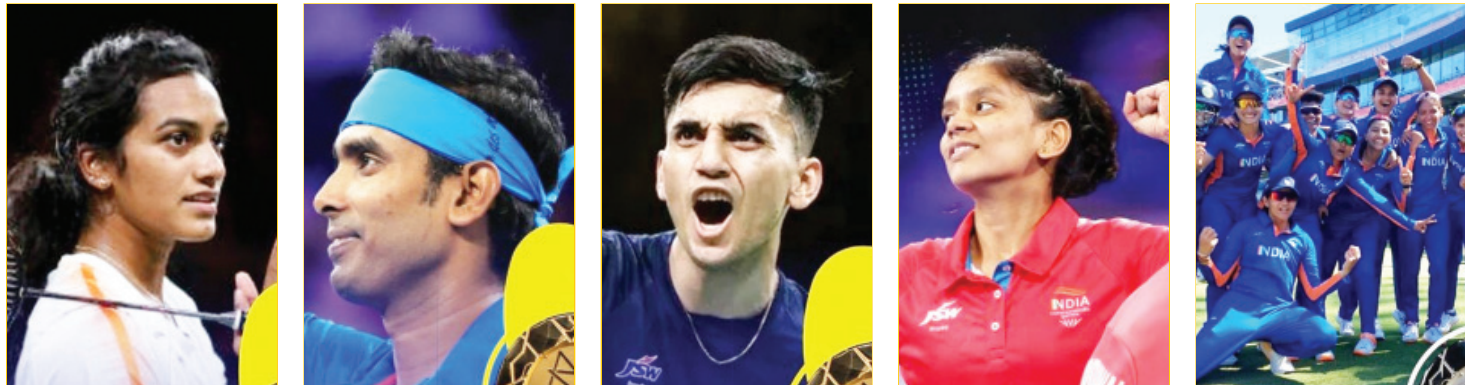

CANADA REVENUE AGENCY SAYS IT HAS \$1.4 BILLION IN UNCASHED CHEQUES SITTING IN ITS COFFERS

The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) has approximately \$1.4 billion in cheques that have gone uncashed over the years. As of May 2022, there were an estimated 8.9 million uncashed cheques with the CRA and we want to make sure this money ends up where it belongs. In taxpayers' pockets! Each year, the (CRA) issues millions of payments in the form of refunds and benefits. These payments are issued by either direct deposit or by cheque. Over time, payments can remain uncashed for various reasons, such as the taxpayer misplacing the cheque or even a change of address which did not allow for delivery. The CRA will be notifying some recipients of the Canada child benefit and related Provincial/Territorial programs, GST/HST Credit and Alberta Energy Tax Refund (AETR) recipients of any uncashed cheques they may have by email notification. Approximately 25,000 e-notifications will be issued in August and another 25,000 in November 2022, followed by the next 25,000 in May 2023. Since the CRA launched this initiative in February 2020, approximately two million uncashed cheques valued at \$802 million were redeemed by Canadians between February 10, 2020, and May 31, 2022. In 2020, the CRA introduced a feature where taxpayers can view their uncashed cheques and collect unclaimed benefit and credit payments that belong to them.

INDIA-PAKISTAN 'BACKCHANNEL' TALKS HIT A DEAD END: REPORT

Backchannel talks between Pakistan and India have met a dead end as both sides have struggled to agree on the moves that may pave the way for slow but gradual improvement in the relationship, a media report said citing an informed source. "Talks have been going on but have reached a point where things aren't moving anywhere," The Express Tribune report quoted the source as saying. There has been a desire from both sides to break the impasse but the issue is how to move forward from this point onwards, the source explained. What has slowed down the process was the political uncertainty in Pakistan, The Express Tribune reported. There was a glimmer of hope for a possible thaw in the relationship following the change of government in Pakistan in April. What spurred the optimism was that Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi was one of the first leaders to congratulate his Pakistani counterpart Shehbaz Sharif when the latter assumed office in April. The source said backchannel contacts that began during the PTI government's tenure picked up pace in April after the change of government. But despite "intense" backchannel diplomacy, the two sides were not willing to concede an inch on their respective issues. Pakistan is keen that India must take steps with regards to Kashmir before any process of normalisation of ties begins. New Delhi, however, is more interested in Islamabad first exploring the option of resuming bilateral trade, The Express Tribune quoted the source as saying further. The friction in the relationship prevented Pakistani and Indian foreign ministers from interacting with each other at the recent meeting of Shanghai Cooperation Organization in Tashkent.

CANADA LOST 31,000 JOBS IN JULY, & UNEMPLOYMENT RATE UNCHANGED AT 4.9%: STATSCAN

Employment was little changed on a monthly basis in July (-31,000). Compared with May, employment was down 74,000 (-0.4%). The number of public sector employees fell by 51,000 (-1.2%) in July, while the number of self-employed workers increased by 34,000 (+1.3%). The number of private sector employees was little changed.

10 OF PUNJAB GANG, ASSOCIATED WITH LAWRENCE BISHNOI, HELD

Punjab Police has arrested 10 gangsters of the Pindri gang associated with Lawrence Bishnoi gang and recovered seven weapons and ammunition from them, an official said on Monday.

Deputy Inspector General, Anti-Gangster Task Force Gurpreet Singh Bhullar said the team acted on a tip off to locate the kingpin Parminder Singh, alias Pindri, who was handling the operation of Bishnoi gang in the Nangal-Ropar belt. He said 22 first information reports (FIRs), including an attempt to murder, have been registered against the gangster. Parminder Singh is an active member of the Bishnoi gang

and had been hiding in Himachal Pradesh and was operating from there only, Bhullar said. He said he was involved in drug smuggling too. Senior Superintendent of Police Sandeep Garg said seven weapons, including two .32 bore country-made pistols, besides 51 cartridges and one magazine have been recovered from them. They all were hardcore criminals. A total of 22 FIRs have been registered against Pindri, two against Baljinder, one each against Gurpreet, Jaspreet and Gurdeep, seven against Iqbal Mohammed, four against Surinder and 24 against Dara, he added.

HOW AKHILESH AND PRIYANKA ARE TWINNING IN UP POLITICS

In politics, horoscopes are not matched necessarily but circumstances often bring out similarities between politicians even though they may not tread the same path.

Samajwadi Party (SP) president Akhilesh Yadav and Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, general secretary in charge of Congress in Uttar Pradesh, have developed a style of working that is strikingly similar and so is the outcome. "They are almost twinning when it comes to politics. Both had a sea of opportunities before them but they seem to destroying the legacy they inherited. Their parties are nose diving ever since they took," said R.K. Singh, a senior political analyst.

The most common complaint against Akhilesh and Priyanka is their inaccessibility to party workers.

Akhilesh, for reasons best known to him, keep the gates of his home and office firmly shut for party workers and meets only those who are members of his coterie.

A senior SP MLA says: "It is much more difficult to meet Akhilesh Yadav than it is to meet Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath. Even during the Assembly elections, I left several messages with his office but was not given time. This kind of behaviour of a political leader, one is leader a political party, is detrimental to party interests and also a major reason for discontent."

Party leaders also blame Akhilesh's coterie of being arrogant. Recently, Abdullah Azam, son of SP leader Mohd Azam Khan, expressed his displeasure over the comments made by a party spokesman Udaiveer Singh, known for his proximity to Akhilesh.

"I have noticed a statement by a spokesperson of the SP. These are the people responsible for SP's ruin. I request them to comment only as per their level, and not attempt to bring in Azam Khan saheb... or else many things would worsen," he said in a tweet. If Akhilesh's 'coterie' is in the line of fire in SP, it is Priyanka's 'team' that has led to widespread resentment in the state Congress.

Priyanka's personal secretary Sandeep Singh and others are known for their arrogance and misbehaviour with party workers. Their audio clips where conversations are interspersed with abusive language are made viral of the party's WhatsApp groups with an alarming frequency. "This team serves as a barrier between Priyanka and party workers. No one can meet Priyanka without the sanction of her team



and, therefore, she is completely inaccessible for party workers now. Even in Delhi, she meets only those who have permission from Sandeep Singh. She has not visited UP in recent months," said a former Congress MLA.

Another factor that is common between Akhilesh and Priyanka is their disdain for senior leaders in the party.

Both have completely sidelined veterans and are pinning their hopes on younger leaders who are not even familiar with the party ideology. In the SP, veterans who belong to the Mulayam Singh era are nowhere to be seen. Leaders like Ambica Chaudhary, Om Prakash Singh, Narad Rai are biding their time in the wings.

In the Uttar Pradesh Congress, former UPCC presidents like Nirmal Khatri, Shri Prakash Jaiswal, Arun Kumar Singh Munna, Raj Babbar have been pushed into oblivion and the remaining have been expelled from the party.

As a result, the two parties are rapidly losing ground by the day.

Under Akhilesh's leadership, the SP has lost the 2017 Assembly, 2019 Lok Sabha and 2022 Assembly elections. The Congress has already hit rock bottom ever since Priyanka took over the reins in 2019. What worries party workers is the fact that the two leaders refuse to see the writing on the wall.

They continue to wage political battles on social media and have disconnected themselves from ground realities.

'SECOND SPLIT': WHY NITISH, BJP NOT ON SAME PAGE ANYMORE?

Nitish Kumar, the powerful JD-U leader, on Tuesday once again parted ways with the BJP-led NDA and resigned as the Chief Minister, joining hands with the Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) -- throwing a stunner that not only created a stir in Bihar, but also in the country's political arena.

However, this is not the first time Nitish Kumar chose to board the RJD boat by dumping the NDA ship. In a dramatic turn of events in 2015, he had decided to walk along with Lalu Prasad's RJD. But the JD-U veteran, in a surprise move in 2017, walked out the of alliance with RJD, and again forged a partnership with the NDA. The developments of Tuesday have made many question Nitish Kumar's intent, as to whether he had pre-planned this move after taking oath as the Chief Minister of Bihar for the seventh time in November 2020.

Many have also been left wondering what could have prompted Nitish Kumar to ally with the RJD -- the party which does not enjoy a decent reputation in several areas, the most prominent being law and order. In fact, Nitish Kumar's brand of politics was majorly being driven on the plank of his crusade against RJD's 'Jungle Raj'. According to political analysts, Nitish Kumar had gotten the drift that he would not be able to run the administration on his terms and conditions, and enjoy a free-hand the moment Sushil Kumar Modi -- considered a trusted lieutenant of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) -- was shown the door and two others -- Tarkishore Prasad and Renu Devi -- were made Deputy Chief Ministers. Nitish Kumar, apparently, was also not pleased with the BJP over certain issues, including appointing ministers from its quota. When the Cabinet was expanded in July 2021, despite Nitish Kumar's repeated requests, only one JD-U leader -- R.C.P. Singh -- was appointed as minister. According to sources, the development made Nitish Kumar upset, and since then the relation between him and Singh -- who recently resigned from the JD-U -- went downslide.

Sources said Nitish Kumar feels that the BJP, by making R.C.P. Singh a minister, not only took away his trusted aide from him, but also tried to deduce his importance. Upset over this, he did not nominate Singh to Rajya Sabha a year later (in 2022). Also, JD-U accused Singh of being involved in corruption, which compelled the former Union minister to resign from the party.

The heated argument that took place in Bihar Assembly in March this year between Nitish Kumar and Speaker Vijay Sinha (appointed from BJP quota) had also raised some points of concern. In fact, Nitish Kumar also accused Sinha of violating Constitutional norms. The soft buzz in the JD-U hinted towards "BJP's repeated attempts to humiliate Nitish Kumar". In fact, since that episode, Nitish Kumar began maintaining a distance from 'Delhi'.

The JD-U has claimed that the BJP tried to create cracks among the party legislators with the help of R.C.P. Singh.

Nitish Kumar, having witnessed the JyotiradityaScindia episode in Madhya Pradesh and the Eknath Shinde saga in Maharashtra, got alarmed about the "possibilities of a sabotage by the BJP", sources said.

Meanwhile, it also needs to be underlined that the BJP never tried to hurt Nitish Kumar's prospects. Despite the exchange of words between JD-U and BJP leaders that remained confined just within Bihar, the senior leaders of the saffron party, including its President J.P. Nadda and Home Minister Amit Shah, have maintained that Nitish Kumar is the leader of NDA, and they would contest the 2024 Lok Sabha polls and 2025 Assembly elections together.

The alliance, however, witnessed an abrupt end on Tuesday.



WHY BEIJING MUST LINK ONE-CHINA POLICY WITH ONE-INDIA POLICY

China's ambassador to India in a newspaper interview expresses the hope that India will support the One China policy, calling such support the foundation of China's relations with all countries, including India.

It is extraordinary he should say this after China has violated all previous border agreements, attempted unilaterally to alter the Line of Actual Control (LAC), massed thousands of troops on our border, continues to build military infrastructure to threaten our security and continues to claim large parts of our territory. That he should not be conscious of the absurdity of his position demonstrates China's sense of entitlement as it grows stronger economically and militarily that it expects others to accept China's positions without it accepting any reciprocal commitments. What is even more absurd is that he calls such support as the foundation of China's relations with India. This is new, because since 1954 it was the principles enshrined in the Panchsheel agreement that governed India-China relations. The 1993, 1996 and later border agreements till 2013 added new foundational stones. After China's aggression on the border in 2020, India has laid down new parameters of India-China ties: Full adherence to agreements reached: any attempt to unilaterally alter the LAC is unacceptable: peace and tranquility in border areas is the basis of development of bilateral relations; Chinese acceptance of the notion of a multipolar Asia as the foundation of a multipolar world; India cannot be sensitive to China's concerns on Tibet and Taiwan without China recognising India's sensitivities about Kashmir; an India-China composite dialogue based on three mutuals- mutual respect, mutual sensitivity and mutual interests; and, civilizational states like India and China must always take a long view.

That the Chinese ambassador should make short shrift of all this and state that India's support for One China policy without reciprocal support for One India policy is precisely what Minister Jaishankar highlighted in 2020 as the objectionable elements of Chinese diplomacy when he referred to the Chinese habit of selectivity-selective interpretation of agreements, interpretation of selective clauses of agreements, and picking up selective portions of the history of bilateral agreements.

The Chinese ambassador's formulation carries a veiled threat that the 'foundation' of China-India ties will be shaken if India did not conform to a One China policy. It is an attempt to create a new pressure point, discouraging India from taking any steps to strengthen ties with Taiwan.

So far India has remained silent on the tensions arising from US House of Representatives Speaker Nancy Pelosi's visit to Taiwan. If India, conscious of our traditionally close strategic with Russia, could, in a constructive spirit and knowing the stakes involved for the rest of the world, call for an immediate ceasefire and recourse to diplomacy in the case of the Ukraine conflict, and state that neither side will emerge victorious from it, the reasons for our circumspection in the case of the conflict building up in Taiwan are not clear.

Unlike Russia, China is an adversary, its aggressiveness and intimidating tactics against Taiwan are mirrored in its belligerence towards India. Calling for restraint, cautioning against military escalation, advising recourse to diplomacy to resolve issues peacefully and expressing concern about interference in navigation through international waters can be rightly said by us, given our own stakes in curbing China's military adventurism and increasing threats, both lands based and maritime, to our own security. Such a norm based non-accusatory statement should not interfere in our efforts to resolve issues on the LAC that have arisen with China's border intrusions. China has a record of making statements on India-Pakistan issues. As is happens, the Chinese ambassador has put us at a disadvantage by cautioning us in advance against India making any statement on Taiwan that displeases China. China has described Nancy Pelosi's visit as reckless, irresponsible and extremely irrational. All these adjectives could apply more appropriately to China's response. Pelosi's visit was political in nature, to express US solidarity with Taiwan in the face of Chinese threats.

Taiwan is no position to threaten China militarily, much less invade it. Her visit did not pose any military threat to China whose response has been unabashedly military in nature. China has conducted military exercises encircling Taiwan, launched missiles, put in action fighter aircraft and drones and crossed the median line with the intention to intimidate Taiwan and signal to the US its capacity and readiness to achieve reunification by force if required. China's claim that Pelosi's visit violates its sovereignty and territorial integrity has no political or legal basis. China may have sovereign claims over Taiwan, as it has over features in the South China and East China Seas, as well as over land belonging to India and Bhutan. But that does not make these claims legitimate. Invoking territorial integrity assumes that Taiwan is an integral part of China.

If that were the case, Taiwan would not have an international personality, issue its own passports, be a WTO member, have FTAs with a handful of countries as well as diplomatic relations. Setting up trade offices in Taiwan, as India has done, does not require Beijing's approval. There is a need to challenge the Chinese narrative.

China's ambassador to the US loftily claims that Taiwan has been an inseparable part of China's territory for 1,800 years. In 1895 Taiwan was ceded to Japan by the Chinese emperor. The Allies restored it to the Republic of China (RoC) in 1945, not the People's Republic of China (PRC), whose legitimacy was questioned until Cold War calculations of profiting from the Sino-Soviet rift and the end of any prospect of 'recovery of the mainland' by the Kuomintang regime in Taiwan coupled with the consolidation of the communist regime in mainland China under Mao, led to the replacement of RoC by the PRC as the only legitimist representative of China to the UN in 1971.

It needs remembering that it was not a unanimous resolution. Only 76 countries voted for, 35 voted against and 17 abstained. If so, many voted against or abstained, it is clear that while the issue of China's representation in the UN was decided, the issue of sovereignty over Taiwan was not. It was left to the two contending Chinas to resolve it in time. That in 1979 when US and China established diplomatic ties the US recognised the PRC as the sole legal government of China merely confirmed what had already been recognised by the UNGA in 1971, nothing more.



ONTARIO TRAINING MORE WORKERS FOR IN DEMAND CAREERS IN AUTO MANUFACTURING

The Ontario government is working for workers by investing \$5 million to provide free training to 500 people from underrepresented groups to prepare them for well-paying jobs in the province's thriving automotive manufacturing sector. The project will provide participants with the necessary skills for rewarding careers in machine operation, assembly, quality control, and logistics. The program will also help address a critical shortage of workers in a vital industry as Ontario positions itself as a North American leader in auto manufacturing. "Our government is securing game-changing investments in the province's auto sector that will ensure the electric vehicles and batteries of the future are made here in Ontario by Ontario workers," said Premier Doug Ford. "As we do, we're investing in training the next generation of Ontario's automotive workers and connecting hundreds of them with good-paying jobs at local businesses in immediate need of their world class talent and expertise." Led by the Automotive Parts Manufacturers Association (APMA), training includes three-month paid job placements through APMA's network of more than 300 small and medium-sized businesses. After completing the program, each participant will receive a job offer from a local employer. "Our auto workers are heroes, and we need more of them to deliver our ambitious plan to build Ontario," said Monte McNaughton, Minister of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development. "This investment will help local manufacturers find the skilled workers they need to grow our economy and connect job seekers with meaningful careers where they can proudly earn bigger paycheques for themselves and their families." The program features a combination of online and on-the-job training, where participants learn critical skills, such as manufacturing essentials, project management, and troubleshooting. Training is tailored to the needs of each participant and employers can receive up to \$4,600 in wage subsidies for each trainee. "The exciting future of the automotive sector in Ontario will benefit from welcoming new faces, voices and perspectives," said APMA president Flavio Volpe. "This investment creates a sustainable platform for communities that



haven't historically participated in the sector to become integral to its success." This project is funded by Ontario's Skills Development Fund, a more than \$200 million initiative that supports innovative programs that connect job seekers with the skills and training they need to find well-paying careers close to home.

ONTARIO'S 2022-23 BUDGET PROJECTS DEFICIT OF \$18.8 BILLION

As part of its commitment to implement the 2022 Budget and build a stronger Ontario for workers, businesses and families, the Ontario government today re-introduced the Plan to Build Act (Budget Measures), 2022. "I am pleased to re-introduce the Plan to Build Act (Budget Measures), 2022 bill today so our government can continue delivering Ontario's Plan to Build, supporting better jobs for workers while building more highways, housing and hospitals right across the province," said Peter Bethlenfalvy, Minister of Finance. "With costs rising, our plan also includes measures to help families, including new direct payments to parents to help their kids catch up and increasing Ontario Disability Support Program payments." To help those who qualify for disability support, the government is delivering on its commitment to increase the rates for income support by five per cent beginning in September 2022, for families and persons under the Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP). Beginning in September, the government will increase both the ODSP rate and the Assistance for Children with Severe Disabilities Program maximum monthly amount by five per cent. Future ODSP rates will also be adjusted to inflation. To help fill gaps in learning for students after two years of pandemic disruptions, the government is also investing \$225 million for direct payments to parents. This is in addition to the previously announced \$175 million tutoring support program, the largest of its kind in Ontario's

history. The government will have more details later in the year on how families can access this new support. "No government in Ontario history has invested more in public education, tutoring supports, and student mental health than our government," said Stephen Lecce, Minister of Education. "We are going further by providing direct financial support to parents, in addition to the expanded tutoring supports for students, all focused on ensuring kids get back to class with the full school experience." The additional investment in tutoring supports and increased ODSP rate will be funded from existing contingencies contained in the government's fiscal plan as presented in the 2022 Budget. Building on the Province's record of transparency and accountability, the government also released the 2022-23 First Quarter Finances today, which provides updated information about the evolution of Ontario's economic and fiscal outlook since the 2022 Budget for the 2022-23 fiscal year. Due to higher-than-projected taxation revenues, the government is projecting a deficit of \$18.8 billion in 2022-23, an improvement of \$1.1 billion from the outlook presented in the 2022 Budget. "We have a prudent and flexible plan which builds on our record of responsible fiscal management, while making the investments that will reduce commute times, support front-line health care and help create good jobs," said Minister Bethlenfalvy. "In a time of economic uncertainty, our government is supporting Ontario workers and families by putting more money back into their pockets."

FBI SEARCHES TRUMP'S FLORIDA HOME

Former US President Donald Trump has said that his home in Florida has been "raided" by the FBI. "My beautiful home, Mar-A-Lago in Palm Beach, Florida, is currently under siege, raided, and occupied by a large group of FBI agents," Trump added on Monday in a statement released through his political action committee -- 'Save America'. The former President was not present at his home at the time of raids. However, neither the FBI nor the US Justice Department have made any comments on the raids at Trump's house. The search -- as approved by the judge and different from the politically loaded term "raid" -- was unprecedented and this was the first time a former US President's home was searched by the FBI, not even former President Richard Nixon, who left the President's office in disgrace over the Watergate scandal. US legal experts said that a search of this kind has to be cleared by a federal judge on two essential grounds. One, there is probable cause that a federal crime has been committed and is being investigated and that, two, related evidence is stored at the site of the search. The raid is likely in connection to Trump's mishandling of official records from his Presidential term. He is reported to have not only carried away 15 boxes of official documents that he should have left for official records keeping but also for destroying documents, which he did, including by flushing them in the toilet. Trump's efforts to overturn the outcome of the 2020 Presidential election, which he lost to President Joe Biden have also been under scrutiny, and at multiple levels. A Congressional Select Committee is looking at them as part of an investigation of the January 6 riots at the US Capitol by large number of people incited by Trump to prevent a joint session from certifying Biden's victory. The FBI has also searched the premises of a former Justice Department official, who participated in and aided Trump's efforts, and has additionally seized the phone of a right-wing lawyer, who is widely believed to have encouraged the former President to challenge the outcome by providing him purportedly constitutional cover.

PUNJAB CM BATS FOR MSP AS LEGAL GUARANTEE

Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Sunday espoused the case of food growers by underlining the need for making minimum support price (MSP) a legal guarantee and ensuring foolproof marketing system for alternative crops. The Chief Minister, while addressing the national Council



meeting of NITIO Aayog chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi here, recalled that at the time when country was starving for food, the hard-working and resilient farmers of the state had made country self-reliant in food production. However, he said as agriculture is no longer a profitable venture so the farmers are facing a serious crisis. "All-out efforts must be made to bail out the farmers from this situation for which the Union government must step in." The Chief Minister underscored the need for making MSP on the crops a legal guarantee. He said it is the need of hour so that interests of farmers can be safeguarded. Likewise, Mann said the MSP must be remunerative as the input cost of agriculture have enhanced manifolds and farmers are not getting right price of their harvest. Outrightly rejecting the committee on MSP constituted by the Centre, he demanded that it should be reconstituted with "real farmers" as its members. He said the committee is dominated by those armchair economists who don't have any knowledge about agriculture, and experts of agriculture, along with all stakeholders, must be made members of this committee. Expressing concern over the import of pulses in country on exorbitant prices, the Chief Minister said this drain of country's wealth needs to be checked and Punjab can play an important role in it. He said the farmers of the state are ready to make country self-relevant in production of pulses. The Union government must announce MSP for pulses and assured marketing system for it. Likewise, the Chief Minister said that diversification of crops is urgently needed to take farmers out of rut of the wheat-paddy cycle on one hand and to save the depleting groundwater level on the other. The Chief Minister also apprised the Niti Aayog that the state government is making efforts to revamp the education structure in state.

69% JOBS IN INDIA UNDER THREAT BY AUTOMATION IN 20 YEARS

Nearly 69 per cent of jobs in India are under threat from automation, as the country, with its relatively young workforce, is set to add 160 million new workers over the next 20 years, a new report showed on Monday. The main priority for the country, set to reach a working population of 1.1 billion by 2040, will be job creation to accommodate new workers entering the workforce, according to Forrester's Future Of Jobs Forecast. "India's workforce is young, with an average age of 38, and its working population will grow by 160 million over the next 20 years," said Michael O'Grady, principal forecast analyst at Forrester. In addition, India's labour force participation rate, which measures the share of the working-age population currently working, has dropped to just 41 per cent, he added. The working populations in the five largest economies in Asia Pacific -- India, China, South Korea, Australia, and Japan -- are more at risk due to physical robot automation than Europe and North America. By 2040, 63 million jobs are expected to be lost to automation, with more than 247 million jobs expected to be in jeopardy across industries that are more susceptible to automation, such as construction and agriculture, the report noted. "To prepare for the changes brought on by automation, the five largest economies in APAC will have to radically rethink their workforce strategies," said O'Grady. "While each economy faces its own challenges, common focus areas such as hiring more female workers can help offset working population declines. In addition, investing in STEM education, technology workforce training, and protecting the rights of freelance workers will become of utmost importance," he noted. India, China, South Korea, Australia, and Japan will create 28.5 million new jobs in renewable energy, green buildings, smart cities and smart infrastructure, and professional services by 2040. But even with the creation of new jobs in areas such as the green economy and information and communications technology (ICT) industries, 13.7 million jobs in the region will be lost to automation across wholesale, retail, transport, accommodation, and leisure sectors.

WHY TEJAS FIGHTER AIRCRAFT ARE IN DEMAND?

The government had informed the Lok Sabha on Friday that Malaysia is procuring 18 Tejas fighter jets while the US, Argentina, Australia, Egypt, Indonesia and Philippines too have shown interest to procure the light combat aircraft (LCA). Last year, the Indian government had awarded a Rs 48,000 crore contract to state-owned Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) for manufacturing 83 Tejas jets to be delivered by 2023. The indigenous Tejas fighter jet was in the news recently after becoming Malaysia's first choice. This Indian aircraft competed with the developed aircraft of China, Russia and South Korea, and due to its features, it overshadowed all the aircraft. Defence expert Qamar Agha said that if compared to Sukhoi, Tejas is much lighter. "Tejas is fully capable of carrying a load of eight to nine tonnes. It can fly with as many weapons and missiles as Sukhoi, which weighs more. Its biggest advantage is its speed. Despite being light, its speed is unmatched. These aircraft can fly as fast as the speed of sound, i.e., Mach 1.6 to 1.8, up at an altitude of 52,000 feet," he said. Agha added: "The Tejas Mark-1A is also costlier than the Sukhoi-30MKI fighter aircraft because many latest equipment have been added to it. For example, it has radar developed in Israel. Apart from this, the aircraft also has an indigenously developed radar. It is very light and its fighter power is also better. It is a multifunctional fighter aircraft." Tejas is fitted with an active electronically-scanned radar for critical operation capability. It can refuel in the air and be ready for war again. It can target enemy aircraft from a distance. Not only this, it also has the ability to dodge the enemy's radar. "At a time when there is a shortage of fighter jets in the Indian Air Force fleet, Tejas should be welcomed," the defence expert said. Tejas made its first flight in January 2001. The aircraft was inducted into the squadron of the Indian Air Force in 2016.



DEFENCE MINISTER ANITA ANAND ANNOUNCES DEPLOYMENT OF CANADIAN ARMED FORCES TO TRAIN UKRAINIAN SOLDIERS IN UK

The Minister of National Defence, the Honourable Anita Anand, announced today that Canada has authorized the deployment of Canadian Armed Forces personnel to train new recruits from the Armed Forces of Ukraine, as they seek to increase the size of their ground forces in the face of Russia’s ongoing unprovoked, unjustifiable, and illegal invasion. Under Operation UNIFIER, Canada’s military training and capacity building mission in Ukraine, the CAF will deploy up to 225 personnel to the United Kingdom, the majority of whom will work as trainers, supported by a command and control element, for an initial deployment of approximately four months. The first of up to three training cohorts, consisting of approximately 90 soldiers, will be largely drawn from 3rd Battalion Princess Patricia’s Canadian Light Infantry based out of Edmonton, Alberta. They are scheduled to depart on 12 August and will begin leading courses in the weeks’ following.

The first Canadian-led courses will take place at a military base located in South East England, and will teach a flexible curriculum focused on individual skills required for frontline combat, including weapons handling, battlefield first aid, fieldcraft, patrol tactics and the Law of Armed Conflict Operation UNIFIER was launched in 2015 at the request of the Ukrainian government, and early this year, was expanded and extended until March 2025. Aspects of the mission were temporarily paused following the February 2022 full-scale invasion of Ukraine, with a commitment to resume training when and where conditions permitted. Since February 2022, Canada has committed or delivered \$626 million in military assistance to Ukraine, including M777 howitzer artillery guns with replacement barrels and compatible ammunition, as well as specialized drone cameras and Armoured Combat Support Vehicles, and associated training.

CANADA LOST 31,000 JOBS IN JULY, & UNEMPLOYMENT RATE UNCHANGED AT 4.9%: STATSCAN

Employment fell among women aged 55 and older (-33,000; -1.7%) and women aged 25 to 54 (-31,000; -0.5%) in July. For men aged 55 and older, employment rose by 32,000 (+1.4%). It was little changed among youth aged 15 to 24 and men aged 25 to 54. In the services-producing sector, employment fell by 53,000 (-0.3%) in July, with losses spread across several industries, including wholesale and retail trade, health care and social assistance, and educational services. Employment rose in the goods-producing sector (+23,000; +0.6%) in July. Total hours worked were down 0.5% in July.

The average hourly wages of employees were up 5.2% (+\$1.55 to \$31.14) on a year-over-year basis in July, matching the pace of wage growth recorded in June.
Unemployment rate remains at record low
The unemployment rate held steady at 4.9% in July, matching the historic low reached in June. The adjusted unemployment rate—which includes people who were not in the labour force but wanted to work—remained at 6.8% in July, also matching its record low. Long-term unemployment dropped 23,000 (-12.2%) to 162,000 in July, the third consecutive monthly decline.

CANADA DEFENDS DECISION TO RETURN RUSSIAN GAS TURBINE

The Canadian government has defended its decision to return a turbine critical to restoring regular gas flows from Russia to Germany that had been held up in the country due to Western sanctions on Moscow.
Foreign Minister Melanie Joly and Natural Resources Minister Jonathan Wilkinson told a parliamentary committee that Ottawa had decided to return the turbine, which had come to Canada for repairs, to maintain cohesion with its German and European allies, reports dpa news agency.
“I cannot overemphasise the depth of concern on the part of the Germans associated with them effectively not being able to access natural gas,” Wilkinson said, adding that refusing to export the turbine was “not viable” given Germany’s dependence on Russian gas.
The turbine has been at the centre of a weeks-long saga over dwindling natural gas flows, in what top German and EU officials say is a politically motivated move by Moscow aimed at sparking an energy crisis in Europe.
Moscow claims that Gazprom was forced to drastically reduce gas deliveries to Germany due to the absent turbine, while German officials have repeatedly maintained that the move was an attempt by Russia to punish Germany for its stance on the war in Ukraine and for imposing sanctions on Russia. The turbine has now been sent to Germany, where it is being stored temporarily before being transported to Russia for installation. Siemens Energy, the company responsible for repairing the turbine, said on Tuesday that the component was ready for transport to Russia, though Gazprom said it was still waiting for documentation necessary for the turbine’s reinstallation, a claim that Siemens denies.

In October 2006, Panghali reported his wife Manjit Panghali was missing. Later, Police discovered her badly burned body five days later. Further investigation unveiled that Panghali had strangled his four months pregnant wife in their home and then took her body to neighbouring Delta, B.C., to try to cover up the crime. In 2007, he was arrested and charged with second-degree murder. He was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole for 15 years in 2011.

MOTORCYCLIST'S IDENTITY SOUGHT IN NUMEROUS ROBBERIES ACROSS PEEL, GTA

Region of Peel: Investigators from the Central Robbery Bureau are working with the Ontario Provincial Police, Toronto Police Service and York Regional Police Service to identify a man committing robberies across Peel Region and the Greater Toronto Area (GTA). The suspect fled the crime scenes on a white motorcycle. From Wednesday, July 13, 2022, until Friday, August 5, 2022, the suspect has committed 12 robberies in Peel Region and several others across the GTA. The suspect generally targets gas stations and fast food establishments between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. throughout the week. The suspect brandishes a firearm when robbing these businesses, demanding money. The suspect is described as male, 5'7" - 5'9", with a thin build. His clothing descriptions vary; however, he wears a black motorcycle helmet with green accents, black gloves with white or green accents and sunglasses. The motorcycle he uses is a 2012-2017 white Kawasaki Ninja 300 with green writing and aftermarket exhaust. PM MODI ASKS STATES TO PROMOTE '3TS' AROUND THE WORLD

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, chairing the meet of the NITI Aayog Governing Council on Sunday, called on each state to focus on promoting its "3Ts" (trade, tourism, technology) through every Indian Mission around the world. He said the states must focus on reducing imports, increasing exports and identifying opportunities for the latter. "We should encourage people to use local goods wherever possible," he said. 'Vocal for local' is not the agenda of an individual political party but a common goal, he added. The PM said even though GST collection has improved, the potential is much more. "Increasing GST collection requires collective action by the Centre and States. It is crucial for strengthening our economic

position and becoming a \$5 trillion economy," he said. On the National Education Policy, the PM said it has been formulated after considerable deliberations, and we should involve all stakeholders in its implementation and develop a clear, timebound roadmap for it. Expressing his gratitude to the CMs and LGs for participating in the meeting and sharing their views and experiences, he said that NITI Aayog will study the states' concerns, challenges, and best practices and subsequently plan the way forward. The issues discussed in this meeting will define the national priorities for the next 25 years, he said, adding that "the seeds we sow today will define the fruits reaped by India in 2047".

10 DAYS LEFT IN OFFICE FOR CJI RAMANA, FIVE IMPORTANT CASES AWAIT DECISION

With just 10 days left in office, Chief Justice N.V. Ramana's decision is awaited on five key matters -- Maharashtra political scenario, report by Pegasus panel, PMs security lapse in Punjab, attempt by Maharashtra Wakf Board to replace Attorney General K.K. Venugopal as the counsel in the case, setting up of a bench to hear petitions against the Karnataka High Court judgment banning wearing of hijab in pre-university colleges in the state -- and others, which include petitions challenging Citizenship (Amendment) Act, and listing of petitions challenging the abrogation of Article 370, which provided a special status to the erstwhile state of Jammu and Kashmir. Justice Ramana has been vocal about non-filling up of judicial vacancies and not improving the judicial infrastructure as the main reason for pendency of cases in the country. He has also emphasised access to justice for the people from the weaker sections of the society. Ramana has minced no words in criticising the government while speaking at public fora and also tried to decide matters of constitutional salience -- on May 11, a bench headed by him put on hold the colonial-era penal provision of sedition, saying the court is cognizant of the integrity of the state on one hand, and the civil liberties of citizens on the other. The Chief Justice is scheduled to retire on August 26. Last week, the Chief Justice shot a volley of questions at senior advocate Harish Salve, representing Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, while hearing petitions filed by the Shiv Sena and its rebel MLAs on constitutional issues of split, merger, defection, and disqualification. On August 4, a three-judge bench headed by him had said that the court would decide on August 8 whether to refer some issues involved in the Maharashtra political crisis to a five-judge constitution bench. The apex court had also asked the Election Commission of India not to decide the application filed by the Shinde camp for recognising them as the 'real Shiv Sena' and allotment of the party symbol. The matter is likely to come up for hearing soon. Reportedly, the court-constituted Pegasus panel has submitted its report in the alleged misuse of the Pegasus spyware to spy on journalists, politicians and activists. The committee is headed by former Supreme Court judge R.V. Raveendran. The contents of the report remain confidential. The top court decision on the panel's report is awaited. On August 3, the Supreme Court had agreed to set up a bench to consider a clutch of pleas against the Karnataka High Court judgment, which upheld the right of educational

institutions to ban wearing of hijab in pre-university colleges in the state. While mentioning the matter for listing, a counsel urged the top court to fix a date in the matter, as petitions against the high court judgment were filed in March. In January this year, the top court had said that an enquiry committee, headed by retired Supreme Court judge Justice Indu Malhotra, will investigate Prime Minister Narendra Modi's security breach in Punjab. A bench headed by justice Ramana, outlining the terms of reference for the enquiry committee, said, "What were the causes for the security breach for the incident on 5th January 2022? Who is responsible for such a breach, and to what extent? What should be the remedial measures or safeguards necessary for the security of the Prime Minister or other protectees?" The top court order came on a petition by the NGO, Lawyer's Voice, which was represented by senior advocate Maninder Singh. The petitioner had emphasised on the importance of protection to the PM of the country and urged the court to constitute an independent committee to probe the matter. The matter has not come up for hearing so far, since then. On August 2, a bench headed by Ramana expressed discontent with the Maharashtra Wakf Board for attempting to replace Attorney General (AG) K.K. Venugopal as a counsel in the case, in the middle of hearing on an important question - whether all land donated by Muslims for charitable work would come under Wakf. The AG had also written to the Supreme Court to take strong exception to the action taken by the Wakf Board. "All this interference with the counsel who are to represent the parties being removed at the last minute is a serious, uncalled for, and unwarranted attempt to interfere in the due administration of justice by removing counsel representing the parties. This clearly is an act of contempt of court," the AG said in his letter to the registrar (judicial). The top court is likely to take up this matter soon. In April this year, the Supreme Court said a reconstituted five-judge constitution bench would deal with the batch of petitions challenging the abrogation of Article 370, as one of the judges on the bench, Justice R. Subhash Reddy, had since retired. A bench headed by Chief Justice. Ramana indicated that the reconstituted bench might hear the matter after the summer vacation. However, the matter has not been listed so far. In December 2019, the top court had issued notice on petitions challenging the validity of the Citizenship (Amendment) Act. In December 2019, the top court had declined to give interim relief in the matter. The matter has been pending for two years now.

MRINAL OF PUNJAB BAGS ALL-INDIA FIFTH RANK IN JEE MAINS

Mrinal Garg (17) from Bathinda in Punjab has brought laurels to the state by bagging all-India fifth rank in JEE Mains Session II entrance exam, the results of which were declared on Monday, securing 300/300. The first six candidates have scored 300/300, but as per the age criteria, Garg was given the fifth rank. Garg has not only topped in Punjab, but has also emerged as regional topper. Earlier, Mrinal, a student of Saint Kabir Convent Senior Secondary School in Bathinda and Sri Chaitanya in Chandigarh, had secured top rank in the JEE Mains Session 1 competitive exam by scoring a perfect 300/300. Another three students of Sri Chaitanya have found a place in the top 100 ranks. Naman Goyal has secured AIR 62, Sankalp Mittal has Secured AIR 76, and Yagya Goyal has secured AIR 99. "Our son has proved that with hard work, anybody can reach the top. We are very happy and proud of his achievement," said Mrinal's parents. Responding to his achievement, Mrinal said he would like to thank his parents and owe his success to his teachers at the coaching institute. "I wasn't scared while giving the exam because I have been put through those circumstances earlier."



ONE PARTY DID 'PARIVARVAD', OTHER DOING 'DOSTVAD': KEJRIWAL



Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Monday slammed the Centre over the latter's 'Revdi' remark and claimed that one party (Congress) did 'Parivarvad' while the other party (BJP) ruling at the Centre is doing 'Dostvaad'. Accusing the BJP of 'dostvaad' (favouring friends) and Congress of 'parivarvaad' (dynastic politics) without naming them, Kejriwal said his party is trying to usher 'Bharatvaad' (Indianness). Targeting the BJP-led Central government in a press briefing, the Chief Minister added, "These people waived off the loans of Rs 10 lakh crore of their friends. Such people must be called as 'traitors' and investigation should be carried out against them." A law should be brought in to declare this 'treason' and all those involved should be sent to jail, he said. He claimed that an atmosphere is being created against free government welfare services by terming them 'freebies', rather than planning to strengthen them during the 75th year of independence. "There are some people who call the provision of free education, free medical treatment by government facilities as 'rewadi' or 'freebies'. An atmosphere is being created in the country against provisions of free education at government schools and free medical treatment at government hospitals," Kejriwal added. He alleged, "We are celebrating the 75th anniversary of the country's independence and should be planning on strengthening such facilities but we are creating an atmosphere against them." "On the eve of 75th independence, I demand to provide free education, healthcare, 300 units of free electricity to every household and an unemployment allowance to all," he said.

MAHARASHTRA: SHINDE-FADNAVIS' ALL-MALE CABINET HAS 18 MINISTERS



Soon after his much-awaited mini Cabinet expansion with the induction of 18 members on Tuesday, Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde faced flak from various quarters for not including a woman in the team, but inducting three allegedly tainted legislators, and excluding Independents and smaller parties. With this, the number of Cabinet ministers has gone up to 20, including Shinde and BJP's Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis -- less than half the total strength of 43. Tuesday's exercise was aimed at 'sailing through' the upcoming Monsoon Session of the Assembly starting August 17, and the next phase of expansion with a few Cabinet ranks and others as MoS will be done later. Shinde has included legislators, including himself, who were part of the former MVA government -- Gulabrao Patil, Dadaji Bhuse, Sanjay Rathod, Sandipan Bhumre, Uday Samant, Abdul Sattar and Shambhuraj Desai -- besides two new faces, Deepak Kesarkar and Tanaji Sawant, who were ministers in the previous Devendra Fadnavis regime. Despite the presence of several women MLAs in both Shinde group (three) and the BJP (12), the two sides have ignored them - - at least for now -- 41 days after the new government was sworn-in on June 30. However, three allegedly scarred MLAs, two from Shinde camp and one from the BJP, are now ministers -- Abdul Sattar, Sanjay Rathod (Shinde group) and BJP's Vijaykumar Gavit. Shiv Sena leader KishoriPednekar and BJP's Chitra Wagh have slammed the Chief Minister for inducting Rathod - who was a minister in the erstwhile Maha Vikas Aghadi government headed by former CM Uddhav Thackeray.

The police have also recovered one hand-grenade, one RDX-IED, two .30 bore pistols, besides magazines and 13 cartridges, 635 gm heroin, 100 gm opium, Rs 36.90 lakh drug money, and one Mitsubishi Lancer car from their possession. Director General of Police (DGP) Gaurav Yadav said accused Gurwinder Singh, who was wanted by the National Investigation Agency (NIA), had played a key role in the killing of Sandhu by providing weapons to shooters. A probe revealed that Gurwinder is a close associate of gangsters Sukhpreet Singh and Sukhmeetal Singh. Preliminary investigations indicated that the recovered explosives and arms and ammunition were to be used to disrupt peace and harmony and create a sense of terror in the state on or before Independence Day, said the DGP. Inspector General of Police (Ferozepur Range) Jaskaran Singh said following inputs that Gurwinder Baba with his aide Sandeep was on the way to Khadoor Sahib, the Tarn Taran police had intercepted their car and managed to arrest them. SSP Ranjit Singh Dhillon said the arrests are likely to lead to disclosures of cross-border smuggling modules. Two motorcycle-borne assailants shot dead Shaurya Chakra awardee Sandhu at his residence in Bhikhiwind in the border district of Tarn Taran in October 2020.



UKRAINE PROPOSES NEW SANCTIONS ON RUSSIA

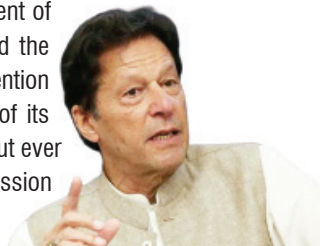
The Ukrainian Parliament has unveiled a draft law to impose new sanctions on Russia. The bill, which was submitted by President Volodymyr Zelensky, envisages 10 new restrictive measures to be introduced against Russia for the next 10 years, reports Xinhua news agency. In particular, the draft law stipulates a ban on transferring funds from

Ukraine to Russia-related individuals and legal entities. Besides, it prohibits Russia-linked individuals from participating in the privatisation and lease of Ukrainian state property and purchasing land plots in Ukraine. The bill also proposes to ban Russian and Russia-linked ships and planes from entering Ukraine, among other measures.

POLITICS IN PAKISTAN BASED ON AN ELEMENT OF VINDICTIVENESS

Politics in Pakistan is based on an element of vindictiveness which often tends to make the creator or supporter of a particular law, victim of his own doing. This vicious political cycle has affected the lives and careers of several prominent politicians in the country and would now come to haunt former Prime Minister Imran Khan. The accusations against Khan in the Toshakhana case is far more complex than it appears and is a matter of serious concern for the former premier. While on the face of it, the case might not appear as part of a major corruption scandal involving embezzlement of crores of state funds, it nevertheless hinges on a principle stand adopted by the Supreme Court on need for earnings to be declared by politicians, including Prime Ministers. In the case of Nawaz Sharif, the Supreme Court had disqualified him from participating in national politics for life, which also became the basis for his removal from the post of Prime Minister. In the Sharif case, the accusation against him was for having not declared a certain amount which he was to have received (but had not yet received) from certain sources. The initial part of the Supreme Court declaration in the case had mentioned: "It is hereby declared that having failed to disclose his unwithdrawn receivables constituting assets from XYZ sources in his nomination papers filed for general elections held in 2013, Sharif remains disqualified from being member of Parliament as per Article 62(1)F of the

Constitution." It is worth noting that in the Nawaz Sharif case, even though he had not received the said amount, the fact that he was due to receive the amount, and had consciously avoided declaring the same in the statement of returns before the Election Commission, led the Supreme Court to come up with, what many members of the Pakistani legal fraternity considered as, a 'controversial' and 'harsh' decision. However, the fact remains that the decision was implemented and Nawaz Sharif was removed from position. Members of the PTI and PML-Q celebrated the occasion appreciating the decision of the Supreme Court. According to reports, Khan had earned around 36 million PKR by illegally selling three watches gifted to him by foreign dignitaries to a local watch dealer. Apparently, Khan during his tenure as prime minister earned millions of rupees from these jewel-class watches collectively worth over 154 million PKR. The watches were gifted to him by foreign leaders. The most expensive watch, of more than 101 million PKR value, was apparently retained by Khan at 20 per cent of its value after his government amended the Toshakhana rules and settled the gift retention price at 50 per cent (not 20 per cent) of its original value. Moreover, he did so without ever declaring the gifts to the Election Commission and getting them evaluated.



US PRESIDENT BIDEN AUTHORISES LARGEST WEAPONS ASSISTANCE TO UKRAINE



The administration of US President Joe Biden has announced that the US will provide Ukraine with \$1 billion worth of additional security assistance, the largest one-time weapons package since the beginning of the Russia-Ukraine conflict. According to a statement by the Department of Defence, the package — the 18th tranche of presidential drawdown since August 2021 — included additional munitions for High Mobility Artillery Rocket System (HIMARS), 75,000 rounds of 155 mm artillery ammunition, 20 120 mm mortar systems and 20,000 rounds of 120 mm mortar ammunition, as well as munitions for National Advanced Surface-to-Air Missile System (NASAMS), Xinhua news agency reported. Washington will also deliver to Kiev 1,000 Javelins, hundreds of AT4 anti-armor systems, 50 armoured medical treatment vehicles, anti-personnel munitions, explosives, demolition munitions and demolition equipment, the statement said. The just-announced aid brings total US commitment of security assistance to Ukraine to nearly \$9.8 billion since Biden took office, according to the Pentagon.

JOHNSON SAYS HIS SUCCESSOR WILL HAVE FIREPOWER TO HELP PEOPLE

British Prime Minister Boris Johnson has declared he is "absolutely confident" that his successor "will have the fiscal firepower and the headroom to continue to continue to look after people". The Prime Minister also said he is "certain" that whoever wins the Conservative leadership election will want to make announcements about how they will "further help people" struggling to get by, amid a cost-of-living crisis, reports dpa news agency. Speaking at a Downing Street reception on Tuesday, Johnson cracked jokes about it being one of his last events in the garden at Number 10, and the next Prime Minister being either a man or a woman, amid a leadership race after he resigned earlier this year. "In these difficult financial times people are feeling the squeeze across our country and they're feeling the impact in particular of the energy price spikes that are being caused by (Russian President Vladimir) Putin's war in Ukraine and of course it's right that the Government is doing everything that we can to help and we're putting 1,200 pounds into the pockets of the eight million most vulnerable households and 400 pounds for everybody to help with the cost of energy, 300 pounds for pensioners, 150 pounds off council tax, and the money will keep coming in throughout the autumn, more coming in September and October," he said.

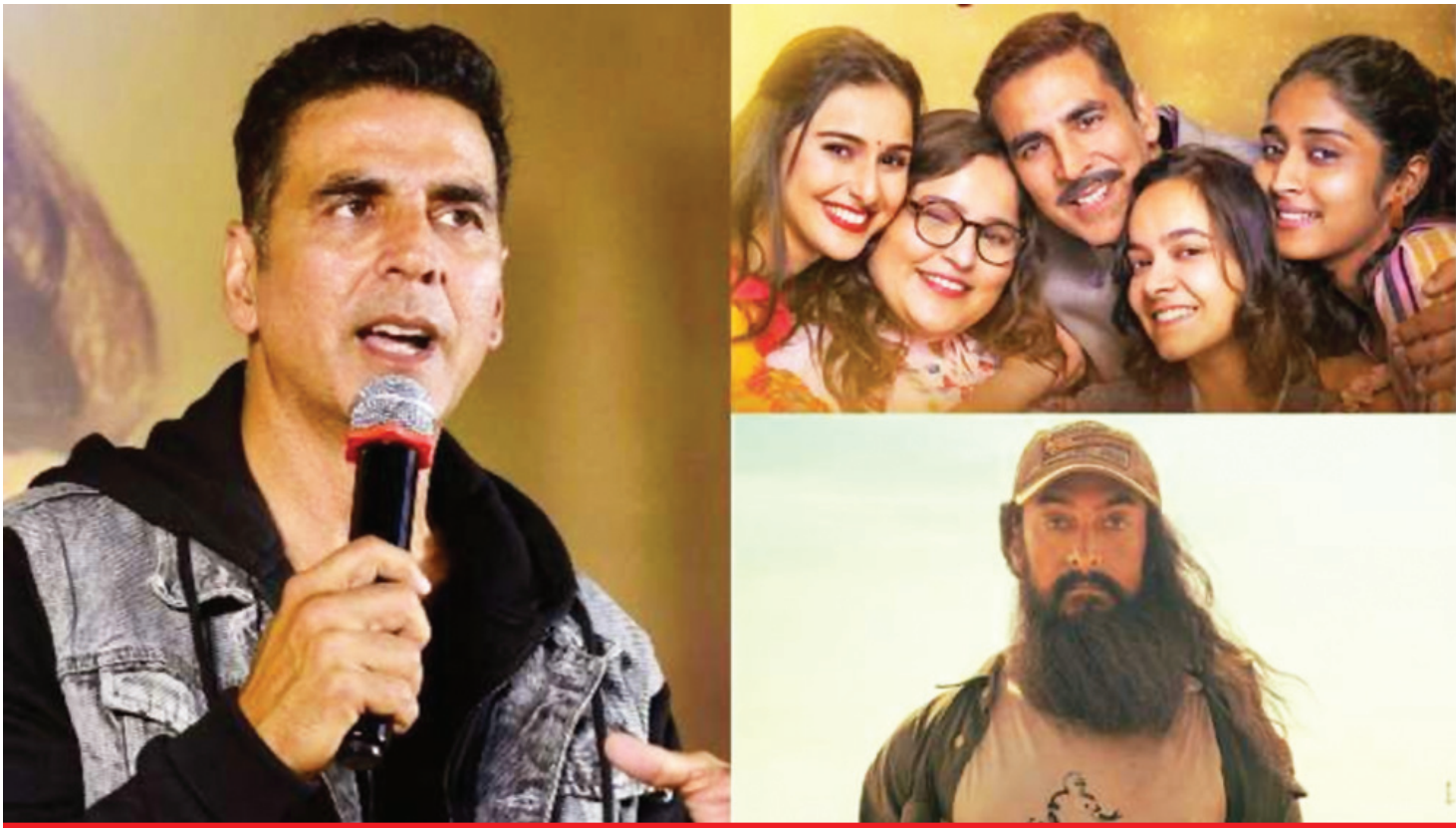

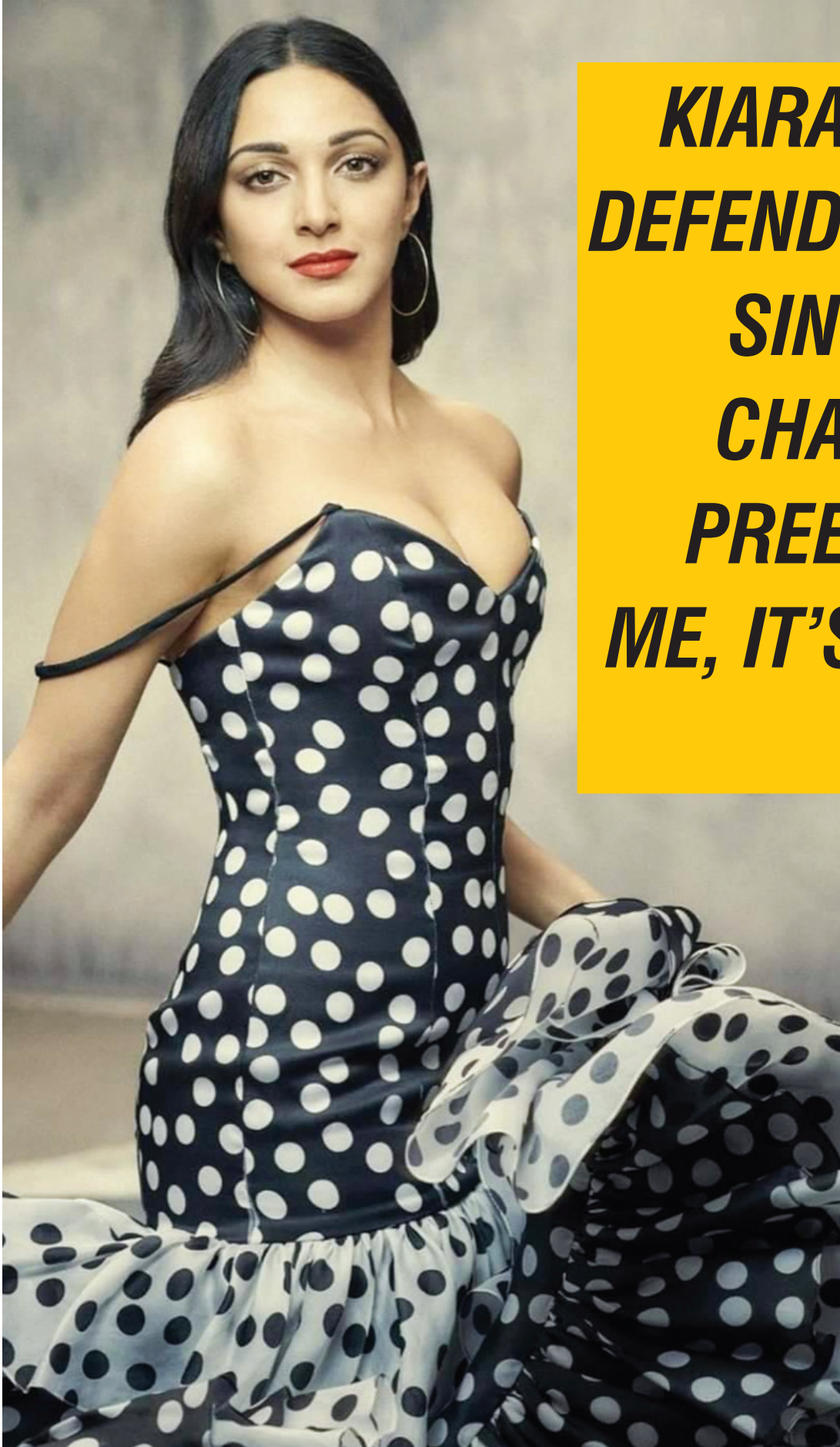

INDIA THRASH WI BY 88 RUNS IN 5TH T20; WIN SERIES BY 4-1



Indian spinners took all ten wickets as they thrashed West Indies in the fifth and final T20I of the series here to complete a 4-1 series victory. Ravi Bishnoi took four wickets while Axar Patel and Kuldeep Yadav shared three apiece to bowl West Indies out for 100 and give India a thumping 88-run win. It was the first instance of spinners taking all 10 wickets in a men's T20I innings. There have been seven other instances of spinners taking as many as nine wickets in a men's T20I innings with the latest occurrence coming in Austria's T20I against Hungary in June, 2022. It also occurred in the T20 World Cup last year when Afghanistan spinners took nine wickets against Scotland. This has, however, happened before in women's T20Is with Thailand spinners taking all 10 wickets against Malaysia in Bangkok in 2019. Malaysia were bowled out for just 27 in that game which Thailand won by 87 runs. Here, India struck early in the second innings while defending 188. Axar Patel had Jason Holder, promoted to open the batting, dismissed for a duck. He followed it up with two more wickets in the fifth over to complete the powerplay with figures of 3-1-15-3.

'YEAH, WHY NOT?' HARDIK PANDYA OPENS TO FULL-TIME CAPTAINCY ROLE



Hardik Pandya struck gold in his debut season as captain in the Indian Premier League (IPL) 2022, he then led India to a 2-0 series win against Ireland, and now on Sunday in the absence of regular captain Rohit Sharma, he led India to a thumping 88-run win on the back of a superb performance by their spinners in Lauderhill, Florida on to complete a 4-1 series win.

JASPRIT BUMRAH SET TO BE RULED OUT WITH BACK INJURY



Senior fast bowler Jasprit Bumrah is set to be ruled out of the upcoming Asia Cup T20 tournament. Bumrah will not be part of the Indian playing XI due to a back injury, which would require some time to heal. The Indian squad for the continental championship will be selected on Monday, but it is still not clear if the official announcement will happen on the day. "Jasprit Bumrah has a back injury and will not play in the Asia Cup. He is our main bowler and we would like him to be back in action before T20 World Cup. We can't risk him in Asia Cup and the injury could aggravate," a senior BCCI official told PTI. Bumrah last played in the ODI away series against England before he was rested from the rubber against West Indies. He is also rested for the upcoming one against Zimbabwe. However, it is understood that the back issue will keep him out for some time. Bumrah will need to do rehabilitation work at the National Cricket Academy in Bengaluru before being deemed fit for the white-ball home series against Australia and South Africa in September-October.

TEAM INDIA SETTLES FOR SILVER AFTER LOSING TO AUSTRALIA



India settled for the silver medal in men's hockey at the Commonwealth Games on Monday. India's hunt to net a single goal went in vain as they lost to Australia by 0-7 in a one-sided final. The goals were scored by Blake Govers, Nathan Ephraums, Jacob Anderson, Tom Wickham, and Fynn Ogilvie. The Australian team looked in control from the beginning of the match. Up against the rampaging team, the Indians struggled to get their act right in the final showdown, which turned out to be completely lopsided. Australia scored the first goal of the game in the first quarter, having started the final on a high note. Australia were 2-0 at the end of the first quarter, with Ephraums scoring the second goal for the six-time CWG champions. They remained indomitable and scored five more goals to extend their domination at the multi-sport sporting extravaganza. On the other hand, the Indian women's hockey team registered a win by 2-1 against the defending champions New Zealand to win the bronze medal at the Commonwealth Games 2022 on Sunday. Earlier in the day, PV Sindhu, Lakshya Sen, Chirag Shetty, and Satwiksairaj Rankireddy, Sharath Kamal won gold medals for India. India is currently positioned at number four in the medals tally table after clinching a total number of 61 medals. These medals include 22 gold medals, 16 silver medals and 23 bronze medals.

INDIA'S SCHEDULE FOR CLOSING DAY OF MULTI-NATION SPORTING EVENT



Birmingham| As the Commonwealth Games comes to a close, the Indian contingency will give it all out to fetch a few more medals for the country. This is the 22nd edition of the Commonwealth games and India hasn't fared that badly in the event. With 55 medals, India will look to solidify their standings in the top 5 when the contest ends. India had a good outing when they came out to compete in various events across various disciplines. Nikhat Zareen living up to all the promises, opened India's account early in the day as she won a gold medal in the 50kg bout. Nikhat was accompanied well by her counterparts Amit Panghal and Nitu Ghangas who managed to fetch the gold medal for India. Indian boxer Sagar Ahlawat could not keep up with the exploits of Zarin and Panghal and ended in the second spot as he was felicitated with the silver medal. Breaking the shackles of a 16-year-long wait and coming strong after the clock howler, the Indian women's hockey team defeated the New Zealand side to claim the bronze medal. Adding to India's medal tally, India's Eldhose Paul and Abdullah Aboobacker clinched gold and silver respectively, and added a page in the books of Indian men's triple jump history. As we head towards the final day of the Commonwealth Games, India will see a few more participation from other disciplines including badminton, table tennis, and hockey.

SATWIK-CHIRAG PAIR WINS MEN'S DOUBLES GOLD IN BADMINTON



India's star doubles pair of Chirag Shetty and Satwiksairaj Rankireddy won the country's third gold from the badminton court with straight-game victory over England's Ben Lane and Sean Mendy at the Commonwealth Games.

HARMANPREET LOOKS TO RECTIFY REPETITIVE MISTAKES AFTER LOSING OUT ON GOLD



India skipper Harmanpreet Kaur is heartbroken and she has identified team India's repetitive pattern of committing mistakes and crumbling under pressure in crunch matches. Courtesy of the same pattern, India lost to England in the finals of the 2017 World Cup, they crumbled in the 2020 ICC T20I World Cup final against Australia and they repeated the same mistake in the gold medal match of the Commonwealth Cricket Championship. India was chasing 162 runs and they almost had the game in their kitty with Jemimah Rodrigues and Harmanpreet Kaur batting and helping India get through a tough phase. Both Kaur and Rodriguez stitched a partnership of 96 runs and put India in firm control. The Meg Lanning-led side looked completely clueless till the time Kaur and Rodrigues batted. After Jemimah was dismissed, the floodgates opened and the remaining 7 wickets fell just for 34 runs. Skipper Harmanpreet Kaur tried her best and she scored a subline 65 off 43 deliveries in a losing cause. The Indian skipper had a very stern reaction after the game and has said that as a team they need to get rid of this kind of mental block. Team India required 50 runs in the last six overs with eight wickets in hand but all the Indian batters ended up playing rash shots and India could never recover which cost them the match.

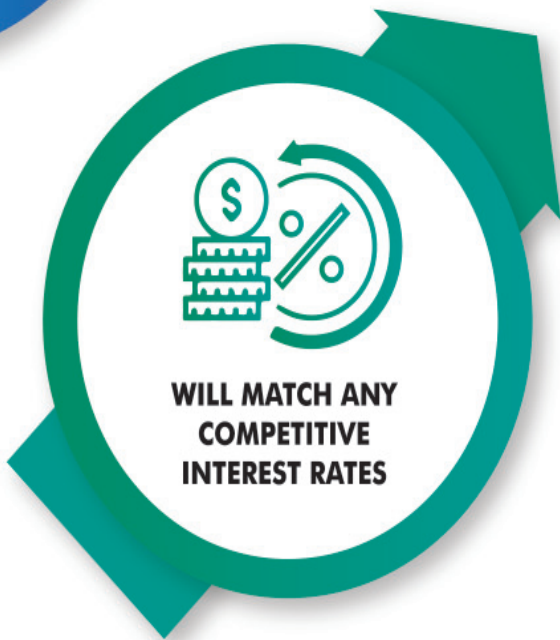
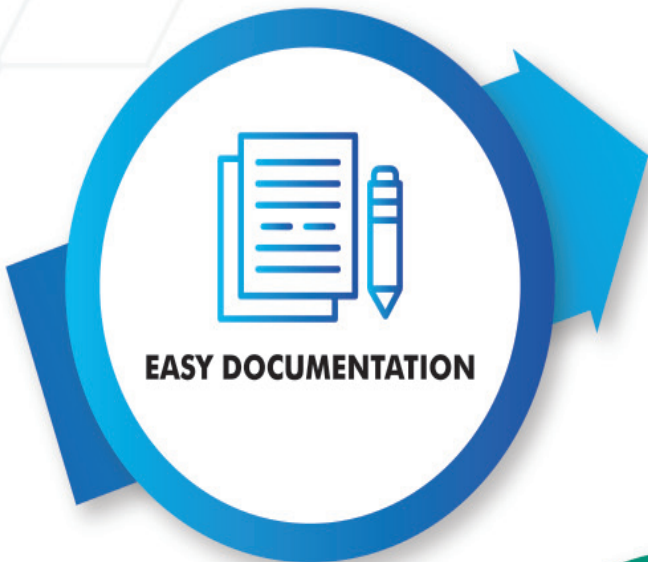
