
AMID UKRAINE CRISIS, PM JUSTIN TRUDEAU MEETS UK PM BORIS JOHNSON

The Prime Minister, Justin Trudeau, concluded a productive bilateral visit to the United Kingdom (UK). The visit reinforced the strong and longstanding relationship between our two countries and our shared commitments to holding Russia accountable for the unjustifiable invasion of Ukraine, promoting international peace and security, protecting democracy, and working collectively to address global challenges including climate change.

to discuss and continue to respond to the ongoing military aggression by Russia against Ukraine. Prime Minister Trudeau announced that Canada will impose new restrictions on 10 individuals complicit in Russia's unjustifiable invasion of Ukraine, including former and current senior government officials, and supporters of Russian leadership. These measures put further pressure on Russia's leadership, including President Putin's inner circle, to cease its repeated violations of human rights and Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity. Both leaders agreed to pursue further joint support for Ukraine by providing critical humanitarian and military aid and ensuring that Russia is held accountable for its illegal, unprovoked

INTEREST RATE TO 0.5%

BANK OF CANADA INCREASES POLICY

The Bank of Canada today increased its target for the overnight rate to $\frac{1}{2}$ %, with the Bank Rate at $\frac{3}{4}$ % and the deposit rate at $\frac{1}{2}$ %. The Bank is continuing its reinvestment phase, keeping its overall holdings of Government of Canada bonds on its balance sheet roughly constant until such time as it becomes appropriate to allow the size of its balance sheet to decline.

The unprovoked invasion of Ukraine by Russia is a major new source of uncertainty. Prices for oil and other commodities have risen sharply. This will add to inflation around the world, and negative impacts on confidence and new supply disruptions could weigh on global growth. Financial market volatility has increased. The situation remains fluid and we are following events closely.







The sample size for the Exit Poll was 1.04 lakh in Uttar Pradesh. In Uttarakhand, the Congress is very close to the majority mark and is projected to get 35 seats in the 70-member Assembly. The ruling BJP is projected to get 29 seats. The others category in Uttarakhand is likely to get 5 seats of which 3 is likely for BSP. The BJP is losing vote share by 5.7 per cent at 40.8 per cent, while the Congress is gaining the similar numbers at 39.3 per cent. Goa is projected for a hung Assembly with no party or block getting a majority. The ruling BJP is marginally ahead of Congress with 15 seats in the 40-member Assembly. The Congress alliance is at 14




seats. The MGP is getting 7 seats and AAP is getting 3 seats in Goa, as per the Exit Poll. BJP's vote share is at 32.7 per cent, followed by the Congress at 30.2 per cent, AAP at 14.5 per cent and MGP at 10.5 per cent. In Manipur, there is no clear verdict. The BJP is the single largest party at 25 seats in the 60-member Assembly, followed by Congress at 14 and NPP at 12. Thre current survey findings and projections are based on C-Voter Exit Poll/Post Poll personal interviews conducted on pollling day and after polling day among 18+ adults statewide. CONGRESS SEEN TO LOSE 11% VOTE SHARE IN PUNJAB, AAP TO GAIN 15% TO FORM GOVT



The Punjab experiment of the Congress seemed to have failed, as per the ABP/C-Voter exit poll, with the last minute change in the leadership bringing its citadel down, while the AAP has gained more than 15 per cent votes over the last elections and is likely to form the government in the state.

In 2017, the Aam Aadmi Party had got around 23 per cent votes but the projections for this election is 39 per cent, while Congress seems to have lost around 11 per cent votes, against in last election's over 38 per cent now, to around 26 per cent and may see its tally come down from 77 seats to 25 seats.

But the surprising predictions are for the Shiromani Akali Dal, which fought in alliance with the Bahujan Samaj Party, and may see its vote percentage come down from 25 per cent to 20 per cent but seats may rise to 23 from 15 in 2017, while the BJP may also win nine seats. According to the exit poll projections, the AAP will oust another Congress government, after Delhi in 2013, winning 51-61 seats in the 117-seat Punjab Assembly.

The Bharatiya Janata Party's alliance with the newly-formed Punjab Lok Congress party of foe-turned-friend Capt Amarinder Singh might be able to secure only 10 seats in these elections.

Punjab has three regions — Doaba, Malwa, and Majha.

According to the exit poll survey, of the 23 seats in the Doaba region — a tie is expected between Congress and AAP with each securing 7 while the SAD may get 5 and the BJP 3.

The SAD might outrun all its rivals by securing 8 of the 25 seats in the Majha region, while the Congress is expected to get 7 seats, the AAP 6. and the BJP 4.

The third and most important Malwa region, with 69 seats, might turn the tables in Punjab as, according to the exit poll, it might see the AAP winning 43 seats, while the Congress might get 11 and SAD 10 seats, and while BJP might have to settle with only 3.

BJP MODEL GIVES THE RULING PARTY 255 SEATS IN UP



The BJP is predicting it will win 255 seats in the Uttar Pradesh assembly polls as per its Political Affinity Model (PAM).

The Model is based on the political affinity of the castes of Uttar Pradesh towards BJP.

As per the model, Brahmin vote is moving 25 per cent away from the BJP as it got 100 per cent affinity in 2017 elections while this time it will be 75 per cent.

Kurmi caste is moving away 50 per cent away from BJP to 50 per cent in 2022 from 100 per cent in 2017. The same number prevails for the Jats in 2022, Gujjar, Rajbhar, Bind and Kushwaha.

In 2017, 35-40 per cent of Jatavs moved voted for BJP but this time only 25 per cent will vote in favour of BJP with a 15 per cent shift away from BJP. For the 26 other castes, BJP is expecting a 100 per cent affinity vote. These are Thakur, Kayastha, Bania, Bhumihar, Maurya, Lodhi, Saini, Pasi, Kori, Shakya, Tyagi , Baghel, Valmiki, Kharwar, Dhobi, Sikh, Pal, Goswami, Sahariya, Jamadar, Halwai, Lohar, Sindhi, Gond, Dom, Vanvasi, etc.

The castes with no political affinity are Muslim and Yadav where BJP expects zero or nil percentage of votes. As per the BJP projection, it is winning 255 seats and losing 158 seats. In the Pashchim region, out of 70 it is winning less than half or 34 seats, in the Braj region it is winning 49 out of 65, in the Awadh region 55 out of 81, 36 out of 65 in Gorakhpur and 42 out of 71 in Kashi region.


167 RALLIES & 42 ROADSHOWS, PRIYANKA EMERGES AS THE STAR **CAMPAIGNER IN CONGRESS**


Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra has emerged as a star campaigner who has been touring all the states going to the polls. She has addressed 167 rallies, held 42 road shows and also did virtual rallies. Being in-charge of the party in Uttar Pradesh, she has lots of high stakes in the state and her campaign in the 2022 Assembly elections has always been in the news. Priyanka's hard work, her energy and positivity-filled campaigns have caught the attention of the people of the state. Congress insiders say that her slogans have made a place in the hearts of the public, and her campaigns in heavy rain, meeting people, including women working in the fields in Barabanki have gone well with the public.

Priyanka also campaigned in Punjab, Goa, Uttarakhand and Manipur. Through 42 road shows and door-to-door campaigns, Priyanka interacted with the public during the election campaign and visited states including three to Punjab, two to Uttarakhand and Goa, and a virtual rally in Manipur. Party Leaders said during the election campaign, Priyanka was constantly seen saying in her speeches that the power in a democracy lies in the hands of the people. She called upon the people to recognise the power of their vote, and vote on the issues. When the Prime Minister said in one of his speeches on the problem of stray animals that he did not know that there was this problem in Uttar Pradesh, Priyanka took a jibe at him and said, "you have given five years to these leaders, but they say they will do it in the next five years". Talking to IANS during her campaign, she had said: "I am trying to send across the message that politics should not be based on hatred and violence and time has come for a new kind of politics which should work to address the problems of the people."









HOW MANIPUR'S POLL OUTCOME WILL IMPACT N-E ELECTORAL POLITICS

On the backdrop of the strong agitations in the Northeastern states to repeal the Armed Forces (Special Power) Act, 1958 (AFSPA) and realignment of the alliance between the political parties, the Assembly elections in Manipur were held in two phases on February 28 and March 5. Political pundits observed that the outcome of the Manipur Assembly elections would be an important ramification in Meghalaya and Nagaland, the two Northeastern states along with Tripura would go to the Assembly polls early next year. The ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and its two estranged allies -- National People's Party (NPP) and Naga People's Front (NPF) -- fought the elections to the 60seat Manipur Assembly separately. Over the two month-long elections campaign, the relations among the three parties worsened and each made allegations and counter allegations against one another. Headed by Meghalaya Chief Minister Conrad K. Sangma, the NPP is the dominant party of the Meghalaya Democratic Alliance government, in which with two MLAs the BJP is the partner. The NPF with 25 MLAs is a major ally of the United Democratic Alliance (UDA) led India's first all party and opposition less government in Nagaland. With 21 members Nationalist Democratic Progressive Party (NDPP) and BJP with 12 MLAs, are the two important constituents of the UDA. The NPP, a national party, NPF, NDPP led by Nagaland Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio and many other regional and state parties are the allies of the BJP-led anti-Congress alliance of regional parties -- North East Democratic Alliance (NEDA), the Northeast unit of the National Democratic Alliance at the center, Assam Chief Minister and BJP leader HimantaBiswaSarmaSarma is the convener of the NEDA. Sushanta Talukdar, a renowned political commentator in the Northeast region and a celebrity writer, said: "With the dwindling relations between the BJP and its allies in the Northeastern states, specially the NPF and NPP, there is bound to be a serious electoral ramification in the near future especially during the Assembly elections in Meghalaya and Nagaland in early next year." "The BJP wrested power in Assam (in 2016 and 2021), Manipur (in 2017) and Tripura (in 2018) with the support of the local and regional parties. The saffron party's current relations with its several allies in the Northeastern states are very unpleasant," Talukdar, the editor of multilingual online portal 'Nezine', told IANS.

AS UP POLLS SHOW, NO PARTY IS ABOVE DYNASTIC POLITICS

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has been attacking rival politicians, accusing them of promoting dynastic politics and ignoring the developmental agenda. However, Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi has refuted the charge and said that the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) too is mired in dynastic politics. Campaigning in Uttar Pradesh, the Prime Minister has been saying that the BJP government is "necessary" for the state and the earlier governments "could not see or think beyond family". His main attack has been on Samajwadi Party (SP) leader Akhilesh Yadav and his ally Jayant Chaudhary of the Rashtriya Lok Dal along with Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi. While Akhilesh is the second generation in politics, Jayant Chaudhary is the third and Priyanka Gandhi is the fourth generation of the Nehru-Gandhi family who is leading the Congress in the state. Modi targeted the P and its allies, terming them as "ghor- parivarvadi log". But in reality the BJP is not far behind in dynastic politics. Priyanka Gandhi said: "The Prime Minister has a problem with only one family, that is the Gandhi family as he knows they will not bow down but he has no problem in admitting the dynasts of the Congress." Her indication was towards JitinPrasada, JyotiradityaScindia and RPN Singh who had ditched thr Congress and joined the BJP. Prasada and RPN Singh are second generation in politics while Scindia is third generation in politics. Not only former Congressmen, but the BJP has its own set of dynasts who are rising in politics. Talking of Uttar Pradesh, Noida MLA Pankaj Singh is the son of Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, Rajveer Singh, MP, is the son of Kalyan Singh, Ashutosh Tandon is the son of Lalji Tandon, Sidharth Nath Singh is related to Lal Bahadur Shastri. The list doesn't end with Uttar Pradesh. Vasundhara Raje, YashodhraRaje and Dushyant Singh are from the family of VijayarajeScindia who was the founder of the BJP. Similarly, Union Minister Anurag Thakur is the son of former Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Prem Kumar Dhumal, Dharmendra Pradhan's father was also in the BJP and MoS in the Vajpayee government, Piyush Goyal's father was treasurer of the BJP for a long time. Maneka Gandhi and her son Varun Gandhi too are MPs. Pramod Mahaian's daughter is a MP in the Lok Sabha. BS Yedyurappa's son has also taken the plunge into politics. So Congress leaders say that dynasts are rising in the BJP also but the BJP says that they are there but the party is not run by a family. The BJP says that the Congress, SP and the RLD are run by families. However, the Congress points out that the party does not have a problem with YSR Reddy's son Jagan who is the Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister as he is supporting the BJP, but has a problem with Uddhav Thackeray, Hemant Soren and MK Stalin as they are opposed to the BJP. Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik too has taken the baton from his father.

WILL WIN MAJORITY IN GOA, BUT TAKE NON-BJP PARTIES ALONG: CONGRESS



Even if the Congress wins a majority in Goa, it would like to bring other non-BJP parties onboard during government formation, former Chief Minister Digambar Kamat said on Monday.

Addressing reporters after a meeting of the party's 37 candidates and their election agents, he also expressed confidence that the party would win a clear majority with its alliance partner, Goa Forward. "(Congress senior observer for Goa and former Union Minister P.)

"(Congress senior observer for Goa and former Union Minister P.) Chidambaram has just told us, even if the party gets a majority, the Congress would like to associate all non-BJP parties (in government formation)," Kamat said.

"We feel that our party will win a clear majority and will come to power in alliance with Goa Forward," he said.


Asked about the Congress' chief ministerial face, Kamat, who is one of the aspirants for the top post, said: "Why are you worrying about this? Even I am not thinking about it."

The Congress, in alliance with the Goa Forward party (three seats) has contested 37 seats out of the total 40.

Celebration of International Women's Day on 8th March annually is a 48.76 per cent of the population. Most analysts agree that women in reminder of the need for gender balance in global society today. However, Pakistan presents a stark case of a nation, whose women are still in the backwaters of civilization.

According to the recently published 'Global Gender Gap Report 2021', Pakistan ranked 153rd out of 156 countries, as per gender parity index. Statistics alone do not reflect the realities of being a woman in Pakistan. The twin challenges of existing societal Islamic norms and the lack of legislation or legal rights empowering women is a reminder that Pakistan needs to change its attitude towards women if it is to modernise as a society.

The most telling example of the lack of recognition of the rights of women emerged in February this year when Waseem Azeem, convicted (2019) of honour killing his sister Qandeel Baloch was acquitted! The tragedy is that while the Government of Pakistan has passed various laws to prevent violence and support those affected by it, the conviction rate for violence against women sits at only 1-2.5 per cent. The available statistics, however, do not accurately represent the full extent of the problem. Estimates indicate that one in two Pakistani women who have experienced violence never sought help or told anyone about the violence they had experienced. The silent majority is obviously out there, making the task of redressal almost impossible. According to the Census of Pakistan in 2017, women make up

Pakistan have played an important role throughout the country's history, and empowerment has come to them slowly. For instance, Pakistani women have been allowed to vote in elections since 1956. Pertinently, the status of women in Pakistan differs considerably across classes, regions, and the rural/urban divide due to the uneven socioeconomic development and the impact of tribal and feudal social formations in Pakistan.

The World Economic Forum (WEF) Gender Gap Index 2021 states that only 45 per cent of women are literate, 61 per cent attend primary school, 31 per cent attend high school and only 8.3 per cent enrolled in tertiary secondary courses.

Women's empowerment in Pakistan has always been contested. Notably, women are ranked lower than men on all vital human development indicators. That this is a factual reality is evidenced by the fact that Pakistan is ranked almost at the bottom of the Gender Gap Index -- 151st of 153 studied countries. The WEF report combines genderrelated parameters of economic participation, opportunities, educational attainment, health, survival and political empowerment to reach a country-by-country assessment of gender gap and achievement. Women's activism in Pakistan is a difficult societal occupation. However, some stalwarts like Asma Jahangir set the ball rolling to protect

the rights of women, children and ethnic minorities.

"Tonight, I say to the Russian oligarchs and corrupt leaders who have bilked billions of dollars off this violent regime, no more," Biden said during his State of the Union address on Tuesday as he announced a new task force under the US Justice Department to investigate Russian oligarchs.

"We are joining with our European allies to find and seize their yachts, their luxury apartments, and their private jets. We are coming for your ill-begotten gains," he said, CNN

The US is also closing its airspace to Russian aircraft, join-

ing a number of countries that took similar measures this past week, "further isolating Russia," Biden said.

He then added, referring to Putin: "He has no idea what's coming."

"Putin has unleashed violence and chaos. But while he may make gains on the battlefield — he will pay a continuing high price over the long run," Biden said.

Biden noted that Putin's aggression had only made the world's democracies strengthen their resolve to counter rising autocracies. "Six days ago, Russia's Vladimir Putin sought to shake the foundations of the free world, thinking he could make it bend to his menacing

ways. But he badly miscalculated," Biden said. "He thought he could roll into Ukraine and the world would roll over. Instead he met a wall of strength he never imagined. He met the

Ukrainian people", CNN reported.

PAKISTAN MINISTER SAYS SPORTING EVENTS BETWEEN PAKISTAN, INDIA SHOULD BE PROMOTED



NEW DELHI, (IANS) Pakistan Information Minister Fawad Chaudhry said on Friday that the government should promote and restore sports between India and Pakistan, including cricket, to connect with people across the border, Express Tribune reported.

Speaking to the media, along with Sindh Governor Imran Ismail at the Rawalpindi Cricket Stadium, the minister underscored the importance of strengthening bilateral ties between neighbouring countries through sports. Referring to the opposition's plan to stage a protest in Rawalpindi during the Australian team's tour, Fawad stated that he believed the opposition was working against the interests of the Pakistani people. He remarked that he will offer the opposition a "free box" in the stadium to "sit in, watch the match and decide their course of action". Taking to his official Twitter handle earlier, the minister said that the first clash between Pakistan and Australia, after 24 years. will begin today and thanked the Australian team for "making this March beautiful for us". He also wished the Pakistani team success. He also extended his gratitude to the Australian High Commission for its efforts in bringing the Aussies to Pakistan.

PAKISTAN SIGNS TRADE DEAL WITH RUSSIA AMID WAR--HOW WILL THE IMF REACT?


Pakistan has become the first country to officially sign a huge trade deal with Russia at a time when Moscow has come under severe criticism for invading Ukraine. As part of the agreement, Pakistan will import two million tonnes of wheat and natural gas from Russia.

Will this impact Pakistan's assistance from the International Monetary Fund (IMF)?

Not only have the US and European Union thrashed out stringent sanctions against Russia, the World Bank and the IMF, too, have issued a joint statement condemning Moscow while promising to provide assistance to Ukraine and other countries that have opened their doors to Ukrainian refugees. Notably, Pakistan is now seeking a bailout package from the IMF, which approved disbursement of \$1 billion under its \$6 billion loan programme. However, the Imran Khan government is desperately seeking a larger portion of loan from the IMF to support its sagging economy. Pakistan's dependence on IMF assistance has risen in the last few years with the growing external debt. This year, Islamabad's gross external financing requirement is estimated at around \$30 billion. In a joint statement, the IMF and World Bank called for coordinated international action to mitigate risks and navigate the treacherous period ahead as the Russia-Ukraine crisis intensified.

Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan's visit to Russia on the eve of the Ukraine attack has already come under scrutiny. Khan met Russian President Vladimir Putin on February 24 to discuss ways to expand bilateral relations. "This visit could not possibly have created a good image of Pakistan in the international community. Pakistan is, after all, heavily dependent on the financial aid of Western countries and their monetary institutions like the IMF and the World Bank," the News International said in a report. While Russia has 2.59 per cent of the total votes at the IMF, the US has 16.40 per cent. The UK has 4.03 per cent and Germany 5.31 per cent. China has 6.08 per cent. Notably, China, an ally of Russia has also opted to remain cautious while maintaining neutrality. Khan has justified his meeting with Putin, saying that the agreements will support import of natural gas, which is the need of the hour amid Pakistan's depleting reserves. Immediately after the Khan-Putin meeting, a \$9.69 billion fine was slapped on National Bank of Pakistan's New York branch by the US regulatory authorities for charges relating to non-compliance and anti-money laundering."One hopes that Pakistan's people do not pay too heavy a price for the indiscretion of its leaders," the Pakistan-based news organisation said.

MICROSOFT CEO SATYA NADELLA'S SON **PASSES AWAY**



Tech giant Microsoft Corporation said that Zain Nadella, son of CEO Satya Nadella and his wife Anu Nadella, has died, Bloomberg reported.

The software maker told its executive staff in an email that Zain, who was 26 years old and had been born with cerebral palsy, passed away on Monday morning. The message asked executives to hold the family in their thoughts and prayers while giving them space to grieve privately, the report said. In October 2017, the CEO talked about the birth of his son in a blogpost. "One night, during the thirty-sixth week of her pregnancy, Anu noticed that the baby was not moving as much as she was accustomed to. So we went to the emergency room of a local hospital in Bellevue," Nadella had said in the post. "We thought it would be just a routine checkup, little more than new parent anxiety. In fact, I distinctly remember feeling annoyed by the wait times we experienced in the emergency room. But upon examination, the doctors were alarmed enough to order an emergency cesarean section," he added. The CEO mentioned that Zain was born at 11:29 p.m. on August 13, 1996, all of three pounds and he did not cry. "Zain was transported from the hospital in Bellevue across Lake Washington to Seattle Children's Hospital with its state-of-the-art Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. Anu began her recovery from the difficult birth. I spent the night with her in the hospital and immediately went to see Zain the next morning. Little did I know then how profoundly our lives would change," Nadella said. "Over the course of the next couple of years, we learned more about the damage caused by in utero asphyxiation, and how Zain would require a wheelchair and be reliant on us because of severe cerebral palsy. I was devastated. But mostly I was sad for how things turned out for me and Anu," he added.

In 2022, Putin is the architect of the globe's most infamous catastrophe. He has single handedly created the worst crisis for Europe and the world in recent times.

But how does the man work?

Some say, he set aside the everyday calculus of political risks and benefits. Others say he has always thrived with a mindset of "diminished sense of danger". This means what is

"dangerous" to the common people, you and me and even other public and military leaders, may not appear dangerous to Putin, a former KGB spy.

It is also argued that Putin's authoritarian inclination actually came from his former idol and boss, Anatoly Sobchak. Once seen as a possible president of Russia, Sobchak has been a central figure in Russia's revolution of the 1990s.

Sobchak and Putin worked together when both were mayor and deputy mayor of St Petersburg.

Well, the conventional wisdom suggests if one has to understand the war in Ukraine in 2022, it is pertinent for the world today to understand and analyse the man called Putin. One simple reference can be Putin's grandfather was a cook with illustrious Stalin.

Experts and scholars who have devoted time and energy into Russian affairs and working on the life and careers of Putin, Boris Yelstin and Sobchak say the incumbent President had the "diminished sense of danger" even in his childhood.

Nothing about this war was inevitable, says The Economist, adding cleverly that "it is a conflict entirely of his own making". A few can dispute this.

It's like the "making" of his career. When boys of his age wanted in the Soviet Union to be a fighter pilot or something glamorous, he wanted to be a spy. Posted to East Germany as a KGB sleuth, he had mastered

smoke and mirrors -- that is intended to make one believe that something is being done or is true, when it is not.

He grew up virtually believing that "one spy could decide the fate of thousands of people". And, thus comes the conviction he is not only a "spy"; he is Moscow -- the centrifugal point of

And Moscow cannot be silent.

Let's face the truth. Putin attacked Ukraine in 2022. In the past, he annexed Crimea in 2014 and Putin also had invaded Georgia in 2008. That's the man for you. The metamorphosis of the man is not sudden.

In contrast, presumably, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky represents the pulse of his country, they all want to fight the Russian aggression. Putin on the other hand wants to

A survey says about 34 per cent of Ukrainians are ready to pick up arms against Putin's forces.

There are a few historical tidbits. During the Soviet era, Russia was the most powerful province of the USSR and Ukraine was the second most powerful. Once upon a time. of course it is said Ukraine was considered a chief competitor to the US and it was even perhaps more powerful than Russia. The two men are now changing the course of history. One trying to invade, and the other resisting the same. Putin had presumed that Ukrainians and their non-text book

variety President would crumble under intense pressure. The US officials have been impressed with the fighting prowess of the Ukrainians, says The New York Times.

Zelensky on the morning of February 26 posted a video of himself on Twitter as Russians had started claiming that he had fled the war-ravaged country.

But Ukraine's President emerged from his office unshaven, looked red-eyed and declared: "Good morning to all Ukrainians! There are a lot of fakes out there... (but) I am here."

One video among billions of social media postings and a mere half a sentence "...I am here" perhaps stalled the course of human history at least for the time being.

Snap elections were held not long ago in his country, and Zelensky himself characterized the contest as "maybe more important than the presidential election".

His Servant of the People party won an absolute majority, capturing 254 of 450 seats -- 26 seats, representing Crimea, a Russia in 2014, and the war zone in the east -- were not

"The result marked the first time in Ukraine's post-Soviet history that a single party could command absolute control over the legislative agenda," says a report in www.britannica.com. Did it mark a new beginning in the history of Europe, Russia and the world? Yes, of course, he has made life tense and competitive if not miserable for Putin.

Now the "worst fear" from the Russia-Ukraine conflict is if Putin falters and fails on ground in the face of stiff fight by Ukraine people and forces, he could actually take the road to "unrestricted war" and use of nuclear powers.

But what matters most for Zelensky is that the capital Kiev has not fallen. There is strong resistance in eastern Ukraine and the President is "happy" to play the role of a national leader.

That was not the role he had chosen, but the one that was thrust upon him. Well, he has carried it off with dignity and strength, savs The Economist.

Many of Ukraine's veterans fought in battles with Russia in the recent past, so there is a subset of the population that is trained and knows how to fight Russians, notes The New York Times. Nevertheless the world has to find a way to escape the bigger conflict.

He also highlighted that Canada stands ready to help the UK replace key supply chains disrupted by sanctions imposed on Russia and Belarus. The Prime Ministers issued a joint statement to further strengthen and deepen national security collaboration in the critical areas of countering state threats, emerging technology and cyber challenges, and combating disinformation and efforts to undermine democracy.

The two leaders also agreed to work together to address other key global challenges, including climate change and a strong economic recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic for both countries. Canada and the UK will strengthen cooperation in the areas of science, technology and innovation, including fields such as artificial intelligence, quantum, biomanufacturing, clean energy sources, telecommunications, Arctic and polar research and food production.

ONTARIO UNVEILS MODERNIZED SCIENCE CURRICULUM. **WILL BEGIN TEACHING CODING IN GRADE 1**

To ensure students have critical life and job skills, the Ontario government is introducing a new science and technology curriculum and de-streaming the Grade 9 science course for the upcoming 2022-23 school year.

The Ontario Curriculum, Grades 1 to 8: Science and Technology, 2022, and the planned changes to the new de-streamed Grade 9 science course, are part of the government's plan to align curriculum changes with the province's economic needs and place an emphasis on critical life and job skills, including the fast-growing skilled trades.

Ontario's elementary science and technology curriculum was last updated in 2007 and the Grade 9 course was last updated in 2008. Since then, significant scientific and technological innovations such as the advancement of smartphones, everyday use of 3D printing and genomic vaccines have emerged, and the global economy has changed. The updated curriculum responds to these changes with the goal of positioning Ontario as a leading jurisdiction in STEM, helping to prepare students for the jobs of tomorrow.

The new curriculum will be implemented in September 2022, in time for the 2022-23 school year as part of the government's plan to ensure that all students have the foundational, transferable and entrepreneurial skills they need to compete in a rapidly changing world.

"Ontario has transformed the curriculum to now emphasize STEM education across all grades, embedding life and job skills that will



support the next generation of scientists, innovators and entrepreneurs," said Stephen Lecce, Minister of Education. "From finding new cures for cancer, to space robotics that reach new planets, and the development of artificial intelligence and technologies that are changing the economy, Ontario's new science and technology curriculum is focused on giving young people the skills to think critically, dream boldly and chart new pathways forward for our economy."

BANK OF CANADA INCREASES POLICY INTEREST RATE TO 0.5%

Global economic data has come in broadly in line with projections in the Bank's January Monetary Policy Report (MPR). Economies are emerging from the impact of the Omicron variant of COVID-19 more quickly than expected, although the virus continues to circulate and the possibility of new variants remains a concern. Demand is robust, particularly in the United States. Global supply bottlenecks remain challenging, although there are indications that some constraints have eased. Economic growth in Canada was very strong in the fourth quarter of last year at 6.7%. This is stronger than the Bank's projection and confirms its view that economic slack has been absorbed. Both exports and imports have picked up, consistent with solid global demand. In January, the recovery in Canada's labour market suffered a setback due to the Omicron variant, with temporary layoffs in service sectors and elevated employee absenteeism. However, the rebound from Omicron now appears to be well in train: household spending is proving resilient and should strengthen further with the lifting of public health restrictions. Housing market activity is more elevated, adding further pressure to house prices. Overall, first-quarter growth is now looking more solid than previously projected.

CPI inflation is currently at 5.1%, as expected in January, and remains well above the Bank's target range. Price increases have become more pervasive, and measures of core inflation have all risen. Poor harvests and higher transportation costs have pushed up food prices. The invasion of Ukraine is putting further upward pressure on prices for both energy and food-related commodities. All told, inflation is now expected to be higher in the near term than projected in January. Persistently elevated inflation is increasing the risk that longer-run inflation expectations could drift upwards. The Bank will use its monetary policy tools to return inflation to the 2% target and keep inflation expectations well-anchored.

The policy rate is the Bank's primary monetary policy instrument. As the economy continues to expand and inflation pressures remain elevated, the Governing Council expects interest rates will need to rise further. The Governing Council will also be considering when to end the reinvestment phase and allow its holdings of Government of Canada bonds to begin to shrink. The resulting quantitative tightening (QT) would complement increases in the policy interest rate. The timing and pace of further increases in the policy rate, and the start of QT, will be guided by the Bank's ongoing assessment of the economy and its commitment to achieving the 2% inflation target.



STARTING MARCH 14, REAL-TIME CONTINUOUS GLUCOSE MONITORS TO BE FUNDED UNDER ONTARIO'S ASSISTIVE DEVICES PROGRAM

The Ontario government is making it more affordable for Ontarians living with type 1 diabetes to monitor their blood glucose levels by providing coverage for real-time continuous glucose monitors, the latest technology in diabetes care, through the province's Assistive Devices Program.

"This year marks 100 years since insulin was first successfully used to treat diabetes right here in Ontario. This lifesaving drug has helped countless people stay healthy, and today we're helping even more people living with diabetes," said Christine Elliott, Deputy Premier and Minister of Health. "By making the latest technology more affordable, our government is ensuring that Ontarians living with type 1 diabetes can conveniently track their glucose levels in real time, allowing them to better manage their diabetes and live healthier lives." Starting March 14, 2022, eligible Ontarians with type 1 diabetes can receive Assistive Devices Program funding for a continuous glucose monitor and the related supplies. Eligible individuals include those with type 1 diabetes who are at risk of severe hypoglycemia or who are unable to recognize, or communicate about, symptoms of hy-

Traditional blood glucose meters require individuals to take blood samples using frequent finger pricks, which can be inconvenient, time consuming and difficult to use during a severe hypoglycemic event. With a real-time continuous glucose monitor, individuals use a small sensor that automatically tests sugar levels every few minutes throughout the day and night. These monitors do not require a blood sample through finger pricks, making it easier and more convenient for people to monitor their glucose levels and stay healthy. The continuous glucose monitors also include an alarm that will notify the individual, their family members or a caregiver of low glucose levels, allowing them to take immediate action that can help prevent health emergencies.

By funding the latest technology and medication in diabetes care, the resources to individuals with diabetes.

government is supporting patient-centred care and improved health outcomes for Ontarians living with diabetes.

Quick Facts

To further support Ontarians living with diabetes, the government is also providing coverage for Baqsimi, a new rescue medicine for insulin-treated diabetics experiencing a severe hypoglycemic event, under the Ontario Drug Benefit program. The new nasal spray can be administered by a caregiver in the event that the person with diabetes is unable to do so themselves.

January 2022 marked the 100th anniversary of the first successful insulin treatment, which was administered in Toronto. In the century since its breakthrough, insulin has saved and improved the lives of millions of people with diabetes in Canada and worldwide.

Diabetes is a disease in which the body either cannot produce insulin or properly use the insulin it produces. Insulin is a hormone produced by the pancreas to regulate the amount of glucose (sugar) in the blood.

Nearly 1.5 million Ontarians have diabetes. Most can lead healthy lives by managing their blood glucose levels, including taking insulin if needed.

Severe hypoglycemia occurs when a person's blood glucose levels are too low and require the assistance of another person to treat. If left untreated, it can be life-threatening.

The Assistive Devices Program helps people with long-term physical disabilities pay for customized equipment and specialized supplies. This includes some devices and supplies used by Ontarians with type 1 and type 2 diabetes, such as insulin pumps, blood glucose meters, and needles and syringes for seniors.

To qualify for an ADP-funded real-time continuous glucose monitor, a patient must first be assessed by the health care team from an ADPregistered Diabetes Education Program. These specialized multi-disciplinary teams provide diabetes education, treatment, and follow-up

The supply of listings for low-rise home types (detached, semi-detached and townhouses) was also down year-over-year, but not by as much as sales. In the condominium apartment segment, particularly in Toronto, new listings were up in comparison to February 2021. "Demand for ownership housing remains strong throughout the GTA, and while we are marginally off the record pace seen last year, any buyer looking in this market is not likely to feel it with competition remaining the norm. Many households sped up their home purchase and entered into a transaction in 2021, which is one reason the number of sales were forecasted to be lower this year and a trending towards higher borrowing cost will have a moderating effect on home sales. Substantial immigration levels and a continued lack of supply, however, will have a countering effect to increasing mortgage costs," said TRREB President Kevin Crigger. The MLS® Home Price Index Composite Benchmark was up by 35.9 per cent year-over-year in February. The average selling price for all home types combined was up by 27.7 per cent to \$1,334,544. The pace of price growth varied by home type and region, but there was relative parity between low-rise and condominium apartment growth rates. "We have seen a slight balancing in the market so far this year, with sales dipping more than new listings. However, because inventory remains exceptionally low, it will take some time for the pace of price growth to slow. Look for a more moderate pace of price growth in the second half of 2022 as higher borrowing costs result in some households putting their home purchase on hold temporarily as they resituate themselves in the market," said TRREB Chief Market Analyst Jason Mercer. "We are close to provincial and municipal elections in Ontario. We know that housing affordability will be top of mind. Parties and individuals vying for political office must concentrate on bold and creative policies that will support increased and diverse housing supply to account for the current deficit and future population growth as immigration accelerates. History has shown that tax based policies pointed at foreign buying and speculative activity, which seem to be the political preference, have had very little impact on the market simply because this type of activity accounts for a small share of overall market activity," said TRREB CEO John DiMichele.

At this time, the investigation is still ongoing and there is no indication that these crimes are hate-motivated. However all possible motives will continue to be considered as this investigation progresses. Members from our Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Bureau and our Crime Prevention Services, have continued to provide proactive prevention support to reduce further break-ins and financial loss.

OVERLOOKED: CANADA'S FASTEST-EMERGING. HIGHEST-EDUCATED WORKFORCE

New study finds South Asian women twice as likely to say they are treated unfairly in the workplace, with almost 60 per cent ready quit their jobs Ahead of International Women's Day, a newly released study is shedding light on the reasons South Asian women have the highest unemployment rate in Canada and what employers can do to unlock the potential of this growing labour force. The report, released today, reveals that more than half (57 per cent) of South Asian women are planning to leave their jobs for other opportunities. That is more than any other female group in Canada and 19 per cent more than the average of all the females surveyed.

The study also noted that South Asian women are twice as likely to report unfair treatment in the workplace: 34 per cent compared to the 17 per cent average of all females surveyed and 20 per for all the men surveyed. The findings are significant considering that over the next five years 100 per cent of Canada's labour force growth will be from immigration. Especially given that in 2018 newcomers from South Asia and the Philippines comprised almost 39 per cent of all newcomers in Canada (Immigration Refugees, and Citizenship Canada).

South Asian women are also the largest female immigrant labour force and the highest educated, according to the 2016 Census. The study follows a 2020 Statistics Canada report which discovered that South Asian women have almost twice the national unemployment rate (20.4 per cent compared to 11.3 per cent). They are also more likely to be both underemployed and underpaid compared to non visible minority women. Other findings include:

* The pandemic has exacerbated challenges facing South Asian women, with 47 per cent they considering leaving the workforce altogether due to the pandemic - compared to the 25 per cent for women and 32 per cent for men in general.

* South Asian women are most likely (64 per cent) to admit that they

have lowered their career salary expectations in the last few years, compared to the 50 percent average of all females surveyed and 45 per cent for all men surveyed.

* 58 per cent reveal empty promises made by work managers about their career progression, compared to the 46.5 per cent of all females surveyed, and almost double when compared to non-racialized women (37 per cent). Furthermore, 65 per cent would rather leave their job than wait in vain for those empty promises to come into fruition. Nevertheless, the study also reveals the resilience of South Asian women, who remain committed to professional growth:

* 71 per cent feel there is room for upward mobility and 66 per cent currently feel empowered in the workplace, the highest percentages of any female ethnic group and even higher than the 63 per cent average among all men surveyed.

PUNJAB CM CHANNI MEETS AMIT SHAH, DISCUSSES BHAKRA BEAS MANAGEMENT

Punjab Chief Minister Charanjit Singh Channi on Monday met Union Home Minister Amit Shah and discussed the issue of Bhakra Beas Management Board (BBMS). After meeting Shah at his residence, he said: "The main issue was the BBMB and officers should be deployed earlier. The Centre wants to deploy people from outside. I requested him to reconsider it.a

"He assured me that he will discuss with his minister in 1-2 days and act as per Punjab's wish."

Channi also said that 997 students from the state were in Ukraine, out of whom 420 have returned, and 200 students have reached Poland and are safe but some of the people are still stuck in Ukraine.

"I made a request for them. HM assured me that they are monitoring and the students will be back," he said.

Earlier in the day, former Chief Minister and Punjab Lok Congress Chief Captain Amarinder Singh also met Amit Shah on Monday. Soon after the meeting he said that he had a general discussion with the Home Minister. "There will be a detailed discussion once the results come in. It was a general discussion on Punjab, not on elections," he said.

INDIA ENSURES WOMEN EMPOWERMENT IN EVERY SPHERE, NUMBER OF WOMEN PADMA AWARDEES SHOOTS UP

In the recently concluded municipal polls, the Trinamool Congress won 102 of the 108 municipalities preceded by the resounding victory in the assembly elections, proclaiming an unquestionable political supremacy in the state. However, the victory in all these elections has been marred by controversies and the ruling party has been accused of political violence.

Take the example of the recently concluded municipality polls where allegations of violence by the ruling party were widespread. At least nine journalists were injured while trying to show the violence allegedly perpetrated by the ruling party. The BJP called a bandh for 12 hours protesting against the violence during the election throughout the state. Not only the municipal elections, there were allegations of widespread violence across the state after the assembly polls. There was an allegation that the Trinamool Congress after coming to power for the third time unleashed violence against supporters of the BJP. The National Human Rights Commission in its findings not only accused several Trinamool Congress leaders and cabinet ministers

for their direct involvement in the violence but mentioned that in the state of West Bengal - 'There is no rule of law rather it is the law of the rulers'. Even though the number of cognizable crimes per lakh of population in 18 Indian states is higher than that of West Bengal, the latter has acquired the dubious distinction of recording the highest number of incidents of political violence for quite some time. According to the latest report of the National Crime Records Bureau, the crime rate -- the number of cognizable crimes under IPC per lakh of population -- was the highest in Kerala (499.7) in 2019, followed by Haryana (386.4) and Assam (358.9): Bengal stood 19th (162.3). In terms of the number of murders per lakh of population, Jharkhand (4.3), Arunachal Pradesh (4.0) and Haryana (3.9) occupy the first three positions. Bengal (2.0) ranks 17th. In economic offences, the rank of the state is 15th. In all these headers, Bengal's crime rate is lower than the national average. As far as crimes against women per lakh of population is concerned, the first three spots have gone to Assam (177.8), Rajasthan (110.4) and Haryana (108.5) with Bengal being 8th (64.0).

INDIA ENSURES WOMEN EMPOWERMENT IN EVERY SPHERE, NUMBER OF WOMEN PADMA AWARDEES SHOOTS UP

Women have a new role to play in new India. The central government did not leave any stone unturned towards women empowerment and development. INDIA: A BEACON OF LIGHT FOR RESCUE OPERATIONS

This involves transportation and other logistic assistance from Ukraine to the neighbouring countries of Romania, Hungary, Poland, Moldova and Slovakia. Accommodation and food for the Indian citizens has been arranged by the concerned Indian embassies in close cooperation with the host countries, which have suddenly faced a large influx of refugees and are deserving accolades for their hospitality as well. Upon ensuring their safety, these Indians (most of whom are medical students) are then flown back to the national capital. In fact, the safe evacuation of Indian nationals was first discussed within few hours at the beginning of the invasion when Prime Minister Narendra Modi brought it up with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky. In addition, this was also discussed during the telephonic conversation with the Russian President Vladimir Putin. In order to aid the same, four Union Ministers of Government of India -- Kiren Rijiju, Hardeep Singh Puri, Gen V.K. Singh and JyotiradityaScindia -- were sent to these countries so as to assist with coordination and facilitate a smooth rescue operation for affected people. As part of the operation, 3 Indian Air Force C-17 aircrafts apart from numerous commercial flights of Air India, Go Air, SpiceJet and Indigo have also been engaged there with concerted efforts for the mission. In toto, 7 flights from Bucharest, 5 from Budapest, 3 from Warsaw and 1 from Slovakia were scheduled by the government of India. An additional location at the Romanian border has also been identified and a couple of flights from the area would also start operating shortly. The Ministry of External Affairs has announced that an increased number of flights would thereby provide for an accelerated rescue operation bringing back almost all Indians in the next 2-3 days. In a strategic manoeuvre, the Indian government also decided to deploy Russian-origin Ilyushin-76 heavy-lift transport aircrafts to bring back stranded persons. Though the Indian government had issued advisories right before the conflict through various communication channels, it had mixed impact partly owing to the lax and casual attitude of the authorities about the possibility of an invasion. The Ministry of External Affairs set up multiple information dissemination and communication channels in the form of regular e-mail blasts, website tickers, text messages over phone numbers, roundthe-clock helpline and an active Twitter handle as well. In a tragic loss to the nation, one Indian student was unfortunately caught in the crossfire despite the proactive effort of the government on the ground. However, timely announcements, advisories and prompt responses helped avoid a large number of fatalities that would have occurred otherwise. This smooth and efficient effort is no longer a surprise given that the government of India, over the past decade, has embarked on multiple similar missions to rescue and evacuate a large number of Indian citizens ongoing military conflict zones like Libya, Yemen, etc. The growing stature of India is also due to the fact that India has come to the aid of persons in need, irrespective of their nationality, race or gender. In fact, during the recent turmoil as well, India stepped up to provide humanitarian assistance and relief material at the earliest. Four tranches of humanitarian aid have already flown in to Poland and Romania for the people in need at the borders. In fact, India is also the only country to have been able to successfully negotiate a ceasefire in order to evacuate stranded people in the war zone. This was seen during the Yemen Civil War as well as the recent Ukrainian conflict and is a testament to India's growing soft power and cordial relations with different countries. Needless to say, this is part of a successful de-hyphenated foreign policy that India has embarked upon over the past few years wherein the relationships with so many countries are maintained in terms of individual interests, mutual respect, cooperation and understanding. With the Operation Ganga at full swing, it is hoped that all Indians would be able to return safely in the next few days as the Government steps up its extensive rescue efforts.

FOR PAKISTAN OPPOSITION, IT IS NOW OR NEVER TO TABLE NO-CONFIDENCE MOTION TO OUST IMRAN KHAN

Pakistan People's Party leader and former Prime Minister Raja Parvez Ashraf asked Imran Khan to convene the National Assembly and explain

why the country has not been able to exit the "grey" list since 2018. But Imran Khan is not ready to enter the trap laid by the opposition, which is ready to submit a notice to requisition a session of the National Assembly within a couple of days to table the no confidence motion. According to Pakistani media, the notice is signed by 86 members of the assembly though it requires only 68. The opposition is determined to table motions of no-Confidence not only against Imran Khan, but against the speaker as well as the deputy speaker so that they could not play any "mischief". But the big question is, when would the opposition table the no-confidence motion which they have been discussing for the last two months? According to Pakistani sources, the main reason for the delay among others is that the opposition wanted to be sure that the Pakistani military

According to Pakistani sources, the main reason for the delay among others is that the opposition wanted to be sure that the Pakistani military establishment would not come to rescue its selected Prime Minister Khan. Another reason was that the leaders of the PPP were not in favour of snap polls after the exit of Imran Khan while Nawaz Sharif was keen for early elections.

"Now the deadlock is over and there is a consensus to hold immediate elections," said Maulana Fazal -ur- Rahman, head of the Pakistan Democratic Movement, a united platform of 11 anti-Imran Khan parties. The Opposition's decision to take the plunge follows weeks of hectic politicking by both opposition heavyweights and government stalwarts. They were aiming to get 20 votes of allies of the ruling party while trying to poach an equal number from the Imran Khan led government. The opposition strength stands at 163, 9 short of the magic number of 172 to oust Khan. The total number of votes of allies is 17.

"Yes we have the numbers. The no-trust motion would be like a "walk in the park" for the opposition parties now that we have the magical figure to oust the government," Rehman claimed, adding that the next week is very crucial. The opposition also hopes that "if the umpire (military establishment)" is neutral, more members of the ruling parties might break ranks when they see that the opposition has the requisite numbers without them. Imran Khan is feeling heat and has deployed all his resources of state and government to thwart the opposition, including arrests of opposition figures, political bribes to allies and harassment of independent media. Khan claims that he and the military establishment are on the same page. According to Pakistani insiders, Imran Khan is unable to "digest" that the military establishment can dump their blue-eyed boy. "Khan is unlike Sharifs or Bhuttos. He believes that with the help of 'divine' powers, he can outsmart opposition and the army. Khan has openly said that he would be dangerous for those who tried to throw him out" says one Pakistani watcher, adding that he might announce elections. Imran Khan can also ask the speaker to prorogue the session of the Assembly indefinitely using some technical reasons. After all, the next

Despite all these apprehensions, Pakistani experts believe that this is the last chance for the opposition to remove Imran Khan.

general elections are due next year.

The opposition has done its homework but nothing is guaranteed in Pakistan's present hybrid regime. "They have nothing to lose and everything to gain. It is now or never," writes the veteran Pakistani journalist Najam Sethi in his column in The Friday Times.

US UNEMPLOYMENT SLIGHTLY DIPS TO 3.8% IN FEBRUARY

US employers added 678,000 jobs in February as the Omicron-fuelled Covid-19 surge fades, with the unemployment rate slightly dropping to 3.8 per cent, the Labour Department reported.

Job growth was widespread, led by gains in leisure and hospitality, professional and business services, health care, and construction, according to the report released on Friday by the Department's Bureau of Labour Statistics (BLS).

Average hourly earnings for all employees on private non-farm payrolls, at \$31.58 dollars in February, were "little changed" over the month, after large increases in recent months, the BLS report showed.

Over the past 12 months, average hourly earnings have increased by 5.1 per cent. Meanwhile, recent data from the Commerce Department showed that personal consumption expenditures (PCE), the Federal Reserve's preferred inflation gauge, rose 6.1 per cent annually in January, the fastest annual pace in four decades.

Persistently high inflation and a tight job market have prompted the Federal Reserve to signal in January that it was ready to begin a series of interest rate hikes in March as it exited from the ultra-loose monetary policy enacted at the start of the pandemic.

Two days prior to the release of the monthly employment report, Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell already reaffirmed the central bank's plan to raise interest rates in the upcoming policy meeting, noting that he is inclined to support a 25-basis-point rate hike.

JUST 41% OF PEOPLE IN BRITAIN 'VERY WORRIED' ABOUT COVID: REPORT

Just 41 per cent of adults in Britain were 'very worried' about Covid-19 in mid-February, says a new survey.

The figure was less than half the proportion that were terrified by Covid-19 at the start of the pandemic in March 2020 (86 per cent), DailyMail reported quoting a survey by the Office for National Statistics (ONS).

The report mentioned that it had been falling since January 22, when the Omicron wave started to subside.

consistently until this week, with UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson dropping all restrictions on February 24.

Since then, infections, hospitalisations and deaths had all been falling

Statisticians surveyed 3,000 people in Britain from February 16 to 27 -- with all restrictions ending on February 24.

They showed the use of face coverings in shops and on public transport

decreased compared to the previous week.

Some 71 per cent said they always or often wore face coverings while in

shops, down from 77 per cent from February 3 to 13.

And 70 per cent reporting wearing a face covering throughout the journey on public transport, down from 78 per cent in the previous period.

Almost one-third (32 per cent) of adults reported always or often

maintaining social distancing, down from 35 per cent.

This is the lowest proportion of adults reporting maintaining social distancing since data collection on this measure started in September 2020, the report said. Around four in 10 (42 per cent) adults said they had taken a rapid lateral flow test in the past seven days, decreasing from 49 per cent. The percentage of people working from home last week also continued to fall, with 15 per cent working remotely compared with 26 per cent from January 6 to 16.

BCCI ANNOUNCES SCHEDULE FOR IPL 2022, CSK TO FACE KKR IN SEASON OPENER

Defending champions Chennai Super Kings will take on fellow finalists of the last season, Kolkata Knight Riders in the opening match of IPL 2022 on March 26 at the Wankhede stadium, the BCCI confirmed on Sunday while announcing the schedule for the 15th season of the cash-rich league.

A total number of 70 league matches and four Playoff games will be played in 65 days in Mumbai and Pune.

In all, 20 matches each will be held at Wankhede Stadium & DY Patil Stadium, 15 matches each at Brabourne and MCA International Stadium. Pune, the league said in a statement.

The league will stage its first double-header on March 27, starting 29th May will be announced later.


with a day game at Brabourne where the Delhi Capitals will square off against Mumbai Indians. The DY Patil Stadium will host the clash between Punjab Kings and Royal Challengers Bangalore at night. The MCA Stadium in Pune will host its first game on March 29 when Sunrisers Hyderabad take on Rajasthan Royals.

Overall, there will be 12 doubleheaders in total with the first match starting at 1530 hrs IST. All evening matches will start at 1930 hrs IST. The final game of the league stage will be played between Sunrisers Hyderabad and Punjab Kings on May 22 at the Wankhede Stadium. The schedule for the Playoffs and the IPL 2022 final, to be played on 29th May will be approunced later.

HOCKEY: RUPINDER, BIRENDRA LAKRA NAMED AMONG INDIA 'A' MEN'S CORE PROBABLES

Olympic bronze medallists Rupinderpal Singh and Birendra Lakra, and veteran forward SV Sunil were on Saturday selected by Hockey India among the 33 players for India 'A' men's core probables, picked up to train a developmental group for the senior national team. Both Rupinderpal and Birendra had announced their retirement soon after the Tokyo Olympic Games but have now made themselves available for selection again for the national team. Sunil has been out of favour and was not selected for the Tokyo Olympics. All three along with experienced forward Ramandeep Singh are now eligible for selection following their inclusion in the core probables for the India A men's team. On Saturday, Hockey India announced a list of 33 players each for the India 'A' men's and women's core probables groups. Former Indian men's hockey team captain Sardar Singh has been named as a coach of India 'A' men's side, while former Indian men's hockey team forward and two-time Olympian Deepak Thakur has been named as a coach of India 'A' Women's team. The two groups will be in their respective camps at the SAI Centre in Bengaluru from March 7, 2022.

Hockey India has taken this step to build a developmental group after a meeting chaired by Sports Secretary Sujata Chaturvedi held on February 15, 2022, wherein the Indian contingent's preparation in eight high priority disciplines for the upcoming 2022 Commonwealth Games and 2022 Asian Games was discussed by the National Sports Federation of India, Sports Authority of India and relevant sports federations. Following the announcement, Hockey India President GyanendroNingombam said, "The selection of this group of 33 players each for India 'A' women's and men's core group is a positive development aimed at widening the talent pool for selection of the respective men's and women's national teams. "We are really happy to have stalwarts like Deepak Thakur and Sardar Singh join the national coaching programme. The wealth of experience, technical know-how and world-class ability that they both will bring to the table will be extremely beneficial for this group of players, which will, in turn, strengthen Indian hockey manifold."

AUTOPSY REPORT CONFIRMS SHANE WARNE DIED FROM NATURAL CAUSES


LONDON, (IANS) An autopsy report on Monday confirmed that Australia's legendary cricketer Shane Warne had died from natural causes. A report in mirror.co.uk quoting Thai police said that the spinner's family "have been informed" and that they "accept the finding".

The 52-year-old cricketer had died on the island of Koh Samui in Thailand after suffering a suspected heart-attack on Friday. A Warne associate had tried to resuscitate the former cricketer for almost 20 minutes before the ambulance arrived but he was declared dead on arrival in hospital.

The ex-cricketer's body will now be handed over to the Australian consular officials for return to his country where he will be given a state funeral. "Today investigators received the autopsy result, in which the medical opinion is that the cause of death is natural," the report quoting Thai deputy national police spokesman Kissana Phathanacharoen's statement, said. "Investigators will summarise the autopsy result for prosecutors within the timeframe of the law." Meanwhile, Warne's family have opened up on their "never-ending nightmare" since he passed away. "To find words to adequately express our sadness is an impossible task for us and looking to a future without Shane is inconceivable, hopefully the mountain of happy memories we all have will help us cope with our ongoing grief," the statement said. Warne took 708 wickets in 145 Tests, the second-most in the longest format after Sri Lanka's Muttiah Muralitharan. He retired from international cricket in 2007 after Australia made a clean sweep of the Ashes.

WARNE'S CHILDREN RELEASE HEART-BREAKING TRIBUTES AFTER LEGENDARY LEG-SPINNER'S DEATH

MELBOURNE, (IANS) Shane Warne's children, son Jackson and daughters Brooke and Summer, on Monday released heartbreaking tributes after the legendary leg-spinner died suddenly in Thailand on Friday. This is the first time that Warne's children have spoken since the 52-year-old died in a villa at the Koh Samui Island of a suspected heart attack. Jackson, who was seen in an Australian reality show 'SAS: Who Dares Wins' last year, spoke about the bond he had with his father. "To my brother, my best friend, to my Dad, I love you so much. I don't think anything is ever going to fill the void you have left in my heart. Sitting at the poker table, walking around the golf course, watching the Saints and eating pizza is never going to be the same. But I know all you ever wanted for me is to be happy, no

SHANE WARNE WAS MORE THAN JUST A LEG SPINNER: GREG CHAPPELL

SYDNEY, (IANS) Former Australia cricketer Greg Chappell believes Shane Warne's identity in the cricketing world was more than just being a great legspinner. He added that Warne's success on the field became a catalyst for many youngsters to become legspinners in cricket. A shocked cricketing world has been giving rich tributes to Warne, who suddenly died on Friday at Koh Samui Island in Thailand of a suspected heart attack, "Shane was more than just a leg spinner, He was an entertainer with enormous charisma who attracted attention wherever he went. His success gen-



erated millions of viewers to the game and brought the art of leg spin to life. "It also spawned a new generation of leg spinners who tried to walk up to the crease and let it rip! What they didn't have was Shane's brute strength and native cunning, so very few have reached great heights," wrote Chappell in his column for The Sydney Morning Herald on Monday.

Chappell, whose cricketing days for Australia were over before Warne entered the scene, described how the experience of seeing the legendary leg-spinner in action was like.

"Watching Warnie bowl was like watching an enactment of the Oberammergau Passion Play. Everything was finely tuned, elaborately planned and played out to a tried and tested script. Ian Healy and the close fielders were important characters, but for Warnie, it was as much about the theatrics as it was about the art of spin bowling." Chappell then explained how the body alignment played a crucial role in making Warne the impactful leg-spinner he was. "He was a conjurer as much as a spin bowler. In his early days, he spun the ball as hard as anyone had. Those who batted against him said the ball seemed to have a life of its own as it hummed towards them, dipped and then spun crazily from the pitch. His sturdy body and big, meaty hands were another important part of what made him the bowler he was.

HAVE BEEN IN COMPLETE SHOCK: CLARKE ON WARNE'S SUDDEN DEMISE

Former Australia captain Michael Clarke on Monday said he is still in complete shock over the demise of legendary leg-spinner and former teammate. Shane Warne. He added that he had spoken to Warne, who sounded and acted normal during Australia's T201 series against Sri Lanka. This is the first time Clarke has spoken since Warne's sudden demise in Thailand on Friday. "Extremely devastated and shocked, that's the one thing for me



still this morning. I haven't said much over the weekend because I've been in complete shock. The hardest thing to comprehend is how quickly it's happened. If Warnie had liver cancer and passed from that, I think everyone would've understood, the amount of cigarettes he smoked throughout his time," Clarke said on Big Sports Breakfast show on Sky Sports Radio. Clarke then revealed his final conversation with Warne when Australia were playing T20Is against Sri Lanka in February this year. "The way he's treated his body at certain times with diet and didn't mind a drink -- he wasn't massive drinker, the drinking around Warnie was more perception versus reality. I spoke to him two days ago before he got on the plane. Spoke to him when he was here (in Sydney) for the T20s against Sri Lanka and nothing had changed. He sounded the same, acted the same." Clarke went on to say that Warne's demise will take time to sink in, just like when his close friend Phil Hughes died in November 2014. "So to all of a sudden get a phone call at 1 a.m. to find out he'd had heart attack, just in complete shock. As it did with 'Hughesy' (Phil Hughes), it takes me time to comprehend -- I'll still be sitting here now waiting for a text to see what the plan was this week, was he coming to Sydney or would I be going to Melbourne. That will take time to sink in. For me at the moment it's about trying to remember and talk about all the good things." Clarke remembers Warne as a person who lived his life on the fast lane and sleep not being his strength. "He lived his life at such a fast pace that he nearly created this invincible feeling around him. He was always on the go. You'd be 'mate, you can't do that' or 'you need to sleep' or 'how do you do that'. Everything was 24/7, like so fast -- he started the car in fifth gear.




