DELHI DEPUTY CM MANISH SISODIA ARRESTED BY CBI IN EXCISE POLICY SCAM

NEW DELHI: Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia was on Sunday arrested by the CBI in the excise policy scam after a day of political drama. Sisodia, who reached the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) headquarters at Lodhi Road in south Delhi at around 11.10 a.m. after visiting the Rajghat for prayers, was questioned for over eight hours before being arrested. A CBI source said the agency will present Sisodia at the Rouse Avenue Courts on Monday and seek two weeks' custodial remand as it needs to confront him with the co-accused, as well as documentary and digital evidence. Sources claimed that Sisodia was questioned about the documentary, electronic and digital evidence which the CBI have gathered during the probe in the scam. "He has been accused of destroying evidence and being the mastermind of the excise policy scam," a source said. Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal termed his deputy's arrest "dirty politics". "Manish is innocent. His arrest is dirty politics. There is a lot of anger among the people due to the arrest of Manish. Everyone is watching," he said in a tweet. In the same tweet, he said that people understand everything. "People will respond to this. This will boost our spirits further. Our struggle will get stronger," Kejriwal said. Sisodia was earlier asked to appear before the

CBI on February 19, but he had sought deferment of his questioning, citing the ongoing Budget exercise. The CBI accepted his request and issued him a second notice to join the probe on February 26. The arrest of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader, who has alleged that the BJP wants to get him arrested to stop the development of Delhi, came after a day of political drama.

EXIT POLLS: BJP TO RETAIN TRIPURA, MEGHALAYA SEES FOUR-CORNERED CONTEST

NEW DELHI, (IANS) With voting for the assembly polls in Meghalaya and Nagaland ending on Monday amid tight security, all eyes are now on the results. In Meghalaya, polling was held at 3,419 polling stations across 59 Assembly constituencies, while in Nagaland voting was held in 59 out of 60 Assembly constituencies. The Matrize exit poll for Meghalaya predicted 21-26 seats for the NPP, 6-11 seats to the BJP, 8-13 to the TMC, 3-6 for the Congress and 10-19 for others. In Meghalaya, it continued to be a fourcornered contest. In the last Assembly polls, although the Congress had emerged as the single largest party winning 21 seats, the Conrad Sangmaled National People's Party, which had won 20 seats, had managed to form the government following an alliance with the BJP. However, this time, with no pre-poll alliance in place, the Congress, BJP, NPP and TMC are looking to win a majority on their own. In Nagaland, in 2018 the NDPP-BJP alliance had formed the government. The Naga People's Front (NPF), which had emerged as the single largest party in the last Assembly polls, faces a tough time as many of its leaders have since quit to join the NDPP.

TORONTO: People missed the Canadian International AutoShow. Returning after two pandemic-forced cancellations in 2021 and 2022, the 50th anniversary AutoShow set four daily attendance records, including the record for the largest single-day audience in the history of the Show — and finished as the third-highest attended AutoShow in the half-century of the event. By the end of the 10-day Show, which also endured a snow and ice storm midweek, 350,214 people attended the Metro Toronto Convention Centre between Media Day and the special VIP Gala on February 16th and the public days of the Show between February 16th and 26th.

With the movement in the automotive sector towards electrification, the debut of the AutoShow's indoor EV Test Track was immensely popular. More than 6,000 drivers, and more than 15,000 show attendees, took an EV for a two-lap spin around the half-kilometer track, with 83 per cent of them driving an EV for the first time.

"Our manufacturer partners responded with a great selection of cars, including several seen in Canada, North America and even the world for the first time. Many of the vehicles they showcased at the AutoShow are difficult to find in showrooms today which explains why we had such enthusiasm from our consumers to see the latest and greatest the industry has to offer.

"We said it last fall when we announced the AutoShow was returning, and it holds even more true today: We're back!"

The 2023 AutoShow was anchored by strong displays from some of the world's leading automotive brands — including Alfa Romeo, Buick, Cadillac, Chevrolet, Chrysler, Dodge, Genesis, GMC, Hyundai, Jeep, Kia, Lexus, Nissan, Polestar, Ram, Subaru, Tesla, Toyota, Vinfast and Wagoneer — that included one global vehicle debut, a North American debut and nine Canadian debuts along with more than 75 all-electric vehicles. Project Arrow, a concept car from a collaboration of the Automotive Parts Manufacturers Association and more than 50 partners, showed what the Canadian automotive sector can accomplish. The futuristic EV was loaded with technology — and the entire vehicle was conceived, designed, engineered and built in Canada entirely with Canadian parts.

There were five other concept vehicles from the manufacturers showcasing the future: Buick Wildcat, Hyundai RN22e, Hyundai N Vision 74, Nissan ARIYA Surfwagon and Nissan NISMO Off Road

The 2023 AutoShow was also shown strong support from the federal and provincial governments. Several MPs and MPPs, including Premier Doug Ford and federal Minister of Innovation, Science and Industry François-Philippe Champagne, attended the event to connect with its audience of automotive enthusiasts and talk about the future of the Canadian and Ontario auto industries on the Show's Electric City Innovation Stage, presented by the Toronto Star and EnerSavings. This special new Electric City showcase feature put a spotlight not only on EVs, but also on vehicle charging options, green electricity and electrified micro-mobility alternatives. A repayable Government of Canada investment of \$500,000 through the Tourism Relief Fund, delivered by the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario (FedDev Ontario) to create Electric City supports the federal mandate for zero-emission vehicles in Canada.

The luxury and exotic brands at the AutoShow were anchored by major displays from Grand Touring Automobiles and Pfaff automotive showcasing Aston Martin, Bentley, Bugatti, Koenigsegg, Lamborghini, Rolls-Royce, Polestar, McLaren and Porsche with Autostrada Magazine showcasing an array of collector car specials including a Spyker, several Ferraris and an ex F1 car from Alfa Romeo. Lotus and Tesla were also showcasing their latest and greatest.

Popular toy brands Hot Wheels and LEGO helped build a family atmosphere at the AutoShow, and fan favourite features like Auto Exotica, Cobble Beach and OBLIVION continued to delight fans.

Also well received by show attendees was the Accessible Mobility display with Universal Motion, showcasing how those with mobility challenges are able to regain their mobility across a range of product offerings, and the Senator APC from Mississauga-based manufacturer Roshel. The Canadian government purchased 200 of the vehicles to be sent to Ukraine as part of Canada's contribution to the international effort in aid of that country's defence.

"We had interactive exhibits that proved incredibly popular with show attendees," says Mr. Campbell. "Our special features continue to draw in fans. There clearly continues to be strong interest in the AutoShow as a consumer engagement platform and great interest in the Total Automotive Experience the Auto Show delivers better than any other." 

When Canadians learn about possible foreign interference through leaked documents, confidence in our democracy is put at risk," said Singh. "The way to stop alleged secret Chinese interference is to refuse to keep their secrets for them. A fully independent and nonpartisan public inquiry is the way to shine a light into the shadows." The allegations, revealed largely in leaks of Canadian Security Intelligence Service (CSIS) documents to media including The Globe and Mail and Global News include information that China interfered in the 2019 election in a variety of ways, including illegally funnelling large amounts of money to candidates and arranging donations from those sympathetic to their cause. According to reports, the documents further allege that campaigns may have illegally returned part of those donations - the difference between the donation and the tax credit - suggesting complicity by sitting members of parliament or the people running their campaigns. Reports have indicated that Trudeau and his senior staff have allegedly been briefed about specific interference concerns from China, even impacting members of his own caucus, and chose not to act.

According to new immigration figures, 490,763 students were given visas last year. They were accompanied by 135,788 dependants -- spouses and children -- up from 16,047 in 2019.

Of these, India became the largest source of students with 161,000 students, including 33,240 dependents, coming to the UK last year. Asylum backlog hit a record high, with more than 160,000 migrants waiting for decisions on their applications, the report said.

The government is yet to make a final decision on the contentious matter. Braverman has drawn up proposals to reduce the number, which includes shortening the duration foreign students can stay in Britain post their course.

However, according to the Department of Education, the restrictions will bankrupt UK universities, which depend on foreign students for money. According to estimates, international students add 35 billion pounds a year to the economy. According to UK-based New Way Consultancy, foreign students and their dependents contributed to the UK economy not just through fees of 10,000 pounds to 26,000 pounds but also via an NHS surcharge of 400 pounds a year for the student and 600 pounds for a dependent. It warned that curbs on graduate work visas will force Indian students to shift to countries like Australia and Canada, ultimately leading to the end of the student market in the UK. More than 45,000 people crossed the Channel to the UK in small boats over the past year, according to government figures, with 90 crossing on Christmas Day alone.

The US has historically had a hold on the Presidency of the World Bank and the Europeans on the International Monetary Fund (IMF). "Ajay is uniquely equipped to lead the World Bank at this critical moment in history. He has spent more than three decades building and managing successful, global companies that create jobs and bring investment to developing economies, and guiding organisations through periods of fundamental change," Biden said in a statement.

"He has a proven track record managing people and systems, and partnering with global leaders around the world to deliver results."

Vice President Kamala Harris, who is also Indian American, said in a separate statement: "Ajay Banga will be a transformative World Bank President as the institution works to deliver on its core development goals and address pressing global challenges, including climate change." Harris said she has worked with Banga since her election "on a new model of public-private partnership designed to address the root causes of migration in Northern Central America", which was a key responsibility Biden entrusted her with to curb the flow of migrants from the region into the US.

Banga, who was born in India and studied at Delhi's St Stephen's College, is currently serves as vice chairman at General Atlantic. Previously, he was President and CEO of Mastercard. The White House said that over the course of his career, Banga has become a global leader in technology, data, financial services and innovating for inclusion.

He previously served on the Boards of the American Red Cross, Kraft Foods and Dow Inc. He has worked closely with Vice President Harris as the Co-Chair of the Partnership for Central America. He is a member of the Trilateral Commission, a founding trustee of the US-India Strategic Partnership Forum, a former member of the National Committee on United States-China Relations, and Chairman Emeritus of the American India Foundation.

Banga was awarded the Foreign Policy Association Medal in 2012, the Padma Shri Award by India in 2016, the Ellis Island Medal of Honor and the Business Council for International Understanding's Global Leadership Award in 2019, and the Distinguished Friends of Singapore Public Service Star in 2021 With US President Joe Biden nominating Ajay Banga, the former Indian American head of Mastercard, to head the World Bank, the top posts in the global financial institution will be held by Sikhs.

Before Banga, who is slated to take up job - which, by convention, been reserved for a US citizen - this May, the World Bank already as a Sikh in a top post, with Indermit Singh Gill its Chief Economist.

He is primarily known for pioneering the concept of the "middleincome trap" to describe how countries stagnate after reaching a certain level of income. Gill, an Indian citizen, studied at St Paul's School, Darjeeling and St. Stephen's College, Delhi where he was probably just a year (or perhaps two) junior to Banga. Like Banga, Gill is also the son of a senior Indian Army officer. Before taking over Chief Economist on September 1, 2022, Gill served as the World Bank's Vice President for Equitable Growth, Finance, and Institutions, where he played a key role in shaping its response to the extraordinary series of shocks that have hit developing economies since 2020. Between 2016 and 2021, he was a professor of public policy at Duke University and non-resident senior fellow at the Brookings Institution's Global Economy and Development program.

Widely regarded for his contributions to development economics, Gill spearheaded the influential 2009 World Development Report on economic geography, as per his World Bank profile. He has published extensively on key policy issues facing developing countries, among other things, sovereign debt vulnerabilities, green growth and natural-resource wealth, labour markets, and poverty and inequality.

Gill has also taught at Georgetown University and the University of Chicago. He holds a Ph.D. in economics from the University of Chicago

Biden's nomination of Banga follows his Democratic predecessor, Barack Obama nominating Korean-American 'Jim' Yong Kim for World Bank chief to ensure that the World Bank is headed by someone with a developing-country background Biden was then Vice President.

If confirmed by the World Bank Board, Bang will be the first person of Indian descent to head the World Bank. He will succeed David Malpass, who was appointed to head the bank by then President Donald Trump.

AS CONG SEEKS OUT ALLIES, GANDHI TRIO STILL CALLS THE SHOTS

The more things change, the more they stay the same. This wellknown expression, first used by a French writer in 1949, reflects the truth about the Congress today.

The Sonia-Rahul-Priyanka trio may be vouching to bring a change in the party to get back the lost fortunes, but the steps taken stealthily ensure that everything stays the same. In the end, everything always goes according to a 'strategic' script overseen by the trio.

The 85th plenary session of the Congress is an example of this. Whether it was a decision about holding elections to the Congress Working Committee (CWC) or changing party rules or anything else, all was to ensure that everything stays the same. And, the 'same' means keeping it the family way.

Despite public posturing of the party leadership on holding elections to the CWC, no election took place. The high-powered steering committee, empowered party president Mallikarjun Kharge to nominate the new CWC members, was not attended by the Gandhi trio. The absence of the family was to create an impression that decisions are being made independently. But the very fact that the party retained the nomination culture in the CWC belied the claim.

Had the elections taken place, Kharge could have joined P.V. Narasimha Rao and Sitaram Kesri, the two non-Gandhi party presidents who conducted CWC elections in 1991 and 1997 respectively. Kharge followed the nomination culture - a system that suits the family, indicating no independent way for the party president.

Remember the relation between Rahul Gandhi and Manmohan Singhled UPA government (2004-2013)? The former seemed to be at loggerheads with his own government most of the time. The 'activist' was often trashing his own people, and everything was 'run' by the National Advisory Council.

This time a similar situation seems to be emerging, the only difference is that Mallikarjun Kharge is not the Prime Minister but the president of the Congress, and Rahul is on a similar divergent path.

Kharge, the octogenarian chief of the grand old party, who of late has been trying to rally the opposition for a front against the BJP, had to face discomforting moments from none other than Rahul Gandhi.

In Parliament, Kharge has been actively pursuing like-minded parties to take on the Centre unitedly, and was able to rally 14-16 political parties consistently in the budget session. Taking this forward, he said at a public meeting in Nagaland on February 21 that his party was in talks with other opposition parties, and asserted that "an alliance led by the Congress would come to power at the Centre in 2024." A day later a bitter war of words broke out between Trinamool Congress leaders and Rahul Gandhi after the latter attacked the former. Rahul while addressing a rally in Shillong, said: "You also know the

history of TMC, you know the violence that takes place in Bengal. You know, the scams... the Saradha scam... that had taken place. You are aware of their tradition. They came to Goa and spent huge amounts of money. And their idea was to help the BJP. This is exactly their idea in Meghalaya. TMC's idea in Meghalaya is to ensure that BJP is strengthened and they come to power. Is Trinamool a silent partner of the BJP? ...Is it intentionally going to cheat the people of Meghalaya also?" What followed this surely must have jolted Kharge, and raised several eyebrows since there is this perceived cordial relationship that Mamata Banerjee and Sonia Gandhi share. In a direct attack, Trinamool national general secretary and MP Abhishek Banerjee said: "The Congress has failed to resist BJP. There irrelevance, incompetence and insecurity has put them in a state of delirium. I urge Rahul Gandhi to revisit the politics of vanity instead of attacking us. Our growth isn't driven by money, it is people's love that propels us." The Trinamool MP has pinned this tweet since then.

Rahul's attacking Trinamool in Meghalaya may have suited the party's local calculations, but on the national perspective Kharge knew that this will not help him in his endeavour of striking an opposition alliance. Even during the party's plenary session in Raipur, he expressed willingness to work with like-minded parties and forge a viable alternative with them to take on the BJP. He also spoke of the UPA-like alliance at the Centre to take on the BJP, where the Congress led the alliance. Rahul's aggressive stance on opposition parties and Kharge's friendship hand present the Congress' confusing strategy which may not go well with anyone. Even within itself it has not been able to sort out its internal differences. Leaders continue to leave the party alleging disrespect, deviation from ideology, and drawing attention to internal suffocation. A day before of the party's Raipur plenary session, C.R. Kesavan, great-grandson of India's first Governor-General, C. Rajagopalachari, resigned, saying that he has not seen any vestiges of the values that made him work for the party with dedication for

over two decades. In a letter to Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge, which Kesavan shared on Twitter and said that "he can no longer concur with what the party symbolises, stands for, nor seeks to propagate." He said he was with the Congress party for the past 22 years but over a period of time, the approach of the party was neither constructive nor concrete.

Kesavan did not join Rahul's Bharat Jodo Yatra, and said he was appalled at Congress' questioning of surgical strike and also the reaction of seniors when President Murmu's candidature was announced. Kesavan's charges are similar to what Congress loyalist A.K. Antony's son Anil Antony had said when he resigned from the party. Reacting to Kesavan's resignation, Antony said: "This letter echoes thoughts shared by many within a party hijacked by a coterie with little understanding of public consciousness or national interest." Veteran politician Ghulam Nabi Azad had also referred to the coterie culture and disconnect with the grassroots and realities within the Congress before he quit the party.

Dismissing the charges of those leaving the party, the Congress said it is fighting for a bigger cause, which is to defeat the BJP. And defeating the BJP is what will get the like-minded parties together and also unify the party from within, as the party leaders say.

The Congress is banking upon the 'defeat-Modi' strategy to attract the opposition parties and also to set its own house in order.

It is showcasing Rahul's Bharat Jodo Yatra, a success and a game changer for 2024.

The test is not far away and the results of the elections in nine states may as well change a lot ahead of the final showdown in 2024.

But, till then the Congress needs to keep its people together and those walking out are distressed by the erosion of the party's original values. The hard reality for the Congress is that it has lost 40 of the last 45 state elections and in the Lok Sabha, it has 52 MPs out of 543, and its strategy has been based on 'hate-Modi' theory.



With this app-driven solution, health care providers open the Voyce app on their tablet, request their preferred language of choice, and are connected with a remote, medically-trained interpreter in a matter of seconds. From there, the patient is able to speak directly with the interpreter about their symptoms, concerns, questions, and more. The app also offers the opportunity to conference in family members and caregivers.

"Voyce was inspired by volunteer work with refugees in Canada, where language barriers were prevalent, so this is really a full-circle moment to now see our vision come to life," said Andrew Royce, CEO of Voyce. "This partnership with THP, will further enable accessible healthcare to patients

After launching a pilot in THP's Diagnostic Imaging unit, close to 220 patients used the service in 36 different languages, including ASL. The top languages requested were Mandarin, Arabic, Spanish, Punjabi, and Cantonese. On average, it took just 32 seconds for a connection with an interpreter of a preferred language. The Voyce app is now rolling out across THP following a competitive Request for Proposal (RFP) process with the CAN Health Network, a federally-funded organization that works with Canadian health care providers to identify their biggest challenges and match them with Canadian-made technology solutions. As a result of the RFP, the Voyce App will now be more accessible to members within CAN Health, including provincial health authorities, public and private hospitals, and long-term care homes. "With our partners in the CAN Health Network now able to adopt Voyce Canada's technology, our hope is that other organizations across Canada will now easily be able to access and experience the same benefits," said Dr. Dante Morra, Trillium Health Partners' Chief of Staff and CAN Health Network Chair. "Promising technologies like Voyce not only improve patient care, but help to create jobs here at home."

PEEL POLICE'S QUICK RESPONSE LEADS TO ARREST IN ARMED CARJACKING

REGION OF PEEL - Peel Regional Police have charged a young person following an early morning armed carjacking in Brampton. On Friday, February 24, 2023, at approximately 8:15 a.m., the victim was operating his motor vehicle as a ride-share operator in the area of Archdekin Drive and Vodden Street East in Brampton. At this time, it is alleged that the accused and an unknown suspect entered the victim's vehicle. The victim was forcibly restrained, at which point the accused produced an imitation firearm, demanded the keys, and forced the victim out of his vehicle. The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

Following an efficient response and coordinated effort from officers in Uniform Patrol, Criminal Investigations Bureau, and the Central Robbery Bureau, investigators located the vehicle in the area of Windsor Street in Toronto and, with the assistance of the Tactical Unit, effected a high-risk takedown. A replica firearm was located during the arrest.

Police have charged a 17-year-old young person with Robbery, Wearing a Disguise, Using an Imitation Firearm, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime, and Failing to Comply with a Recognizance.

He was held for a bail hearing and appeared before the Ontario Court of Justice in Brampton on February 24, 2023.

This remains an ongoing investigation, and investigators anticipate further arrests and charges.

A general provision of the Youth Criminal Justice Act (Y.C.J.A.) prohibits the release of the name of a Young Person, and, therefore, the identity of the Young Persons charged in this investigation is protected.

THOSE WHO DEMANDING GOVERNOR'S RULE ARE ANTI-PUNJAB: CM BHAGWANT MANN SLAMS BJP

Ajnala Incident: Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann Monday lambasted BJP leaders, including former CM Amarinder Singh for demanding "Governor's rule" in the state saying people know that these leaders have always been "anti-Punjab".

Trouble mounts for Mann government

The Mann-led AAP government came under attack after pro-Khalistan elements created havoc in Amritsar by attacking a police station. The Opposition has been alleging a deteriorating law-and-order situation in the state in the wake of a sudden rise in activities of pro-Khalistani organizations in Punjab.

CM vs Governor

The chief minister's also involved in a tussle with Governor Banwarilal Purohit. It worsened last week with the governor indicating that he is in no hurry to summon the Assembly's Budget session, and reminding the chief minister about his "derogatory response" to a letter from the Raj Bhavan. Purohit's letter to Mann had come two days after the Punjab Cabinet decided to call the assembly session from March 3 and requested the Governor to summon the House.

"Capt Amarinder Singh, Kewal Dhillon, Balbir Singh Sidhu, Fateh Jang Bajwa, Raj Kumar Verka, Gurpreet Kangar, Rana Gurmit Singh Sodhi...all Congressmen (who are) in BJP these days can often be seen around the Governor's residence. They are speaking about Governor's rule in Punjab. People of Punjab know that they have always remained anti-Punjab," Mann in his tweet in Punjabi.

AAP MP Raghav Chadha on Sunday said the Punjab government has been forced to move the Supreme Court as the Governor was not responding to the state cabinet's decision of convening the budget session to select liquor manufacturers," Majithia alleged.

of the assembly. Meanwhile, Punjab BJP leader Fateh Jang Bajwa demanded Governor's rule in Punjab while attacking the AAP government over various issues, including alleged deteriorating law and order in the state. "Our party, while considering the present situation, demands that Governor's rule should be imposed in Punjab," Bajwa said here on Monday and accused the AAP of not being able to run the state. He said the state government was talking about attracting investments from other states but considering the present law-and-order situation, "there is a fear that the existing industry may leave".

Meanwhile, Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) president Sukhbir Singh Badal also attacked the AAP government over the law and order issue. In a statement, Badal said, "No one is safe in today's Punjab." "The police force has been bottled down by the AAP administration as was witnessed recently during the attack on the Ajnala police station by radicals led by Amritpal Singh. This, as well as other incidents, which have revealed the complete lack of an integrated command structure, have demoralized the state police and compounded the problem," he alleged. Punjab BJP leader Subhash Sharma slammed the AAP for holding protests over CBI arresting Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia, stating the arrest was made on the basis of proof. SAD leader Bikram Singh Majithia demanded that the CBI probe into the Delhi excise policy case be extended to Punjab, claiming Sisodia was also the "architect" of the Punjab excise policy which had caused "losses of hundreds of crores to the state exchequer". "The actors and directors of the Punjab excise policy are the same as in the case of Delhi. As in the case of Delhi, the CBI should probe the role of senior officers and AAP politicians who had colluded to give huge benefits

'MOST CBI OFFICERS...': ARVIND KEJRIWAL'S BIG CLAIM ON MANISH SISODIA'S ARREST



Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Monday (February 27) claimed that most CBI officers were against the arrest of deputy CM Manish Sisodia. Kejriwal, in a tweet, said that despite CBI officers unwilling to arrest Sisodia, they were under 'pressure' from 'political masters' to act. "I am told that most CBI officers were against Manish's arrest. All of them have huge respect for him and there is no evidence against him. But the political pressure to arrest him was so high that they had to obey their political masters," Kejriwal said. Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia was arrested by the Central Bureau of

Investigation (CBI) late on Sunday after hours of questioning in the now scrapped Delhi liquor (excise) policy case. Sisodia's arrest, one of the most high-profile actions against an opposition leader, comes after that of Satyendar Jain, Delhi's the then health minister, in June last year. The CBI investigators were not satisfied with Sisodia's answers, an official said, adding he was not cooperating in the probe and avoided clarifications sought on crucial points. "He gave evasive replies and did not cooperate in the investigation despite being confronted with evidence to the contrary. Therefore, he has been arrested," the CBI said in a statement.

'INDIA READY TO MEDDLE PEACE TALKS BETWEEN RUSSIA, UKRAINE': PM MODI AFTER MEETING GERMANY'S SCHOLZ

India has again reiterated its readiness in mediating peace talks between Russia and Ukraine which have been involved in brutal attacks for the past year. While holding a crucial meeting with German Chancellor Olaf Scholz, Prime Minister Narendra Modi asserted that India stands ready to contribute to any peace process between the two nations.

In his statement at a joint media event with Modi, the German Chancellor described the Russian "aggression" against Ukraine as a "major catastrophe" that has negatively impacted the globe and said it is important for the countries to state "very clearly where we stand" on the war at the UN as international law governs international relations.

Developing country impacted

On his part, Modi said, "since the beginning of the developments in Ukraine, India has insisted on resolving this dispute through dialogue and diplomacy. India is ready to contribute to any peace process."

Referring to the destruction in Ukraine including to its energy grids and infrastructures as well as the overall consequences of the Russian invasion and stressed that developing countries were being negatively impacted by energy and food shortages resulting from the war. "But above all, it is a disaster, a catastrophe because we know this war violates a fundamental principle to which we had all agreed for such a long time, and that is that you do not change borders through the use of violence," he said.

"Thus, it is important that in the United Nations too, we time and again state very clearly where we stand on this subject matter," he said.



Key issues discussed

Asked whether the comments by the German Chancellor were a message to India and whether there were divergent views between the two countries on the conflict, Foreign Secretary Vinay Mohan Kwatra said he only saw "understanding and appreciation" of each other's perspective on the matter. "It was the Indian Prime Minister who openly stated in Samarkand that this is not the era for war. In the discussion, I would say, I only saw understanding and appreciation of each other's perspective," the foreign secretary told reporters at a briefing. In a bilateral meeting with Russian President Vladimir Putin in the Uzbek city of Samarkand in September last year, Modi said "today's era is not of war" and nudged the Russian leader to end the conflict. On Thursday, India abstained in the UN General Assembly on a resolution that underscored the need to reach "comprehensive, just and lasting peace" in Ukraine and called for Russia to end the hostilities.

SHIV SENA ROW: UDDHAV THACKERAY CALLS ELECTION COMMISSION 'BOGUS', SAYS SHINDE FACTION 'CREEPERS, THIEVES'



Amid rift over the Election Commission's decision over Shiv Sena, (UBT) leader Uddhav Thackeray attacked the EC for declaring the party faction led by Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde as the "real" Shiv Sena and allotting it the 'bow and arrow' symbol. While addressing the gathering in Matoshree on the occasion of Marathi Day, Thackeray said he no longer had trust in the apex poll body, adding it should be called "Election Chuna Lagao Aayog". "Chuna lagana" is street lingo for defrauding somebody. "The Election Commission is bogus. It should be called the Election Chuna Lagao Aavog. We have lost trust in it." Thackeray said at a party event on the occasion of Marathi Language Day. He claimed the Election Commission should not have given its decision on the party name and symbol when hearings connected to it were underway in the Supreme Court. The former CM said the EC had given a symbol each to Rashtriya Lok Janshakti Party factions headed by party founder late Ram Vilas Paswan's son Chirag and Paswan's brother Pashupati Kumar Paras in a dispute similar to the one in the Sena. However, both factions are quiet over it as they are with the ruling Bharatiya Janta Party, Thackeray alleged. He claimed parties had begun uniting against the BJP and referred to his meeting with Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and his conversations with West Bengal and Bihar CMs Mamata Banerjee and Nitish Kumar, respectively.

"CENTRE MUST INTERCEDE..." SAYS AMARINDER SINGH AFTER AJNALA INCIDENT



Three days after the Ajnala incident, former Punjab Chief Minister Captain Amarinder Singh lambasted his successor Bhagwant Mann and asserted that the Centre must intercede "if the AAP government is not able to control the law and order situation in the state".

The critical remarks from Singh came after thousands of supporters of Amritpal Singh, a Khalistan sympathizer, had on Thursday staged a massive demonstration in Amritsar to protest against the arrest of his aide Lovepreet Singh Toofan. Later, the police had to release him.

"Drones getting caught every day"

Taking a dig at the recent development, the defence veteran, while speaking to the news agency ANI, said, "The law and order is not the Centre's subject. If they (Punjab Govt) are not able to handle it then the Government of India will have to take charge. There are drones getting caught every single day, I think Centre must see it."

Singh also raised grave questions over the visit of Mann to Mumbai where he met former Shiv Sena chief Uddhav Thackeray-- just a day after the Ajnala incident happened. "CM Bhagwant Mann is not interested in what is going on in Punjab. He is afraid of taking any steps. Police officials may have got orders not to take any steps during the Ajnala incident. The law and order have deteriorated in Punjab," he noted.

'SAVARKAR'S IDEOLOGY IS TO BOW BEFORE MIGHTY': RAHUL GANDHI QUESTIONS MODI GOVT'S 'DESHBHAKTI' MODEL



Former Congress president Rahul Gandhi, who is currently in Chhatisgarh's capital, Raiput, addressed the party delegates on the third and final day of the party's plenary session on Sunday. While addressing a gathering, Gandhi shared the memories that he cherished during the Bharat Jodo Yatra and recounted how he used to walk miles even though he was suffering from severe pain. He asserted that he had arrogance about his good health and added it was totally ruined during the 'Bharat Jodo Yatra' when he encountered severe leg pain. "I used to be an arrogant person, especially, when it comes to my health. However, it was totally ruined after he started Bharat Jodo Yatra. I used to receive messages from Bharat Mata and that gave me strength," he said. While addressing a cheering crowd in front of his mother, Sonia Gandhi, he also recounted how his family had a hard time when they were told to vacate their official house.



TIKTOK BAN IN US! WHITE HOUSE GIVES 30-DAY DEADLINE TO FEDERAL AGENCIES

The White House has ordered federal agencies to remove Chinese-owned video-sharing app TikTok from all government-issued devices within the next 30 days. The Office of Management and Budget director, Shalanda Young issued a memo requesting that government agencies "remove and disallow installations" of the app on agency-owned or operated IT devices, as well as "prohibit internet traffic" from such devices to the app. The US Congress had previously ordered a ban on TikTok, and the law signed by US President Joe Biden last month prohibits the use of the app on government-issued devices, as well as in the US House of Representatives and Senate. The ban will not affect businesses in the US or the millions of private citizens who use

the app. However, a bill has been introduced in Congress that would effectively ban TikTok from the country entirely, according to the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU). The ACLU opposes such a ban, arguing that it would violate Americans' constitutional right to freedom of speech and expression. Owned by Chinese tech giant ByteDance, TikTok has been the subject of political scrutiny due to concerns that it could be used for spying or propaganda by the Chinese Communist Party (CCP). These fears have been amplified in recent weeks, following the shooting down of a Chinese balloon that had traversed US airspace, as well as the Canadian government's decision to ban TikTok from its phones and other devices, citing fears about Beijing's access to user data.

PAKISTAN, IN THE POCKET OF CHINA, CUT ITS AID, SAYS US PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION 2024 CANDIDATE NIKKI HALEY



Nikki Haley, former US ambassador and Republican who recently announced her bid for 2024 US Presidential Elections has pitched her voice for snapping aid to Pakistan saying its in the pocket of China.

In a statement on Sunday, Nikki Haley said, "Belarus, in the pocket of Russia. Zimbabwe, in the pocket of China. Pakistan, in the pocket of China. Cut all their aid." "I will cut every cent in foreign aid for countries that hate us. A strong America doesn't pay off the bad guys. A proud America doesn't waste our people's hard-

earned money. And the only leaders who deserve our trust are those who stand up to our enemies and stand beside our friends," she wrote in an op-ed in the New York Post. "When I'm President, we will no longer give foreign aid to our enemies. We will stop that. (We) will start being smart, and will start being strong again," Haley told a US news channel. "They will be shocked to find that much of it goes to fund anti-American countries and causes. As president, I'll put a stop to this fiasco," she said. "It was a major victory for our troops, our taxpayers and our vital interests, but it didn't go nearly far enough. We've still given them way too much in other aid. As president, I will block every penny," she added. "Communist China for ridiculous environment programmes, despite the obvious threat China poses to Americans." "We give money to Belarus, which is Russian dictator Vladimir Putin's closest ally. We even give money to Communist Cuba — a country our own government has designated as a state sponsor of terrorism," she said. Nikki Haley, the 51-year-old two-term Governor of South Carolina and the former US Ambassador to the United Nations, had launched her 2024 presidential bid on February 15, 2023.



ANOTHER BLOW TO CHINA: COVID-19 LIKELY CAME FROM LAB LEAK IN WUHAN, CLAIMS US STUDY



The virus that drove the COVID-19 pandemic, killing close to 7 million people globally, most likely emerged from a laboratory leak in China, according to a US media report, citing a classified intelligence report recently provided to the White House and key members of Congress.

The Huanan market in central China's Wuhan city was the epicentre of the pandemic. From its origin there, the SARS-CoV-2 virus rapidly spread to other locations in Wuhan in late 2019 and then to the rest of the world.

The pandemic's origin has been the subject of vigorous debate among academics, intelligence experts and lawmakers. The findings of the US Department of Energy – a departure from previous studies on how the virus emerged – came in an update to a document from the Office of National Intelligence director Avril Haines, the Wall Street Journal reported on Sunday.

The new report highlights how different parts of the intelligence community have arrived at disparate judgments about the pandemic's origin.

The Energy Department now joins the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) in saying the virus likely spread via a mishap at a Chinese laboratory. Four other agencies, along with a national intelligence panel, still judge that it was likely the result of natural transmission, and two are undecided.

ZELENSKYY FIRES UKRAINE'S COMMANDER OF JOINT FORCES WEEKS AHEAD OF HIS WORK ANNIVERSARY



In a major development, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy fired the commander of the joint forces operation from his post on Sunday. According to a report by CNN, President Zelenskyy signed the decree for the removal of Major General Eduard Mykhailovich Moskalov but he did not mention the reason behind his concrete action. Moskalov's removal came weeks before he was about to complete his work anniversary in March. It is worth mentioning this was not the first time when Zelenskyy fired his top official. Ever since the war erupted against Russian forces, President Zelenskyy took staunch action against those involved in spying or other corruption charges. In the series of such actions, Zelenskyy had dismissed the deputy head of Ukraine's presidential office, Kyrylo Tymoshenko. On the same day, Deputy Defence Minister Viacheslav Shapovalov also resigned, local media reported, alleging his departure was linked to a scandal involving the purchase of food for the Ukrainian Armed Forces.


US PRAISES INDIA, SAYS ITS ROLE ON GLOBAL STAGE CONTINUES TO GROW

FIFA AWARDS: MESSI WINS BEST MEN'S PLAYER AWARD AFTER WORLD CUP HEROICS; SCALONI NAMED BEST MEN'S COACH

Lionel Messi added yet another piece of silverware to his impressive trophy cabinet as he landed the FIFA Best Men's Player of the Year award for 2022. The Argentine skipper inspired his homeland to their first FIFA World Cup title in 36 years in December 2022 which saw him score seven goals. Messi compatriot and coach Lionel Scaloni was named the Best Men's Coach for guiding the South American nation to World Cup glory.

Another feather in Cap

The 35-year-old beat French forwards Kylian Mbappe and Karim Benzema to the prize. Messi captained Argentina to World Cup glory in Qatar, and scored 27 goals in 49 games for club and country in 2021-22. Messi, who won the award for a second time, said: "It's amazing. It's been a tremendous year and it's an honour for me to be here and win this award. Without my team-mates I wouldn't be here. "I achieved the dream I had been hoping for for so long. Very few people can achieve that and I have been lucky to do so." At the ceremony in Paris, Lionel Scaloni, who led Argentina to their third World Cup title, was named men's coach of the year. Scaloni beat Pep Guardiola - who guided Manchester City to a sixth Premier League title - and Real Madrid's Champions League-winning boss Carlo Ancelotti to the honour. England manager Sarina Wiegman was named women's coach of the year after leading the Lionesses to European Championship glory on home soil last year, the team's first major trophy. Aston Villa and Argentina's Emiliano Martinez was recognised as the best men's goalkeeper, while England's Mary Earps won the women's award. Martinez, 30, helped his country win the World Cup, saving four penalties along the way including in the shootout victory against France in the final.



AUSTRALIA SET FOR MITCHELL STARC BOOST IN THIRD TEST MATCH AGAINST INDIA

Having lost the series with just two matches in, Australia would want to bring their A-game in the last two Tests in Indore and Ahmedabad. The team, however, is set to get a major boost in terms of Mitchell Starc, who feels that he is pretty much at full tilt. "It's good enough. There's going to be a level of discomfort. I don't think it is going to be 100% for a little while, but the ball is coming out quite nicely and I feel like I'm pretty much at full tilt." Starc further said that the only issue while bowling would be to deal with the discomfort or lack of sufficient mobility in the knee joint. "It's more the discomfort of the joint being restricted having been in a splint for six weeks and still having to be in a splint for another couple of weeks yet. That's probably the only part - dealing with the discomfort of it, getting the mobility back into it. That'll come over the next couple of weeks and it's progressed again, it's a progression each day I bowl. It's not a concern for me, the comfort levels - it's doing what I need it to do to be available to play." "It wouldn't be the first Test match I've played in some sort of discomfort. If I only played when I was at 100%, I would have only played five or ten Tests.

VIRAT DOESN'T GIVE REST TO FAST BOWLERS, SAYS MOHD SIRAJ

NEW DELHI, (IANS) Fast bowler Mohammad Siraj revealed his struggle to bowl talismanic batter Virat Kohli in the nets and said the former Indian skipper doesn't give rest to seamers to settle after delivering a bowl. "Pujji Bhai (Cheteshwar Pujara), he plays with a deep focus in Test cricket... Virat bhai does not give rest to the fast bowler. He gets ready immediately after hitting the shot, I don't even get time to settle," Siraj said on SG Cricket YouTube channel when asked which batsman he enjoys bowling in the nets. "After hitting the shot, the batsman looks here and there, but Virat Bhai... he gets ready immediately. He has this passion... his aggression, which is amazing about a superstar like him," he added.

'IT WASN'T MY FINEST MOMENT': SMITH OPENS UP ON DISMISSAL IN DELHI TEST

INDORE, (IANS) Australia batter Steven Smith has admitted he was furious with himself after being dismissed while attempting a sweep shot during the second Test in Delhi. He also said the Australian batters will aim to slow things down at the crease when they take on India in the third Test, starting on Wednesday here at Holkar Stadium. The 33-year-old fell victim to Indian ace spinner Ravichandran Ashwin for 9 while attempting his first sweep shot of the series on day three of the second Test in Delhi.

AUSTRALIA RELYING TOO MUCH ON SMITH. LABUSCHAGNE, SAYS GLENN MCGRATH

NEW DELHI, (IANS) Former Australian pacer Glenn McGrath has said that the Pat Cummins-led side is heavily dependent on Steve Smith and Marnus Labuschange in the ongoing Border-Gavaskar Trophy and added that the "whole batting line-up needs to stand up." "I think they're relying too much on (Steve) Smith and Marnus (Labuschagne) at the moment. Travis Head has had a really good year as well. The whole batting line-up has to stand up," McGrath said. Australia have already conceded the Border-Gavaskar trophy after suffering defeats in the first two Tests in Nagpur and Delhi, respectively, that drew heavy criticism on their approach and shot selection.
