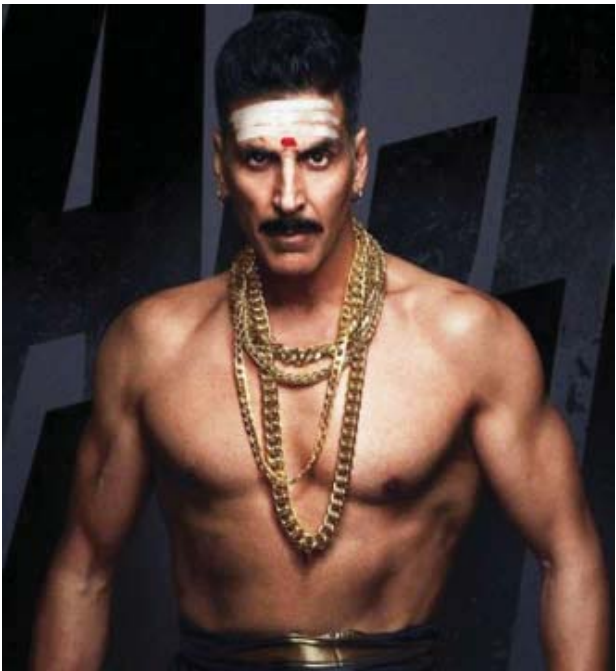

'TEAM SHOWED ITS CHARACTER AND FOUGHT TILL THE END', SKIPPER RAHANE AFTER SCG DRAW



SKIPPER AJINKYA RAHANE WAS DELIGHTED WITH THE FIGHT TEAM INDIA SHOWED ON THE FIFTH DAY AND HEAPED PRAISED ON HANUMA VIHARI AND RAVICHANDRAN ASHWIN.

Skipper Ajinkya Rahane was delighted with the character Team India showed on Monday and fought till the end to save the third Test against Australia in the ongoing Border-Gavaskar Trophy. India needed 309 runs at the start of the day and Australia needed 7 wickets effectively, even though Ravindra Jadeja was shown padded up. Asked about his feelings at the end of the game and what was the best thing that he was proud of on Day 5 of the SCG Test, Rahane said, "I think our talk, this morning was all about showing character today, fight till the end, not to think about results. Team showed its character. "Really happy, the way we fought especially today, but also throughout the game, even in the first innings when Australia were 200 for 2 and from there getting them all out for 338 was really good. There are few areas we can improve on but special mention to Vihari and Ashwin in the end the way they batted was really good to see." India came back storming into the game on the second day of the Test after they broke the Marnus Labuschagne-Steve Smith partnership. Despite Smith's magnificent century, Australia were bowled out for 338 after losing their last six wickets for 89 runs. Needing 309 runs on the fifth morning, India lost Rahane's wicket in just the seventh over of the first hour as India promoted left-hander Rishabh Pant to No 5. But that move turned out to be a genius one as Pant played a whirlwind knock of 97 runs to keep India alive in the

game and set them up for a really interesting chase. **'Strategy was ours, but Pant executed it'** Talking about the masterstroke, Rahane gave credit to Pant for playing that courageous knock with a bruised elbow. "We made that strategy but in the end it's all about that player, showing the character. I think, it was all about left-hand right-hand combination in the middle and that worked out really well for us. Credit to him, the way he batted, attacking innings, backed himself really well." After Pant and Cheteshwar Pujara, both got out India were in a spot of bother again, with 44 overs remaining in the day and just four wickets in hand, five, if Ravindra Jadeja had to play. But, injury to Hanuma Vihari meant India couldn't go for the win and had to grind out the remaining overs to draw the game. Ashwin-Vihari played out 256 balls and added just 62 runs as they showed grit and fought hard against the Australia's fearsome bowling unit. With series poised at 1-1 and SCG Test ending in a draw, the two teams will head to the Gabba for the fourth and final game of the series. Looking forward to that game and giving an update the injuries in the Indian camp, that they suffered in this Test, Rahane said, "Rishabh is alright (elbow) and looking toward the Brisbane Test match, on Jadeja (thumb), the physio will take the call, apart from that we'll have to see how Vihari (hamstring) is feeling. But yeah, looking forward to Brisbane now."


IND VS AUS: 'WE WOULD'VE WON THE MATCH IF....' SAYS BCCI VP RAJEEV SHUKLA

The whole world has been going gaga over India's fight on the fifth day of the Sydney Test to save the game and end the Test match in a draw, however, one person wasn't happy with the draw and has said that India could have won the Test match, if they performed a little better. BCCI's newly appointed Vice President Rajeev Shukla has said that India could have won the game had the batsmen batted better on Day 5 of the Test match. Taking to Twitter, Shukla wrote, "Actually the middle order could have performed little better and we would have won the match. @BCCI." Needing 309 runs on the final day of the Test match against Australia's exceptional bowling attack wasn't going to be easy. India got off to a poor start with Rahane getting dismissed cheaply. However, a masterstroke of sending Rishabh Pant at No 5 worked wonders for the visitors as he blasted the Australian attack and took them to cleaners. Pant's 97-run knock gave them hope of winning the game as they required 200 runs in 66 overs in the last two sessions. But losing wickets of Pant and Pujara in quick succession pegged India back and Vihari's injury meant India's hope of winning the game had died. Vihari and Ashwin with the 256-ball stand helped India to salvage the draw, taking the series 1-1 to a decider in Brisbane in the fourth Test.

'INDIA FOUGHT REALLY HARD,' SAYS SMITH AFTER SCG TEST DRAW

Australia batsman Steve Smith praised India's efforts on Day 5 of the Sydney Test and said that the opposition fought really hard in the middle. Smith's remarks came at the post-match presentation ceremony after Hanuma Vihari and Ravichandran Ashwin put on a brave stand in the final session to push the match to a draw. India needed over 300 runs to win with 8 wickets in hand, and it seemed like Australia will have their way once again when skipper Ajinkya Rahane was dismissed in the 2nd over. But the visitors were stunned by a fiery show from Rishabh Pant who was promoted up the order, and the 148-run stand between Cheteshwar Pujara and Pant reignited India's hopes. But after Pant was dismissed for 97 and Pujara fell down for 77, India had a hard task in front of them to get 135 more runs with an injured Vihari and Ashwin in the middle. Ravindra Jadeja was also out of the equation with a finger dislocation, so India had no choice to push for a draw, which Vihari and Ashwin achieved successfully. The duo stitched an unbeaten 62-run stand as India posted 334/5 at stumps on Day 5. "India fought really hard. Our bowlers kept coming and coming, did their hardest today. On day three or four, we felt that a few kept low, few that bounced a bit more. But there was not much of it today. They fought really hard," Smith said after the match. Speaking on his hundred he added: "Always means a lot when you score a hundred for your country. To be able to do that here on my home ground is pretty special. Doesn't mean a lot now as we didn't win the game."

'Absolute peak of rowdy behaviour', Virat Kohli says THIS while condemning racism incident at SCG



Team India batsman and skipper Virat Kohli, has termed the behaviour of the crowd at the Sydney Cricket Ground (SCG) 'unacceptable' while calling the incident as an 'absolute peak' of rowdiness on Sunday. Virat Kohli, who has returned to India for the birth of his first child with wife and actor Anushka Sharma, has not been involved with the side since the end of the Adelaide Test. Kohli took to Twitter and said that it was sad to see what transpired on the field on Sunday, having gone through several incidents of being said pathetic things on the boundary line. "Racial abuse is absolutely unacceptable. Having gone through many incidents of really pathetic things said on the boundary lines, this is the absolute peak of rowdy behaviour. It's sad to see this happen on the field," Kohli wrote. Kohli asked for the things to be set straight for once and asked for strict action to be taken against the offenders. "The incident needs to be looked at with absolute urgency and seriousness and strict action against the offenders should set things straight for once," Kohli further wrote. The incident took place in the afternoon session on the fourth day of the third Test when pacer Mohammed Siraj, who had reported a similar incident to authorities on Saturday after the third day's play, was standing on the boundary, when he immediately reported the incident to his teammates and the on-field umpires. After which, NSW Police and Cricket Australia launched parallel investigations and the section of the crowd was removed from the stands. Team's senior and experienced player Ravichandran Ashwin too asked for the matter to be dealt with 'iron fist' to ensure its non-repetition. "But this is one time they've gone one step ahead and used racial abuses. Like we already mentioned, there was an official complaint lodged yesterday and the umpires also mentioned that we must bring it to their notice as it happens on the field. And they'll be able to take action. It's definitely not acceptable in this day and age, we've seen a lot, we've evolved as a society. And sometimes I think this roots back to the upbringing and the way one sees. This must be definitely dealt with an iron fist and we must make sure it doesn't happen again."

'I've had experienced myself in Sydney before', says Ashwin

Team India's senior statesman, off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin has condemned the racial abuse by the crowd at the Sydney Cricket Ground (SCG), saying that the matter should be dealt with 'iron fist' as both New South Wales (NSW) Police and Cricket Australia (CA) have launched parallel investigations into the matter. Recalling his past experiences of similar behaviour from the crowd, Ashwin said that this has not been the first time in Australia and definitely not at the SCG. "Look I'd like to point out something. This is my fourth tour to Australia and Sydney especially here we've had a few experiences [racial abuse] even in the past," Ashwin said. "I think one or two times, even players have reacted and gotten into trouble in the past and that's not because of the player, it is actually because of the way the crowd has been speaking. Especially the people on the lower tier of the stands, they have been quite nasty and been quite abusive as well. "But this is one time they've gone one step ahead and used racial abuses. Like we already mentioned, there was an official complaint lodged yesterday and the umpires also mentioned that we must bring it to their notice as it happens on the field. And they'll be able to take action. It's definitely not acceptable in this day and age, we've seen a lot, we've evolved as a society."

'Absolutely disgraceful': Michael Hussey, Shane Warne condemns racial abuse on Jasprit Bumrah, Mohammed Siraj

Former Australian cricketers Michael Hussey and Shane Warne have condemned the racial abuse at the Sydney Cricket Ground (SCG) during the Test match between India and Australia. The Indian team on Saturday lodged an official complaint after the crowd at the SCG racially abused pacers Jasprit Bumrah and Mohammed Siraj over the second and third day of the ongoing Pink Test between India and Australia. "It's terrible behaviour and I can't believe it's still happening in this day and age. They should be banned for life from coming to cricket. The Indians have come here to our shores to entertain us, play some great cricket, we should be so grateful that we can watch some live sport. To treat the players like that is unacceptable," Hussey told Fox Cricket. Warne also said that "severe punishment" should be given to the members of the crowd who hurled racial slurs at Siraj and Bumrah. "Disgraceful to be honest, absolutely disgraceful. Should never happen, especially what's happened in the last 12 months or so with everything else around the world. Let's hope they come down heavy and find the culprits," said Warne. On Saturday, speaking to ANI, a BCCI official in the know of developments said that the Indian cricket board stands with the boys as such behaviour is "unacceptable".

"The tour has surely turned sour and the last thing you expect in a civilized society is racial abuse. The ICC (International Cricket Council) and Cricket Australia need to be very responsive to this as the possible alternatives are not very pleasant for cricket, especially during the present circumstances. The Sydney Test has now become an acid test for CA interim CEO Nick Hockley and we are in complete solidarity with our boys. Racial abuse is unacceptable," the official explained. Sources aware of developments in the team said that the bowlers initially brought the matter up with stand-in skipper Ajinkya Rahane before the team went into a huddle with the coaching staff led by Ravi Shastri and decided that this sort of behaviour should not and will not be ignored. The relationship between the two teams has taken a turn in recent times with Queensland's Health Shadow Minister Ros Bates' comments regarding quarantine guidelines for the fourth Test in Brisbane also painting the visitors in poor light. With questions raised on whether the Indian team would be willing to follow strict quarantine protocols for the final Test of the series at The Gabba, Bates had said: "If the Indians don't want to play by the rules, don't come."

INDIA VS AUSTRALIA: CHETESHWAR PUJARA REACHES MILESTONE, SCORES 6000 TEST RUNS

The cricketer scored 6000 Test runs and even reached his half-ton soon after. The commentators spoke about his achievement but the cricket fans at the stadium were clueless. India made a clever move on the fifth day as they promoted Pant up in the order after skipper Ajinkya Rahane departed early and interestingly it worked for the visitors. Pujara scored 58 off 184 balls and is playing alongside Hunuma Vihari. Rishabh Pant and Pujara had put on 148 runs partnership. Pant played in an aggressive manner and took a special liking towards Nathan Lyon and went on to bring up his fifty. The wicketkeeper-batsman was, however, denied his century by Lyon. Pant was dismissed for 97 but his knock surely reduced the target set by the Aussies. At the lunch break, India's score reads 206/3, still needing 201 runs to win the match. The first session saw 36 overs being bowled and 108 runs were scored.

'ABUSE OF CRICKETERS BY CROWD UNACCEPTABLE', CA LAUNCHES PARRAREL INVESTIGATION INTO RACISM INCIDENT

Cricket Australia (CA) have condemned the crowd abuse at the Sydney Cricket Ground (SCG) on the fourth day of the third Test. CA have launched a parallel investigation into the matter, which is being probed into by the New South Wales (NSW) Police, of the incident that took place in the afternoon session during the Australia's second batting innings. Indian pacer Mohammed Siraj, first complained it to the on-field umpire Paul Reiffel about the incident, which took place at the end of the 86th over of the Australian innings, when Siraj was fielding on the boundary. The umpire, then consulted it with the Indian skipper Ajinkya Rahane, after which the authorities took the matter in their hands. The match was interrupted and the section of the crowd was immediately removed from the Brewongle Stand. Cricket Australia's head of Integrity and security, Sean Carroll, has ensured the Indian team that the matter will be investigated to the fullest extent. NSW Police launched the investigation subsequently and interviewed a number of spectators. In the latest statement issued by the CA, Carroll said, "The abuse of cricketers by crowd members is not acceptable. "We thank the Indian team for their vigilance in reporting today's incident, which we are now in the process of investigating," Carroll added. Assuring the Indian team of necessary and quick probe into the matter, Carroll said that while NSW Police is doing their part, they have launched their own inquiry into the matter. "It is most regrettable that an otherwise excellent Test match contested in tremendous spirit by the two friendly rivals has been tarnished by the actions of a small number of spectators over the past two days."



Jadeja ruled out for six weeks, participation in England series in doubt



India's injury woes in the ongoing tour of Australia keeps growing with all-rounder Ravindra Jadeja now ruled out of with a fractured thumb. Jadeja suffered a dislocation and fracture and has been ruled out for about 6 weeks with the management set to check on the need of surgery with a specialist. Speaking to ANI, sources in the know of developments said that while the player is out for 6 weeks, a specialist's opinion will be sought and a call will be taken if he needs surgery. "He has a dislocation and fracture. He will be out for around 6 weeks and a specialist's opinion will be taken to check if the all-rounder needs a surgery as is the procedure in such cases. A call on his availability for the England series can be taken only after the specialist checks on the thumb," the source said. Jadeja was hit on the thumb by a delivery from pacer Mitchell Starc. While the commentators speculated if he had dislocated his thumb, the all-rounder carried on batting after receiving treatment from the physio. Jadeja did not take the field either in the final session as Mayank Agarwal replaced him on the field. Taking to Twitter BCCI wrote, "UPDATE - Ravindra Jadeja suffered a blow to his left thumb while batting. He has been taken for scans." He now joins Mohammad Shami, Umesh Yadav and KL Rahul in the list of players who suffered serious injuries and were ruled out. While Shami broke his arm in the first Test, Umesh injured his calf in the second Test and Rahul sprained his wrist during training. In what comes as a good news, Rishabh Pant doesn't have any scare and will be available to bat in India's second innings. He was hit on the elbow by a ball from Pat Cummins. Wriddhiman Saha kept wickets for India in the final session on day three of the third Test against Australia at the Sydney Cricket Ground after Pant was taken for scans.

RISHABH PANT TAKEN TO HOSPITAL AFTER BEING HIT ON ELBOW IN SYDNEY TEST VS AUSTRALIA

Rishabh Pant has been taken to hospital after being hit on the elbow by a short delivery from Pat Cummins while batting on day 3 of the Sydney Test against Australia. The BCCI released a statement which said, "Rishabh Pant was hit on the left elbow while batting in the second session on Saturday. He has been taken for scans." During the tea break, Wriddhiman Saha was seen warming up and he will take the gloves as the fitness report on the availability of Rishabh Pant is awaited. Australia put in a splendid performance with the ball, with Pat Cummins taking 4/29 as they took a lead of 94 runs. This injury compounded an already poor Test match for Rishabh Pant. In the first innings, he dropped two catches off Will Pucovski as the debutant scored a fifty on debut. This further intensified the trolling of Rishabh Pant with many arguing that Wriddhiman Saha was the safest choice behind the wickets. Rishabh Pant shared a crucial partnership of 53 with Cheteshwar Pujara as the duo looked to recreate their heroics in 2019 when both Pujara and Rishabh Pant shared a brilliant partnership to help India ensure they won the Test series in Australia for the first time. Rishabh Pant was looking in fine form in this match as well as he struck a couple of confident boundaries. Cheteshwar Pujara, at the other end, took 174 balls to reach his fifty and this was the slowest fifty of his career even by his standards. Rishabh Pant looked to be aggressive and often missed the drive of a wide ball. The incident took place in the 85th over when Rishabh Pant looked to pull a short ball from Pat Cummins but he missed and got hit on the elbow. The physio tended to him and applied the magic spray and he continued batting.

IND vs AUS: Tim Paine fined for showing dissent at an umpire's decision

The International Cricket Council (ICC) on Sunday announced that Australia captain Tim Paine has been fined 15 percent of his match fee for breaching Level 1 of the ICC Code of Conduct during the third day of the third Test against India in Sydney. ICC, in a statement, said: "Paine was found to have breached Article 2.8 of the ICC Code of Conduct for Players and Player Support Personnel, which relates to 'showing dissent at an umpire's decision during an International Match'." "In addition to this, one demerit point has been added to the disciplinary record of Paine, for whom it was the first offence in a 24-month period." The incident occurred during India's first innings on Saturday when Australia made a massive appeal as the hosts believed Cheteshwar Pujara was caught in close on the leg side by Matthew Wade. On-field umpire Wilson did not give the Indian batsman out and the hosts then opted to review the decision. Third umpire Bruce Oxenford was not able to find any conclusive evidence on Snicko and Hot Spot and as a result, the umpire's call stayed and Pujara was asked to continue his innings. It was then that Paine lost his cool and was seen having a verbal exchange with Wilson. The Australian skipper did not hold back and was heard on stump mics, saying that the third umpire needed to examine the off-side Hot Spot rather than looking at just the leg-side version, the Sydney Morning Herald had reported. Wilson was then heard saying that the third-umpire made the final call, and Paine should not be saying anything to him.
