptill continued in the same vein as he has done throughout the series. Even though he got a reprieve, he made it count and went on to score another fifty. However, once he got out to Yuzvendra Chahal it all fell apart for the T20 World Cup finalists. No one was able to score much and when they wanted to, lost their wicket as eventually, they fell 73 runs short of the target. Even though they have won coach Rahul Dravid said that they need to keep their feet on the ground knowing that New Zealand had a quick turnaround and have played four games in eight days, going into the Test series.

realistic. We have to keep our feet on the ground and be a bit realistic about this win," Dravid said at the post-match presentation here. The series was also Dravid's first assignment as head coach.

The Kiwis had reached Jaipur for the series opener less than 24 hours after losing the World Cup final to Australia in Dubai.

"Not easy for NZ to play a World Cup final and then to turn up three days later and play three games in six days, was never going to be easy for them. It was nice from our perspective but we have to learn from this series and move forward.

"It's a long journey ahead over the next two years and we'll have our share of ups and downs."

India also rested some of their crucial players including the likes of Virat Kohli, Jasprit Bumrah and Ravindra Jadeja. New Zealand gave rest to their skipper Kane Williamson.

India also gave debut caps to IPL performers Venkatesh Iyer (Kolkata Knight Riders) and Harshal Patel (Royal Challengers Bangalore) in the series. "It's been really good to see some of the young guys come through. We have given opportunities to some of the boys who haven't played a lot of cricket over the last few months. "We have seen some Some of the key players from both teams were rested for the series of the skills available to us and we have to keep building on those skills as we go forward. It's going to be a long season between now "It was a really good series win. Everyone played really well right and the next World Cup being realistic with how much cricket some of our experienced players will play," Dravid signed off.

HECTIC SCHEDULE, TIME AWAY FROM HOME TAKING A TOLL ON KIWIS: MCCULLUM

AUCKLAND, (IANS) Former New Zealand skipper Brendon McCullum has partly blamed the hectic schedule for the Black Caps' 3-0 T20I series loss to India, saying that while it was fr ustrating to lose in such a manner, it was more on account of players being away from home for far too long. New Zealand lost the third and final T20I against the Rohit Sharma-led India in Kolkata on Sunday to add to the defeats they suffered in Jaipur and Ranchi.

The Black Caps were bowled out for 111 at the Eden Gardens as they were nowhere near India's 184, with Martin Guptill hitting a half-century and Mitchell Santner taking three wickets. "The Blackcaps were a bit frustrating, but it's a tough schedule for them to bounce straight out of a (T20) World Cup Final and then head over to India and take on a team over there, but



they'll be disappointed with their return no doubt," McCullum told SENZ Breakfast on Monday. The New Zealand team, after finishing their T20 World Cup assignment in the UAE where they lost to Australia in the final, flew straight to Jaipur the next morning, and less than two days later they were playing the three-match T20I series against India. While praising Guptill's knock, McCullum also said that not many in the team gave him support in the series. "Not many guys actually put up their hand to be honest. Probably only (Martin) Guptill, was probably the only one who will walk away from that tour really content that he sort of made a fist of the conditions." New Zealand have been away from home for six weeks and, with the two Tests against India coming up in Kanpur and Mumbai, it'll be two more weeks before they head back. "It's not always easy (to be away from home), I understand that. If I look at the Black Caps, I actually think they looked a little fatigued as well and their performances over the last couple of days.

FOR CAPTAIN ROHIT, ASHWIN IS AN



With Ravichandran Ashwin getting a second wind in white-ball cricket, Rohit Sharma spoke of the senior off-spinner's contributions in glowing terms since his return to the limited-overs fold after a gap of four years.

"He (Ashwin) is always an attacking option for his captain. When you have someone like him in the squad, it always gives you the opportunity to take wickets in the middle, and we understand how important that middle phase is. That's where you need to put the brakes on run-rate and try keep taking wickets. Ashwin provides that in the middle, along with Axar (Patel)," India's T20 captain said at the post-match press conference after a 3-0 clean sweep over New Zealand. Washington Sundar's injury paved the way for Ashwin's return to the shortest format, as he was picked for the T20 World Cup. However, he wasn't selected for the first two matches in the tournament, against Pakistan and New Zealand, and belatedly, on the heels of back-to-back defeats, Ashwin was included in the playing eleven for the game against Afghanistan. In three matches at the World Cup, the 35-year-old offie claimed six wickets at an economy rate of 5.25. His resurgence continued in the home T20Is against the Kiwis, where in the first two matches – Ashwin was rested for the dead rubber - he once again made an impact, including a worldie to dismiss Mark Chapman at Jaipur. "It's been a great comeback for him. Ever since he played in Dubai (at the T20 World Cup) and till now... He is a quality bowler, we all know that. And now the way he has come back and bowled in Dubai and the two games here, it shows the quality that he has," Rohit said, dropping a hint that unlike the previous team management under Virat Kohli and Ravi Shastri, the new leadership group of Rohit and head coach

Time right for Cummins to be made Test skipper: Clarke



SYDNEY, (IANS) Former Australian cricketer Michael Clarke feels the time is right for pacer Pat Cummins to be made the captain of the Test team despite his leadership inexperience. He added that the seniors in the team can help Cummins in adjusting to captaincy duties.

Cummins is the front-runner to lead Australia in the Ashes after Tim Paine decided to step down from the post due to an off-field scandal. In the past few days, several former Australian players have said in unison about elevating Cummins from vice-captain to captain. Clarke is now the latest to join the list.

"If we were three or five years on it might be different. But with so much seniority in the team, I think it is the right time for him. Because they can help him. Steve Smith, David Warner, Nathan Lyon, Mitchell Starc, Josh Hazlewood. These guys have played a truckload of Test cricket. They can be there to help him, with or without the C or VC next

to his name," Clarke said on the Big Sports Breakfast show on Sky Sports Radio.

After Paine's sudden resignation, Cricket Australia had announced that they have begun the accelerated process of selecting the next Test captain. But, as things stand, there has been no word on who will be the Test captain when the Ashes first Test begins on December 8 in Brisbane. Clarke, who has been a vocal supporter of Cummins being made skipper since 2018, thinks that one needs to see how the 28year-old is involved with the on-field proceedings.

"You have to allow him time to get into this job. Because he hasn't had 10 years of captain first-grade or state cricket. But sometimes you can see certain things in people, and I think he's got it. He reads the game. He's a cricket captain. Looking at on the field tactics. The way he talks to his players. The way he sets the field when he bowls."

16 teams ready to battle it out for FIH Men's Junior World Cup



BHUBANESWAR, (IANS) Hockey fever is set to grip the nation as 16 participating teams prepare to battle it out for top honours at the FIH Odisha Hockey Junior World Cup Bhubaneswar 2021, scheduled to begin on November 24.

All four teams in their respective pools will be aiming to finish in the top half of their pool, as the top two teams from each pool will qualify for the quarterfinal. In Pool A, European heavyweights Belgium will face off against Malaysia, Chile and South Africa.

"While we did not have overseas competition, the team played some practice games against the senior side in Bhubaneswar, which were quite valuable. It's good that we are getting to train here before we start," India chief coach Graham Reid added on the team's preparations.

India will begin their campaign against France on November 24. Netherlands, Spain, Korea and USA will lock horns in Pool C. Pool D will see Germany, Pakistan, Egypt and Argentina face off against each other. Belgium will play against South Africa in the first game on November 24.

THEY HAVE BEEN VERY PROFESSIONAL: BANGAR ON INDIA'S BOWLING

MUMBAI, (IANS) Former India cricketer Sanjay Bangar has showered praise on India's bowlers for putting up a professional performance against New Zealand in the three-match T20I series.

He listed out the spin duo of Ravichandran Ashwin and Axar Patel along with pacers Bhuvneshwar Kumar and Harshal Patel as key performers in India's bowling attack. India completed a 3-0 sweep over New Zealand in T20Is, marking a good start to their preparations for next year's T20 World Cup in Australia. "They have been very professional, they have been put under the pump a bit by the New Zealand openers but the way Indian spinners have responded in the middle overs has been fantastic. So, Ashwin and Axar Patel both bowling well in tandem has really worked well for the Indian team in the middle overs and when they were chasing," said Bangar on Follow The Bules show on Star Sports. Bangar further spoke about Kumar gaining his form after being out of the playing eleven post the T20 World Cup opening match against Pakistan, emphasising on his dismissal of Daryl Mitchell in the first T20I at Jaipur.

"Can't take anything away from somebody like Bhuvneshwar Kumar, who's got his swing back because whenever he's played and he's bowled with that new ball, he's got his swing back. The wicket that he took in the first match of Daryl Mitchell was a dream and it augers really well for the Indian team because he's somebody who can give you those initial breakthroughs in the first six overs inside the powerplay and that sets any opposition on the back foot." Bangar, who served as the batting coach of India from 2014 to 2019, applauded Patel's efforts in using the variations at the back-end of the innings.

ALWAYS CHALLENGING COMING TO INDIA AND PLAYING A REALLY GOOD SIDE: SANTNER

KOLKATA, (IANS) New Zealand spinner Mitchell Santner, who captained the team in the third T20I against India on Sunday, admitted that it is always a challenge to play against an Indian team in their home conditions. He added that New Zealand couldn't step up to the challenge of consistently picking wickets at the top.

With the 73-run loss in the third and final T20I on Sunday, New Zealand were consigned to a 3-0 loss in the series which came just three days after playing in the Men's T20 World Cup final against Australia in Dubai.

"It was a challenging series. It's always challenging coming to India and playing a really good side. We were good in patches in every game. I think we lost a couple of overs here and there and stuff like that. Rohit Sharma is a very good player and showed that again in the series. I guess the challenge for us was to get wickets at the top and we couldn't seem to do that throughout the series," said Santner

"But credit to the way Rohit and KL (Rahul) batted at the top and backed up throughout the game. We had our chances. I think the conditions changed in every game. Obviously, the dew played a big factor. The pitch felt like it slowed down a little bit," added Santner, who had figures of 3/27 in Kolkata.

Asked if fatigue was a reason in New Zealand losing the series, Santner remarked, "It's been a challenge. It's been a quick turnaround after the World Cup. But we pride ourselves on turning up in all the three matches and playing some good cricket against a very good Indian side. We tried to win a series in India which is tough to do and they showed once again that it's a tough challenge."

Santner insisted that beating India will be tough in home conditions, especially with the Test series starting from November 25. New Zealand were beaten 3-0 by India in the Test series back in 2016. "It doesn't really matter what format you come up against India. They are going to be a challenge to beat. We saw that the last time we were here for Tests in 2016.

HARMANPREET KAUR NAMED IN WBBL **TEAM OF THE TOURNAMENT**



Indian T20 skipper Harmanpreet Kaur has been named in the Women's Big Bash League's official 'Team of the Tournament' after her stellar all-round performance for Melbourne Renegades this season. Kaur has shone bright with both bat and ball for the Renegades, scoring 399 runs with three half-centuries. Her strike rate has been an impressive 135.25 while her average is 66.5. Her highest score was an unbeaten 81-run knock against the Sydney Thunder last week. She has also hit a competition-best 18 sixes till now.

"Harmanpreet Kaur has been a dominant force with bat and ball for the Renegades, spearheading their rise back up the ladder after joining her new club," cricket.co.au said. Kaur has also proved her mettle with the ball following an injury to the team's star leg-spinner, Georgia Wareham. The 32-year-old has been brilliant in the power play and has snared 15 wickets. The Indian T20 skipper also boasts of the best figures of 3/22. Kaur is the only Indian to feature in the best XI of WBBL despite some quality performances by the likes of Smriti Mandhana, who became the first from the country to hit a century in the league with a record-equalling 114 not out.

WRIST SPINNERS ARE MATCH-WINNERS IN T10 FORMAT: ADIL RASHID



ABU DHABI, (IANS) The importance of wrist spinners in the shortest format of cricket is paramount, feels England leg spinner Adil Rashid. He said that wrist spinners can shift the momentum of the game in T20 and T10 cricket and can be matchwinners on any track.

Rashid who himself is a wrist spinner said that the most important thing for a leg spinner in T10 is to keep the confidence with which he is bowling despite going for runs.

"These days and age we have smaller grounds, flatter pitches, and bigger bats, people are hitting the ball further so they can be a bit difficult for spinners. It can play with your mind but the most important thing as a wrist spinner is to maintain that confidence knowing that you can change the game," Rashid said on the sidelines of Abu Dhabi T10 League where he is playing for Delhi Bulls.

"You can become a match-winner, you are a match-winner, you can change the game in what 3 or 4 or 5 balls by getting a key wicket then another wicket, that's the ability of a wrist spinner in general," he added.

Rashid admitted that bowling is a tough job in T10 format since the batter has the license to go after you right from the word go. "Well, the challenges are people are trying to hit every ball for sixes and four in T10 cricket, whereas in T20 batsmen take a couple of balls to see and know the game," he said.

PAINE MAKES A HUGE STATEMENT BEHIND THE STUMPS; TAKES SIX CATCHES



HOBART, (IANS) Former Australian Test captain Tim Paine made a huge statement on Monday, as he returned to competitive cricket, taking six catches behind the stumps playing for Tasmania second XI at the Lindisfarne Oval here, indicating that he has recovered fully from the invasive neck surgery the wicketkeeper-batter underwent in September.

Paine, who stepped down as Australia's Test captain following a sexting scandal less than three weeks before the Ashes, had undergone a neck surgery in mid-September to set right a bulging disc that had been causing him discomfort in his left arm and neck. The bulging disc was pressing on the nerve canal, causing pain on the left side of the body.

While the 37-year-old Paine has stepped down as captain, he has made himself available for selection in the Ashes side. On Monday, he finally played his first full day of competitive cricket against South Australia second XI.

Paine looked at ease behind the stumps taking several low catches on both sides as South Australia were bowled out for 165, with Tasmania 58 for one at stumps. Paine will bat for Tasmania if required on Tuesday.
