

MUMBAI, (IANS) Veteran singer-composer Alokesh alias Bappi Lahiri - nephew of the legendary trio of late Ashok Kumar, Kishore Kumar and Anoop Kumar - passed away around midnight due to multiple health issues, his family said here on Wednesday. Wielding the baton from the age of 19, Lahiri, 69, and breathed his last at the Criticare Hospital, Juhu, said the hospital Director Dr Deepak Namjoshi. "He had been admitted to the hospital for a month and was discharged on Monday. But his health deteriorated on Tuesday and his family called for a doctor to visit their home, after which he was brought to the hospital," said Dr Joshi. He suffered from several health complications and died due to OSA (obstructive sleep apnea) last night, the medico added, Lahiri - who attained fame as India's first 'Disco King' - is survived by his wife, Chitrani, daughter Rema and a son Bappa, who has taken to his dad's musical career.

Veteran singer Bappi Lahiri died late on Tuesday at the age of 69. His doctor told news agency PTI about his demise, and said that the singer was facing 'multiple health issues'.

Popularly known as 'Disco King', the singer was credited for popularising synth-based dance music in the Indian mainstream. He was also known for his inimitable dressing style, dominated by gold chains.

Such was the level of his success back in the 1980s and 1990s, the singer said in an interview that he is the 'Amitabh Bachchan of the music industry'. Dismissing the notion that he has competition in India, he told Hindustan Times in 2009, "In film industry, there is Amitabh Bachchan and in music industry, there is Bappida. But Amitabh Bachchan is 12 years older than me."

He even suggested that he's peerless internationally, and said, "There is no competition, but there are singers who dress like me. Among women, there's Beyonce and there's Shakira and among men, there is 50 Cent, Eminem and definitely, Akon..." Bappi Lahiri died late Tuesday due to OSA (obstructive sleep apnea). Tributes poured in from all quarters. PM Modi condoled his death, "Shri Bappi Lahiri Ji's music was all encompassing, beautifully expressing diverse emotions. Kanye followed up the post by sharing several more snaps from his alleged conversation with Kim on her "other phone". The first saw Kim tell the father of her four kids "thank you" for his post regarding violence. The message then read: "There are dangerous people out there and this is scary and it doesn't have to be." Kanye's response read: "I will always do everything to protect you and our family forever. #### ALIA ON 'GANGUBAI KATHIAWADI': SHE'S SUNSHINE BUT THERE'S SADNESS IN HER



NEW DELHI, (IANS) Every time she comes on screen she gives her all to the role she plays. Actress Alia Bhatt, who currently awaits the release of her upcoming film 'Gangubai Kathiawadi', has talked about how emotionally draining it was to play an intense character like Gangubai in the Sanjay Leela Bhansali directorial and described her as "sunshine" but with "sadness". 'Gangubai Kathiawadi' tells the tale a young girl named Ganga who becomes Gangubai, a madame in the red light area of Kamathipura. It is loosely based on the true story of Gangubai Harjivandas, popularly known as Gangubai Kothewali, whose life was documented in the book 'Mafia Queens of Mumbai' written by S. Hussain Zaidi.

In a conversation with IANS, Alia spoke about the emotionally draining part of playing a real life character like Gangubai, who was sold by her suitor to a brothel.

Alia said in the candid chat: "One of the things that maybe you'll also get to see in the trailer that there is a constant anger in her eyes so that comes with what happened to her and the situation she was put in. I remember whenever we used to play out scenes and there would always be that layer sir would ask me to bring in the character and maybe I didn't understand it while I was doing it and bringing it I was understanding it but when I saw the film in a flow I understood what he was trying to do and that is something ... that all adds up."

"That was one of her biggest sensitive points that what happened to her was not fair and which world she had to enter is not fair but the beauty is what she does with that anger... She has it in her body and soul but how she turns it around." So how would you describe Gangubai?

"She is sunshine but there is sadness in her that is emotionally draining...to that to do what she did... "

The 28-year-old actress added: "Her picture was on every girl's wall in Kamathipura for 50 years. That was the impact she had for women so put yourself out for other people and not really be there for yourself that is another weight to carry. Even when I was dancing, walking or laughing... Sanjay sir said 'weight'. 'Weight' doesn't mean physical weight... It means in the heart and head and that's what translates hopefully in the screen. Asked how much is too much an actor to invest in intense roles, Alia, who has given power-packed performances in films such as 'Highway', 'Raazi' and 'Udta Punjab' to name a few, said: "Well, it depends in your personality I am that kind of a person where I will give everything."

"That's how I think sir and I connected. I kind of feel we had a sould connect by the end of it. We are both number 6... I could hear him without him saying things to me.. That's the kind of connect we have formed and I have seen how he gives everything." Alia added: "He does not even rest even when his back was hurting he would be standing in pain and would not let his crew down. It is a very soldier like attitude. You have to soldier on there is no excuse. So, I am that kind of person and so is sir."

#### WHEN BAPPI LAHIRI EXPLAINED HIS LOVE FOR BLING, WHY HIS 'GOLD CHAINS GOT **BIGGER' AS CAREER PROGRESSED**



Veteran singer Bappi Lahiri died late on Tuesday at the age of 69. His doctor told news agency PTI about his demise, and said that the singer was facing 'multiple health issues'. Popularly known as 'Disco King', the singer known for his inimitable dressing style, dominated by gold chains.

He was never seen in public without them, and was even mocked on occasion for his public persona. Bappi Lahiri took it in his stride. In fact, he said that if he is ever spotted without his trademark gold chains, people are disappointed. But do you know how his fascination for gold started?

"Gold is my lucky charm. When I recorded of Zakhmi, my mummy gave me a gold chain with a locket that has God's name. When I got married, Mrs Lahiri said that gold is very lucky. As my married life passed by, my gold chains got bigger. "I know people make fun of me but I can't help it, gold is lucky for me. It's my pehchaan, just like my music," he told Indian Express in 2011. Best known for his work on films such as Disco Dancer, Namak Halaal, Dance Dance and Commando, his last Bollywood composition came in the 2020 film Baaghi 3.


## Nawazuddin, Bhumi to star in Sudhir Mishra's 'Afwaah'

# RAHUL REMAINS 4TH, KOHLI STATIC ON 10TH IN T20 RANKINGS; IYER, SURYAKUMAR, PANT RISE IN ODI CHART

India opener KL Rahul and teammate Virat Kohli continued to occupy the fourth and 10th spot respectively in the latest ICC men's T20 batting rankings released on Wednesday.

No Indian featured in the top 10 of the bowlers and all-rounders' list. The recent run of form from Australia pacer Josh Hazelwood has been rewarded as he rose to a career-high second place in the bowling rankings. The right-armer jumps four spots on the latest rankings, ahead of Adil Rashid, Rashid Khan and teammate Adam Zampa and is only behind South Africa's Tabraiz Shamsi at the top of the charts.

The unlucky bowler is Wanindu Hasaranga, who drops from first to third after sitting out Sri Lanka's six-wicket loss to Australia on Tuesday night after testing positive for COVID-19. Australia captain Aaron Finch drops one spot to seventh in the batting rankings, with New Zealand batter Devon Conway rising one spot to sixth.

Kohli static on 2nd, Rohit 3rd in ODI rankings

There was little movement on the latest ODI rankings, with Virat Kohli

and Rohit Sharma holding on to their second and third place, respectively. Pakistan skipper Babar Azam continued to hold on to the top spot. The Indian pair of Shreyas Iyer and Suryakumar Yadav have made strides up the table. Yadav scored 64 in the second ODI against the West Indies whilst Iyer made an 80 in the third to help the home side complete a 3-0 series win.

Their teammate Rishabh Pant added a half-century in the third match to move to a career best of 469 points at the 71st place.

Indian pace spearhead Jasprit Bumrah also remained static on seventh while fellow fast bowler Prasidh Krishna, who was the leading wicket-taker across both sides with nine wickets at just 7.55, gained 50 places from 94th to 44th in the ODI bowlers list.

West Indies' Alzarri Joseph took two wickets in each of the three matches to earn himself a place in the top 20 bowler's list. New Zealand's Trent Boult remains the top-ranked ODI bowler, while Bangladesh star Shakib Al Hasan is the highest rated all-rounder.

# IPL AUCTION IS DONE AND DUSTED, IT'S ABOUT GIVING BEST FOR WEST INDIES NOW, SAYS KIERON POLLARD



Their players may have earned hefty deals at the IPL mega auction but West Indies skipper Kieron Pollard on Tuesday said it's time to move on and focus on international cricket as his team looks to tame India in the T20 series. From the large pool of available players, 14 West Indians were chosen to join Pollard, Sunil Narine and Andre Russell, who were retained by their respective franchises ahead of the auction, making up the largest number of foreign players in the IPL, from any territory outside of India. "That's (IPL auction) is done and dusted and it's back to International cricket. When the IPL comes they will deal with that. It's about representing the West Indies and putting your best foot forward now," the Windies skipper said in a virtual media interaction on the eve of their three-match T20I series here. West Indies wicketkeeper-batter and vice-captain Nicholas Pooran, who has been woefully out of form, fetched the highest bid among his teammates when he was picked up by Sunrisers Hyderabad for Rs 10.75 crore in the IPL mega auction on Sunday. Asked if the players will look to justify their hefty pay days by showcasing their talents in the series, Pollard said: "I would not say that. Every time they get an opportunity to represent their International team, they want to do well. "These guys would have been selected in the IPL. Each and every time you step on a cricket field, you are expected to do well." West Indies were blanked 0-3 in the ODI series and Pollard hoped his team would make amends in the upcoming T20I series. "Guys who have not been here before would have got some experience of the conditions coming up against a well-drilled Indian team. For us, it's about improving all the time. We can definitely improve on that," he said.

#### KOHLI REMAINS RELAXED AND POSITIVE, HUNDRED WILL COME SOON, SAYS CHILDHOOD COACH RAJ KUMAR SHARMA

Virat Kohli remains in a relaxed frame of mind and it is just a matter of time before he gets that elusive hundred," said childhood coach Raj Kumar Sharma on Tuesdav.

Kohli has been getting starts and half-centuries regularly but has not added to his 70 hundreds in more than two years.

Questions are being raised over his form but Sharma feels they are not valid ones as he continues to score runs.

"I feel people who are questioning his form should look at his stats. After watching that they will find it tough to criticise him. The hundred is not coming but he has 70 of them. People should realise that.

"Honestly, he is playing well and matter of time before he plays a big innings. He is very positive and very relaxed and soon we will have a big one from him," Sharma told PTI. Sharma is also the coach of the Delhi team and is currently with the Ranji Trophy squad in Guwahati. Yash Dhull, who also hails from West Delhi like Kohli, has earned his maiden call-up after leading India to the U-19 World Cup trophy. The 19-year-old has not played red-ball cricket in a long time but Sharma feels he is ready for the challenge. He might open in Delhi's opener beginning on Thursday.

## ON CURRENT FORM, RAINA DID NOT FIT INTO TEAM, SAYS CSK CEO KASI VISWANATHAN

Chennai Super Kings did not bid for their longtime servant Suresh Raina at the IPL auction because of his "current form", said CEO Kasi Viswanathan on Tuesday. While the social media was abuzz about Raina being ignored and it probably meant an end to the IPL legend's run in the league, CSK CEO K S Viswanathan said team combination and form meant the left-handed UP batter could not fit into the team. "Missing out on Raina...He has been a great asset for the side earlier. Considering the current form, he did not fit into the side," Kasi told PTI. Raina, an IPL superstar in his own right, having scored 5,528 runs from 205 matches with 1 century and 39 fifties, went unsold in the auction. He had pegged himself at a base price of Rs 2 crore in the auction. CSK veteran Faf du Plessis, a key member of the victorious teams in 2018 and 2021, was snapped up by Royal Challengers Bangalore as was Australian pacer Josh Hazlewood, star of the triumph last year. "We will miss Faf who has been with us for a decade. But, that is the dynamics of the auction," he added. The Super Kings, however, managed to buy back veterans Dwayne Bravo, Ambati Rayudu, Robin Uthappa, Mitchell Santner and pacer Deepak Chahar at the auction.

## LEAVE KOHLI ALONE; ROHIT DISMISSES CONCERNS AROUND STAR'S POOR FORM

In no mood to talk about the prolonged lean patch that Virat Kohli is enduring, India captain Rohit Sharma on Tuesday said "everything will fall in place" if the chatter around him stops. Ahead of the T20 series against the West Indies starting Wednesday, media queries were once again focussed on Kohli's batting form and Rohit wasn't pleased.

"I think it starts from you guys," Rohit was curt in his first response. "If you guys (media) can keep quiet for a while, everything will be alright. If talking from your side stops, everything will be taken care of."

Rohit said Kohli is not under any pressure and will come good soon.

"He is in a very good space and he has been part of international team for more than a decade. He has spent so much time in international cricket that he knows how to handle pressure situations," Rohit said, not amused at repeated queries on Kohli's form.

"So I think everything starts from you guys. If you guys can keep it quiet for a bit everything will fall in place," he added.

Kohli has not scored a hundred for more than two years in international cricket. In ODIs, it has been three years since his last century. He has 44 hundreds in the format overall.

However, Kohli has scored a lot of half-centuries which is an indication that he is not exactly in wretched form.

On Tuesday, It was apparent that Rohit isn't pleased about Kohli being singled out for scrutiny at every media interaction. After the last game in the ODI series, Rohit was more playful when asked if Kohli needs a bit of confidence. "Virat Kohli ko confidence ki zaroorat hai? Kya baat kar rahe ho yaar (Virat Kohli lacks confidence? What are you saying?)," he had said in jest.

Kolkata Knight Riders appointed new signing Shrevas Iver as their The rechristened Delhi Capitals'fortune under the new captain, and new captain ahead of the Indian Premier League 2022 season on Wednesday. The Indian middle-order batter was bought for a whopping Rs 12.25 crore by the franchise during IPL 2022 auction last Saturday. Winning the Emerging Player of the year in his rookie season with 439 runs for then Delhi Daredevils, who bought the uncapped player for a record Rs 2.6 crore at the auction. The troubled franchise's faith in the young man's ability only grew as they made him the captain in 2018 while asking misfiring and aging Gautam Gambhir to step down after six games into the season.,

more importantly under the new ownership, only got better as the next season he led the side to the playoffs for the first time in seven

The team only improved further in the subsequent season; finishing runners-up in 2020. As far his personal stats were concerned, lyer amassed 463 and 519 runs in the 2019 and 2020 seasons respec-

A shoulder injury in 2021 forced him to miss the first half of the season and had to let go of his captaincy to teammate Rishabh Pant. Shreyas played 8 games in phase 2 of the season in the Middle East, scoring 175 runs at 35 on average.

With the limitations of just four players, DC opted for Pant over Iyer in the retention list and the latter went into the auction list.

## **MAXWELL SET TO MISS PAKISTAN VS AUSTRALIA SERIES, START OF IPL 2022**



Australian all-rounder Glenn Maxwell is set to miss the tour of Pakistan and the initial few games of the Indian Premier League due to his wedding next month.

Maxwell told 'Fox Sports' that the clash was unavoidable due to changes in the schedule. He is one of the retained players by Royal Challengers Bangalore alongside Virat Kohli and Mohammad Siraj. "Originally when I organised the dates with CA there was a two-week gap where I could potentially have it," Maxwell said after the third T20 against Sri Lanka in Canberra.

"So when I sorted that out I was pretty happy that I wasn't going to be missing in any series. And then I came to the [CA] contract meeting midway through last year and they said well this is [when] the Pakistan series [is on] and I thought well obviously that's changed since

had to pull out of its hosting plans.

The IPL is expected to start in last week of March and Pakistan limited overs tour is scheduled from March 29.

Richardson feels leaving IPL early last season contributed to him and Zampa being unsold at the auction

The Australian duo of pacer Kane Richardson and spinner Adam Zampa had left India due to the devastating COVID-19 wave before the IPL was eventually suspended last year. Both bowlers had no takers in the IPL mega auctions held last week.

Richardson was more surprised about Zampa going unsold.

"I was definitely more shocked for him. To be brutally honest, when we left last year, in the circumstances early, I remember having a conversation with him.

"I said to him, look, this may come back and bite us, and at that time it wasn't a priority for us to be there. We wanted to get back to Australia." "So I think there'd be some kind of buyers that'd be pretty wary of picking us up thinking that we wouldn't come again. I definitely think that's a factor." Richardson said.

The right-arm pacer had missed the 2020 IPL due to the birth of his child. He said he understood why the IPL teams did not bid for him but he has not spoken to any of them.

"I'm just speaking on what I think would be a factor in it. I don't know. I've never had a dialogue with a franchise or a person that says that's what would be the case. But I think I didn't go the year before as well with the birth of my boy.

"So my reputation probably is that in the last couple of years I haven't gone so it's obviously not something that I am. "I try and play as much cricket as I can. But I think the circumstances in the last couple of IPLs have made me not go. But it's not a reputation I want." he added.

AUSTRALIAN STATE IN BID TO HOST 2026 COMMONWEALTH GAMES

The Australian state government of Victoria says it has entered into "exclusive negotiations" with the Commonwealth Games Federation to host the 2026 version of the games in regional centers in the state.

The Commonwealth Games are held every four years involving 70-plus countries from the British Commonwealth of nations. It was scheduled to be held in Durban this year, but Birmingham, England stepped in when financial constraints meant the South African city

If Victoria gets approval for 2026 it would be the second time in eight years that Australia hosted the games after the Gold Coast in Queensland held them in 2018. Melbourne hosted the games in 2006 while other Australian editions included those in Sydney (1938), Perth (1962) and Brisbane (1982). Commonwealth Games Australia's chief executive officer Craig Phillips says Victoria's bid will be submitted to the CGF in mid-March with official approval likely in April.

There have been no suggested dates for the games in 2026, although the Gold Coast event in subtropical Queensland was held in April 2018 — the middle of autumn in Australia. The Melbourne games in 2006 were held in March.

#### 'I'M WILLING TO PAY THE PRICE': NOVAK DJOKOVIC

World No. 1 Novak Djokovic is prepared to put convictions over his place in tennis history if tournaments around the world insist on having players vaccinated against Covid-19 in order to participate.

In an interview with BBC, the Serb denied he was anti-vaccination, but said he was only exercising his personal choice when it came

to deciding what entered his body.

Djokovic was deported when he went to play the Australian Open. Rafael Nadal subsequently went took the crown, moving one ahead of him and Roger Federer in Grand Slam count with his record-breaking 21st title. And Djokovic insisted he may decide not to play future

"Yes, that is the price that I'm willing to pay. I was never against vaccination, but I've always supported the freedom to choose what you

Grand Slams if required to be vaccinated to do so. That may allow Nadal to move further ahead in the overall race. On the possibility of skipping future Grand Slams over his vaccination stance

"I understand the consequences of my decision. I am unable to travel to most tournaments at the moment."

The present Covid protocols for the remaining Grand Slams of the year

French Open: France requires people entering public venues to show proof of vaccination. This applies to sportspersons, but Djokovic may be exempted due to his Covid infection within the previous six months.

Wimbledon: Vaccination is not mandatory but Djokovic will have to take a Covid test before and after his arrival in England. A period of quarantine is mandated only if one returns a positive result.

US Open: If he stays unvaccinated, Djokovic may need an exemption from the American government. These are generally given to persons who may not have got the jab on medical advice or may not have had access to one before arriving in the country. Humanitarian exemptions are given on an "extremely limited basis."

#### Djokovic's justification of his stance

"Because the principles of decision making on my body are more important than any title or anything else. I'm trying to be in tune with my body as much as I possibly can.

## PREMIER LEAGUE 2021-22: RONALDO ENDS **GOAL DROUGHT AS MANCHESTER UNITED BEAT BRIGHTON 2-0; ENTER TOP FOUR**



This time, Manchester United held on to their lead. Cristiano Ronaldo ended his six-game goal drought by lashing in a 51st-minute goal to set United on its way to a 2-0 win over Brighton that moved the team into fourth place in the Premier League on Tuesday.

Bruno Fernandes added a second goal in the seventh minute of stoppage time, with virtually the last kick of the game, following a rapid break as Brighton committed men forward.

United had failed to win any of its last three games despite taking the lead each time — twice in the league, against Burnley and Southampton, and in getting eliminated from the FA Cup by secondtier Middlesbrough.

"First half was Mr. Hyde, second half Dr. Jekyll," United manager Ralf Rangnick said, "and for a change it (the result) was different."

Helping United's cause against Brighton at Old Trafford was visiting defender Lewis Dunk getting sent off three minutes after Ronaldo's goal for a professional foul, bringing down Anthony Elanga as the winger was through on goal. Dunk was initially shown a yellow card but it turned to a red after a video review.

United moved above West Ham and into the Champions League qualification positions, four points behind third-place Chelsea but having played one game more.

Ronaldo had been on his worst scoring run in 13 years at club level but ended that by cutting inside, after teammate Scott McTominay dispossessed Yves Bissouma, and powering a curling shot into the far corner from outside the area.

The Portugal forward headed wide from Fernandes' cross later in the half, kicking the post in frustration, but his display was praised by Rangnick. "Very important not only that he scored but it was an outstanding goal," Rangnick said. "It was important for all of us, but his overall performance was one of the best since I arrived here."

## **IPL 2022: WE WERE LOOKING FOR LEFT-**ARMER PACERS, GLAD IT WORKED OUT, **SAYS ZAHEER KHAN**



Stressing that left-arm bowlers bring a different angle while having a go at the batters, former India pacer Zaheer Khan said that Mumbai Indians were indeed looking for such bowlers and got them at the recent IPL auction. During the two-day mega auction, five-time champions Mumbai Indians roped in left-arm pacers in England's Tymal Mills and India's very own Jaydev Unadkat, who is an experienced campaigner. "Look, a left-armer does bring a different angle and that does work as an added advantage, so we were looking at left-armers in particular and I am glad that it all worked out," Zaheer, who is the Director of Cricket Operations, said on a show posted on Mumbai Indians official Twitter handle. Apart from the two, Mumbai Indians also roped in Australian left-arm quick Daniel Sams, who has played five T20s and Arjun Tendulkar, who is a budding pacer and son of legendary Sachin Tendulkar. "We did get four of the certain left-handers which went out of our reach but we held our ground and made sure that we put up a squad together which we can definitely have a lot of hopes there," added Zaheer, himself a left-arm pacer.


