The International Cricket Council (ICC) announced the new schedule for the T20 World Cup 2021. Originally scheduled to be held in Australia in October-November this year, the tournament has been postponed to 2022. The 2021 edition, meanwhile, which was scheduled in India will take place as planned. Format of the Men's T20 World Cup 2021 will remain as it was for 2020, and all the teams who qualified for the 2020 event will now participate in the edition in India. 

Rhea Chakraborty appeared before the Enforcement Directorate (ED) on Friday along with her brother Showik Chakraborty and former manager Shruti Modi and now her call details of the past one year have revealed some shocking details.

According to our sources, in the past one year, Rhea spoke to her father 1192 times, her brother Showik 1069 times and with Sushant Singh Rajput around 145 times. However, sources say that Rhea spoke to Sushant's househelp Samuel Miranda 287 times in a year, which is probably more than she spoke to Sushant.

Apart from this, Rhea spoke to several other people including Shruti Modi 791 times, Siddharth Pithani 100 times, Deepesh Sawant around 41 times, Sushant's sister Rani only 4 times in a year. Interestingly, Rhea also spoke to her mentor and filmmaker Mahesh Bhatt 16 times in a year over the phone, Uday Singh Gauri for 22 times and Bollywood actor Aditya Roy Kapur 23 times. She also talked on the phone with Dream Home Real Estate company, 23 times in the past year.

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has summoned Sushant Singh Rajput's ex-manager Shruti Modi. She was snapped at the ED office in Mumbai some time back. Reportedly, Sushant's girlfriend Rhea Chakraborty was in touch with Modi and made various phone calls to her.

Rhea was spotted with her brother Showmik Chakraborty as they came before ED for interrogation in the case. While Rhea is still being interrogated, Showmik was allowed to leave the office. A few hours before appearing, Rhea requested the ED to postpone the recording of her statement till her Supreme Court plea hearing. Rejecting the request, the ED had reportedly also warned they would register Rhea Chakraborty's absence as non-compliance of summons. Both Rhea and Showmik were reportedly business partners with Sushant Singh Rajput. ED has summoned Rhea for questioning in connection with a money laundering case related to actor Sushant Singh Rajput's death. The Bihar Police had found Rs. 15 crore missing from Sushant's bank account. The same was also confirmed by Mumbai Police Commissioner Param Bir Singh.

Sushant's father KK Singh, in his FIR with the Bihar Police, had also stated that he suspects Rhea took Sushant's money. KK Singh had made other claims too, including Rhea kept Sushant away from his friends and family.



MS DHONI PERFECT BLEND OF AGGRESSION AND BEING SAFE, VIRAT KOHLI GETTING THERE: FORMER BCCI SELECTOR



S Dhoni and Virat Kohli have different leadership styles but just because the current India captain shows his emotions more than his predecessor does not mean Dhoni was any less aggressive a captain, feels former BCCI national selector Gagan Khoda. His knock of 254 against South Africa at Pune in 2019 remains his highest Test score to date. When it comes to ODIs, the current Indian skipper has played 248 matches and has 43 centuries. On the other hand, Tendulkar finished his career with 100 international centuries and the batsman is the highest run-scorer in both Tests and ODIs.

During the chat between Bishop and Mbangwa, the former also praised the current crop of fast bowlers.

BCCI eyes start of domestic season from November 19, IPL players may miss first few rounds



The BCCI is mulling November 19 as tentative date for start of domestic season with Syed Mushtag Ali T20 tournament but Indian players in various IPL teams won't be able to play first few rounds due to quarantine protocols in place.

The delay in the beginning of the domestic season due to Covid-19 pandemic means that only Mushtag Ali trophy and Ranji Trophy (December 13- March 10) comprising of 245 games (across the formats with 38 teams) will be played.

There will be no Vijay Hazare Trophy, Duleep Trophy or Challenger Series this year and as of now there is no provision for Irani Cup also. "This is a tentative list that has been prepared and it has gone for approval of president Sourav Ganguly and secretary Jay Shah," a senior BCCI official told PTI on condition of anonymity. While this is a draft schedule, it is being asked how the Indian players, who will return from IPL, will play since they will have to be in a 14-day quarantine as per government rules. "That's an issue primarily for the uncapped players, who would be with the squad and would like to play some cricket. Now even a player's team is knocked out before play-offs, he won't be back before November 3 and till November 17 will be in quarantine. "For those whose teams are in playoffs and may reach finals, they will have to miss the first few rounds in that case. But again this is a draft proposal and there could be some tweaks in it," the official said.

Babar Azam scored a brilliant half century on the first day of the Test, but was dismissed early on the 2nd day, and could only score 5 runs in the 2nd innings.?Akhtar said that Babar needs to become a matchwinner to make a name for himself.

SHAHID AFRIDI, MICHAEL VAUGHAN REACT TO PAKISTAN'S LOSS TO ENGLAND IN 1ST TEST



The first Test between England and Pakistan was a cliffhanger. There were moments where it looked like Pakistan had the upper hand, then it looked like England were cruising. The pendulum kept on swinging for four days at Old Trafford in Manchester. Eventually, it was England who emerged victorious in the first Test as they chased down Pakistan's target of 277 runs with 3 wickets to spare.

England were in big trouble when five wickets fell for just 117 but a sixth-wicket stand of 139 between Chris Woakes, who remained unbeaten on 84, and Jos Buttler (75) took the match away from Pakistan during Saturday's fourth day.

Leg-spinner Yasir Shah (4-99) had put Pakistan in pole position with two wickets as England slipped from 86-1 to 117-5 in its second innings. Earlier, Pakistan resumed on 137-8 and added a quickfire 32 runs before being bowled out for 169.

Former Pakistan skipper Shahid Afridi was disappointed with the end result as he believed the match was in their grasp. Meanwhile, Mohammed Yousuf and Michael Vaughan also reacted to England's victory on Twitter. Pakistan captain Azhar Ali maintained that the series is not over as he looks forward to the next Test match in Southampton.

- "It's disappointing but not over yet, there are still two Tests to go," Azhar told reporters.
- "There a lot of positives from this game, we outplayed England on most parts of this Test match. "I wouldn't say we lost the match in (our) second innings, but we missed a chance to knock England out
- of the game there."
- "We were sure we'd wrap it up if one more wicket fell," said Azhar.
- "But they (Buttler and Woakes) attacked from the off and snatched the game away from us.

'I was telling my friends that he will break down': Shoaib Akhtar on Jasprit Bumrah



Raising concerns over India pacer Jasprit Bumrah's fitness, former Pakistan speedster Shoaib Akhtar said the right-arm seamer will not be able to play in all three formats of the game for a long time. Bumrah has been spearheading India's pace attack for the past few years and en route become one of the best bowlers in world cricket.

However, he started facing injury problems last year and was rested for the majority of the 2019 before making a comeback against New Zealand in early 2020.

"Bumrah has a difficult action. He cannot play in all formats," Akhtar told former India opener Aakash Chopra in his show Aakash Vani.

Bumrah, who rose to the status of being one of the world's best fast bowlers in all three formats of the game after playing a major role India's first-ever Test series win in Australia in 2018-19, sustained a stress fracture in his back ahead of the home series against South Africa.

He missed the entire home season and only made a comeback in the New Zealand tour where he wasn't at this best. "It is his braveness that he showed his skills in Test matches. He is a very hard working guy and is very focused. He knows where he wants to go. But will his back support him?" Asked Akhtar. The former Pakistan pacer also said that he had predicted such an injury to Bumrah a lot earlier.

"Till when will his back withstand that much load. It had to break down. I was watching his matches before he broke down. I was telling my friends that he will break down," he said. Bumrah averages in the early 20s in all formats of the game and has 68 wickets in Tests along with 104 in ODIs and 59 in T20Is.





IPL 2020 I 'HIS KNOWLEDGE, HIS EXPERIENCE WILL SURELY HELP': BRETT LEE EXPLAINS HOW KXIP CAN WIN THIS SEASON



Former Australia pacer Brett Lee hopes Kings XI Punjab are able to go the distance this season of the IPL, and expects them to benefit from having someone of Anil Kumble's stature as coach of the team. Kumble was appointed KXIP's coach last October and with the experience of having coached the Indian cricket team for a year, Lee, a former player of the franchise, is hopeful of the former India leg-spinner making a big impact for the franchise.

"Having someone like that (Anil Kumble) in terms of the mix of the team and certainly the squad will be invaluable. The knowledge, the experiences, will definitely help," Lee said on the Cricket Connected

Show on Star Sports.

Lee was with KXIP the first three seasons of the IPL and picked up nine wickets from 13 games, including a wicketless season in 2010. The franchise has struggled for consistency since the very beginning with their best performance coming in 2014, when they made the final against Kolkata Knight Riders but lost. They finished semi-finalists in the inaugural edition of the IPL but have thrice finishes.

"Kings XI need to win, they have got a great squad, they have got a wonderful team that can definitely get close and close but they have not got over the line yet, so,

I'm actually waiting for that to happen. A great franchise to play for, I put up my hand-up and say that was a lot of fun to play for that franchise," Lee added.

Lee weighed in on the safety protocols associated with the IPL which is moving to the UAE this season - and expects the players to act responsibly in the Emirates. KXIP co-owner Ness Wadia highlighted how the entire focus should be on ensuring that not a managed sixth and eighth place single Covid-19 case is registered. As he rightfully pointed out, one positive Covid-19 case and the IPL will run the risk of getting cancelled altogether, an aspect that Lee touched upon.

"Firstly, for your health, the most

important thing to do is to make sure you social distance and to make sure you adhere by the COVID standards, so I don't reckon any player would want to go out and do the wrong thing. It's also for their teams and their fans, because if the IPL didn't happen, it


MS Dhoni would clap for the bowler when a good ball was hit for a six: Muttiah Muralitharan

Legendary Sri Lanka spinner Muttiah Muralitharan lauded India-wicketkeeper batsman MS Dhoni for his captaincy skills. Murali said the best part about Dhoni's captaincy was that he trusted the bowler and gave him the freedom to set his own field. "Definitely he was a young captain, I would say. It was in the 2007 World Cup that he captained and won. But his theories are very nice to see. Because he will give the ball to the bowler and tell him to set the field and bowl. If it wasn't working, then he would ask them to give a chance to the field he sets," Murali told India off-spinner R Ashwin on his Youtube chat show DRS with Ash.

Murali, who has played under Dhoni's leadership in IPL franchise Chennai Super Kings (CSK), said Dhoni would sometimes clap for the bowler when a good ball was hit for a six.

"He (Dhoni) will clap if a good ball gets hit for a six. He'll tell the bowler that it's a good ball, and it doesn't matter if the batsman has hit you for a six. Batsmen too have the talent to hit," said Murali. Murali, who picked up 40 wickets while playing under Dhoni in three seasons of IPL between 2008 and 2010, said Dhoni would take the bowler alone to tell him what to do instead of doing it in public. "So with that kind of appreciations, he'll call you alone, to tell you what's needed instead of doing it in pubic because of those qualities, he has been so successful," added Murali.

Further explaining Dhoni's qualities as a leader, Murali, who has more than 1300 international wickets - the most - to his name, said Dhoni always listened to the advice of seniors even at a young age. "He has the ability to think calmly, it's because of these plus points that he became such a good leader. Even when he was young, he'd listen to advice (from seniors). He'll listen to people and then he'll make the decision at the end of the day. That's how he used to captain.
