

'Have delivered Rs 100 crore film as a director before': Kangana Ranaut on 'Manikarnika: The Legend of Didda'



Kangana Ranaut had made her directorial debut with 'Manikarnika: The Queen of Jhansi' in 2019 after which she recently announced a standalone sequel 'Manikarnika: The legend of Didda'. On January 25, as Manikarnika completed 2 years of release, Kangana said that she would love to direct despite her hectic schedule unless she gets someone better to do the job.

For the uninformed, Kangana who had worked in 'Tanu Weds Manu' had told Aanand L Rai to maintain the same crew that had worked on the first part for the sequel and has said that she plans to do the same for the Manikarnika series.

Kangana told The Times of India, "I had told Aanand ji that it is everybody's efforts from the smallest person to the biggest, so try and stick to the same crew. I will apply the same rule when it comes

Speaking about directing the film herself, Kangana said, "I have delivered a Rs 100 crore film as a director with 'Manikarnika: The Queen of

Jhansi'. So, I will try and keep myself as the director unless I find someone better than me for this job. Obviously, I will be more than happy to just act as an actor because I have lots of responsibilities in terms of other projects that Manikarnika productions are going to announce. The pressure is a lot but I do believe that I can do a lot. So, I'm looking for someone to direct but if not then I am there, I will definitely do it."

Kangana fulfills her previous commitments. "This year I will be finishing my earlier commitments and then I will start the pre-production of 'Aparajita Ayodhya' in July. It is dependent on the seasons, so we have to shoot accordingly. I can simultaneously do pre-production of two projects and roll with two films in 2022. This is the plan right now but let's see how things go, it is a creative process," Kangana added. On the work front, the 'Panga' actress will be next seen in 'Dhaakad', 'Tejas', and 'Thalaivi'.

CASE AGAINST MAKERS, CAST OF 'TANDAV' WEB SERIES IN KARNATAKA

A case has been registered by the city police against the cast and crew of the controversial web series 'Tandav' starring actor Saif Ali Khan, for allegedly hurting religious sentiments of Hindus.

Based on a complaint by Kiran Aradhya, the case was registered on Friday against 'Tandav' director Ali Abbas Zafar, producer Farhan Akhtar, actors Mohammed Zeeshan Ayyub and Saif Ali Khan and the head of India Originals of Amazon Prime Video, Apama Purohit.

In his complaint, Kiran alleged that the cast and crew made the deity of Hindu religion Lord Shiva spell invective to hurt the Hindu sentiments. Cases have been registered under section 295A, 298, 153A and 34 of the IPC for insulting religious belief and promoting religious enmity between groups. Several cases have been filed against the makers and cast of the web series in states like Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.





People who are writing against Virat Kohli, his percentage of win record is over 70%: India's bowling coach Bharat Arun



While Team India's historic victory at the Gabba under Ajinkya Rahane's captaincy is still celebrated, there were a few that criticised captain Virat Kohli. The right-handed batsman, who had taken paternity leave after the first Test had given Rahane the charge to lead the team Down Under in the remaining Tests.

However, while Rahane is being praised for his quiet leadership, many pointed out that the Mumbai cricketer should replace Kohli at the helm in the longest format. With all these critics going around, India bowling coach Bharat Arun responded saying that people tend to forget what Kohli has done for the team.

"First thing, I would like to congratulate Ajinkya Rahane for the magnificent job he did in Australia. But to the people who are writing against Virat Kohli, I would just like to put up one stat for them. Out of the 20 series that he has captained, he has won 14 series for India. Which means the percentage of win record is over 70%," Arun told Sports Today.

"If you look at captains across all formats, Virat Kohli's record has to be one of the best ever. All Blacks (New Zealand Rugby team) has

about an 80 per cent success rate, so after them, Virat Kohli's record is 2nd across all sports. People who tend to write about him have forgotten what he has done over the years. What has Virat not done? The fitness culture he has brought into the team. Fast bowlers, fielding have all gone up under him," he added.

"Yes, Rahane has done a magnificent job, he's an outstanding team man. When Virat Kohli is there, he does a pretty good job as vicecaptain, he goes and suggests things to Virat and Virat is also very open to suggestions," he further said.

Arun also described India's brand of cricket as "fearless" and credited Kohli and head coach Ravi Shastri for it. "Absolutely, I would like to sum it up this way. This Indian team is absolutely fearless and brutally honest. These are the qualities that are necessary for a team to do well. And there are two men who have gone and brought about this change. It is Ravi Shastri and Virat Kohli," he added.

As for India, they retained the Border Gavaskar Trophy with a 2-1 series win over Australia and will now look to continue the same form against England at home.

COUNTERING INDIA WILL BE BIG CHALLENGE FOR ENGLAND SPINNERS: MAHELA JAYAWARDENE



England spinners Dom Bess and Jack Leach must have gained a lot by bowling in Sri Lanka in a just-concluded series but a bigger challenge awaits them against India in the four-Test rubber starting February 5, feels former Lankan skipper Mahela Jayawardene.

Left-arm spinner Leach claimed 10 wickets in the two-match series while off-spinner Bess took 12 in England's 2-0 victory. "I think that's going to be a very exciting series and a very good challenge for this group of players. That's what cricket is all about. You need to go away and win the Test series," Jayawardene told 'Sky Sports'.

"The two spinners (Bess and Leach) will have learned a lot here but it will be a bigger challenge in India." Jayawardene though believes that England are "well prepared" for the India series, especially when they will have services of star all-rounder Ben Stokes and impressive paceman Jofra Archer. Both Stokes and Archer were rested for the Sri Lanka series.

WE WERE NOT ALLOWED TO SHARE LIFT WITH AUSTRALIAN PLAYERS IN SYDNEY: R ASHWIN



Ravichandran Ashwin has revealed that the Indian players were not allowed to share the lift with their Australian counterparts during the Sydney Test, something the visitors found "too difficult to digest".

The third Test of the recently-concluded four-match series was played at the Sydney Cricket Ground and throughout the tour, players and support staffs of both the teams stayed in a bio bubble due to threat posed by the COVID-19 pandemic. "We reached Sydney, they locked us with severe restrictions. There was a unique thing that happened in Sydney. It was strange, to be honest. Both India and Australia were in the same bubble. But when Australian players were in the lift, they won't allow Indian players inside it," Ashwin said. The seasoned spinner made the revelation during a YouTube video chat with India's fielding coach R Sridhar. Ashwin added, "Seriously guys? We felt so bad at that time. We are in the same bubble. But you get into the lift and you can't share the space with another person staying in the same bubble. It was too difficult for us to digest. "We are all in the same bubble, but you get into the lift and share the lift space!" The Test was also marked by allegations of racial abuse against Indian pacers Mohammed Siraj and Jasprit Bumrah. In the matches that he had played before missing the seriesdeciding fourth Test due to a back injury, Ashwin contributed significantly and helped India stage an incredible turnaround that saw the visitors claim the rubber 2-1. Ashwin and Hanuma Vihari — both fighting injuries — batted for more than five hours on the final day of the Sydney Test to help India achieve an improbable draw and keep the series locked at 1-1. In the final Test at Brisbane's Gabba, India chased down a record target of 328 to beat Australia by three wickets and break the home team's unbeaten run of 32 years at the venue.

HOW AJINKYA RAHANE FELT AFTER THAT MIX-UP WITH VIRAT KOHLI ON THE FIRST DAY OF ADELAIDE TEST



TEAM INDIA STAGED A MASSIVE COME-FROM-BEHIND FIGHTBACK AS THEY BEAT THE AUSTRALIAN SIDE 2-1 AFTER FACING A HUMILIATING DEFEAT IN THE FIRST MATCH.

Not just for India, there was one man, who also witnessed resurgence personally as the four match Border-Gavaskar series against Australia went on. Down in the series 1-0, without the regular skipper, pressure of getting him run-out and he had to lead that Indian side on the Boxing Day at the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG), how do you put aside all of this? Smash a century lead you side to victory at the MCG! That's Ajinkya Rahane for you.

But it wasn't easy for the man, who played a huge role in India's historic series win against the Aussies on their home soil. The standin captain emerged as a leader of a depleted group, who just wanted to perform for their country at the highest level.

Rahane, before seeing all this was involved in a horrible mix-up with Virat Kohli on the first day of the Adelaide Test, that resulted in Kohli getting run-out when he was batting on 74. Rahane was visibly distraught and it affected his mindset as well.

Talking to the Hindustan Times about how he felt after the mix-up, Rahane said, "Was really blank when that run out happened. I knew we were both going really well, and if we had continued...they were on the back-foot. I felt bad. Once I went in, I told sorry to Virat and he was fine. He was like "it's ok, lets focus on how we

India were in a strong position, however, that run-out triggered a collapse as India got all out on 244 after they were at 188-4 at one point. After which, it was just one hour of madness which cost them the game, according to him. But, Rahane admitted that they had to come back from that and had to do it without Kohli.

Since, this time he knew he was going to lead the side in three out of four games, he had his plans in mind from the practice games and he knew what he wanted to do, how to use certain players, field settings, etc. According to him, he is an instinctive captain and he was clear in his head about what he had to do. The mindset showed in his first innings after the Adelaide debacle at the MCG. According to him, the MCG century was his best ever, considering the circumstances and the situation the team was in. Rahane said that he was in that zone, after India lost three early wickets, there was pressure on him, so he just wanted to feel that pressure, take it upon him to score and just keep going. Rahane's 112 helped India get a 131-run lead and won the game by 8 wickets after bowling out Australia for 200 in their second innings. India not just answered their critics but also levelled the series 1-1 going into the last two Tests. India played a fighting draw at the SCG and won the final game at the Gabba, to complete an odddefying victory, beating Aussies in their own backyard.

'GIVE IT TO SIBLEY AND CRAWLEY', KEVIN PIETERSEN SHARES NOTES GIVEN BY RAHUL DRAVID ON HOW TO PLAY SPIN



England, owing to their skipper Joe Root's tremendous form, won the first Test against Sri Lanka in the two-match series and are giving a tough fight in the second due to the same reason. However, one aspect which would worry the English side, given they have a spirited Indian side to face in a week's time, is the form of their openers, Dominic Sibley and Zak Crawley.

Both Sibley and Crawley have been struggling to score runs against the left-arm spinner Lasith Embuldeniya, who has dismissed the duo thrice now in the three innings. While Crawley has returned with scores of 9, 8 and 5 in the three innings, Sibley on the other hand, has been worse with scores of 4, 2 and 0.

While, Root with a double century in the first and 186 in the second Test has shepherd the England batting against Sri Lanka, the openers' form is a cause of concern with a stern Test waiting for them in form of India, who are on a high coming from a 2-1 heist against Australia on their home soil. Former England batsman, Kevin Pietersen. however, suggested that an email from Rahul Dravid, which he received in his playing says on how to play spin bowling in India. Initiall, he took to Twitter to write that he needed to find that email, expressing his frustration over the form of the duo. Later, when he found the effect of the advise clearly showed.



same, which was published in the South Africa-born cricketer's autobiography, he shared the same in form of pictures, while saying, "Hey @englandcricket, print this and give it to Sibley & Crawley. They can call me to discuss it at length if they want...!" In the email, while saying that Pietersen could ignore if what he is going to say doesn't make sense or he doesn't find relevant, Dravid wrote, "Against guys who bowled a bit quicker (and I grew up playing against Anil) I would look to go forward without committing or planting the front foot. Dravid suggested that but the focus shouldn't be on planting the front foot too early, as if that is done, the automatic signal from the braian will be to bring the bat down early too, which will mean the batsman forcing himself on the ball, rather than it comig to them. Dravid also had suggested to Pietersen to play against the likes of Graeme Swann and Monty Panesar, without his pads on. He elaborated the reason, saying, "When you have no pads it will force you, sometimes painfully, to get the bat forward of the pads and will force you to watch the ball. Also the leg will be less keen to push out without any protection." Pietersen said that this email changed his game, given he had played a match-winning 186 against India in Mumbai in 2012 series, the

Prolific Joe Root has potential to surpass Sachin Tendulkar's Test record, says Boycott

The legendary Geoffrey Boycott believes prolific England captain Joe Root has the potential and talent to surpass Indian great Sachin Tendulkar as the all-time run scorer in Test cricket.

Root, 30, amassed 426 runs in four innings at an average of 106.50 including two centuries with a high score of 228 in the just-concluded 2-0 series sweep over Sri Lanka.

Root, whose next assignment is the four-Test series India starting February 5, also became the fourth-highest run-getter in Test cricket for England and the first ever captain to hit two double-hundreds.

"Forget just scoring more Test runs for England than David Gower, Kevin Pietersen and myself. Joe Root has the potential to play 200 Tests and score more runs than even Sachin Tendulkar," Boycott wrote in a column for 'The Telegraph'.

"Root is only 30. He has played 99 Tests and scored 8249 runs already. As long as he does not suffer serious injury there is no reason why he cannot beat Tendulkar's all-time record of 15,921."

Boycott, however, doesn't want people to compare Root with stars of bygone eras, saying he should be judged only with his contemporaries. "His contemporaries, such as Virat Kohli, Steve Smith and Kane Williamson, are wonderful players as well who could also score that many runs. We should enjoy Root and only judge him alongside those guys, not great names of the past because every player is a

product of their environment," he said. The 80-year-old England batting great observed that Root has worked on his batting during the COVID-enforced break but said the righthander will face his biggest test on Australia soil. "Until this tour Joe had not been making the big scores that influence matches. Perhaps the COVID-19 lockdowns allowed him time to take stock of his batting. For too long he appeared to be influenced by Twenty20 cricket. He was trying to force his way back into England's T20 side, but that frenetic type of batting is not for him," Boycott said.

What did Rishabh Pant tell Washington Sundar in epic Gabba chase? Details emerge now



India was placed in a precarious situation at 265/5 on the final day of the fourth Test against Australia in Brisbane. Washington Sundar, who was making his debut, joined Rishabh Pant under pressure. Earlier in the Test, Washington Sundar had shared a partnership of 123 with Shardul Thakur as the duo smashed fifties to ensure Australia's lead would not be so great. The duo stitched a 53-run stand and Rishabh Pant hit the winning runs with a boundary to longoff of Josh Hazlewood as India created history by ending Australia's 32-year dominance at The Gabba. However, during the course of the partnership, there was apparently a tense argument between Rishabh Pant and Washington Sundar about the approach to the target.

Speaking to Times of India after his arrival back in India following his series-winning exploits, Rishabh Pant revealed that Washington Sundar wanted to play shots while the wicketkeeper told him to play the anchor role. After a tense argument, Rishabh Pant said that he will go for the shots and Washington Sundar would play the anchor role. Washington Sundar hit a six and a four off Pat Cummins to ease the pressure and although he fell to an audacious sweep shot with 10 runs needed, Rishabh Pant held his nerve and gave India one of their most famous wins.

SL vs ENG: James Anderson achieves his best bowling figures in Asia



England pacer James Anderson on Saturday recorded his best bowling figures in Asia. The bowler recorded the feat on day two of the ongoing second Test against Sri Lanka here at Galle. Anderson finished with figures of 6-40 from 29 overs as the hosts were bundled out for 381 in the first innings. The 38-year-old took the wickets of Lahiru Thirimanne (43), Kusal Perera (6), Oshando Fernando (0), Angelo Mathews (110), Niroshan Dickwella (92) and Suranga Lakmal (0) in the first innings. This is Anderson`s 30th fifer in Test cricket. During the course of this innings, Anderson also became the oldest bowler to take a five-wicket haul in Asia. He also went past Glenn McGrath (29) in the list of most five-wicket hauls in Test cricket.

Anderson now has 606 wickets in the longest format of the game and he is the fourth-highest wicket-taker in Tests. He is only behind Muttiah Muralitharan (800), Shane Warne (708), and Anil Kumble (619).

The pacer has played 157 Test matches for England and this is the most number of games that a pacer has ever played in the history of Test cricket. Resuming day two on 229/4, hosts Sri Lanka got off to a bad start as overnight centurion Angelo Mathews (110) was sent back to the pavilion by Anderson. Soon after, Ramesh Mendis was dismissed for a duck by Mark Wood, reducing Sri Lanka to 243/6.

SHAKIB AL HASAN CONTINUES DREAM **COMEBACK, BANGLADESH MOVE TO** THIRD IN ICC ODI SUPER LEAGUE



Shakib Al Hasan continued his dream comeback in international cricket as he dazzled with a superb all-round show in the second ODI against the West Indies in Mirpur. After having taken magnificent figures of 4/8 in 7.2 overs, Shakib Al Hasan repeated his magic in the second ODI in the same venue as he took 2/30 and smashed an unbeaten 43 to help Bangladesh win the match and take an unassailable 2-0 lead in the three-match series. Shakib Al Hasan was aided by Mehidy Hasan's 4/25 as Bangladesh moved to third in the ICC ODI Super League standings which is the qualification cycle for the 2023 ICC Cricket World Cup which will be held in India. West Indies won the toss and chose to bat and they started off in a solid manner despite Sunil Ambris falling cheaply. However, the inexperience of the Windies side came though yet again as they lost four wickets for five runs from which they recovered.
