

Kartik was last seen in Imtiaz Ali's Love Aaj Kal, a sequel of the 2009 film of the same name



Further investigation in the drug-related cases is underway. A special narcotics court in Mumbai on Tuesday had granted bail to Agisilaos Demetriades, the brother of Arjun's girlfriend Gabriella. Demetriades, who was arrested by the NCB in October this year after it raided a resort in Lonavala, where it also allegedly found drugs.

Diljit also recalled the kind of films that he used to watch during his childhood and said that 'he always had a strong connection to hill stations".



ABSENCE OF MOHAMMED SHAMI AND VIRAT KOHLI ARE BIG LOSSES FOR INDIA, SAYS JOE BURNS



score a half-century in the second innings of the first Test against India, has said that the visitor will be depleted by the absence of pace bowler Mohammed Shami and skipper Virat Kohli in the remaining matches of the series.

Shami was hit on his bowling arm by fast bowler Pat Cummins on Saturday, the third day of the first Test that saw India fold for 36. He is likely to be ruled out of the Test series. Kohli will return home to attend the birth of his first child.

"I think Shami and Virat are big losses for India. In saying that, the Indian team has got very good depth. They are still going to be challenging. It is always hard to replace world-class players like that (but) we are going to look who are going to come in. We have to prepare really well for the next game, we know Indians can bounce back strongly. We have to start well and carry on the momentum from the last game. We know we can bounce back," Burns told reporters was Warner's replacement opener in the first Test. on Monday. Burns had a torrid time in the lead-up to the series and there were question marks on whether he will start in the first Test. However, lack of options with both David Warner and Will Pucovski injured made it possible for him to get into the opening position again. "It was obviously nice to make some runs. In the lead-up to the game, I was obviously short of a few runs. It is nice to see a little bit of rhythm...get the job done. It has been an amazing day for Australian cricket to back-up their bowlers. It is a really nice feeling to finish the job really quickly," said Burns who had made 62 across nine firstclass innings in the lead-up to the first Test of the Border-Gavaskar

Australia opener Joe Burns, who overcame a run of poor form to Trophy. He could make just eight in the first innings in the pink-ball Test but came good in the second with 51 not out as Australia chased down the 90-run target on the third day of the match. "It certainly helped to get the runs...felt like coming back home again (to the Test team) after the Covid-19 break...so much support and confidence in the team...so much success together...to take on such opposition in a big game," said Burns.

"We are the best team in the world, we are very, very confident against everyone in every venue. Our bowlers are unbelievable. I think they bowled really well in the first innings, didn't get the rewards and in the second innings, everything fell in place. We know the game in and game out. They (bowlers) are going to be pushing pressure on the opposition the great luxury the team has," added the 31-year-old.

The right-handed opener said that there is still no news on the availability of Warner and Pucovski and gave credit to Matthew Wade who

"We have not heard anything final on injuries...Dave has been in Melbourne, we are still in Adelaide. We'll find out over the next few days...we are still soaking up this Test match," said Burns before adding, "Wade is such a tenacious player. He has got so much experience. Just loved the fact that he kept the momentum rolling throughout the (second innings) innings. He never let them get on top of us at any stage. Very unfortunate with the way he got dismissed but he did a fantastic job." The second Test will be played at the Melbourne Cricket Ground from Saturday and will be telecast live on Sony Ten 1, Sony Ten 3 and Sony Six.

Five lowest totals for Indian cricket team in Test history

42 all out vs England, Lord's 1974

India had registsred a historic win in 1971 when they won a Test series in England for the first time. However, in 1974, things went awry. In the Test match at Lord's, Dennis Amiss, Mike Denness and Tony Grieg all hit centuries as England notched up a mammoth 629 all out. India made 302 with fifties from Farokh Engineer and Gundappa Viswanath. Following on, India looked to save the Test match but in a devastating display of bowling from Geoff Arnold and Chris Old, India were shot out for 42. Eknath Solkar chipped in with 18 while Old took five wickets and Ar nold four. The innings lasted just 17 overs and over an hour as India achieved the ultimate low.

58 all out vs Australia, Brisbane 1947

It was India's first-ever tour of Australia following their Independence. In the first Test in Brisbane, Australia were boosted by a magnificent 185 from Sir Don Bradman as Australia ended on 282/8 declared. Lala Amarnath was the pick of the bowlers with 4/84. However, disaster struck India as they were bowled out for 58 in the first innings with Ernie Toschak picking up 5/2. Amarnath was the top-scorer with 22 as India had no answers. Things reached rock bottom as they were shot out for 98 in the second innings, with Toshack claiming 6/29 and thus losing by an innings and 226 runs.

58 all out vs England, Manchester 1952

Five years later, on their tour of England, there would be more humiliation. In the third Test in Manchester, Sir Len Hutton hit a century and England reached 347/ 9 declared. However, Fred Trueman bowled like the demon and intimidated India with raw pace. He ended with figures of 8/31 as India were bowled out for 58. In the second innings, Alec Bedser took five wickets and Tony Lock finished with four as India were bowled out for 82, losing by a big margin. In that same series, during the Headingley Test, India were reduced to 0/4 thanks to Trueman. 66 all out vs South Africa, Durban 1996

On a pacy wicket in Durban, India failed to find the answers against a charged up Allan Donald. South Africa made 235 in the first innings thanks to Andrew Hudson's 80. In response, India were shot out for 100 with Allan Donald taking 5/40. The icnonic moment being Donald uprooting Sachin Tendulkar's middle stump. South Africa increased their lead in the second innings with fifties from Hudson, Adam Bacher and Brian McMillan. Venkatesh Prasad finished with 10 wickets in the match but there was more horror in store in the second innings. Donald took four wickets and Shaun Pollock ended with three as India were bowled out for 66, with Rahul Dravid's 27 the highest.

67 all out vs Australia, Melbourne 1948

In the same inaugural tour of Australia, India faced more pain in Melbourne. Neil Harvey hit 153 and Bill Brown managed to score 99 as Australia reached 575/8 declared. In response, India hit 331 with Vinoo Mankad scoring a century and Dattu Phadkar remaining unbeaten on 56. Despite that respectable show, India suffered a calamity when being asked to follow on, they were bundled out for 67 with Len Johnson and Doug Ring taking three wickets apiece. Australia ended up winning the series 4-0.

GAP BETWEEN VIRAT KOHLI-STEVE SMITH NARROWS, R ASHWIN **OVERTAKES JASPRIT BUMRAH**



India skipper Virat Kohli has managed to fractionally close the gap on Steve Smith at the top of the ICC Test Player Rankings from 25 points to 13 points while after the culmination of the first Test of the ongoing Border-Gavaskar Trophy. Kohli's innings of 74 & 4 in the Adelaide Test, which India lost by eight wickets, has enabled him to gain two points, whereas Smith's 1 & 1* lost him 10 points in the table. Marnus Labuschagne's innings of 47 & 6 in a lowscoring match have pushed him to a career-best 839 points. Whereas, captain Tim Paine's player-of-the-match innings of 73 not out has lifted him with a career-best of 33rd place with 592 points. His previous best was 45th in December of 2018. Further down, Joe Burns unbeaten 51 saw him move into 48th place, the first time he has been in the top 50 since 2016. With the ball, Pat Cummins took seven wickets in the match to gain six points and move from 904 to 910, which is a comfortable lead over Stuart Broad in second place.

Josh Hazlewood's astonishing figures of 5/8 in India's second innings helped him gain four spots and move back into the top five with 805 points, the first time since March 2018. With four wickets in Australia's first innings, India's off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin has overtaken Jasprit Bumrah as India's top-ranked bowler, currently in the ninth place.

The two teams will now face each other in the second Test beginning December 26 at the Melbourne Cricket Ground.

If Ishant Sharma is fit, send him to Australia now, says Sunil Gavaskar after Mohammed Shami's injury



Problems around Team India are not seeming to end especially with the return of skipper Virat Kohli to India and Mohammed Shami getting injured.

In the first Test, India collapsed below 50 and the Virat Kohliled team registered India's lowest total in Test innings of 36. The game was over before Tea and Australia took a 1-0 lead. India would have to try and win at least two of the remaining three Tests to win the series.

With Shami suffering a blow on his forearm and has reportedly suffered a fractured arm. According to a report by news agency ANI, Shami has been ruled out of the Test series. An official confirmation on the same from BCCI is still awaited. Talking about the same, India batting legend Sunil Gavaskar believes that Shami's injury is a big problem for India.

"It (Shami injury) is a big problem. he has the knack of taking wickets, he can shock the opposition with his bouncers and yorkers. If he is not playing, then it's going to be trouble for India," Gavaskar told Sports Tak. Gavaskar even suggested that India should bring in Ishant Sharma if he is fit. "If Ishant Sharma is fit, I am suggesting to send him to Australia now. If he is capable of bowling 20 overs in a day, the management should send him to Australia on tomorrow's flight so that he can be ready for the Sydney Test," he said.

'KL RAHUL SHOULD COME IN PLACE OF PRITHVI SHAW', SAYS SUNIL GAVASKAR



Former Indian batsman and commentator Sunil Gavaskar said that India has to come with a positive mindset and intent into the Boxing Day Test after the horrendous outing in Adelaide in the first Test.

The whole team went down for a 36-all out monumental collapse and lost the first game by eight wickets.

Gavaskar said that India should try to forget athat and start afresh. Speaking to Sports Tak, India should start the Melbourne Test well, it's necessary for them to step onto the ground with a lot of positivity. Australia's weak point is their batting."

"India have to believe that they can come back in the remainder of the Test series. If India don't find the positivity, then there 4-0 series loss can happen. But if they have positivity, why not? It can happen (comeback). It's natural that there is anger after such a performance. But in cricket, anything can happen. Look at how the scene was yesterday, and what lead down to 50 runs," Gavaskar said.

has happened today," Gavaskar added. With virat Kohli not available and seeing Prithvi Shaw's woeful touch, gavaskar also suggested a potential couple of changes. "India will look at making 2 changes. Firstly, maybe KI Rahul should replace Prithvi Shaw as an opener. At No. 5 or No. 6, Shubman Gill should come in. His form has been good. Things can change if we start well," Gavaskar said.

The Legendary batsman also pointed out the sloppy fielding by the visitors and said that apart from the quality of fielding, Team India has to also improve upon the field placements.

"Had we held on to our catches well and had good field placements, there might not have been any problem, Tim Paine and Marnus Labuschagne would have gotten out early. We could have got a lead of 120 runs. Australia got ahead in the Tests because of those dropped catches, they got the

MSK PRASAD BACKS DECISION OF PANT'S SELECTION OVER SAHA, ADVOCATES PROMOTION OF THIS PLAYER



Former BCCI Chairman of Selectors, MSK Prasad said that he would be in agreement with the Team management if they pick Rishabh Pant ahead of Wriddhiman Saha as wicket-keeper batsman for the remaining three Tests against Australia.

While, Saha was preferred over Pant in the first Test due to his outstanding skills behind the stumps especially during the night with the pink ball at the Adelaide Oval. However, his failures with the bat might have worked

With Pant smashing a 73-ball century in the second practice game, he might get a nod for the rest of the series ahead of Saha unless he fails badly. Talking to the news agency PTI, Prasad said that their committee (when he was the chief selector) had decided that Pant would be their first choice wicket-keeper while playing in England and Australia and also has a century in his name in both those countries.

"Look, our committee was clear that Rishabh Pant will be our first choice keeper in places like England and Australia. Only when we are looking at first child with wife and actor Anushka Sharma.

matches in India where you don't need batting after number six most times, you can have a specialist keeper," said Prasad.

Pant, who has been struggling with his fitness and form concerns, has a great record playing in Australia as during the 2018-19 tour, where he smashed 350 runs, averaging over 50, which also included a century.

"I believe Rishabh has worked on his fitness issues during the past month and looked in good touch during the pink ball practice game. So I would agree with the team management if they give Rishabh a go for the next three Tests." he added.

Vihari is 'Gutsy' batsman, should bat at No 4: MSK Prasad

In absence of Virat Kohli, the batting line-up will see changes other than just the wicket-keeper as Team India now have a couple of options to go

MSK Prasad believed that the 'gutsy' batsman Hanuma Vihari should be promoted to No 4 rather than Pant or any other batsman, given he batted at that position in both the practice games.

"Vihari has a very sound technique and temperament and he can serve this Test team for a long time. In absence of Virat, it would be a great opportunity for him and KL (Rahul) to stand up and be counted," Prasad said in the interview to PTI.

While he backed Vihari to bat in the middle-order, he also advocated inclusion of KL Rahul at No 6, with Pant at No 7.

"I would prefer Vihari batting at No. 4 or 5 in the next few Tests and face the challenge. He is a gutsy boy and I have confidence that he will do well if given the challenge. KL can be a good No. 6 in this series," he said. Ajinkya Rahane will be leading the side against Australia in the remaining three games as Virat Kohli leaves Australia owing to the birth of his

1ST TEST STATISTICS: A HORROR COLLAPSE

The third day of the first Test between India and Australia in Adelaide witnessed horror and ecstasy for both sides. The Indian cricket team were shot out for a miserable 36 while Australia continued their dominance of the Pink Ball Test. Heading into day 3, India had a lead of over 60 and with Australia batting last in conditions which would become difficult. However, in a shocking display of batting, India were bundled out for 36 and Australia won the match by eight wickets to take a 1-0 lead in the four-Test series. The third day of the Test match saw plenty of unbelievable records being broken. Here is a list of the numbers that were accumulated on the end of the Adelaide Test. 8 - This is the eighth win for Australia in Day Night Tests since 2015. Australia have won two Pink Ball



Tests against Pakistan, two against New Zealand, one each against England, South Africa, Sri Lanka and India. They are the only team to have a 100 percent record in Pink Ball Tests. 36 - The lowest total for India in Tests in their 88-year history. Their previous lowest was 42 against England in Lord's in 1974.

88 - The score of 36 was the joint-lowest total in Tests in Australia after 88 years. Before India, the previous lowest was also 36 and it was by South Africa in the 1932 Test at the Melbourne Cricket Ground.

73 - Josh Hazlewood's figures of 5/8 are the most economical spell by a bowler for Australia in 73 years. In 1947, Ernie Toshack picked up 5/ 2 against India in Brisbane. 1 - This is the first time in Indian cricket history that none of the batsmen reached double figures in a Test innings. When India were bowled out

for 42, Eknath Solkar had top-scored with 18.

2 - This is the second time in the history of Day Night Tests that a team that was trailing in the first innings has gone on to win the match. The

first instance was in the match in 2018 between West Indies and Sri Lanka in Barbados. 1 - This is the first time in 26 Tests that India have lost the match after Virat Kohli won the toss.

35 - The number of times India have lost the first Test of the series outside Asia. Unfortunately. India have lost 31 series and only three times in the last 40 years that India have managed to avoid defeat. In the 1980/81 series in Australia, the 2002 series in England as well as the 2010/11 series against South Africa, India managed to draw the series after losing the first game. They have never won a series in SENA countries after losing the first match.

ANDY FLOWER SAYS HE ALWAYS FOUND THE CRICKETING ATMOSPHERE IN INDIA STIMULATING



Andy Flower emerged as one of the finest international batsman during his decade long career with Zimbabwe. To achieve that feat with a relatively weaker Test nation was even more phenomenal. The elder of the Flower brother, Andy, ended his Test career with a phenomenal average of 51.54 after 63 Test apart from 213 ODIs. The high point, of course, was the 2000-01 season, where Andy Flower scored a staggering 1466 runs at an average of 133.27. On a two-Test tour of India, Andy Flower ended with scores of 183 not out, 70, 55 and 232 not out. No wonder England cricket lapped him up once his international career got over and he spent the next 15 years as assistant coach, Head coach and then 'A' team coach of the English cricket team. Andy Flower will now take over as the Head Coach of the Delhi Bulls franchise in the Abu Dhabi T10 League this year. The former Zimbabwe captain and England coach spoke exclusively to DNA about his love of batting in India, his favourite batsmen in world cricket challenges of coaching a side in T10 cricket.

England name Jacques Kallis as batting consultant for Sri Lanka series



England Cricket Board (ECB) have announce former South African all-rounder Jacques Kallis as the new batting consultant for the two-match test series against Sri Lanka, next month. The ECB have also insisted in the normalcy in the plans of the tour despite the increase in travel restrictions or suspensions to and from UK by various governments, due to the latest wave of COVID-19 pandemic in the country.

The ECB sped up their search for the full-time appointments to fill the voids in the support staff, which included vacancies of batting, pace and spin bowling coaches.


While, the appications date close by January 10, Kallis' appointment comes as the biggest of the lot. The role of batting consultant for Kallis is the follow-up on England's appointment of Jonathon Trott for the Pakistan Tests last summer and Marcus Trescothik for the recently concluded shortened white-ball tour of South Africa. The current appointment of Kallis is only for the Sri Lanka series at this stage, and may or may not stretch to the India series. While England has also made several announcements in the support staff which inlcudes that of Jon Lewis as fast-bowling coach, James Foster as wicket-keeping consultant and Jeetan Patel as spin consultant. Graham Thorpe, England's regular assistant coach to the head coach Chris Silverwood, has been rested for Sri Lanka series, but is expected to be back for the India tour, keeping in mind the bio-bubble fatigue.

Opener Prithvi Shaw slams critics after twin failure in Adelaide



Young Indian opener Prithvi Shaw has been under the hammer after his twin failures in the opening Test of the ongoing India-Australia series. Shaw score 0 and 4 in India's eightwicket loss in the day-night Test in Adelaide last week which saw the visitors bundled out for just 36 in the second innings. The Mumbai opener's lack of foot movement have cost him dear with Mitchell Starc dismissing him second ball - bowled through the gate and Pat Cummins hitting the timber in the second essay. India's 2018 U-19 World Cup-winning skipper took to Instagram and posted a message that read - 'If sometimes people demotivate you for something you try to do, that means you can do that but they can't'. Shaw began with a century on debut against West Indies - scoring 134 at Rajkot and followed that up with a 70 in the next Test at Hyderabad against the same opposition. However, on his first overseas tour of New Zealand, the 21-year-old had scores of 16 and 14 and 54 and 14 in the two-Test series which India lost 2-0.
