



India again re-created history after 21 years as Chandigarh's Harnaaz listed horse riding, swimming, cooking, singing, poetry writing, reading, Kaur Sandhu was crowned Miss Universe 2021 on Sunday.

In an exclusive conversation with Y Media, Miss Universe 2021 Harnaaz Kaur Sandhu's mother, Ruby Sandhu, a gynecologist, said, "any Miss Universe is passionate and compassionate about this beauty pageant, And nothing is impossible to achieve in this world."

The 21-year-old's winning response to a question on climate change -"This is the time to take action and talk less. ... Prevent and protect is
better than repair and repent" -- helped her clinch the coveted title.

Harnaaz Sandhu's mother piqued her interest in female empowerment. Harnaaz advocates for women's empowerment, especially their constitutional rights to education, careers, and freedom of choice. Sandhu believes that pageants are a platform where women come forward to celebrate sisterhood and womanhood, and people across the world celebrate their beauty queens and their successes with great pride.

"Right now, Harnaaz is on cloud nine, and it is because of her hard work and dedication that she was able to win the Miss Universe 2021 title. Since childhood, the glamour industry has always interested her, and we never stopped her from chasing her dreams and goals," her mother added. Inspiring and motivating children are the essence of success. Even though Harnaaz belonged to a patriarchal society, she broke all the shackles and achieved her dreams. Sandhu clan has 17 brothers and only one sister, Harnaaz, in the extended family. Her father, Pritampal Singh Sandhu, who is in the real estate business, said, "we are proud and happy that our daughter brought laurels to the country. "She is very confident, down to earth and belongs to a middle-class family. Beauty pageants and the glamour industry always excited her, focusing on her goal. We have never stopped her from pursuing her dreams, she added. The family

I had a 20minute drive home from the Gurudwara and I don't remember the journey back." Sandhu was crowned by the outgoing Miss Universe, Andrea Meza of Mexico, at a glittering ceremony held on Sunday night at the Universe Dome in Eilat, Israel. She edged out Paraguay's Nadia Ferreira and South Africa's LalelaMswane. This is India's third crown after Sushmita Sen in 1994 and Lara Dutta in 2000. Sandhu's final statement at the pageant was about young people's pressures across societies today. She said: "The biggest pressure the youth of today is facing is to believe in themselves, to know that you are unique, and that's what makes you beautiful. Stop comparing yourself with others, and let's talk about more important things worldwide. "This is what you need to understand. Come out, speak for yourselves because you are the leader of your life. You are the voice of your own. I believed in myself, and that's why I am standing here today." Sandhu has several pageant titles, such as Times Fresh Face, Miss Chandigarh 2017, Miss Max Emerging Star India 2018 and Femina Miss India Punjab 2019. She has also starred in Puniabi films like 'Yaara Divan Poo Baran' and 'Bai Ji Kuttange.' She can mimic everyone, including animals, and loves writing couplets in Punjabi, her mother tongue.



The 'Kick' actor also received a Mini Cooper from Sukesh, which she claimed that she returned. She further stated that the conman had arranged private jet trips and her hotel stay on different occasions. An India Today report also states that Sukesh had also given gifts to Jacqueline Fernandez's family members. The conman extended a loan of USD 150,000 to the actor's sister, who lives in the US and also gave her a BMW X5 car. The accused gifted Jacqueline's parents a Maserati and her mother in Bahrain a Porsche. He also extended a loan of USD 50,000 to her brother in Australia.

On Monday, Sandhu became the third Indian to be crowned Miss Universe — actors Sushmita Sen and Lara Dutta won the title in 1994 and 2000, respectively. It's a huge celebration for the whole

"I feel so grateful and my heart is filled with so much respect for all those who have shown their faith in me and showered me with all their love. Her mother and gynaecologist Ravinder Kaur Sandhu has been an inspiration for Sandhu, who wants to lead the way for women empowerment with special focus on menstrual hygiene and breast cancer awareness.

83 PRODUCER ON CHEATING CASE: 'IT IS FALSE, BASELESS AND MOTIVATED'


A few days back, Ranveer Singh's 83 landed itself in a soup after a complaint was filed against the producers for cheating. Since Deepika Padukone is also a co-producer, her name was also dragged into the controversy.

On Monday, Vibri Media's Vishnu Induri's spokesperson clarified the legal hassle calling the case by Future Resources FZE as 'false, baseless and motivated'. They also denied the claims of the complainants and said that 'the makers of 83 are in no way concerned with the case'. "Future Resources FZE is a minority shareholder in Vibri Media, there have been internal disputes between the promoters of Vibri Media Pvt Ltd and the complainant, which are pending in various courts. The complainant Future Resources FZE has been restrained by the Hon'ble Telangana high court from interfering with the movie 83 in any



manner," they said. The spokesperson further called out the timing stating that the complainant decided to act just prior to the release of the film. Calling it a 'publicity gimmick' they said that it constitutes contempt of court for which Vibri Media Pvt Ltd is availing its legal remedies against the complainant. "The film 83 and the producers are in no way concerned with this and they reserve their right to initiate appropriate action against Future Resources FZE," the spokesperson from Vibhi Media added. For the unversed, a UAE-based financer alleged that his company was promised good returns by Vibri Media after they invested close to Rs 16 crore in 83. Since they did not get what was promised in return, the businessman approached the Andheri Metropolitan Magistrate Court in Mumbai and filed a complaint against the makers of 83.

While the final Test of the tour will be played from Jan 11 to 15, the ODI series will kick off on January 19. Vamika was born on January 11 last year and the skipper is looking forward to spending time with his daughter.

Seein both the skippers of the Indian team not playing a particular format, netizens believe the two players do not want to play under each other and there is a possible rift between them.

Earlier, BCCI and the selection committee had axed Kohli as the ODI skipper and replaced him with Rohit Sharma. The change in India's ODI captaincy had shaken up the Indian cricketing fraternity.

Bumrah is joined by some elite players as Riaz also included Shaheen Afridi and Mitchell Starc in his list of top bowlers in the world.

"They have a lot of capability. They read the game and execute their plans really well. If they require yorkers, or if they require slow ones, they would read the wicket and bowl accordingly," said Wahab Riaz, as per an official release.

The 36-year-old further named AB de Villiers and Babar Azam alongside Rohit, as the most dangerous batsmen in the world currently. Riaz further opined that former South African skipper de Villiers is one of the most difficult players he has played against.

"There are a lot of such players like Rohit Sharma and Babar Azam who are hard to bowl to. But one player I have always been afraid to bowl to is AB de Villiers. He always knows what is coming next from me. He reads the game well, and always plays well against me," added Riaz. For the unversed, Riaz is currently plying his trade for Jaffna Kings in the ongoing Lanka Premier League 2021, having picked up five wickets already in three matches. On the other hand, Team India duo Jasprit Bumrah and Rohit Sharma were gearing up for the series against South Africa that begins from December 26 onwards. The 'Hitman', however, has suffered a hamstring injury and subsequently has been replaced by Gujarat batsman Priyank Panchal.

INDIA'S TOUR OF SOUTH AFRICA: ROHIT SHARMA RULED OUT OF TEST SERIES. VIRAT **KOHLI TO SKIP ODI MATCHES**



Virat Kohli's Test Team is all set to head to South Africa for three Tests matches and three ODIs, beginning December 26. However, ahead of the tour, it has come to be known that both Kohli and new limited-over skipper Rohit Sharma will be missing from the ODI and Test games respectively. Rohit Sharma on Monday was ruled out and the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) confirmed the news through a tweet. The 'Hitman' will be replaced by opening batter Priyank Panchal, who was part of India A tour to the Proteas side earlier this month. BCCI added that Rohit has been ruled out due to a left hamstring injury.

"Priyank Panchal replaces injured Rohit Sharma in India's Test squad. Rohit sustained a left hamstring injury during his training session in Mumbai yesterday. He has been ruled out of the upcoming 3-match Test series against South Africa," the BCCI tweet stated.

As far as Kohli is concerned, the batting maestro will reportedly be missing the ODI series against South Africa. While he will be leading the Test side, he will not play the ODI series to celebrate his daughter Vamika's first birthday. According to a report in the Times of India, he has informed the BCCI about the same and the former ODI skipper is planning a holiday with his family after the conclusion of the Test series.

While the final Test of the tour will be played from Jan 11 to 15, the ODI series will kick off on January 19. Vamika was bom on January 11 last year and the skipper is looking forward to spending time with his daughter.

The ODI captaincy change saga:

Recently, BCCI and the selection committee had axed Kohli as the ODI skipper and replaced him with Rohit Sharma. The change in India's ODI captaincy had shaken up the Indian cricketing fraternity.

While fans had no issue with the captaincy change with Kohli already stepping down as the skipper of T20I, it was the manner in which the responsibility was taken away from the batter and handed to Rohit that rose eyebrows. The India cricket board had in a single tweet, announced Rohit's appointment and there has still been no proper statement from the BCCI explaining the change nor a word from Kohli about him being replaced.

India's former white-ball skipper Virat Kohli has not officially asked for a break from the ODI leg of the upcoming series against South Africa, as per the latest reports.

In an interesting turn of events, it was being speculated that Virat Kohli, who was recently replaced by Rohit Sharma as India's skipper in ODI format will be taking a break from the ODI leg of India's South Africa tour. The Men in Blue are scheduled to fly to South Africa to take on the Proteas in a 3 match Test series, which will begin from December 26 and go on until January 15. Subsequently, the two teams will play a 3 match ODI series that kicks off on January 19.

Kohli is set to lead India in the Test series, however, reports emerged earlier on Tuesday that the Delhi-born batsman has asked for a break after the Test series, and he won't be able to take part in the ODIs as he wants to be there with his family for the first birthday celebration of his daughter Vamika.

However, as per the latest developments, Virat Kohli has not officially asked the BCCI for a break, as per various reports. Therefore, it remains to be seen, whether Kohli will be a part of India's squad for the ODI leg or not. Moreover, it will be interesting to see who leads Team India for the ODIs, because newly crowned skipper Rohit Sharma has sustained a hamstring injury of late, and it's not clear whether he will be able to make a comeback in time for the ODI leg of the series.

FORMER INDIAN SKIPPER SLAMS VIRAT KOHLI. ROHIT SHARMA FOR THEIR BEHAVIOUR AHEAD OF SOUTH AFRICA TOUR

Team India's former captain Mohammed Azharuddin has lambasted the current skippers Rohit Sharma and Virat Kohli for not being clear about their availability across formats ahead of a crucial tour of South Africa. The Men in Blue are scheduled to take on the Proteas from December 26, although there have been a few hiccups along the road. Firstly, the BCCI decided to remove Virat Kohli as the ODI skipper and gave the captaincy to Rohit Sharma, stating that there can't be two captains across T20 and ODI formats. For the unversed, Kohli had earlier stepped down as the skipper in T20I format after the ICC Men's T20 World Cup earlier this year.

Rohit Sharma then led India to a 3-0 series win against New Zealand in the T20I series at home, and subsequently, owing to his good run of form in the purest form of cricket, he was promoted to vice-captain in the Test format as well. However, Rohit had missed the Test series against New Zealand, while Kohli only played in the last of the two matches against the Kiwis. Now, in the latest turn of events, Rohit has been sidelined from the upcoming Test series versus South Africa through an injury, while Kohli has reportedly, asked for a break after the Tests as he wishes to be with his family, for the first birthday celebration of his daughter Vamika. Team India will be playing 3 Test matches against the Proteas from December 26 to January 15, while the 3 match ODI series will be played between January 19 to January 23. Subsequently, former Indian skipper, Mohammed Azharuddin came down heavily on Rohit Sharma and Virat Kohli for their behaviour ahead of the tour of South Africa. The veteran tweeted that the pair should have been clear about their availability and that such behaviour will only add fuel to the speculation about a rift between the two skippers.
