AT ONE POINT - STEVE SMITH AFTER RR'S

RECORD-BREAKING WIN Captain of Rajasthan Royals, Steve Smith was all smiles after his team downed Kings XI Punjab by four wickets and in the process, pulled off the highest successful chase in the history of the IPL. KXIP posted a strong 223/ 2 with Mayank Agarwal leading the way with a maiden IPL century. The Royals responded in style with Sanju Samson, Rahul Tewatia and Smith peeling off fifties, which in the end, paved the way for RR's win with three balls to spare in Match 9 of IPL 2020. Smith lauded the efforts of Tewatia (who hit 30 in one over from Sheldon Cottrell) and Samson (top-scoring with 85 including seven sixes) and said the way KXIP batsmen were going, he harboured the thoughts of the Royals chasing down a target of 250 at one stage. "That was some chase! Tewatia, that was some sort of display against Cottrell. We got an idea about the conditions here in the last game. It's a small ground, we always thought if we have wickets in the shed, we always have a chance," Smith said. "Samson is hitting sixes at will at the moment. We saw in the nets that he was hitting the ball like he did in that over to Cottrell. Credit to him. Three sixes off Cottrell would have got us back in that game, that's great self-belief. Looked like we could be chasing over 250 at one point, credit to the bowlers for pulling things back." This is the first time in his IPL career that Samson has scored back-to-back fifties in the IPL. In the Royals' first game, Samson hit an astonishing nine sixes and only one four en route to playing a knock of 74 off 32 balls. As far as

NCB official reveals Deepika Padukone, Sara Ali Khan, Shraddha Kapoor said they don't even smoke



An official of the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) recently revealed that all four actresses Deepika Padukone, Sara Ali Khan, Rakul Preet Singh, and Shraddha Kapoor who were recently questioned about the alleged drug nexus in Bollywood have denied substance abuse.

As reported earlier, all four actresses said that when they spoke about "doob" in their WhatsApp messages, they were referring to hand-rolled cigarettes. "They said they don't even smoke cigarettes," the official said, Times of India reported. The actresses reportedly have also denied having any knowledge regarding late actor Sushant Singh Rajput's drug habit. The NCB officer said that technical analysis of their mobile phones which were voluntarily surrendered will clear all doubts. Apart from these actresses, Kshitij Prasad, who is a former executive producer of Dharmatic Entertainment, owned by Karan Johar has been remanded in NCB custody till Oct 3. Prasad told a magistrate's

court that he was 'harassed' to make a statement that would implicate Johar. Prasad is among the 20 people, including Rhea Chakraborty, who is in custody. An NCB official seeking Prasad's remand said he was a key accused linked to the "drug syndicate" and was being uncooperative.

The remand application states that Prasad had taken delivery of ganja from Karamjeet alias Anand Singh and his associates Ankush Arneja and Kaizan Ibrahim, who is connected with Sushant's manager Samuel Miranda and hence NCB needed his custodial interrogation to probe deeper into his role. Meanwhile, his lawyer Satish Maneshinde has alleged that the NCB was using intimidatory tactics to draw out a confession from Prasad. He said they found nothing during a search of his house "apart from the end bit of a stale and dry cigarette butt in the balcony but they suggested it was ganja and even drew up a 'panchnama' to that effect despite his protests."

EX-BIGG BOSS CONTESTANT HIMANSHI KHURANA TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 AFTER PARTICIPATING IN FARMERS' PROTEST

Himanshi Khurana informed her fans on Sunday afternoon that she has tested positive for coronavirus. She informed that it happened days after she participated in the farmers' protest in Punjab, despite taking proper precautions. The 'Bigg Boss 13' contestant requested people who came in touch with her, to get themselves checked. She asked people protesting to not forget that we all are going through a pandemic and thus proper care is essential. Himanshi shared the news on Instagram through an image which read, "I want 2 inform u all dat i hv been tested positive 4 covid-19 even after taking proper precautions. As you all know that i was the part of the protest day before yesterday & d area was crowded so i thought to get d test done before i go for my shoot today evening. . I jst wanted to inform people who came in my contact to get ur test done & please take proper precautions in d protest. Its my request to all the people protesting to not forget that we are going through pandemic so please take proper care."

RAKUL PREET SINGH REVEALS KSHITIJ PRASAD PROCURED DRUGS REGULARLY: REPORT





Kshitij Prasad has been arrested by the Narcotics Control Bureau after having strong hints that he was in possession of drugs. The agency is currently seeking four-day custody of former Dharmatic (sister concern of Karan Johar's Dharma Productions) executive producer, confirmed Times Now.

The news agency also said that Rakul Preet Singh, during her probe with the NCB, revealed that Kshitij procured drugs for Bollywood celebrities regularly. They also reported that teh actress took four names of high-profile celebrities and said that he provided drugs to them on regular basis, along with other celebs.

According to reports, NCB also raided his home and found small quantity of weed there. Kshitij had told reporters "I am being framed" while being taken for interrogation on Saturday. Prasad was arrested hours after Karan Johar disassociated himself from Kshitij. "Mr Prasad joined Dharmatic Enter tainment, a company linked to Dharma Productions, in November 2019 as one of the executive producers on contract basis for a project which eventually did not materialise. Neither I, nor Dharma Productions can be made responsible for what people do in their personal lives. These allegations do not pertain to Dharma Productions," read a part of the statement which Karan Johar released.

ANI confirmed the news of the arrest, sharing images of Kshitij and stating that he is being taken for COVID-19 test, which is a formality before arresting someone.

The agency had previously shared, "Dharma Productions executive producer Kshitij Ravi Prasad to be arrested by Narcotics Control Bureau soon, in connection with a drug probe. Formalities are being completed."

It has now confirmed the arrest, writing, "Narcotics Control Bureau officials take Kshitij Ravi Prasad for medical examination as a part of formalities before his arrest."





Millie Bobby Brown takes on patriarchy as detective, decipherer, finder of lost souls

When we have a director Harry Bradbeer, who has his names credited to helm episodes of Fleabag and Killing Eve, you cannot expect anything less from Enola Holmes. Arthur Conan Doyle, the legendary British writer gave the world its famous detective Sherlock Holmes and on the other hand, an American author Nancy Springer created Enola Holmes, younger sister to Sherlock and Mycroft Holmes. Although she is set in Victorian England, bibliophiles got a hand on her in the early 2000s.

Based on The Case of the Missing Marquess, Enola Holmes has Millie Bobby Brown playing the titular role as well as the narrator. Her piece to camera is appealing and also sweet as she explains her thoughts to the viewers before she gets to it. Enola explains the real meaning of her name and that's the purpose of the film too. Teaching a young girl to be independent and that too by a revolutionary single mother is something we hear today in 'Humans of Bombay/New York' stories. But Eudoria Holmes showed her unconventional way which she foresighted will be in use for her daughter.

After talking about her 16-year-long history, Enola reveals that on her birthday, her mother left without leaving any hints (or did she?) to investigate the case. Enter Sherlock (Henry Cavill) and Mycroft (Sam Claflin), who look pretty disappointed in seeing their sister not being poised or lady-like. neck-deep into every character she played. As the film is set in the 19th century, we cannot overlook the amazing costumes the character donned in Enola Holmes. Academy Award nominee Consolata Boyle has once again done a commendable job. Daniel Pemberton's music makes the film more thrilling to watch and Giles Nuttgens's cinematography is kickass, indeed!

Sara Ali Khan admits close relations with Sushant Singh Rajput; Shraddha Kapoor confesses partying at actor's farmhouse



Amid the ongoing probe being conducted by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) in a drugs related case which is a part of investigations going on in late actor Sushant Singh Rajput's death case, actresses Sara Ali Khan and Shraddha Kapoor on Saturday appeared before the investigating agency.

According to sources, actress Sara Ali Khan has denied taking drugs in any form. She has also refused to identify any of the drug peddlers previously arrested by the NCB. However, the 'Simmba' star has admitted to having close relationships with late actor Sushant Singh Rajput during the filming of 'Kedarnath' in February 2018.

Sara Ali Khan also revealed to the NCB officials during the interrogation that she would often visit the 'Dil Bechara' actor at his residence in 'Capri House'. Sara also spoke about her trip to Thailand with Sushant and disclosed that she had been to Sushant's Lonavala farmhouse with the actor several times.

Sara admitted to smoking cigarette however, denied taking drugs. She added that late actor Sushant, on some occasions did smoke weed.

During the interrogation, while Sara dismissed allegations of receiving drugs via Karmajit Singh Ananad in a parcel, she did not

give any clear answers to taking drugs along with actor Rhea Chakraborty.

Meanwhile, according to sources, actress Shraddha Kapoor too has denied taking drugs before the NCB. She has also dismissed all allegations against her in the case.

During her interrogation, Shraddha revealed to the NCB officials that after the release of the film 'Chhichhore', a party was held at Pawna farmhouse. Divulging details, she said that they arrived at the farmhouse around 3 pm in the afternoon. Soon after lunch, Sharddha said, that they took a boat to an island where the party was held till late in the night. However, Shraddha added that she did not consume drugs at the party.

In a shocking revelation, Shraddha revealed to the officials that she had seen Sushant Singh Rajput take drugs in his vanity van and sometimes on the sets during the shooting of the film.

However, when the NCB showed Shraddha a drug chat of her's with Jaya Saha, the actress did not give any clear answer.

Meanwhile, the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) on Saturday questioned Bollywood actor Deepika Padukone and her former manager Karishma Prakash too, for over five hours in the alleged drugs case in connection with the death of actor Sushant Singh Rajput.

50 years of YRF: Aditya Chopra remembers late father, legend Yash Chopra; wants to be part of Bollywood every lifetime



YRF head honcho Aditya Chopra has shared a letter he wrote as the production house completed 50 years of existence. Co-incidentally, it also marks late Yash Chopra's birth anniversary. In his letter, Chopra remembered how his father was a salaried employee of BR Films and started the company with nothing, but created a legacy. He also recalled making 'Dilwale Dulhania Le Jayenge' when Yash Rash Films completed 25 years of being.

The CEO of YRF, married to Rani Mukerji, who also has a daughter Adira with her, announced what are his special plans as the production company completes 50 years. He thanked every person ever associated with YRF, and said that he would love to be part of Bollywood in every lifetime. In 1970, my father Yash Chopra, left the security and comfort of his brother Mr. BR Chopra and formed his own company. Till then, he was a salaried employee of BR Films and didn't own anything of his own. He did not know how to run a business and did not even have the basic knowledge of what goes into making a company. All he had was a strong belief in his talent and hardwork and a dream to be self-reliant. That conviction of a creative man backing nothing but himself and his art, gave birth to Yash Raj Films. Mr. V Shantaram, who owned Rajkamal Studios, graciously gave him a small room in his studio for his office. My father didn't know then, that the small company that he started in a tiny room, would one day become the biggest film company of the Indian Film Industry.

In 1995, as Yash Raj Films (YRF) entered its 25th year, my directorial debut film Dilwale Dulhania Le Jayenge released. The historic success of that film gave me confidence to give wings to some crazy risky ideas that I had for the future of YRF. Besides the immense love that my father had for me, he now also had a lot of faith in my ideas because of the miraculous success of my film. I had foreseen the advent of international corporate studios coming to India and taking over our business. I wanted us to achieve a certain scale, so that we could retain our independence before they came in. My father contradicted his own conservative mindset and bravely indulged all my bold initiatives. And in a span of 10 quick years, we went from a film production house to India's first fully integrated independent film studio.

Across 5 decades YRF, at its core, has been a traditional company with deep-rooted old world values and a conservative approach to business. But at the same time it's also been a bold forward looking company, constantly trying to push itself in embracing technology and innovations to be ahead of the curve. This perfect balance of traditional and modern is what defines Yash Raj Films.

DEEPIKA PADUKONE SHED TEARS THRICE DURING NCB 'WHATSAPP GROUP CHAT' PROBE: REPORT

Deepika Padukone, who had appeared before NCB on Saturday, September 26, 2020, had admitted to being part of the famous WhatsApp group, where 'D' asked 'K' about 'maal'. She was probed along with her manager Karishma Prakash.

We had received information that Deepika accepted being part of the group, but has maintained silence on drugs issue. The information came a day after Karishma reportedly accepted Deepika was admin of the group. According to the latest report by India Today, Deepika cried thrice during her probe. It is to be noted that news reports stated that Ranveer Singh was going to be part of the interrogation because Deepika has 'anxiety attacks'. However, NCB declined the news, and Ranveer eventually did not accompany Deepika.



An NCB source had said that Deepika was asked to identify the mobile number in the alleged chat with her former manager Karishma Prakash. She was also asked if she sent those messages or someone on her behalf sent the alleged messages enquiring about "maal" from Karishma.

The sources said that the NCB ask probed Deepika, who is the daughter of badminton icon Prakash Padukone, if she used to consume

drugs, if yes, from where she used to procure them and who made the payment for the drugs.

The NCB further asked her if she was procuring the drugs for her personal consumption or for someone else and since when she has been using these substances and who all were the persons who provided her these drugs. She was also asked for how long she has known Karishma and Sushant's former talent manager Jaya Saha, who worked with Kwan Talent Management Agency. NCB is now trying to find a bigger drug peddler who supplied substances to Bollywood celebrities. Meanwhile, Deepika, Karishma, Sara Ali Khan and Shraddha Kapoor's statements will be presented in court today.

Deepika, Shraddha, Sara not summoned again, Karan Johar's party video not under scrutiny now: NCB official



NCB Director Deputy General (DDG) Mutha Ashok Jain, in his byte to the media, clarfiled certain questions. While he said that Deepika Padukone, Shraddha Kapoor and Sara Ali Khan, who appeared before the agency on Saturday, have not been summoned again, the DDG also said that Karan Johar's viral party video is not under investigation, not in the case, and not now.

On Saturday evening, Jain gave a press statement in which he said that no one has received another summon yet. He said that all the statements recorded on Saturday (from Deepika Padukone, Karishma Prakash, Shraddha Kapoor and Sara Ali Khan) will be presented before court on Sunday.

The DDG refused to answer many questions stating that it is protocol to not reveal anything which happened during the investigation. He however said that all the points will be presented in court today, after which it might become public knowledge, if the court allows it.

Further answering question about probing the viral video from Karan Johar's party in 2019, Jain said that the video is not related to the current investigation, so they are not probing it. 

However, Sunil Gavaskar issued

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Rahul Tewatia, Sanju Samson star as Rajasthan Royals register highest-successful chase in history

he desert city of Sharjah is not unknown to batting storms. The most famous of them all, of course, remains Sachin Tendulkar's bashing of Shane Warne in 1998. The Australian great is back in the UAE as the mentor of Rajasthan Royals, and from his resort in Dubai, where he is undergoing one week quarantine, saw his team at the receiving end of another storm, brewed by Kings XI Punjab's Mayank Agarwal (106 -- 50b). For Warne's solace there was another storm waiting to happen. Chasing KXIP's mammoth 223/2 after Agarwal's ton, with frontline batsmen Jos Buttler, Steve Smith and Sanju Samson back in the dugout, Rahul Tewatia took it upon himself to turn the tide. With 51 needed off 18 balls, he struck five huge sixes against Sheldon Cottrell to take the equation to 21 off 12. Next over by Mohammed Shami saw 19 runs scored with Tewatia and Jofra Archer doing the damage as RR needed just two of the last over.

The job was completed by Tom Curran with a four against spinner Murugan Ashwin as RR recorded the highest successful chase in IPL history. On any other day, KXIP could have breathed easy after putting up such a big score. Not at Sharjah and not against a team like RR which has the likes of Buttler, Smith and Samson, who had scored a 32-ball 74 at this very ground in his previous match. Buttler departed early, but Smith and Samson fired. The duo helped RR score the highest runs in the powerplay this season (69/1), surpassing KXIP's 60/0 in the first innings. Smith and Samson reached their half-century off 26 balls and were involved in an 81-run second wicket stand in 40 balls. Once Smith was caught at deep cover by Shami off Jimmy Neesham in the ninth over, RR's pace of scoring slowed. Samson off just 45 balls, and was involved in the third-highest opening stand greeted with a hug by Rahul.

ever in the tournament, 183 with KL Rahul. Those batting highlights catapulted KXIP to 223/2 in 20 overs.

Agarwal's knock stood out because he strived for it. Having shown penchant for age-group tournaments with an aggressive style, the Karnataka batsman was expected to do well in limited-overs cricket. After tons of runs in the domestic circuit and a long wait, Agarwal made his international debut but first in Tests. With a consistent display, he has sealed his position in the whites. As far as limited-overs go, Agarwal is yet to showcase his mettle.

Early signs show the 29-year-old has chosen this IPL to make a point. At the 2019 IPL, Agarwal scored 332 in 13 matches. This edition, he already has 221 in three matches. "There is always risk involved, just that in T20s you have to take them a little more often," Agarwal told this paper before the tournament. The intent to tilt the risk-reward balance in his favour has clearly showed. And what better place to take risks than the Sharjah Stadium, the smallest of the three grounds where IPL 2020 is being played. With KXIP captain and statemate Rahul playing the anchor at the other end, Agarwal went all out. Anything short and wide, and there were many of those, the KXIP opener would hook over the mid-on and if there was any length ball he would loft it over mid-off. When his timing was not perfect, Agarwal's placement was. Generally, teams rely on left-right combination to break a bowler's rhythm. Here two right-handed openers achieved that objective with non-chalance. Except seamer Ankit Rajpoot (9.80) no RR bowler had an economy of less than 10. Agarwal was most ruthless against RR spinners Rahul Tewatia and Shreyas Gopal. The former kept going despite Tewatia struggling at the other end before he even- was taken off the attack after one over after conceding 19 runs while tually fell for a 42-ball 85. 'BATTING FOR 2 MINUTES IS NOTHING,' PIETERSEN AND GAVASKAR NOT HAPPY WITH MUMBAI'S TACTICS IN SUPER OVER

The Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) vs Mumbai Indians (MI) clash held on Monday was one of the most fiercely fought battles in the history of the Indian Premier League (IPL). The contest was tied after 40 overs and led to the second Super Over of the season which Virat Kohli & Co won on the last ball.

RCB scored 201 in the first innings and MI levelled the score as Ishan Kishan and Kieron Pollard took the control and garnered 79 runs in the last 4 overs. Later, when the team got into the Super Over, the management decided not to send Kishan to bat. This move didn't work well and MI could only score 7 runs off the six balls. Commentators Kevin Pietersen and Sunil Gavaskar weren't pleased to see Ishan sitting at the dugout and not coming out to



bat. Pietersen recalled the mistake Kings XI Punjab made against Delhi Capitals, by sending in Nicholas Pooran instead of Mayank Agarwal, who had scored 89 in the match. "He (Ishan Kishan) has to be incredibly exhausted and tired to have not batted in that Super over. I think Mumbai missed a trick, I'm sorry but with that smaller boundary, batting for 2 minutes is nothing. I'm not criticising him but the decision not for him to bat. We saw when Mayank Agarwal didn't do it the other night (KXIP vs DC in Match 2) and Kings XI lost the contest," Pietersen said while commentating.

"There's not much time in a Super Over to plan anything. If it was a 40-over game, Ishan Kishan would still want to go out and bat because form is such a fickle thing, it can go just like that. So yes, I think he should have come in because it was a matter of just 6 deliveries." Gavaskar said.

Later in the post-match presentation ceremony, Rohit Sharma revealed why that decision was taken. He stated that Ishan was drained

after his innings and didn't look comfortable so the management decided not to send him.

Pakistan players like Babar Azam can learn a lot if given chance to play in IPL, says Shahid Afridi

SANJU SAMSON CREDITS GYM SESSION WITH VIRAT KOHLI FOR HIS FRESH VERVE IN CRICKET

Sixteen sixes in two matches underline the power-hitting Sanju Samson has unleashed in Indian Premier League (IPL) 2020. While the Rajasthan Royals wicketkeeper-batsman credits increased fitness as a reason, his interaction with India skipper Virat Kohli on the New Zealand tour in February played a crucial role in a crucial change of perspective. "I am a deep person. I keep on thinking about my future, which direction I am leading to. I keep thinking how many years I have left in my life. Everyone will die one day. At the same time if I am playing cricket, I am going to finish one day. That brought me to the thought that I can't play cricket after 10-12 years. So, if I am not fit enough I should not play," said the 25-year-old Kerala player, who hails from near Thiruvananthapuram. "An amazing experience happened when I was in the gym with Virat Kohli. I asked why he put so much energy into fitness work. He asked me 'Sanju, how many years are you going to play?' I said 'I am 25, I think till 35 I am going to play'. He said after 10 years I can do anything, eat Kerala food, pursue whatever I want. 'But after these 10 years you won't be able to play cricket. So, why don't you give everything in these 10 years?' That changed my perspective." Samson also credits former Kerala first-class player Raiphi Vincent Gomez for his improved fitness.

"I have understood my game. It's more about power-hitting, and it's bit more higher in T20s. I was lucky to have those four-five months training, increasing my strength and doing power exercises," he said. "I had Raiphi bhai by my side. He has played cricket for Kerala and hails from the same place as I do. He was always there to push me."

Samson scored a 32-ball 74 in the first game against Chennai Super Kings and did better in an IPL record 224-run chase against Kings XI Punjab in the second game, scoring a 42-ball 85. Against KXIP, it was Rahul Tewatia who surprised all by overcoming his early struggle to put bat to ball by smashing five sixes in an over by Sheldon Cottrell. Tewatia struggled to such an extent early on that batting partner Samson even refused a single to stay on strike.

"Glenn Maxwell (off-spin) was bowling at that time. I thought I am a right-handed batsman and should be taking chances against him. Also, Rahul was yet to get into his scoring momentum," Samson said. Tewatia has become the toast of IPL and Rajasthan Royals after his 31-ball 53 took the team home on Sunday.

The 27-year-old Haryana player credited clarity provided by the RR management on his role to his staying confident despite the initial struggle. "I was sent at No. 4. The only plan was to go and take on the bowlers. It was not decided before the match but much before that. When we started training in the UAE and when we had video meetings during lockdown, the team management was clear with me about my role. That really helped," he said.





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
