That's what Pagglait is all about! It's much beyond a widow who can't cry, it's about unlearning and accepting the age-old way of grievances.

Even in today's times, some families want to see their children married irrespective of how they feel about each other. Caste, religion everything comes into question when two individuals fall for each other and want to become life partners.

When Sandhya discovers about her husband's past post his death, she realises she didn't know the man at all. What she thought is his nature as a person was something else in totality. While discovering about her husband. Sandhva also knows how he was forced into this marriage despite being in love with someone else (Sayani Gupta).

Despite being a highly-educated person, she is constrained to the four



walls. She becomes an English tutor to her brother-in-law whereas she can seek a high-level job easily.

The patriarch of the family (Raghubir Yadav) shows that he is broadminded but shows the typical mindset of seeing a person of another religion living under the same roof during the mourning period. Her cutlery is also separated from the rest of the people and expects her to eat from outside. The gossipmongers of the family assemble like a WhatsApp group to talk behind Sandhya and her parents who are staying with her until the thirteenth day of the death.

Pagglait touches upon many important subjects still existing in the country which need a few unlearning in the process. The film talks about how money is above all, the higher the girl is educated, the more well-earned guy she can get married to. Coming to performances, Sanya Malhotra is a natural actor and her straight face dialogue delivery is on-point. She carries the film on her shoulders like a boss and gets effortless support from the stellar supporting cast.





Recently, in her documentary, "Demi Lovato: Dancing with the Devil", Lovato had revealed being sexually assaulted by her drug dealer, on the night she almost died.

Oprah Winfrey asked Aishwarya Rai why she has never kissed on screen, Abhishek Bachchan's answer had everyone in splits





Team India defeated the England side in a nailbiter at the Maharashtra Cricket Association (MCA) Stadium in Pune by just seven runs in the final over to clinch the series 2-1. It didn't seem like the England side will take the game that far as they were struggling at a couple of moments, however, all-rounder Sam Curran defied all odds as he stayed unbeaten on 95 off just 83 balls as he notched up his maiden ODI half-century in the third ODI. India had a fabulous start in the second innings as pacer Bhuvneshwar Kumar removed the two openers Jason Roy and Jos Buttler early before Ben Stokes and Dawid Malan kept the Indian bowlers at the bay for a few overs. Stokes lived a charmed life as he was dropped once and was almost run-out once but his luck ran out as he tried to slog left-arm pacer T Natarajan's full toss. It didn't take time for India to get England's stand-in captain Jos Buttler as the breakthrough specialist Shardul Thakur got him trapped in front of the wickets and India got their fourth wicket in an inspiring review. After which, Dawid Malan and Liam Livingstone stitched a

60-run partnership to help England come back into

the game. But losing two quick wickets pegged them back again and India were now on the top.

But Sam Curran stood like a wall and along with Adil Rashid kept the scorecard ticking as the run-rate was never out of England's reach. Curran brought up his first half-century but a stunning catch by skipper Kohli meant, Thakur broke the partnership again. Then. Mark Wood joined the forces and the two continued to frustrate the Indian side. But in the end, it proved to be too much for him in the end even when he kept India at the bay staying unbeaten on 95.

ROHIT SHARMA-SHIKHAR DHAWAN BECOMES SECOND INDIAN PAIR TO ACHIEVE THIS MASSIVE RECORD

Team India opening pair of Rohit Sharma and Shikhar Dhawan went past 5000 partnership runs in the ODIs on Sunday in the decider of the three-match series against England in Pune. Rohit and Shikhar stitched a 103-run partnership on just 14.4 overs to give India a much-needed fast start to challenge this marauding England's batting line-up. With those 103 runs, Rohit and Shikhar took their partnership runs tally to 5023 runs in the ODIs. By the virtue of the same, they became the second Indian pair to score 5000plus runs as an opening partnership after Sachin Tendulkar and Sourav Ganguly, who are on the top of the pile with 8227 runs. The former legendary batting pair has batted together in 176 innings and average 47.55 with 26 100-plus and 29 5-plus stands. While Rohit-Shikhar average 45.25 with 17 100-run partnerships



and 15 50-plus stands. Earlier, after losing the toss for the third time in the ongoing series India were put in to bat and rectifying their batting approach from the last game, India started their innings in an aggressive manner even if it meant risking losing wickets.

THISARA PERERA BECOMES FIRST SRI LANKAN TO HIT SIX SIXES IN AN OVER

All-rounder Thisara Perera became the first Sri Lankan to hit six sixes in an over in any form of professional cricket during a domestic tournament near in Colombo. The 31-yearold achieved the feat during his unbeaten 13-ball 52 while captaining Sri Lanka Army in a group match against Bloomfield Cricket and Athletic Club in the Major Clubs Limited Over List A tournament at the Army Ground in Panagoda town on Sunday. His knock, which had eight sixes in it, was also the second-fastest half-century by a Sri Lankan in List A cricket, after former Sri Lanka all-rounder Kaushalya Weeraratne's 12-ball fifty in 2005. Perera came in to bat at No. 5 with 20 balls remaining in their innings that was truncated to 41-overs-a-side. Part-time off-spinner Dilhan Cooray was the bowler at the receiving end of Perera's onslaught. Perera is the ninth cricketer in the world to have achieved this feat in professional cricket, after Garfield Sobers, Ravi Shastri, Herschelle Gibbs, Yuvraj Singh, Ross Whiteley, Hazratullah Zazai, Leo Carter and recently Kieron Pollard.

Rishabh Pant is the future, can't imagine an Indian side without him: Ian Bell

"I can't imagine an Indian side without Rishabh Pant in it," says former England batsman Ian Bell and calls the swashbuckling wicketkeeper-batsman a "rare talent", who played with a lot of maturity against the Englishmen recently. Making a comeback into the Indian white-ball side, Pant was promoted to No. 4 and the 23-year-old did not disappoint. He scored two half-centuries in the two ODIs.

'He has shades of MS Dhoni': Jos Buttler on Sam Curran's valiant 95-run knock

England stand-in skipper Jos Buttler saw shades of the 'great finisher' Mahendra Singh Dhoni in Sam Curran's valiant 95 not out that went in vain as India sealed the ODI series 2-1 by winning the third and final match here on Sunday. In a nerve-racking series decider, Curran, coming out to bat at number 8, led a fine England fight back after they were seven wickets down for 200 to revive the visitors' hopes of chasing down 330 but eventually fell short by seven runs. With all eyes will now be on the IPL beginning on April 9, Buttler believes Curran, who is in the Dhoni-led Chennai Super Kings, will have a great opportunity to talk to the former India captain. "I'm sure Sam would want to talk to MS about tonight's innings," Buttler said at the virtual post-match news conference. "I'm sure there were shades of the way that he (MS Dhoni) would have liked to take the game down if he was in that situation. He's a great person for Sam to have a conversation with when he meets up MS (in the IPL)." England all-rounder Moeen Ali will also play for CSK in the IPL.
